QUICK NOTES

*Kentucky bounced back with back-to-back road sweeps over Alabama and Ole Miss last weekend. The Wildcats' defense paved the way, holding their opponents to .126 hitting in the two matches, as UK out-blocked the opposition, 27-10.

*For the third consecutive week, the Kentucky Wildcats claimed Southeastern Conference honors on Oct. 26, as the league office named sophomore Kaz Brown the Player of the Week and Defensive Player of the Week, while freshman right side Brooke Morgan was named the top freshman.

*Defense at the net has played a large role in UK's success in conference play, as UK ranks first in blocks per set in SEC. The team averages 3.11 blocks per frame in conference play, with Brown, Emily Franklin and senior Morgan Bergren all ranking among the top 10 blockers in league play.

*Bergren looks to further cement her place in UK history, as she continues to close in on the 3,500 career assists mark. She currently sits at 3,443 career assists, needing just 57 more to achieve the benchmark. Only four other Wildcats have eclipsed the 3,500 career assist mark.

*The Kentucky Wildcats are ranked No. 20 in the Oct. 26 AVCA poll. With the ranking, UK extends its ranking streak to 42 consecutive weeks, dating back to Aug. 18, 2012 - the longest streak in program history.

Last Time Out: Alabama and Ole Miss

The Kentucky Wildcats bounced back last weekend, following their first SEC loss with back-to-back road sweeps. UK began with a 3-0 (25-15, 25-22, 25-18) victory against the Crimson Tide before toppling Ole Miss, 3-0 (25-20, 25-18, 25-23) in Oxford, Miss.

A dominant defensive presence told the tale of both matches. The Wildcats stifling defense led to a weekend in which opponents were held to .126 hitting as Kentucky out-blocked opponents 27-10, averaging 4.50 rejections per frame during the six sets. Sophomore Kaz Brown was involved in 18 of the 27 team blocks, garnering her first career Player of the Week honor.

Scouting the Opponents

Texas A&M Aggies (13-6, 6-2, 31 RPI)

Key Wins: 3-2 vs. No. 4 Minnesota (6 RPI), 3-2 vs. Colorado State (36 RPI)
 Notable Losses: 0-3 at Stanford (12 RPI), 0-3 vs. Florida (1 RPI)
 Texas A&M enters its match with the Wildcats on a four-match winning streak including three sweeps the last three matches. Texas A&M will play UK coming off a nine-day hiatus, last playing LSU on Oct. 21. Preseason All-SEC selection Jazzmin Babers leads the Aggies' offense, averaging 3.56 kills per set in conference play.

LSU Tigers (9-11, 5-4, 99 RPI)

Key Wins: 3-1 vs. Xavier (RPI), 3-2 vs. Auburn (RPI)
 Notable Losses: 0-3 vs. Texas (RPI), 0-3 vs. Purdue (RPI)
 The Tigers enter Friday winning three of the past five matches including a sweep of Mississippi State. LSU, standing at 5-4 in league play sits in the middle of the standings, with five of its nine SEC matches so far being determined in five sets. Gina Tillis is the focal point of the LSU offense, averaging 4.03 kills per set during league matches.

Brown, Morgan Secure SEC Weekly Accolades

For the third consecutive week, the Kentucky Wildcats claimed Southeastern Conference honors on Oct. 26, as the league office named sophomore Kaz Brown the Player of the Week and Defensive Player of the Week, while freshman right side Brooke Morgan was named the top freshman.

Brown, en route to her first SEC Player of the Week honor, had a dominant presence at the net logging 18 blocks in six sets of play. With 10 blocks at Ole Miss, Brown tied for the most in an SEC match and most in a three-set SEC match in 2015. Her effort at the net was a large part of helping UK out-block opponents 27-10 in the two outings. Brown also added 14 kills on .345 hitting during the sweeps.

Morgan claimed her third Freshman of the Week honor following a weekend where she hit .520 for 15 kills with nine blocks in six sets. Morgan played a critical role on both sides of the ball and set a new career-best hitting percentage at Alabama, going 7-for-10 with no errors against the Crimson Tide.

Cats Lead SEC Play in Blocks Per Set

Defense at the net has played a large role in UK's success in conference play, as the Kentucky Wildcats rank first in blocks per set in SEC play. The team averages 3.11 blocks per frame in conference play, with sophomores Kaz Brown, Emily Franklin and senior Morgan Bergren all ranking among the top 10 blockers in league play. Brown leads SEC play with 1.78 blocks per set, Franklin ranks seventh with 1.12 and Bergren placed 10th with 1.06.

Senior setter Morgan Bergren looks to further cement her place in Kentucky volleyball history, as she continues to close in on the 3,500 career assists mark. The Muncie, Ind., native currently sits at 3,443 career assists, needing just 57 more to achieve the benchmark. Only four other Wildcats in Leigh Marcum (2002-05), Jane Belanger (1990-93), Laura Linder (1987-90) and Sarah Rumley (2006-09) have eclipsed the 3,500 assist mark. Additionally, only 20 active players in NCAA Division I have logged 3,500 or more assists in their career.

Brown, Dusek in National Top 25

Sophomores Kaz Brown and Ashley Dusek find themselves among the top 25 in the nation in respective statistical categories. Brown ranks in the top 25 in blocks and blocks per set, placing eighth in both categories, with 119 blocks averaging 1.57 per set in the 2015 campaign. Dusek currently ranks 24th in the country in digs per set, averaging 5.03.

Dusek's Digs, Brown's Blocks Lead Conference

Sophomore libero Ashley Dusek now leads the Southeastern Conference in digs per set, both in all matches (5.09 digs/set) and conference-only statistics (5.38 digs/set). Dusek's 382 total digs are a team best, with the East Bernard, Texas native logging including 166 in SEC action. Sophomore middle Kaz Brown leads the SEC in total blocks (52) and blocks per set (1.78) in league play.

Still Streaking

Following the Oct. 25 weekend, the Kentucky Wildcats are ranked yet again in the Oct. 26 AVCA poll, coming in at 20. With the ranking, UK extends its ranking streak to 42 consecutive weeks, dating back to Aug. 18, 2012. The 42-week streak is the longest ranked streak under head coach Craig Skinner and the longest in program history.

Defense Wins Championships

The Wildcats are living up to the old adage "defense wins championships." The Wildcats have held every in-conference opponent below its average hitting percentage this season. Over the season, UK has only allowed three opponents (Little Rock, Southern California and Wichita State) to hit better than their average.

Memorial Magic

Memorial Coliseum has been the home of the Wildcats for all 39 volleyball seasons, and the historic venue has provided the Wildcats with a home court advantage unlike any other. The Oct. 4 victory over

Wildcats Excel on the National Stage

The Wildcats have found a way to win this season while playing on a bigger

stage, as the team is 4-1 so far while competing in nationally televised outings. The Wildcats' second meeting with Florida marked the fifth time Kentucky appeared on a national broadcast this season. UK had 3-0 wins over South Carolina, Mississippi State and Arkansas earlier this season, as well as a 3-1 road upset over then-No. 5 Florida. UK is slated for nine regular-season national television broadcasts, each airing on the SEC Network.

Dusek Takes Home POTW, DPOW Honors

The Southeastern Conference announced its weekly volleyball honors on Monday, Oct. 19 with Kentucky sophomore Ashley Dusek taking home Player of the Week and Defensive Player of the Week honors. The recognition marked Dusek's second Defensive Player of the Week nod of the season and the first time in her career being named the league's top performer.

Dusek put on an incredible performance during the week's play, logging a jaw-dropping, league-high 7.56 digs a set, snagging 68 total digs over the span of nine sets. The sophomore's monster weekend was highlighted by a record-breaking performance at Auburn on Oct. 16. The East Bernard, Texas, native broke a 22-year-old record, setting the all-time record for digs in a single match with 40 against the Auburn Tigers. Dusek followed up her 40 dig performance by logging 28 more in four sets against No. 17 Florida in the lone top-25 matchup in the SEC during the past week. The loss to the Gators snapped a nine-game winning streak for the Cats, including an unscathed record in league play.

Dusek Sets Program Record in Auburn Win

Sophomore libero Ashley Dusek logged a career-best 40 digs during the five-set match with Auburn on Oct. 16, setting a new program record for digs in a single match. The previous record was set 22 years prior when Ann Hall logged 39 against the South Carolina Gamecocks on Oct. 22, 1993. Dusek is one of just six players to record 40 or more digs in a single match this season in NCAA Division I and the only one from a major conference to do so.

12 for the previous week's play. Bergren was the league's top performing player and setter, while Morgan hauled in Freshman of the Week accolades.

Bergren helped guide the Kentucky offense with 32 assists on 42 of the team's kills. She registered her second double-double of the season with the 32 assists and 11 digs. Bergren found a way to get everyone involved in the offense, with five different players recording five or more kills. Bergren contributed five kills as well. She also assisted at the net with three of UK's eight blocks. With the 11 digs, she led the team for the most in the match.

Morgan had nine kills and four blocks in the win over the Razorbacks. She averaged 3.00 kills per frame – well above her season average of 1.94. She utilized a .353 attacking clip in the win, and also added 1.33 blocks per set en route to her second career Freshman of the Week honor

Bergren Moves to Sixth All-Time in Assists

In the Oct. 2 win over Mississippi State, senior setter Morgan Bergren guided the Cats to .306 hitting with 32 assists. With the 32 assists, Bergren climbed to sixth all-time on Kentucky's career assists leaderboard, passing Irene Smyth (1993-1996), who recorded 3,195 in her time with the Wildcats. Bergren has 3,256 assists to date and looks to continue to climb the leaderboard, with Christine Hartmann's 3,497 the next milestone to reach at fifth all time.

Win over Alabama Marks Program's 400th in Memorial

The Kentucky program hit another milestone on Oct. 4, when the Wildcats logged their 400th program win inside the confines of Memorial Coliseum. The Wildcats have thrived historically inside Memorial, with a 401-153 record in 39 seasons, with Skinner recording a 139-32 mark during his time in the Cats' home venue.

Dusek, Morgan Earn SEC Weekly Honors

The Southeastern Conference announced its weekly honors for Sept. 28, with Kentucky sophomore libero Ashley Dusek earning Co-Defensive Player of the Week and freshman right-side hitter Brooke Morgan was named the conference's Freshman of the Week.

Dusek started the week with a strong showing at South Carolina where she notched 14 digs in three sets. She also got involved in the serving game with two aces. Dusek recorded her first kill of the year against the Gamecocks, with a set-clinching point at the end of the first frame. She continued to be a defensive stalwart against Florida where she tallied a team-high 18 digs in the match. Dusek also was perfect on serve-serve during the weekend.

Morgan began the weekend with seven kills and two blocks against the Gamecocks on Friday night where she hit .267 on the evening. The freshman sprung to life with a career match at No. 5 Florida, registering a personal-best 13 kills against the Gators on a red-hot .500 hitting clip. She also dug up three balls in the contest.

Cats Leave Gainesville with Big Win

The then-No. 24 Kentucky Wildcats had debatably its biggest win of the season on Sept. 27, leaving Gainesville, Fla., with a 3-1 (22-25, 55-23, 25-21, 25-21) victory over the then-No. 5 Florida Gators. It marked the first

time that the Wildcats defeated a top-five team since they defeated the No. 4 Minnesota Gophers on Sept. 14, 2013. It also marked the first road win for the Wildcats in Gainesville since Oct. 2, 2009 in which the Wildcats downed the

Morgan Has Career Outing at Florida

Freshman Brooke Morgan chose the right time to have a breakout match, stringing together a 13-kill performance against the then-No. 5 Florida Gators. Morgan found plenty of success on the slide, hitting at a .500 clip during the match – the second best of her career. Morgan has a history of playing up in big matches, as she set her career record for hitting percentage (.538) against the now No. 2 ranked Southern Cal Women of Troy.

Brown Named SEC Co-Defensive Player of the Week

Sophomore Kaz Brown was named SEC Co-Defensive Player of the Week on Sept. 21. In a breakout season,

Brown continued to impress over the week, where she averaged 2.88 kills per set on a .283 hitting clip and had a staggering 2.62 blocks per set. The sophomore had two phenomenal outings during the week, first posting 13 kills and tying her then-career best eight blocks at Xavier before an unbelievable defensive outing against Louisville in which she had 10 kills and 13 blocks. Brown leads the team in total points (168.5), blocks (62) and hitting percentage (.344) this season while placing second on the team in kills (133) and kills per set (3.02).

Looking Back: Auburn and Florida

Kentucky extended its winning streak to nine straight with an exhilarating five set, 3-2 (22-25, 25-22, 23-25, 25-21, 15-12) win on the road against Auburn before dropping its first match of the SEC season, 3-1 (25-22, 21-25, 22-25, 20-25) on Sunday to the No. 17 Florida Gators.

Against Auburn, the Wildcats relied on an impressive defensive effort once again to earn the five-set win. The team registered 93 digs and 17 blocks – both season highs - to hold the Tigers to .144 hitting. Sophomores Ashley Dusek and Emily Franklin both contributed heavily to the effort with career nights. Dusek logged a career-best 40 digs during the night, setting a new program record for digs in a match. Franklin had a career night with 10 blocks – including two solo stops. The Mesa, Ariz., native also added nine kills and four digs.

In the loss to Florida, Dusek had another impressive match for the Wildcats with a match-high 28 digs. Junior outside hitter Anni Thomasson and senior setter Morgan Bergren both logged double-doubles for the Blue and White. Thomasson posted 11 kills and 12 digs, while Bergren registered 43 assists and 11 dug balls on the afternoon. Sophomore Darian Mack paced the attack with a team-best 14 kills, while classmate Emily

Franklin notched a career-best 13 on a blazing .579 attacking percentage.

Looking Back: Mississippi State and Alabama:

The Wildcats extended their winning streak to seven straight including a perfect 4-0 record in Southeastern Conference play, blanking Mississippi State 3-0 (25-17, 25-20, 25-20) on Friday, Oct. 2, before defeating Alabama in four on Oct. 4, 3-1 (25-19, 27-25, 24-26, 25-20).

Senior setter Morgan Bergren led the Kentucky offense to a pair of sets in which the Cats utilized a hitting clip of .394 or better in the win over Mississippi State. The sophomore duo of Kaz Brown and Darian Mack benefited from Bergren's distribution, as Brown notched 12 kills on a blazing .429 hitting clip with Mack contributing 11 kills on .333 hitting.

In the win over Alabama, the Wildcats had to fend off a late charge by the visiting Tide who rallied to take set three and prolong the match. Kentucky logged 13 total blocks on the night – nine of which Brown was involved in. Junior Anni Thomasson registered her fourth double-double of the season to aid the Wildcat cause with 13 digs and 11 kills.

Looking Back: South Carolina and Florida

Kentucky finished its opening weekend undefeated in the Southeastern Conference, going on the road where the team first swept South Carolina, 3-0 (25-15, 25-22, 25-18), before taking down the then-No. 5 Florida Gators in an upset, 3-1 (22-25, 55-23, 25-21, 25-21).

Sophomore Darian Mack led the way for the Wildcats in the last two matches, posting 16 and 15 kills against South Carolina and Florida, respectively. Sophomore libero Ashley Dusek (32 digs, 1 kill, 2 aces, 5 assists) and freshman Brooke Morgan (20 kills, 2 blocks) also had outstanding weeks,

Brown Has Milestone Match against Louisville

Sophomore Kaz Brown had an incredible match against Louisville, in which she became the first UK middle to record a double-double in a match since Queen Nzenwa in 2007 with a 10-kill, 13-block performance. Her 13 rejections also marked a new UK record for blocks in the 25-point rally scoring era and a new career high, while her 11 block assists against the Cards set a new Kentucky best for individual block assists in a four-set match during the rally-scoring era.

Thomasson Shines in Return against Louisville

Junior Anni Thomasson returned to full action for the first time since Sept. 1 against the Louisville Cardinals and looked to be back in form. The junior outside had her 19th career double-double, registering 13 kills and 13 digs in the match. With the double-double, Thomasson moves into sole possession of fourth on the career double-doubles list for the 25-point rally scoring era, needing just three more to tie for third with Christine Hartmann (2009-12).

One For the Books

Sophomore libero Ashley Dusek wrote a piece of Kentucky volleyball history on Sept. 12 against Northern Illinois, where she became the first libero in the rally scoring era to record a double-double with 11 assists and 10 digs.

Bergren Named Candidate for Senior CLASS Award

Premier Sports Management, Inc., announced the candidates for the 2015 Senior Class Award on Wed., Sept. 9, with Kentucky senior setter Morgan Bergren being tabbed as one of the 30 candidates for the annual honor. Bergren is one of six players on the list to have garnered All-America honors by the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) in 2014 and is one of 25 candidates to hold a 3.0 GPA or higher. A national media committee narrows this field to 10 finalists per sport approximately eight weeks before the NCAA championship. Public fan voting on the Senior CLASS Award website takes place each year during the month leading up to the NCAA Championship.

Breakout Weekend for Barnes

Sophomore Sharay Barnes had a breakout performance during the Shocker Volleyball Classic, making starts against both Wichita State and Northern Illinois. In nine sets played, the outside

hitter/middle blocker tallied 28 kills, while setting single match highs in kills, with 16 against Wichita State, and hitting percentage, going .600 against Northern Illinois.

Front Line Defense Shines vs. No. 7 Illinois

Despite dropping the match in three sets, the Kentucky front line came to play against No. 7 Illinois, tying the record for block assists in a three set match during the 25-point rally scoring era with 26. Sophomore Kaz Brown led the team with a career-high-tying eight block assists, while freshman Brooke Morgan followed with a career-high six. Sophomore Emily Franklin tied her season best, registering five in the effort. Senior setter Morgan Bergren (3), sophomore Darian Mack (2) and freshman Anna Nyberg (2) all made multiple blocks as well.

Cats in the Top 10

On Aug. 31, the Wildcats were named No. 10 in the nation by the AVCA. It marked the first time the team had been in the top 10 since the team was ranked 10th in the Aug. 28 poll in 2012. The Cats are currently in the midst of a 35-week streak being ranked in the AVCA poll.

Memorial Coliseum to Host NCAA Regionals

UK is one of four sites selected for the Sweet 16 and Elite Eight matchups with one team advancing to the Final Four in Omaha, Neb., from the Lexington Region. This marks the third time in five seasons Memorial Coliseum will host this premier volleyball event. Kentucky advanced to the Sweet 16 and played in front of the largest crowd in the Craig Skinner era in 2011 where the unseeded Wildcats took No. 1 Texas to the brink. The Longhorns prevailed by a 3-1 score, but no set score was decided by more than two points.

Looking Back: Rigorous Non-Conference Slate Prepares UK for SEC Play

The Wildcats non-conference schedule didn't hold back, as Kentucky built a 7-5 record during play outside of the SEC. UK, despite having a young team, scheduled talented opponents, facing eight teams that ranked in the top 70 of the Rich Kern Power Index in Southern California (2), Illinois (15), Louisville (21), Ohio (24), Creighton (26), Michigan State (35), Northern Iowa (65) and Wichita State (66).

Due to injuries and adjustments throughout the season, all 13 members

of the Kentucky roster have seen action in 2015, with 12 playing in 20 or more sets during the out-of-conference schedule.

The sophomore duo of Darian Mack and Kaz Brown headed up the offense in the first 12 matches. Mack led the Wildcats with 144 kills, averaging 3.32 kills per set, while Brown added a team second-best 133 kills while tallying an additional 53 blocks – a team-best and second in the conference. The Wildcats also logged a 1-2 record against ranked opponents during out-of-conference play, beginning the season with a five-set win over No. 19 Michigan State before falling in sweeps to No. 8 Southern Cal and No. 7 Illinois.

Cats Dominant in Win over Northern Iowa

UK had a great all-around performance in the four-set win against Northern Iowa. On offense, the team logged a season-best 67 kills. The 67 kills ties the most kills in a four-set Kentucky match during the 25-point rally scoring era. During the match, five players had double figure kills in the match (Darian Mack, 17; Kaz Brown, 13; Anna Nyberg, 12; Brooke Morgan, 10; Sara Schwarzwald, 10). It marked the first time four or more players had 10 or more kills since the team played Georgia Southern on September 13, 2014. Ashley Dusek had 31 digs, making her the only UK player to log 30 or more digs in multiple matches since the beginning of the 25-point rally scoring era.

The matchup with Northern Iowa also proved to be a big night for many individuals on the team, with five players setting or tying 10 career-bests, while two others made or tied five season-highs. Three career records were set for kills (Mack, 17; Nyberg, 12; Morgan, 10). Morgan (5) and Nyberg (2) also had a career-record five blocks, while Brown tied her career-best eight blocks. Dusek set new highs for assists (7) and service aces (3), while fellow defensive specialist McKenzie Watson had new highs in digs (9) and assists (3). Senior Morgan Bergren had a season-best 11 digs while tying her season-high five kills and three blocks. Classmate Sara Schwarzwald had season highs in kills (10) while tying her season-high with three blocks.

Dusek Silver Lining in UNI Tournament

Dusek earned All-Tournament honors at UNI, logging 60 digs in three matches for a whopping 6.00 digs per set over the weekend. Dusek also provided four service aces during the three matches. Dusek enters this weekend on five consecutive matches charting 10 or more digs.

Mack's Career Night vs. Ohio

Darian Mack set new personal bests in the loss to Ohio, as the sophomore outside hitter posted her second double-double of the season. Mack had 15 kills and 15 digs in the effort, both marking new personal bests. Mack has seen an increased role in 2015, where she's started in every match, and is currently leads the team in kills (117).

Career Night for Brown

The season opener against No. 19 Michigan State marked a career night for Kaz Brown, as the sophomore middle blocker doubled her previous single game high of 10 kills against Oakland in the first round of 2014's NCAA Tournament. Brown's 20 marks the most kills for a UK middle blockers since the beginning of the 25-point rally scoring era. It marked the first time that a UK player had 20 or more kills since Lauren O'Conner did so with 21 against Georgia last season (11/7/14). Brown is the first middle blocker to log 20 or more kills in a match since Queen Nzenwa and Nicole Britenriker each turned the trick in 2007.

Dusek Cracks the Record Books

In addition to Brown's career night, sophomore libero Ashely Dusek also had an impressive match against No. 19 Michigan State. Dusek made history, registering 34 digs, the most ever in a five-set match in UK history in the 25-point rally scoring era. Dusek becomes just the second Wildcat to log 30 or more digs in a match, joining former player BriAnne Sauer. After her 31-dig performance vs. Northern Iowa, Dusek is also the only UK player during the 25-point rally scoring era to log multiple games with 30 or more digs.

Bergren Tabbed to Preseason All-SEC Team

Senior Morgan Bergren was named to the preseason All-Southeastern Conference team as voted on by the league's coaches, while the Wildcats were tapped to finish third in the league standings. Bergren led UK with

1,291 assists in 2014, the second most in a single season in program history in the 25-point rally scoring era. The Muncie, Ind., native directed the UK offense to a .272 hitting percentage and a Southeastern Conference-best 14.25 kills per set, both the highest totals by the Wildcats since 2009. Along with earning American Volleyball Coaches Association second-team All-America accolades as well as All-Region honors, she was an All-SEC selection as a junior. Bergren earned SEC Player of the Week honors on Oct. 6, 2014 after she led UK to a .306 attacking percentage with six players averaging 1.29 kills per set or better in Kentucky's wins over Alabama and No. 21 Texas A&M. Bergren had 43 or more assists in each win and added 11 kills on .579 hitting with no errors.

Wildcats Ranked in the Preseason Again

For a program-record fourth consecutive year, the Kentucky volleyball team will begin the season ranked in the American Volleyball Coaches Association's preseason top-25 after the Wildcats earned a No. 15 ranking in the poll. UK's spot in the top 25 poll marks the sixth time in the last seven years in which the Wildcats have earned a place in the preseason poll, all under 11th-year head coach, Craig Skinner. The preseason ranking marks the 77th time under Skinner the Wildcats have been ranked in the preseason, weekly or final poll by the AVCA. Kentucky debuted at No. 17 in 2013 and has been ranked in the top 25 every week since then.

Wildcats Earn AVCA Academic Award

For the first time in head coach Craig Skinner's tenure, the Kentucky volleyball team has earned the American Volleyball Coaches Association (AVCA) Team Academic Award for the 2014-15 season. The Wildcats posted a GPA above a 3.3 both semesters in 2014-15, including a 3.563 in the spring, the second-highest GPA among all UK teams. The team's 3.378 GPA among scholarship student-athletes in the fall of 2014 ranked seventh among all UK teams.

2015 Class Ranked No. 10 in the Nation

Kentucky's incoming class comprised of setter Olivia Dailey, middle blocker Brooke Morgan, outside hitter Anna Nyberg and defensive specialist McKenzie Watson has earned the distinction as PrepVolleyball.com's

10th rated class for 2015. The 2015 class marks the sixth top-20 class in Craig Skinner's tenure. Since Skinner's arrival, the Wildcats have hauled in nine classes rated in the top 30 of PrepVolleyball.com's rankings including his very first class in 2006 which came in at No. 26. That class included future Southeastern Conference Player of the Year and two-time All-American setter Sarah Rumely. In all, Kentucky has recruited 12 players who have garnered 17 All-America accolades during their careers. Players from these recruiting classes have notched 20 All-SEC distinctions and at least one member of every freshman class has earned an All-SEC Freshman team nod during Skinner's tenure.

Bergren and Team USA

Kentucky volleyball junior setter Morgan Bergren was selected as one of six setters to the U.S. Collegiate National Team this summer. The 36-member team trained and competed in conjunction with the USA Volleyball Girls' Junior National Championships, June 21-29 in New Orleans, La. Bergren led her squad to the championship of the event. UK's senior setter also competed for the U.S. Collegiate National Team last summer during a 10-day trip to China.

Ten In Ten

Kentucky is one of just 10 teams in the country to advance to the NCAA tournament in each of the last 10 seasons. UK joins Colorado State, Florida, Hawai'i, Nebraska, Penn State, Southern California, Stanford, Texas and Washington in achieving the feat.

NCAA Revival Under Skinner

When head coach Craig Skinner arrived in Lexington prior to the 2005 season, UK had made six NCAA Tournaments, most recently in 1993 and never in more than two consecutive seasons. Ten years later, the Wildcats have advanced to the postseason in each of Skinner's 10 seasons. Kentucky made its first NCAA Tournament under Skinner in 2005, won its first postseason match since 1992 in 2006 and advanced to the Sweet 16 in 2009. UK's Sweet 16 run in 2009 was UK's first regional appearance since 1993 and the first time the Wildcats had won two NCAA matches in the same season since 1989. Five times under Skinner's leadership, UK has earned a national seed and hosted the first and second rounds.

Since being tabbed Kentucky's head coach in December 2004, Craig Skinner has rejuvenated the Kentucky volleyball program into a national prominence once again. Skinner has directed the Wildcats to **10** consecutive NCAA Tournaments - a feat only 12 other schools in the nation have achieved. That run includes **THREE** Sweet Sixteen appearances in the last six seasons. Furthermore, the Wildcats have captured **17 or more victories** in all **10** seasons under Skinner's direction, including tallying **20 or more wins** in **SEVEN** of the last **EIGHT**, including 2014.

He became the fastest coach in school all-time to total 100 career victories in just his fifth season, and is the only coach in program history to advance to postseason play in each season at the helm. With the team's 3-1 victory over Georgia Southern on Sept. 13, 2014, he eclipsed Kathy DeBoer as the winningest coach in UK volleyball history.

Twelve players have garnered 18 All-America distinctions, while UK has hauled in 37 All-Southeastern Conference honors in his 10 seasons - including the 2008 SEC Player of the Year, 2006 SEC Freshman of the Year, 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2014 SEC Libero of the Year and the 2005 SEC Defensive Player of the Year.

The Wildcats have enjoyed unprecedented success which has included a school-record run of 42 consecutive weeks ranked in the top 25 of the American Volleyball Coaches Association poll, record-breaking attendance marks and a six-time host of NCAA Tournament play including serving as one of four host sites for the 2011 and 2013 NCAA Regionals. UK is slated to host against in 2015.

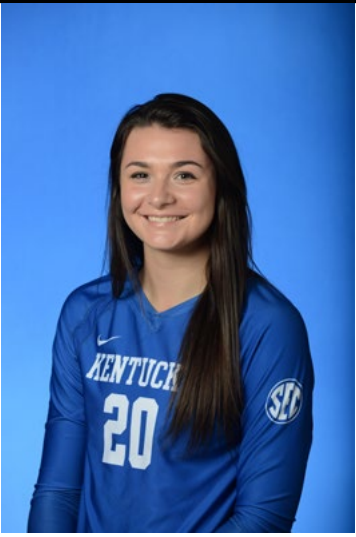
