TERRIER TIDBITS

- BU last went on a five-game road trip in the 2007-08 season ... Opened with win against Yale and head coach Joe Jones' older brother, James, before dropping four straight.
- John Papale, Cheddi Mosely and Kyle Foreman have combined for 39 of BU's 45 3FGs ... BU ranks 9th nationally in made 3FGs at 11.3.
- Papale has hit five 3FGs in three straight to rank second in the NCAA in made 3FGs (4.75) ... Earned back-

- to-back 21-pt. performances vs. Albany and at NJIT after reaching 20+ points a combined two times his first three years ... Ranks third at BU all-time in career treys (211) and needs 46 more points to reach 1,000.
- The reigning back-to-back PL Rookie of the Week Kyle Foreman is shooting a team-high 56.8 FG % to average 13.8 ppg while also averaging a team-high 5.8 apg.
- Opponents are averaging 7.8 more made FTs per game than the Terriers and are out-rebounding BU by 6.7 rpg.
- Nathan Dieudonne owns the team's lone double-double this season with 10 points and 10 rebounds vs. Northeastern.
- In the loss to NJIT, the Highlanders shot 47.8 percent ... The Terriers have dropped their last 18 games when an opponent reaches the 45 FG% threshold ... BU's last win came against American during the regular season in 2014 when the Eagles shot 46.0 FG% and still lost 71-62.
- Saturday's win at South Florida marked BU's first-ever win against the American Athletic Conference and the program's first over a major conference opponent since winning at Maryland in 2013 ... The Bulls went 0-of-10 3FG to become the first opponent in at least 17 years to fail to hit a 3FG.
- Mosely has led BU in scoring twice already after doing it just once last season ... Classmate Nick Havener (5.0 ppg, 5.rpg) already owns 20 points after tallying 15 total last year.

GAME PREVIEW

- BU resumes its five-game road trip with the Terriers' third visit to Rupp Arena in the last six years.
- The contest marks the final game of the Basketball Hall of Fame Classic following a 69-64 home win over Albany, 90-76 loss at NJIT and 78-66 victory at South Florida.
- BU is looking for its first victory against a ranked team since beating Navy in the 1959 NCAA Sweet 16.
- BU is playing back-to-back major conference opponents for 1st time since facing Kansas St., Indiana and Georgia Tech during 2009 Puerto Rico Tip-Off.

SEASON PREVIEW

- BU was selected 2nd in the Patriot League preseason poll.
- Led by 5th-year head coach Joe Jones, BU is coming off 13-17 (9-9 PL) season in which it finished .500 or greater in conference play for 15th straight season ... He seeks his 3rd postseason appearance after reaching 2013 CIT & 2014 NIT.
- The Terriers return every scholarship athlete for the second time in three seasons ... In 2013-14 as a first-year member in the Patriot League, BU went 24-11 (second most wins in program history) and 15-3 in league play to claim the program's first conference regular season title since 2004.

WEEKLY HONORS

- After being blanked last season for first time in program history, BU has claimed three awards already this year ... Monday's conference sweep was BU's first since 1995-96.
- Kyle Foreman is the third-ever PL freshman and first since 1997-98 to open career with two Rookie of the Week honors ... Averaged 13.3 ppg, 5.3 apg and 4.7 rpg.
- John Papale earned his first career weekly award after averaging 19.7 ppg and shooting 55.6 3FG% in three games.

BU-KENTUCKY NOTES

- Rick Pitino got his first head coaching job at BU from 1978-83 ... Led UK to victory over BU in 1994 (90-49) ... Took BU to first NCAA appearance since 1959 in 1983 ... One guard on team was current 76ers head coach Brett Brown ('83).
- BU last visited the famed Rupp Arena one year ago ... 2015 All-PL honoree Cedric Hankerson tallied 24 points against the No. 1 Wildcats, who only led 40-35 at the half and 66-57 at 8:29.
- Calipari is 6-1 all-time vs. the Terriers ... Lone loss came against BU in 1988 at UMass (80-78).
- Senior Nathan Dieudonne was named Kentucky's Mr. Basketball (1st private school winner in 50 years) and Gatorade Player of the Year in 2012 after leading Trinity H.S. (Louisville) to state title ... Had 12 pts. & 12 rebs. to earn 71-53 win at Rupp Arena vs. Scott County.
- John Papale is making 100th appearance tonight.

2014-15 CONFERENCE HONORS

- Cedric Hankerson was named to the All-PL 2nd Team ... Lone All-PL rep to rank in PL for steals (2nd, 1.8 spg), points (3rd, 15.9 ppg), assists (13th, 2.6 apg) and rebounds (17th, 4.6 rpg).
- Cheddi Mosely (10.1 ppg in PL) earned All-Rookie honors, giving BU its fourth recipient in three seasons, joining current teammates Hankerson and John Papale.

NEWCOMERS

- BU has brought in just one scholarship freshman with two recruited walk-ons.
- 6-foot-1 guard Kyle Foreman was the No. 6 ranked player in the state of Washington ... Earned All-State Second Team accolades ... Two-time Kingco League Defensive Player of the Year.
- Kamali Chambers was a three-time All-Metro Team honoree at Hopkins H.S. (Minn.) before helping lead Brewster Academy (N.H.) to National Prep School title ... Older brother is Harvard's three-time All-Ivy honoree Siyani Chambers.
- Brandon Johnson earned All-PENSAC Class A

honors at Loomis Chaffee Prep School (Conn.).

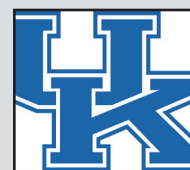
SCHEDULE HIGHLIGHTS

- 14 home games, including four against defending conference champions (CAA's Northeastern, America East's Albany, Ivy League's Harvard and Patriot League's Lafayette).
- Nine games vs. 2014-15 postseason participants, including NCAA Final Four member Kentucky.
- 4 of first 5 opponents are coming off 20+ win seasons - NU, Albany, CIT participant NJIT and UK.

SENIOR LEADERSHIP

- Alston, Dieudonne and Papale have helped lead BU to two postseason appearances (2014 NIT, 2013 CIT) and an overall record of 54-41 (.568) ... In three years of conference play (2 in PL, 1 in America East), they are 35-17 (.673).
- Alston has repeated last two years as the team's most improved player ... In 2014-15, reached 10+ scoring 10 times after reaching mark once his first two years ... He also earned his first double-double with 10 points and 11 boards vs. Navy ... His .571 shooting percentage was the 10th-best mark in a season at BU ... Finished 12th in the PL at 5.4 rpg after averaging 1.5 rpg his first two years.
- Dieudonne finished 2nd in PL at 7.4 rpg, best mark at BU since Kevin Gardner averaged 7.4 rpg in 2005-06 ... Reached double figures 19 times after hitting mark a combined seven times his first two seasons ... Tallied six dbl-dbls, highlighted by a career-high 14 rebs. at Loyola with 11 points.
- Papale played 1,111 minutes last year, fifth most ever in a season at BU while most probably breaking school record for minutes per game (37.0 mpg) ... Ranks ninth in "Shooters Analytics Geeks Love" from the 2015-16 edition of Jay Bilas' *The Bilasator* ... He was the top shooter from dribble handoffs last season in the NCAA with a 78.3 effective FG% ... Had assist-turnover ratio of 2.55, fourth best mark in a season at BU, after serving primarily as a shooter his first two years ... Finished eighth in PL in assists at 3.4 apg.

BOMBS AWAY

• Currently riding streak of 591 games with at least one made 3-pointer ... Run began following 0-for-10 performance against Vermont on 2-10-96.

POSTSEASON HISTORY

• By winning the 2014 PL regular season title, Terriers earned their 15th overall postseason appearance with a trip to the NIT ... (7-NCAA, 5-NIT, 1-CBI, 1-CIT).
 • Reached first round of CIT in 2013, the second round of NAAs in 2011 and CBI semifinals in 2010 ... Best performance came in 1959 with trip to NCAA Elite Eight.

ACTIVE CONFERENCE STREAK

• With 9-9 PL record, BU extended its streak of finishing .500 or greater in conference action to 15 seasons (5-13 in 2000).
 • During the streak, BU has reached 10+ wins in 10 seasons, including six of the last seven years ... Finished at .500 twice.
 • Tied for 11th nationally with Memphis and VCU ... Xavier leads at 32 seasons ... Florida, Wisconsin and Norfolk State are tied for eighth at 16 seasons.

MORE ON HANKERSON

• The junior became the second Terrier to earn PL preseason All-Conference honors, joining D.J. Irving ('14) ... He reached 20+ points eight times and led BU in scoring 15 times while also leading in rebounding six times and in assists 12 times ... His 72 3-pointers were the seventh most ever in a season at BU ... Had career-high 26 points plus 10 rebounds for his first career double-double at New Hampshire ... Tallied 24 points at Kentucky.

COACH JONES MILESTONES

• Joe Jones earned his 60th BU win vs. Quinnipiac last season ... The contest marked his 300th career collegiate game as a head coach.
 • Jones participated in his 600th collegiate game as a coach against UMass Lowell on Nov. 30, 2014.
 • Claimed 150th win as a coach vs. Navy.
 • Win vs. Army made him the fifth BU coach to reach 70+ wins.

2013-14 HIGHLIGHTS

• 24 wins, one win shy of BU record set in 96-97.
 • Claimed first regular season title since 2004.
 • Hosted 1st-ever NIT game vs. Illinois at Agganis.
 • Won at Maryland for second ACC road win in four years (won at BC in 2011).
 • Owned seven non-conference wins before start of league play, most since 1993-94 ... First winning non-conference schedule (7-6) since 6-3 in 04-05.
 • Shot 45.2%, BU's highest mark since 1992-93 ... Shot school-record 66.1% in PL QF vs. Lafayette.

THIRD YEAR IN THE PATRIOT LEAGUE

• BU officially joined the Patriot League on July 1, 2013 and moved 20 of 24 sports into conference ... BU was previously a member of the America East from 1979-2013.
 • Terriers have won the last two Patriot League Women's Presidents' Cups.

ABOUT BOSTON UNIVERSITY

• Established in 1839, BU has over 32,000 students and 16,300 undergrads from over 135 countries ... There are over 4,000 faculty and 288,000 living alumni.
 • Two have won a Nobel Peace Prize ... Former lecturer Elie Wiesel was honored in 1986 ... Rev. Martin Luther King, Jr. (1964) earned his Ph.D. at BU in 1955.

• #37 - U.S. News Best Global University rankings.
 • First university in the country to open all divisions to women, including med school in 1873.
 • BU professor Alexander Graham Bell invented the telephone in a BU lab.
 • Other famous former students include commentators Howard Stern and Bill O'Reilly, actress Geena Davis, actress Faye Dunaway, actress Julianne Moore, 1980 Olympic hero Mike Eruzione, MLB Hall of Famer Mickey Cochrane, former U.S. Secretary of Defense William Cohen, ESPN/Grantland personality Bill Simmons, former world jump record holder John Thomas and 1968 400m hurdles Olympic gold medalist David Hemery.

NBA COACHING TREE

• BU currently has ties to a pair of NBA head coaches ... 1980 team MVP Brett Brown ('83) is in his third season as the head coach of the Philadelphia 76ers ... Bobcats head coach Steve Clifford was an assistant at BU from 1990-94.
 • Former Terrier head coaches Rick Pitino ('78-'83) and John Kuester ('83-'85) previously had stints in the NBA as well.

BU OFFSPRING ALL-STARS

• The 2015 NBA All-Star game featured two offspring of former BU players on Eastern squad.
 • Kyrie Irving's father, BU Hall of Famer Drederick Irving, played 1984-88 ... 3rd all-time - 1,931 pts.
 • Jeff Teague's father, Shawn Teague, played 1982-85 ... 2nd all-time - 600 assists.

TEAM IMPACT

• In fall of 2012, Dylan Flynn became a member of BU's squad through Team IMPACT, a non-profit chartered to improve the quality of life for children facing life-threatening illnesses by establishing and expanding vibrant team-based support networks.
 • Flynn was diagnosed early in life with neurofibromatosis ... Team presented him with his own jersey at the 2013 banquet in April ... Players recently joined him at the Steps2Cure NF Walk at Lake Quannapowitt in Wakefield, Mass., for the second consecutive year.

GRADUATION SUCCESS RATE

• In Oct., NCAA announced that men's basketball was one of 11 BU teams to earn a perfect 100 GSR ... Data reflects an aggregate average of incoming students from 2005-06, 06-07, 07-08 and 08-09.

MEET JOE JONES

• Jones joined BU after serving as associate head coach at Boston College in June 2011 after helping the Eagles reach 2011 NIT 2nd Round.
 • Joe Jones and his staff BU were named second toughest to recruit against at the mid-major level by ESPN's Jeff Goodman in the summer of 2013.
 • Served as head coach at Columbia (2003-10) and assistant at Villanova (1997-03) & Hofstra (94-97).
 • In 2006-07, Columbia went 16-12, earning the program's most wins since 1991-92 ... The Class of 2010 would finish with 26 Ivy League victories, marking the most conference wins by a Columbia class since the Class of 1994.
 • His older brother, James, is in his 16th season as head coach at Yale.

TURNPIKE TROPHY

• BU and Holy Cross announced over the summer the creation of an all-sports competition between the two in-state rivals ... Each regular season and potential postseason game will count as one point apiece for the final standings.

JOE JONES HEAD COACH

FIFTH SEASON • SUNY OSWEGO '87, '89



With over 20 years of coaching experience, Joe Jones enters the 2015-16 season in his fifth year at the helm with the Boston University men's basketball team, as the Terriers look to claim their third postseason berth in four years.

During his tenure, he has led BU to four top-four finishes in the conference standings, including a Patriot League regular season title in 2014 and No. 2 finish in the 2013 America East schedule. Both of those performances led to postseason berths, the 2014 National Invitation Tournament and the 2013 CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament.

Jones has coached eight All-Conference Team honorees, including 2012 America East Player of the Year Darryl Partin and most recently All-Patriot League Second Team honoree Cedric Hankerson, who was the lone PL player to earn a conference ranking in points, rebounds, assists and steals. At least one Terrier has earned All-Rookie accolades in each of the last three years, including Cheddi Moseley in 2015.

This past season, a youthful BU squad was without a senior and only had two returning starters in the lineup to open the year for the first time since 2005. Still, the Terriers managed to extend their streak of finishing with a record of .500 or better in conference play to 15 seasons, which is tied for 12th longest in the nation. Highlights of the year include Hankerson scoring 24 points at then-No. 1 Kentucky and swiping a program-record nine steals against American to help BU sweep the Eagles for the first time since joining the conference. Three men earned at least one double-double with Nathan Dieudonne tallying six as a junior after earning just one his first two years at BU.

The 2013-14 season proved to be a memorable one, as BU finished atop the conference standings for the first time since 2004. The Terriers went 15-3 in league play and finished with a 24-11 overall record for the second most wins in school history and just one win shy of the record set in 1996-97. After making their 16th overall appearance in a conference championship final, they advanced to the NIT for the team's second consecutive postseason appearance following the 2013 CIT.

In-season highlights include Jones becoming the first-ever BU coach to claim two victories against the 61-year-old Atlantic Coast Conference when the Terriers won at Maryland (83-77) on Dec. 21 after topping Boston College (75-61) at Conte Forum in 2011. Under his guidance, BU averaged 71.2 ppg and finished the year shooting 45.2 percent from the field, the team's highest mark since 1992-93. The team set two team records with 64 points in a first half against UMass Lowell and a 66.1 shooting percent mark against Lafayette in the Patriot League tournament.

Individually, Maurice Watson Jr. set a school and Patriot League record with 248 assists in a season while also tallying 74 steals, second most in a season. D.J. Irving finished his collegiate career ranked ninth in scoring, while classmate Dom Morris became just the sixth Terrier in program history to reach 1,000 points and 700 rebounds.

On the defensive end, BU went 17-3 when holding opponents below 70 points and led a conference in turnover margin for the first time since 2005 at +1.91. Season highlights included holding fellow Patriot League member Navy to its lowest offensive output (32) since 1943 and limiting the league's top scoring offense (Lafayette) to just 54 points in a 91-54 rout. The margin of victory was the largest ever for a Patriot League quarterfinal game.

The strong regular season and conference tournament performances helped BU earn the opportunity to host Big Ten member Illinois at Agganis Arena in front of a national television audience on ESPN2. The National Invitation Tournament appearance marked the Terriers' first since 2005 and the program's fourth overall postseason berth in the last five seasons.

BU's success was a continuation of the momentum built from the 2012-13 season. Despite being banned from the 2013 America East tournament due to the move to the Patriot League, the Terriers (17-13, 11-5 AE) finished second in the league standings and swept both of the conference tournament finalists en route to the CollegeInsider.com Tournament.

Besides the tournament ban, the 2012-13 season was presented with many other challenges, including the graduation of six players from the previous season. With a recruiting class heralded by ESPN.com as one of the best at the mid-major level, BU started two freshmen in the season opener for the first time since 2006. The Terriers would go on to lead the conference in field goal shooting percentage (.449) for the first time since 1994 and in assists (13.6 per game) for the first time since 2004. On the defensive end, they held nine straight non-conference opponents below 70 points, a feat last seen over 50 years ago.

In Jones' first season on Commonwealth Ave., the Terriers went 12-4 (.750) in America East action, marking the best-ever winning percentage in conference play by a first-year head coach in BU history. They finished 16-16 after facing a challenging non-conference schedule that included 11 of 15 games away from home.

BU named Joe Jones, who was most recently the associate head coach at Boston College, the 25th head coach of the men's basketball program, on June 23, 2011. He left BC after helping the Eagles go 21-13 and advance to the second round of the NIT.

Prior to joining the Eagles, Jones served as head coach at Columbia from 2003 to 2010. In the season prior to his arrival, they went 2-25 overall and 0-14 in conference play. The following year, he led them to a 10-17 (6-8) record, marking the third-best single-season turnaround in Ivy League history.

In 2006-07, the Lions captured 16 wins, the best performance by a Columbia squad since 1992-93. The Class of 2010 would finish with 26 Ivy League victories, marking the most conference wins by a Columbia class since the Class of 1994. In addition, the group became the third consecutive class to record 53 wins, a feat that hadn't been reached since the Class of 1979.

Jones previously served as an assistant coach at Villanova for six seasons (1997-2003) - four years under Steve Lappas and two years under Jay Wright - and was named one of the nation's top recruiters by Eastern Basketball magazine in 1999. During his tenure, the Wildcats advanced to postseason play in five of the six seasons and compiled a 105-83 record.

His collegiate coaching career began in the America East with Hofstra (1994-97) as an assistant coach under Wright. During his first season, he helped recruit the No. 1 ranked class in the conference. His recruiting efforts assisted in laying the groundwork for the Pride's rise in prominence that culminated in a three-year record of 72-22.

Before entering the collegiate coaching arena, Jones served as head coach at Long Island's Coneswogue High School for two years (1993-94). The Long Island native was a four-year letterman at the State University of New York at Oswego (1983-87) where he graduated with a bachelor's degree in communications in 1987 and a master's degree in counseling in 1989.

Jones and his wife, Kristin, have two children - daughter, Sydney (13) and son, JJ (9). His older brother, James, just completed his 16th season as the head coach at Yale.

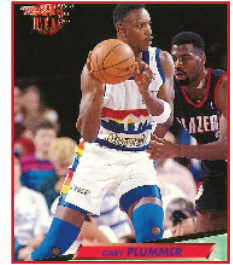
