QUICK NOTES

- EKU picked up its first road win of the season, 74-71, at Savannah State on Saturday.
- The Colonels shot a season-low 38% (21-56) from the field and 27% (8-30) from three-point range on Saturday, but shot a season high 89% (24-27) from the free throw line.
- Senior Jarelle Reischel nearly had a tripledouble in EKU's win on Saturday, recording 24 points, 12 rebounds and eight assists.
- Reischel missed his first free throw attempt at Savannah State, but then sank 17 straight foul shots to close out the game. He currently ranks third in the country in free throws made (65) and fourth in the country in free throws attempted (80).
- Junior JaVontae Hawkins contributed 16 points at Savannah State and converted the game-winning layup with 10 seconds on the clock. He has scored in double figures in all nine game this season, and he ranks 10th in the country in field goals made (63).
- Reischel (19.7 ppg) and Hawkins (18.8 ppg) are #1 and #2 in the OVC in scoring.
- Junior Isaac McGlone leads the OVC in threepoint field goal percentage (61.9).
- EKU ranks sixth in the country in scoring offense (90.4 ppg), sixth in field goal percentage (52.4) and fifth in three-point field goal percentage (44.3).
- This is the 12th all-time meeting between EKU and UK. The Wildcats defeated the Colonels, 82-49, last year in Rupp.

FIRST ROAD WIN

EKU picked up its first road win of the season, 74-71, at Savannah State on Dec. 5.

IMPRESSIVE FRESHMEN

Through eight games, Freshman Dujuanta Weaver is fifth in the country in assist-to-turnover ratio (24 assists, 4 turnovers). Fellow freshman Nick Mayo is second in the OVC and 21st in the country in field goal percentage (64.2).

#HEATEMUP

EKU shot 60 percent (15-of-25) from threepoint range in Tuesday's loss at WKU. The Colonels are now second in the country in three-point field goal percentage (47.4). Eastern is also third in the country in field goal percentage (54.2) and fourth in the country in scoring offense (92.5 ppg).

JBH LEADS THE CHARGE AT WKU

Junior Javlen Babb-Harrison came off the bench to lead EKU with 18 points vs. WKU. After the Colonels went down 21-2 to start the game, Babb-Harrison and senior K.J. Bluford combined to go 10-of-13 from behind the arc to spark Eastern's comeback.

BATTLE OF THE BLUEGRASS HEARTBREAKER

EKU fell to rival Western Kentucky, 86-84, on Dec. 1 in Bowling Green. WKU's Justin Johnson hit the game-winning three-pointer with 1.4 seconds on the clock. It was his first-career three-pointer.

OVC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK, AGAIN

Freshman Nick Mayo was named the OVC Freshman of the Week for the second consecutive week on Monday. He averaged 19.5 points-per-game and 4.0 rebounds-per-game in two EKU wins last week.

RIVALRY RENEWED

Eastern Kentucky and Western Kentucky will meet for the 156th time on Dec. 1; however, the Colonels and Hilltoppers have not played since Dec. 8, 2007 in Richmond. WKU won that game, 77-60.

CENTURY MACHINE

After beating Thomas More, 101-67, the Colonels have now scored over 100 points three times in six games this season. The last time EKU scored 100 points or more three times in a season was 2003. The last time the feat was achieved four times in a season was 1987.

FLIRTING WITH A TRIPLE-DOUBLE

Senior Jarelle Reischel just missed the first

triple-double in EKU history vs. Thomas More. He finished with 16 points, nine rebounds, nine assists and five steals.

DROPPING DIMES

Freshman Dujuanta Weaver dished out a career-high nine assists in only 16 minutes of action vs. Thomas More.

FIRST POINTS AS A COLONEL!

Walk-on (and Richmond native) Daniel Parke scored his first points as a Colonel vs. Thomas More. He completed a three-point play and knocked down a three-pointer to finish with six points in two minutes of action. He also came up with a steal.

NATIONAL RANKINGS

The Colonels rank sixth in the country in three-point field goal percentage (45.2) and 11th in the country in field goal percentage (52.8).

HIGH OCTANE COLONELS

EKU currently ranks 17th in the country in scoring offense (91.4 ppg). The up-tempo Colonels are averaging 100 ppg in four home games this season, all against Division I competition.

HAWKINS MID-MAJOR POW

Junior JaVontae Hawkins was named the National Mid-Major Player of the Week by College Sports Madness on Monday. He averaged 20.3 ppg, 4.3 rpg and 3.0 apg in four games last week.

MAYO OVC FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

Freshman Nick Mayo was named the OVC Freshman of the Week on Nov. 23. He averaged 10.0 ppg and 3.8 rpg over the week.

REISCHEL OVC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Senior Jarelle Reischel was named the OVC Player and Newcomer of the Week on Nov. 23. The transfer from Rhode Island averaged 20.3 ppg and 9.5 rpg in four games over the week. He scored a career-high 37 vs. Longwood to go along with 13 rebounds, six assists and three steals.

MAYO GETS 20

Freshman Nick Mayo poured in a career-high 20 points on 9-of-11 shooting from the field to lead EKU to a 92-82 win over South Carolina State on November 21.

BENCH TO THE RESCUE

EKU's bench contributed 53 points to help the Colonel stage a come-from-behind 89-81 win over Ball State. Three of the Colonels' top four scorers in the game (Jon Hood, Jaylen Babb-Harrison and Ja'Mill Powell) came off the bench.

ONE-SIDED SERIES

EKU and Ball State will meet for the seventh time in the 2015 @EKUHoops Classic. Eastern leads the series, 6-0. The last meeting came on Dec. 13, 2008 in Muncie. The Colonels defeated the Cardinals, 71-58.

Senior Jarelle Reischel recorded his first doubledouble as a Colonel on Monday at UNCW, scoring 17 points and grabbing a career-high 13 boards. The transfer from Rhode Island now leads the Colonels in scoring (19.0 ppg) and rebounding (8.0 rpg) this season.

NEWCOMERS LEAD THE WAY

Four of the Colonels' top five scorers on Friday were newcomers. Redshirt junior JaVontae Hawkins (a transfer from South Florida) scored 19, sophomore Greg King (a transfer from Chipola College) scored 11 and freshman Nick Mayo scored 10.

FIVE IN DOUBLE FIGURES

Senior Jarelle Reischel - a transfer from Rhode Island - paced five Colonels in double figures with 21 points in Friday's win. It was the first time five Colonels



had scored in double figures in a single game since the OVC semifinal win over Murray State on March 7, 2014.

CENTURY MARK

The win over Coppin State was the first time Eastern had scored more than 100 points against a Division-I opponent since a 107-71 win over Alabama A&M on December 30, 2004.

TIMES THEY ARE A 'CHANGIN'

2015-16 will feature a new-look Colonel team. First-year head coach Dan McHale took over the program in April. The Colonels lost 72 percent of its scoring and 67 percent of its rebounding from last year's 21-win team. Senior Ja'Mill Powell and junior Isaac McGlone are the lone returning Colonels who saw significant minutes last year.

GOLDEN ERA?

Three of Eastern Kentucky's eight winningest seasons, including the top-2, have come in the last three years. The 2012-13 team won a school record 25 games. The 2013-14 squad won 24 games. The 2014-15 team tied for fourth with 21 wins.

20 WINS FOR 3RD STRAIGHT YEAR

With its victory over Norfolk State (March 17) in the CIT, the Colonels recorded their third straight 20-win season and the 10th in program history. It's only the second time EKU has posted three straight 20-win seasons.

BACK-TO-BACK-TO-BACK POSTSEASON TRIPS

EKU has earned three consecutive bids to national postseason tournaments. Before this streak, Eastern Kentucky had never played in two straight national postseason tournaments.

POSTSEASON WINS ARE ROUTINE?

In 2013 Eastern beat Gardner-Webb in the CIT for the first win in a national postseason tournament since 1945 (68 years). After beating Norfolk State and High Point, EKU has three postseason wins in three years.

TOP-3 FOR THREE

Eastern Kentucky has finished in the top-3 in the OVC for three straight years. Two of those years, 2012-13 and 2014-15, the Colonels finished with the second best record in the league.

TWO ON 1ST TEAM ALL-OVC

Corey Walden and Eric Stutz were chosen First Team All-OVC. It is the first time since 1994 that two Colonels earned first team honors in the same season.

1ST IN TURNOVER MARGIN

EKU led the country in turnover margin (+7.2).

HIGH RANKINGS YEAR-AFTER-YEAR

Eastern Kentucky has ranked in the top-5 in the nation in turnover margin the last three years (2013 - 4th, 2014 - 2nd, 2015 - 1st) and in the top-10 in the nation in steals the last two years (2014 - 6th, 2015 - 2nd).

With Corey Walden earning first team All-OVC honors, each of EKU's three recent starting point guards have earned first team All-OVC recognition. Mike DiNunno (2013) and Glenn Cosey (2014) got the streak started.

WINNINGEST 4-YEAR STRETCH

With its win at Tennessee State (Feb. 14), EKU set a new program record for the winningest four-year stretch. Eastern won 86 games over the last four years. The previous record was 80 from 2010-14.

WINNINGEST 3-YEAR STRETCH

With their win over Austin Peay (Feb. 23), the Colonels set a new program record for most wins over a three-year period. EKU had 70 wins since 2012. The previous record was 65 from 2011-14.

2ND WINNINGEST OVC TEAM LAST 10 YEARS

With 188 victories, EKU is the second winningest program in the Ohio Valley Conference over the last 10 seasons (among members during that entire time).

PROTECTING THE BALL

Over the last two seasons, a total of 67 games, EKU has committed more turnovers than its opponent only four times.

COLONELS IN SCHOOL RANKINGS

Corey Walden set new school records for career steals (236) and steals in a season (99). He also posted the fourth-best career free throw percentage (84 percent) and 10th most career assists (288).

Eric Stutz set a new school record for games played (133) and finished with the third-best career field goal percentage (60.8 percent) in program history.

30 OR FEWER IN A HALF

In EKU's 66 halves of basketball this season, the Colonels held their opponents to 30 or fewer points 26 times. Which means, 39 percent of the time this season, an Eastern opponent hasn't scored more than 30 points in a half.

TURNING TURNOVERS INTO POINTS

EKU committed 238 fewer turnovers and outscored its opponents by 325 points off turnovers (683-358) during the 2014-15 season. In 2013-14, the Colonels committed 215 fewer turnovers and out-scored their opponents by 287 points off turnovers (699-412). In 2012-13, Eastern committed 199 fewer turnovers than its opponents and out-scored its foes by 268 points (736-468) off turnovers.





Sophomore Paul Jackson recorded his first career double-double on Nov. 22 vs. Longwood, scoring 14 points and dishing out 13 assists. He is the first Colonel to record double-digit assists in a game since Jabs Newby in 2011.

MR. DISTRIBUTOR

Since making his first collegiate start at Belmont on Feb. 19, freshman Paul Jackson had 21 assists and only nine turnovers. That's an assist-to-turnover ratio of 2.33 in his last eight games.

SEEING MORE MINUTES

Paul Jackson played 10 or more minutes in nine of Eastern's last 10 games. Over Eastern's final four regular season games, Jackson averaged 21 minutes per contest.

MINE, MINE, MINE, MINE

Paul Jackson grabbed a career-best four rebounds and had two assists in EKU's OVC East first place-clinching win over Tennessee Tech (Feb. 28).

PROVIDING "ASSIST"-ANCE

Just one game after setting a new career-high with five assists, Paul Jackson broke that mark with seven helpers against Austin Peay (Feb. 23). He also had only one turnover in 22 minutes of action.

STEPPING UP

In the absence of senior point guard Corey Walden, Paul Jackson got the start at Belmont (Feb. 19) and played a career-high 30 minutes. He dished out a career-best five assists, made only four turnovers and had two steals.

SECOND MOST POINTS

Paul Jackson scored four points at Tennessee State (Feb. 14). It was the most points he has scored in a game since recording 10 points in EKU's second game of the season against Kentucky Christian.

FIRST CAREER START

Paul Jackson made his first career start at Murray State (Jan. 29). He had two assists and a rebound in 15 minutes of play.

IMPRESSIVE FIRST GAME

Paul Jackson made his official EKU debut against Kentucky Christian (Nov. 18). He finished with 10 points, three assists and three steals. He made 4-of-5 from the field, including 2-of-2 from behind the arc.

LAND DOWN UNDER

Played in all four games during Eastern Kentucky's summer tour in Australia ... averaged 3.3 points, 2.0 assists and 1.8 rebounds ... shot 38.5 percent from the field, including 33.3 percent (1-for-3) from three-point range ... scored 10 points on 4-of-5 shooting from the field in EKU's win over the Suncoast Clippers (Aug. 11) ... also had five assists, no turnovers and four rebounds against the Clippers.





Dan McHale, a former University of Louisville assistant, was introduced as Eastern Kentucky's new head coach on April 9, 2015.

"We are ecstatic to welcome Coach Dan McHale and his family to the Colonel Family," Eastern Kentucky University President Michael Benson said. "Dan brings years of experience at some top-flight programs to EKU, along with ties to Kentucky and this region. He came to us with the highest recommendations from some of America's best coaches and we have every confidence he will take our basketball program to the next level."

Before being chosen as Eastern Kentucky's 20th head men's basketball coach, McHale completed his second season as an assistant coach at the University of Minnesota where he worked under head coach Richard Pitino. McHale got his coaching start under Hall of Fame coach Rick Pitino as a staff assistant at Louisville from 2001 to 2003.

"I'm extremely excited to be working at Eastern Kentucky University," McHale said. "I want to thank President Benson and Steve Lochmueller for this opportunity. With the leadership of these two, it's an honor to be a part of these exciting times at EKU. We are going to bring excitement to McBrayer Arena with a fast paced style of play. It's going to be fun for our players and our fans."

In his first season at Minnesota, McHale helped the Gophers to a NIT Championship and a 25-13 record that included wins over No. 9 Wisconsin and No. 11 Ohio State. The 25 victories are the second-most in program history. The 2014-15 squad won 18 games, including a victory at Michigan State, a team that would reach the Final Four.

"I am extremely excited and proud of Dan McHale," Richard Pitino said. "Eastern Kentucky is getting a tremendous coach and recruiter, but more importantly a great person. He will represent the Eastern Kentucky program in a first-class manner. There is no doubt in my mind that he will do great things there."

McHale served as a student manager for four seasons (1997-01) at Kentucky. He was part of one national championship team, four NCAA Tournament teams and three Southeastern Conference championships while working with Tubby Smith's Wildcats.

The Cardinals went 25-7, won the 2003 Conference USA Tournament title and reached the NCAA Tournament in McHale's second season as a staff assistant at Louisville. During his first stint he assisted with opponent scouting, game preparation and

on-campus recruiting. After one year as the director of operations at Manhattan College, McHale returned to UofL for two seasons as the director of video operations, overseeing advance scouting video and evaluation video of Cardinal players. In his second two-year stint at Louisville, the Cardinals won 45 games and played in two NCAA Tournaments.

"Dan is one of the hardest working coaches in our profession," Rick Pitino said. "I have great admiration for his dedication to our game. He is a great addition to our state."

In 2007, McHale joined Kevin Willard's first staff at Iona College. As an assistant, McHale helped lead the Gaels from two wins the season before the duo arrived to 12 wins their first season and 21 wins in year three at Iona. He recruited NBA draft pick and 2012 MAAC Player of the Year Scott Machado to Iona.

McHale followed Willard to Seton Hall when he was named head coach in 2010. In their second season, the Pirates won 20 games. While at Seton Hall, McHale was responsible for the Pirates' defensive game planning and spearheaded opponent scouting and game preparation.

"Eastern Kentucky has hit a home run with the hiring of Dan McHale, who is a rising star within the coaching ranks," Willard said. "He is not only a terrific recruiter and mentor of student-athletes, but he also has a great mind for the game of basketball. Dan has earned the opportunity to lead a basketball program, and with his outstanding knowledge, personality and work ethic, he will make a positive impact at Eastern Kentucky."

McHale will look to add to the success of the Rick Pitino coaching tree that includes Billy Donovan (Florida), Tubby Smith (Texas Tech), Mick Cronin (Cincinnati), Richard Pitino (Minnesota) and former EKU head coach Travis Ford (Oklahoma State).

McHale has caught the eye of one of America's top young college basketball coaches – Memphis head coach Josh Pastner.

"Dan is going to do an outstanding job at Eastern Kentucky University," said Pastner. "He is a tireless worker and will do the job with great principle and great work ethic. Eastern Kentucky got a winner in Dan McHale."

The Chatham, New Jersey native earned a bachelor's degree in business administration and graduated with honors from UK in 2001. McHale and his wife Jackie have two daughters, Lilly and Molly, and a son, Daniel.
