THE #FASTEAST40 FACTS

- The Razorbacks are the only team in the SEC with consecutive home wins against Kentucky. Arkansas has defeated UK in three straight meetings at Bud Walton Arena in 2011, 2013 and 2014.
- With the trio of Anthlon Bell (17.1), Moses Kingsley (16.9) and Dusty Hannahs (16.0), Arkansas is one of five teams in the country and the only power five conference program with three players averaging 15-plus points per game.
- During the Mike Anderson era, Arkansas has posted a record of 75-9 inside Bud Walton Arena, marking the third-most home wins in the country during this span behind Kentucky (79-4) and Ohio State (78-12).
- Over the last 30 SEC regular season games dating back to 2013-14, Arkansas and Kentucky have the top two records in the league with the Razorbacks checking in at 22-8 and the Wildcats at 24-6.
- Under Anderson, unranked Arkansas teams are 2-0 in BWA against teams ranked 20 through 25 in the Associated Press Top 25, beating Michigan (01/21/12) and Vanderbilt (01/31/12).
- The Razorbacks are No. 3 in the country in three-point field goal percentage at .447, sitting only behind top-ranked Oklahoma (.457) and No. 3 Kansas (.449).

- Over the last four games, Anthlon Bell (17) and Dusty Hannahs (14) have combined to make 31 treys and shoot 56-percent from behind the arc.
- At LSU, Bell sank his 200th career three-pointer to become the sixth player in program history to eclipse the mark.
- Bell and Hannahs are the top three-point shooting tandem in the SEC, combining to make 99 treys on the year and shoot 47-percent from long range.

STARTING FIVE >>

#4 || Jabril Durham (G)

- Leads the SEC and ranks No. 3 in the country with 7.4 assists per game.
- Is the only player in the country to record two games of 10-plus points and assists and five-plus steals.
- One of five players in the country with five double-digit assist performances this year.
- Has five of the 12 double-digit assist games in the SEC this year.
- Is one of six players in the country with four games of five-plus steals this year.

#5 || Anthlon Bell (G)

- Named the SEC Player of the Week on Jan. 11 after averaging 25.5 points per game and making 11 treys.
- At LSU he became the sixth player in program history to make 200 career three-pointers.
- Is second in the SEC with 55 made three-pointers this season.
- Has made 22 of his last 43 three-pointers (.511) over the last six games.
- Is one of 20 players in the country with five-plus treys made in five different games.
- Has scored double-digits in 16 of the first 17 games this year.
- Is averaging 19.6 points in conference play, the sixth highest in the league.

#3 || Dusty Hannahs (G)

- Started the last four contests after coming off the bench the previous 11 games.
- Is 14-for-23 (.608) from behind the arc over the last three games.
- Recorded his seventh 20-point effort of the year with 20 points at Missouri (Jan. 12).
- Scored a career-high 26 points against Mississippi State (Jan. 9) on a career-best eight three-pointers.
- Is one of three players in school history to make eight three-pointers in an SEC game.
- Has led Arkansas in scoring seven times, with six of those coming off the bench.
- Ranks No. 5 in the SEC in three-pointers made (44) and No. 2 in three-point field goal percentage (.478).

#33 || Moses Kingsley (F)

- Has 17 consecutive double-digit scoring games and six 20-point efforts to start the year.
- Has scored 20-plus points in four of the last seven games.
- Is the first player in school history with two 8-for-8 shooting performances in a career (Southern & Missouri).
- After one double-double in two seasons, he has eight in 17 games to open the year.
- First Razorback in 30 years with eight double-doubles through the first 12 games.
- Is one of two players in the country with multiple games of 20 points, 10 rebounds and five blocks.
- Is one of two players in the SEC with eight-plus double-doubles on the year (Ben Simmons).

#55 || Keaton Miles (F)

- Has made 15 consecutive starts and started 16 of 17 games this year.
- Scored four of the final seven points in regulation as Arkansas forced OT against Vandy (Jan. 5).
- Pulled down a career-high nine rebounds against North Florida (Dec. 22).

OFF THE PINE >>

#1 || Trey Thompson (F)

- Posted first career double-digit scoring effort against Tennessee Tech (Dec. 12).
- Played a career-long 26 minutes against Tennessee Tech (Dec. 12).
- Missed the Stanford, Northwestern State and Wake Forest games with ankle injury suffered in Ga. Tech game.
- Dished out a career-high five assists and tied a career mark with seven rebounds against North Florida (Dec. 22).

#21 || Manuale Watkins (G)

- Has six double-digit scoring games in his career, all coming this season.
- Made his first collegiate start against North Florida (Dec. 22) and scored 11 points.
- Has consecutive double-digit scoring efforts two different times this season.
- Tied a career high with 14 points at Wake Forest (Dec. 4).

#24 || Jimmy Whitt (G)

- Had a career-high 15 points against Mizzou (Jan. 12) in his return to Columbia.
- Has six double-digit scoring efforts in his first 16 collegiate games.
- Recorded a career-high four assists against Northwestern State and Tennessee Tech.
- Made his first collegiate three-pointer in his SEC debut at Texas A&M (Jan. 2).

#31 || Anton Beard (G)

- Reinstated to the program on Nov. 16 following resolutions in the legal and the campus judicial processes.
- Joined team-related activities and practice on Nov. 16.
- Was suspended for the fall semester and the first nine games of the year.
- Scored a career-high 15 points at Dayton.
- Has four double-digit scoring efforts in eight games this season.
- Is 11-for-24 (.458) from behind the arc over the last eight games.

#50 || Willy Kouassi (C)

- Recorded season-highs of points (12), rebounds (9) and minutes (18) against Northwestern State (Dec. 1).
- Has recorded a block in 54 of his 100 collegiate games.
- Tallied a season-high four blocks in 14 minutes against Evansville (Dec. 8).

WELCOME TO THE #SPLASHZONE >>

• Anthlon Bell and Dusty Hannahs have combined to make 99 three-pointers, making them the No. 1 three-point shooting tandem in the SEC. Auburn's Kareem Canty and Bryce Brown rank No. 2 with 95 treys.

• The Razorbacks have the top two three-point field goal percentages in school history for a single game this season, shooting 9-for-13 (.692) against Evansville on Dec. 8 and 16-for-24 (.667) against Mississippi State on Jan. 9.

• The Razorbacks have made at least four three-pointers in 60 of the last 65 games dating back to the 2013-14 season, including every game this year.

• Against Mississippi State (Jan. 9), Arkansas' 16-for-24 performance made it the third team in the country to make 16-plus threes and shoot at least 66.7 percent while doing so.

• Arkansas has made at least one three-pointer in 891 consecutive games dating back to a 0-for-2 performance against Texas on Jan. 7, 1989.

RING THE BELL >>

• Anthlon Bell picked up his first SEC Player of the Week honor on Jan. 11 after averaging 25.5 points per game in wins over Vanderbilt and Mississippi State. The senior knocked down 11-of-17 three-point attempts and currently leads the SEC with 17 treys in conference play.



HELP YOURSELF >>

• Jabril Durham is one of five players in the country with five double-digit assist games this season. He has five of the 12 double-digit assist performances in the SEC this year and ranks No. 3 in the nation with 7.4 assists per game. Durham is the only player in the country with multiple games of 10 points, 10 assists and five steals.

#BEASTMO FOR REAL >>

• Moses Kingsley is the first Razorback in 20 years to record a game of 20 points, 10 rebounds and five blocks, and the junior has accomplished the feat twice this season. He is one of two players in the country to reach the stat line multiple times this year.

MO BLOCKS PLEASE >>

• Kingsley is on pace to record 89 blocks this year, which would rank fifth all-time in program history for blocks in a single season and the most since Delvin Johnson's 91 blocks in 2010-11. Oliver Miller's 112 blocks in 1991 is the school's all-time mark. Kingsley currently leads the SEC and ranks No. 15 in the nation with 47 blocks, recording two-plus blocks in 10 contests.

PORTIS IMPRESSION >>

• Through the first 17 games of the season, Moses Kingsley is putting up nearly identical numbers to SEC Player of the Year and 2015 NBA First Rounder Bobby Portis. #BeastMo has eight double-doubles compared to five for Portis.

#NYLONBELL >>

• After leading Arkansas in three-point shooting each of the last three years, senior Anthlon Bell is attempting to join Pat Bradley (1995-99) as the only players in program history to lead Arkansas in three-pointers made for four consecutive seasons.

BRAND NEW HOG >>

Dusty Hannahs is one of five players in the last 28 years to score 20-plus points in his debut as a Razorback when he dropped 21 on Southern. He also joined an elite group of four players to make five or more three-pointers in their first Arkansas game in the same time span.

RIGHT ON PACE >>

• Jabril Durham is on pace to record 235 assists this season and set the school record, which is currently held by Kareem Reid with 219 helpers in 1995-96.

• Anthlon Bell is on pace to knock down 103 three-pointers and break Scotty Thurman's single season record of 102 treys in 1994-95. Bell's career total is on pace to be fourth-best in program history.

• Head coach Mike Anderson is five wins away from his 100th win at Arkansas and his 300th win overall. He would become the seventh coach in program history to reach 100 wins at the helm of the Razorbacks.

RECORD WATCH IN 2015-16 >>

• Anthlon Bell is 67 points away from becoming the 39th player in program history to score 1,000 career points.

• Bell has 203 career three-point field goals, which ranks sixth all-time in school history. Next up on the list is current staff member Lee Mayberry with 218 made treys.

• Moses Kingsley used a career-high eight blocks against Tennessee Tech to pass Bobby Portis and break into the top 10 of career blocks in school history. He is now fifth all-time with 134 career blocks and leads the SEC this season with 47 blocks.

PERFECTION IN THE PALACE >>

• During the Mike Anderson era, Arkansas has posted a record of 75-9 inside Bud Walton Arena, marking the third-most home wins in the country during this span behind Kentucky and Ohio State.

• Arkansas (75-9) is one of eight teams in the country with 70+ wins and fewer than 10 losses at home over the past four-plus seasons.

• Arkansas has won 30 of its last 31 non-conference games in BWA, including an astounding 45-1 mark under Anderson against unranked non-SEC teams.

THE OPPONENT >>

• The Wildcats, from Lexington, Kentucky, are 13-4 on the year with a 3-2 record in SEC play. Kentucky's game at Bud Walton Arena will be its fourth road game in its last five contests. Both of the Wildcats' losses in SEC play have come on the road; first a 85-67 loss at LSU on Jan. 5, and then at Auburn by a score of 75-70 on Saturday. Kentucky has played two top-25 teams this season and beaten both of them; No. 5 Duke on Nov. 17, and then No. 16 Louisville on Dec. 26. The Wildcats are 10-0 in the friendly confines of Rupp Arena, but 2-1 in neutral-site games and 1-3 in true road games.

• As usual, it's a group of freshmen who lead Kentucky on the stat sheet. Guard Jamal Murray averages a team-best 17.8 points per game, including 46 three-pointers on the season. Guard Isaiah Briscoe also averages double-figures, with 10.7 points per contest, while adding 5.3 rebounds and 1.5 steals. The strength of the team is on the inside, as Kentucky is 22nd in the country with 5.5 blocks per game, 29th with a plus-7.4 rebounding margin and 14th with 14.2 offensive boards per contest.

• Head coach John Calipari is in his seventh year at Kentucky, and has a 203-42 (.829) record in six-plus seasons with the Wildcats. Calipari has previously coached at UMass for eight seasons and Memphis for nine, accruing six Final Four appearances and one National Championship (with Kentucky in 2012) in 23 seasons of head coaching experience. Since arriving in Lexington for the 2009-10 season, the Wildcats have had 19 players taken in the first round of the NBA Draft.

SERIES NOTES >>

- Arkansas trails the all-time series 27-11, but holds a 6-5 edge in Bud Walton Arena.
- The Razorbacks have won three straight meetings against Kentucky in BWA.
- Arkansas has won three of the last five meetings against the Wildcats.
- Mike Anderson is 4-4 all-time against Kentucky, including a 3-3 mark at Arkansas.

The Razorback Nation welcomed home one of its own on March 23, 2011, when Mike Anderson was named the 12th head men's basketball coach in Arkansas history. Charged with bringing back the winning tradition that was synonymous with the Razorback program throughout the '80s and '90s, Anderson has helped the Razorbacks improve each year on and off the court as the tradition-rich program grows closer to returning to its glory days.

Fans caught a glimpse of those glory days in 2014-15, as the Razorbacks returned to both the NCAA Tournament and SEC Tournament championship game for the first time since 2008. Highlighted by a victory over Southern Conference champ Wofford in the NCAA Tournament second round and a program-record six SEC road wins, Arkansas produced the sixth-most wins in program history with a 27-9 record. Of course, the up-tempo style of play donned the "Fastest 40 Minutes in Basketball" reached another level, as the Razorbacks led the SEC in five different statistical categories, including scoring (77.4), assists (16.1) and turnover margin (+3.8).

The 2014-15 campaign brought back memories of the 90's, as Arkansas finished second in the SEC at 13-5 and spent eight weeks ranked in both the Associated Press Top 25 Poll and the USA Today Coaches Poll. Anderson's attention to detail in skill development helped sophomore Bobby Portis become only the second Razorback in program history to be named the SEC Player of the Year by both the Associated Press and league head coaches. Portis was the first Razorback to surpass 1,000 points and 500 rebounds as a sophomore and went on to become the 12th player in program history to be selected in the first round of the NBA Draft when he went 22nd overall to the Chicago Bulls.

A long-time assistant and associate head coach at Arkansas, Anderson spent nine years as a head coach at the University of Alabama-Birmingham and the University of Missouri before returning to the Razorbacks.
