Opening Tips

- Texas A&M looks to close the gap in the SEC race Saturday evening when the Aggies host No. 14 Kentucky ... The Wildcats maintain the top spot in the SEC standings with a 10-3 league mark, but the Aggies are close behind in a tie for third with an 8-5 conference record.
- The series between the Aggies & Wildcats has been a closely contested one since Texas A&M joined the SEC for the 2012-13 season ... The two schools have faced off four times in league play with two games going into overtime, including last season's double-overtime thriller at Reed Arena that stood out as UK's closest call during an undefeated regular season run.
- Along the way to earning First-Team All-SEC honors last season, senior **Danuel House** garnered national attention for his impressive outing vs. Kentucky during the Aggies' double overtime loss to the 'Cats ... Only Auburn's Antoine Mason, who scored 28 points vs. Kentucky on Feb. 21, put up more than House's 25 points against the Wildcats during their undefeated regular season run.
- The Aggies have already faced off against four ranked teams this season and own a 3-1 record in those contests ... Two of the wins have come inside Reed Arena where A&M defeated No. 16 Baylor 80-61 on Dec. 19 and No. 14 Iowa State 72-62 on Jan. 31.
- Senior **Alex Caruso** is coming off a milestone performance, scoring four points Tuesday against Ole Miss to become the 35th member of Texas A&M's 1,000-Point Club with exactly 1,000 points during his A&M tenure ..
- Already A&M's all-time steals leader with 258 career take-aways, **Caruso** is approaching another top spot in program history as he enters the UK game with 591 career assists ... His assist total trails only David Edwards, who dished out 602 dimes for the Maroon & White from 1991-94.

Caruso Set School Record for Steals; Approaching Assists Record

With a first period steal against Arkansas on Jan. 2, Caruso passed David Edwards on Aggie basketball's list of all-time steals to become A&M's career leader. The College Station native now has 258 career take-aways.

Additionally, Caruso notched his 500th career assist during the Dec. 12th win over Kansas State. Caruso native currently has 591 during his A&M career to rank second in school history behind only David Edwards (1991-94) who owns first place with 602 career assists.

A&M Searching for Ninth 20-Win Season in 12 Years

An 80-55 victory over Auburn on Feb. 28 of last season stood out as the team's 20th win of the season.

The 20-win season was the 14th in program history and the first since the 2010-11 campaign. Texas A&M has won 20 or more games in eight of the last 11 seasons.

Kennedy Notches Career Win No. 300

Aggie head coach Billy Kennedy has enjoyed successful coaching stops at Centenary (1997-99), Southeastern Louisiana (1999-05), Murray State (2006-11) and now Texas A&M (2011-).

On Jan. 30 when the Aggies earned a 72-62 victory over No. 14 Iowa State, Kennedy hit a career milestone as he captured his 300th victory as a collegiate head coach.

Kennedy enters the Kentucky game with a career record of 301-247 in 18 seasons as a collegiate head coach.

- Saturday will be the eighth meeting between the Aggies & Wildcats on the hardwood and the fifth in SEC league play.
- The two schools first met during the 1941-42 season when the 'Cats earned a 49-29 victory.
- Last year on Jan. 10, the top-ranked Wildcats got their biggest scare of what would be an undefeated regular season as they edged the Aggies 70-64 in double overtime at Reed Arena ... Danuel House led the way for the Aggies with 25 points.
- A&M's Billy Kennedy is 1-3 against Kentucky.
- Kennedy's head coaching counterpart, UK's John Calipari, is 4-1 all-time against the Aggies ... Before his tenure at UK, his lone contest against Texas A&M came on March 22, 2007, while coaching at Memphis ... The Tigers defeated the Aggies 65-64 during the NCAA Tournament's South Regional semifinal at San Antonio's Alamodome.

Now in his fourth year in the Aggie program, Caruso has worked extremely hard to grow in that area and the fruits of his labors are showing on the court this season as he ranked among the team leaders in both field goal percentage (51.0 percent) and 3-point field goal percentage (39.3 percentage).

Texas A&M senior Jalen Jones was honored Jan. 25 as one of just 20 players nationally with a spot on the midseason watch list for the Oscar Robertson Trophy, which is presented annually to men's college basketball's National Player of the Year by the U.S. Basketball Writers Association.

The Oscar Robertson Trophy will be presented at the College Basketball Awards gala in Oklahoma City on April 11, 2016, at the National Cowboy & Western Heritage Museum. Access Sports, a non-profit organization committed to supporting various charitable causes, will serve as host for the gala. Funds from the gala are used to support youth basketball programs in Oklahoma that allow disadvantaged youth the opportunity to participate in leagues and training.

A&M Hits Highest Ever National Ranking

Entering the season with high aspirations, Texas A&M got off to a hot start and raced out to a 4-0 record allowing it to climb back into the Nov. 23rd edition of the *Associated Press* rankings at No. 25.

It marked the first time the Aggies have appeared in the rankings since they were No. 22 in the AP rankings on Dec. 12, 2011. The Jan. 25 edition of the rankings saw the Aggies reach No. 5 in both the *Associated Press* Top 25 & *USA Today/Coaches* Poll, marking the highest ranking in school history and breaking the previous high of No. 6 set on several occasions during the 2006-07 campaign.

For the second time this season, Texas A&M's Jalen Jones has been named SEC Player of the Week by the league office.

A 6-foot-7, 220-pound senior forward from Dallas, Texas, averaged 19 points and nine rebounds in wins over Florida and at Georgia. Against the Gators, Jones made 8-of-13 shots from the field, including 3-of-4 from 3-point range, to finish with a game-high 26 points and post his sixth 20-point outing of the season.

The Dallas native followed up that performance with his 12th career double-double (third at A&M) at Georgia, scoring 12 points and pulling down a season-best 12 boards. For the week, Jones shot 46.2 percent from the floor and 57.1 percent from long range.

Jones Named SEC Player of the Week (Jan. 4)

Following standout performances in Aggie wins over Cal Poly and Arkansas, Texas A&M's Jalen Jones was named SEC Men's Basketball Player of the Week on Jan. 4.

A 6-foot-7, 220-pound senior forward from Dallas, Jones averaged 19.5 points and 6.5 rebounds in wins over Cal Poly and Arkansas. Jones exploded for a career-high 28 points during the Aggies' SEC-opening victory over Arkansas, converting 9-of-13 shots from the field, including 4-of-6 from 3-point range, while grabbing seven rebounds and notching two steals.

Earlier in the week, Jones scored 11 points with six rebounds, two assists, two blocks and a steal as the Aggies defeated Cal Poly at Reed Arena.

Davis Named SEC Freshman of the Week (Dec. 21)

Following an outstanding performance in a victory over No. 16 Baylor, rookie Tyler Davis was named SEC Men's Basketball Freshman of the Week.

A 6-foot-10, 265-pound center from Plano, Texas, Davis helped the Aggies earn their second win over a ranked opponent this season, scoring 13 points by going a perfect 6-of-6 from the field during the 80-61 win Saturday night at Reed Arena. Playing against Baylor standout big man Rico Gathers, Davis was solid on the defensive end, adding five rebounds to go along with a game-high two blocked shots.

Davis is shooting a team-high 71.4 percent from the floor this season. The rookie center leads the country in 2-point basket shooting percentage according to KenPom.com.

House & Jones Named to Battle4Atlantis All-Tournament Team

Following a strong showing in the Bahamas, seniors Danuel House and Jalen Jones were named to the Battle4Atlantis All-Tournament team. House led the Aggies with a 17.7 point-per-game scoring average during the event, while Jones contributed a game-high 23 points in the title contest.

After making his long awaited debut season on the court of the Aggie big man Tonny Trocha-Morelos struggled at times last season to feel comfortable on the court after waiting almost two seasons to hit the court. The Columbian averaged under two points in 10.2 minutes per contest a year ago, but this season is turning heads as one of the most improved players on the A&M roster.

Trocha-Morelos' numbers are significantly up across the board through 26 games of his sophomore campaign, including his first career double-double [10 points and 10 rebounds vs. Arkansas on Jan. 2].

Ags Turn Heads with Runner-Up Showing at Battle4Atlantis

Playing against one of the best fields of any in-season tournament in front of national TV audience, the Battle4Atlantis (Paradise Island, Bahamas) stood out as a huge stage for Texas A&M to make an impression on the college basketball world. The Aggies did not disappoint, winning a pair of games to reach the event's title game and turning heads of national media pundits along the way.

After opening the event by defeating rival Texas 84-73 on Nov. 25, the Aggies returned to the court on Nov. 26 where they downed No. 10 Gonzaga 62-61. The win stood out as the program's first over a top-10 opponent since a 80-63 victory over Texas on Jan. 30, 2008.

Following the win over the Zags, the Aggies received praise from the national media on twitter.

Despite a 74-67 loss to Syracuse in the championship game, Texas A&M generated a significant amount of buzz at the Battle4Atlantis and signaled that it would be a team to be reckoned with on the national scene this season.

Aggies Topple No. 10 Gonzaga for first Top-10 Win since `08

A final shot from the Zags' guard Silas Melson rimmed out during the closing seconds of a 62-61 win over No. 10 Gonzaga on Nov. 26 at the Battle4Atlantis to give the Aggies a signature win during the campaign's opening month, as well as their first over a top-10 opponent in eight seasons.

The victory was the Aggies' first over a top-10 opponent (AP rankings) since a 80-63 victory over Texas on Jan. 30, 2008, as well as the first over any ranked opponent since a 70-68 win over #20 Missouri in College Station on Feb. 7, 2013

The tournament will be played on Nov. 24-25 in Cal State Fullerton's Titan Gym with the final day of play on Nov. 27 at the Honda Center in Anaheim.

House, Caruso Garner Preseason All-SEC Honors

The roll out of preseason honors continued for the Aggie men's basketball team in the weeks leading up to the start of the season with Danuel House (1st Team) and Alex Caruso (2nd Team) receiving preseason All-SEC honors from both the SEC coaches and the media that covers the league.

Both players, along with fellow senior Jalen Jones, garnered All-SEC accolades from various media outlets after last season with House (1st Team) and Jones (2nd Team) recognized by the league's coaches and Caruso selected honorable mention all-league from the *Associated Press*.

Texas A&M Only SEC Team to Return Multiple All-SEC Selections

Texas A&M stands out as the only SEC school to return multiple player who garnered All-SEC honors from the league's coaches last season as seniors Danuel House (1st Team) and Jalen Jones (2nd Team) are back on the hardwood this year.

Additionally, House, who also garnered second team all-district honors from the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC), stands out as one of only three first team All-SEC player back for this season (Stefan Moody, Ole Miss and Damian Jones, Vanderbilt).

Eubanks Joins the Active Roster & 2015 Signing Class

The heralded Texas A&M men's basketball 2015 recruiting class received a late boost in late December as shooting guard Kobie Eubanks joined the roster.

A 6-foot-5 prospect, Eubanks is considered a big, talented guard with scoring ability and will join the Aggies at the semester break this December.

The Fort Lauderdale, Fla., native is regarded as a four-start prospect by ESPN, 247Sports, Rivals.com and Scout.com. A consensus top-100 recruit, Eubanks was listed as the fifth-ranked player in New York and No. 21 in the East Region coming out of high school.

Eubanks made his Texas A&M debut Jan. 16 at Georgia, scoring three points against the Bulldogs

Collins Joins Aggies after Four-Year run at USF

The Aggies added another veteran ball-handler to the roster during the offseason as graduate transfer Anthony Collins joined the program after a four-year career at South Florida.

The 6-foot-1 guard missed a total of 24 games during the 2013-14 season due to injury, qualifying for a medical redshirt.

During his four seasons in Tampa, Collins drew the starting assignment in 98 of 101 games played after joining the Bulls' starting lineup early during his freshman campaign in 2011-12. He averaged 33.9 minutes per outing during his tenure and stood out as a solid scorer, averaging 8.1 points per contest including a career-best 9.0 average his freshman season when he shot 50.8 percent from the floor.

As a rookie, Collins reached double-digit scoring in 10 of USF's final 11 games to help lead the Bulls to the third round of 2012 NCAA Tournament.

Collins dished out 569 assists during his USF career, including an American Athletic Conference-leading 167 dimes last season, ranking 34th nationally with a 5.2 assist-per-game average. He dished out 10 or more assists three times a year ago and finished with the eighth-most in USF single season history.

An outstanding free throw shooter, Collins maintained a 78.0 percent clip at the charity stripe during his time with the Bulls.

Texas A&M Inks Two Standouts During Early Signing Period

A year after signing a consensus top-10 class, the Texas A&M coaching is continuing its roll on the recruiting trail and is already well on its way to reeling in another outstanding class by inking a pair of impressive athletes during the early signing period.

J.J. CALDWELL

Point Guard • 5-11 • Cypress, Texas (Cypress Woods HS / SATCH)

A 5-foot-11 athlete, Caldwell is regarded by well-known recruiting expert Bob Gibbins as the nation's fifth-ranked point guard recruit as well as the country's No. 30 overall recruit. Additionally, he is a member of the ESPN Top 100, ranking as the No. 84 recruit nationally and listed as a four-star prospect by ESPN, 247 Sports, Rivals.com and Scout.com. Scout also slots him as the 53rd-ranked player in the country.

ROBERT WILLIAMS

Power Forward • 6-8 • Vivian, La. (North Caddo HS)

Williams is considered a consensus four-star prospect, with ESPN regarding him as a member of its Top 100 as well as the No. 1 player in the Pelican State. Both ESPN and Scout.com slot Williams as the No. 12 power forward prospect nationally with ESPN ranking him as the 48th overall recruit in the country.

COLLEGE STATION, Texas (AP) -- Danuel House scored 13 points to lead four Texas A&M players in double figures, and the Aggies snapped a four-game skid with a 71-56 win over Mississippi on Tuesday night.

The Aggies trailed by double digits in the first half before rallying to take the lead.

They led by 5 at halftime and were still up by that amount before scoring the next eight points to extend their advantage to 53-40 with about 15 1/2 minutes remaining. House got A&M going in that stretch with a 3-pointer and Jalen Jones added a dunk to help Texas A&M push the lead.

Mississippi missed six shots in that span, with four coming on layups and never threatened again.

The Rebels were led by Stefan Moody's 17 points.

Tyler Davis added 11 points for A&M and Anthony Collins and D.J. Hogg had 10 apiece.

Ole Miss couldn't do much in the second half offensively and made just 2 of 20 shots in a stretch in the second half that ended with about one minute remaining. The Aggies used a 6-0 run at the end of that span to stretch the lead to 71-54.

Texas A&M dropped out of the top 25 this week after a loss at LSU that was its fifth in six games. Their last three games had been close, with the losses coming by a combined nine points. Early on it looked like they might be headed for another defeat with Ole Miss jumping out to a 20-11 lead after a 3-pointer by Moody with about 12 minutes left in the first half.

The Aggies found their offense soon after that, using a 13-5 run to cut the lead to 25-24. Admon Gilder opened that spurt with a 3-point play and House capped it with another one.

Tomasz Gielo made a 3-pointer for the Rebels, but A&M responded with three consecutive dunks to take a 30-28 lead about 4 1/2 minutes before halftime.

The game was tied a couple of minutes later when the Aggies scored eight straight points, with the first six on free throws, to make it 40-32.

TEAM NOTES

- The Aggies outrebounded Ole Miss, 50-36, in the contest led by Jalen Jones' nine ... Four Aggies recorded seven or more boards.

A&M's bench scored 27 points to Ole Miss' 12 and outscored the Rebels 40-18 in the paint.

INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Senior **Anthony Collins** recorded 10 points, eight assists and a season-high six rebounds.

- Freshman **DJ Hogg** scored 10 points off the bench for his first double-digit performance since January 6 against Mississippi State and his fifth of the season.

- Senior **Alex Caruso** became the 35th member of Texas A&M's 1,000-Point Club, hitting the mark on a dunk put-back with 4:39 remaining in the first period.

- Fellow senior **Danuel House** also hit a milestone, eclipsing 1,500 career points between his time at the University of Houston and Texas A&M ... The Fresno, Texas, product notched 13 points on the night, leaving him with 1,511 points for his career.

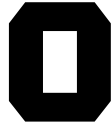

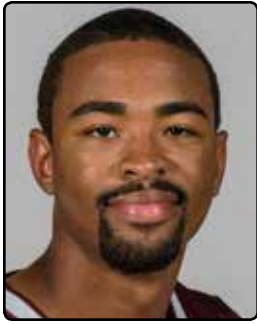
