#### THE OPENING TIP

- The top two teams nationally in both wins and winning percentage this decade will square off Tuesday when No. 5/4 Duke takes on No. 2/1 Kentucky in the State Farm Champions Classic.
- Duke has the best winning percentage (.839) in the NCAA since the start of the 2009-10 season. The Blue Devils have also won 187 games this decade, second-most in the NCAA.
- Duke is 27-13 in top-five matchups under **Mike Krzyzewski**, including an 8-2 mark on those occasions since the start of the 2009-10 season.
- Duke is 3-1 in the Champions Classic, including a 75-68 win over Kentucky in Atlanta in 2012.
- Ranked fifth by the Associated Press, the Blue Devils have been ranked in the AP poll an NCAAbest 157 consecutive weeks, the seventh-longest streak in NCAA history.
- With freshmen Brandon Ingram, Chase Jeter and Luke Kennard joining the fold this year, Duke has a nation-leading seven McDonald's All-Americans on its 2015-16 roster.
- In two games this season, Duke has hassled opponents into an average of 18.0 turnovers per game. The Blue Devils have turned the miscues into 22.5 points per game and an average +13.0 margin in points off turnovers.
- Behind a combined 10.0 offensive rebounds per game from Amile Jefferson and Marshall Plumlee, Duke is collecting 44.3 percent of available offensive boards.
- Grayson Allen scored 54 points in Duke's first two games, one shy of Johnny Dawkins' program record of 55 in the first two games to open a season (1983-84).

#### 111TH SEASON OF BASKETBALL

- The 2015-16 campaign marks the 111th season of Duke basketball. The Blue Devils have compiled a 2,064-853 record in that span to rank fourth all-time in victories.
- Only Kentucky (2,180), Kansas (2,154) and North Carolina (2,142) have more wins.
- Duke's all-time .707 winning percentage is the fifth-best in NCAA history, behind only Kentucky (.764), North Carolina (.736), Kansas (.722) and UNLV (.708).

#### **COACH 1K**

- Mike Krzyzewski owns a 1,020-310 record over 40-plus seasons as a head coach, including a 947-251 mark at Duke (35-plus seasons).
- Krzyzewski became the first men's coach in Division I college basketball to record 1,000 career victories with a 77-68 win over St. John's on Jan. 25, 2015 at Madison Square Garden.
- Krzyzewski also passed Dean Smith for the most ACC victories on Feb. 4, 2015, with a 72-66 win over Georgia Tech.

#### **UNRIVALED LONGEVITY**

- Mike Krzyzewski led Duke to its fifth NCAA championship in 2015, extending his own record for length of time between a coach's first and most recent national title to 25 years.
- Coach K and Connecticut's Jim Calhoun are the only coaches in NCAA history to win national championships in three decades: the 1990s, the 2000s and the 2010s.

#### INTERNATIONAL EXCELLENCE

- Having previously announced that the 2016 Rio Olympics will be his last as head coach of the U.S. Men's National Team, **Mike Krzyzewski** will transition to the role of special advisor to USA Basketbal for the 2017-20 quadrennium.
- Krzyzewski has been on the staffs of 14 different USA Basketball teams, compiling a 125-7 (.947) record and 14 medals (10 gold).
- As a head coach with USA Basketball, he has a 94-7 (.931) record with 10 teams, claiming six golds among his 10 medals.
- Krzyzewski has guided the U.S. Men's National Team to a 75-1 (.987) record, including an active 63-game winning streak, and six total medals (five gold).

#### **COACH K'S TALLEST TEAMS**

- The 13 players on Duke's 2015-16 roster have an average height of 79.231 inches, making this year's team the third-tallest in Coach K's tenure.
- Ten of Duke's 11 scholarship student-athletes in 2015-16 stand 6-5 or taller, ranking the Blue Devils second nationally in average height per kenpom.com.

#### **OPPORTUNITIES AVAILABLE**

- As a team, Duke returned just 24.0 percent of its scoring (19.0 ppg), 32.3 percent of its rebounding (11.9 rpg) and 16.6 percent of its assists (2.5 apg) from last season's national championship run.
- As a group, the returning Blue Devils combined to start only 77 games heading into the season (Jefferson 59; Jones 18). That figure was the third-fewest in the ACC heading into 2015-16.

#### **SUSTAINED SUCCESS**

- Duke has won 20 or more games 50 times in its 110 years of basketball. Including its 35-4 mark a year ago, Duke has won at least 20 games for 19 consecutive seasons.
- The Blue Devils have recorded 30 or more wins 14 times under Coach K, including five of the past seven seasons.
- Duke is one of 10 programs nationally to win at least 25 games in each of the last three seasons along with Arizona, Gonzaga, Kansas, Louisiana Tech, Louisville, Michigan State, Stephen F. Austin, VCU and Wichita State.

#### WINNINGEST FOUR-YEAR PERIODS

- Duke has won 93 games since the start of the 2012-13 season, a total that is 23 wins shy of tying for the 15th-best four-year period in program history.
- The Blue Devils' .830 (93-19) winning percentage since the start of 2012-13 would rank 12th in program history for a four-year period.

#### **ADDITIONS TO CAMERON INDOOR**

- A two-story addition measuring 14,200 square feet is currently being built on the south side of Cameron Indoor Stadium. The project began in April 2015 with a projected 15-month timeline.
- The first floor of the addition will feature a new lobby and exhibit space, as well as two new areas for ticket operations. The second floor will feature a club space with a capacity of roughly 250 seats.

#### **FORMER CAPTAINS ON STAFF**

- Duke's 2015-16 coaching staff once again features three former team captains in **Jeff Capel** (associate head coach), **Nate James** (assistant coach) and **Jon Scheyer** (assistant coach).
- Head coach Mike Krzyzewski has had three former Duke captains on his staff every year since 1996-97, a period in which the Blue Devils won three NCAA championships, 10 ACC Tournament titles and eight regular season ACC crowns.

#### **NOBEL/BASKETBALL COMBO**

- On the heels of its fifth NCAA championship in men's basketball, Duke is the first school since California in 1959 to win a men's basketball title and have a Nobel Prize winner in the same year.
- Paul Modrich, the James B. Duke Professor of Biochemistry, was named a 2015 Nobel Prize Winner for his work in mechanistic studies of DNA repair.

- Duke was 5-0 when Allen scored in double figures in 2014-15. He averaged 16.4 points in those games. The Blue Devils moved to 7-0 all-time when Allen registers double-digit points after he opened the 2015-16 campaign with back-to-back double-digit scoring games.

• Allen has flown out of the gates to start the 2015-16 campaign, scoring over 25 points in each of the first two contests. ### **Duke Basketball in the Polls**

The Duke basketball program has held a prominent spot in the national basketball scene since the beginning of the post-World War II era. The final national rankings are just one measuring stick in which the Blue Devils are among the elite in the history of the sport.

In the Coach K era, which began in 1980-81, Duke has finished in the Associated Press top 25 a total of 29 seasons, including seven times as the No.1 team in the nation. With consecutive AP number one finishes from 1999-2002, Duke became the first school in college basketball history to be ranked at the top of the final AP poll for four straight years.

- Duke has been ranked No. 1 in 19 of the past 30 years (AP & USA Today polls).
- Mike Krzyzewski has spent more weeks ranked in the top 25 (546 weeks), top 10 (480) and No. 1 (109) than any other active coach (AP poll only).
- Duke has been ranked No. 1 in 96 weeks since 1990, the most by any school in the nation. The next closest school is North Carolina at 52 weeks during the same time period.
- Duke has been No. 1109 weeks (218 games, 190-28) in the AP poll since 1986.
- Of the 1,198 games coached at Duke by Mike Krzyzewski, 1,057 of them have come as a ranked team (88.2 percent). Duke's record as a ranked team since 1981 is 870-187.
- · Under Coach K, Duke has played more games as a No. 1 team (218) than it has as an unranked team (141).
- The Blue Devils were ranked in the top 25 of the AP poll in 380 consecutive games (Nov. 20, 1996-Feb. 11, 2007).
- Duke has been ranked No. 1 in the nation 127 weeks overall, the second-highest figure in NCAA history behind only UCLA (134).
- Duke finished in the top 10 for 10 consecutive seasons from 1997-2006 second all-time behind UCLA (13 straight years 1967-79).
- Duke's 1991-92 team is one of only 12 schools in college basketball history to be ranked No. 1 for the entire season.
- Duke has been ranked in 359 of the last 361 AP polls (dating back to the start of the 1996-97 season). The Blue Devils have been ranked in the top 10 for 328 weeks in that span.
