THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW

- Kentucky takes a 12-match winning streak into Memorial Coliseum when they welcome South Carolina on Friday.
- Kentucky took down South Carolina 3-1 on Oct. 2. Four Wildcats had double-digit kills in the four-set match.
- Leah Edmond earned SEC Freshman of the Week honors for the fifth time this season after averaging a team-best 3.50 kills per set and 3.17 digs per frame during sweeps of Arkansas and Ole Miss.
- During the 12-match winning streak, UK has only dropped two sets (at South Carolina, vs. Mississippi State).
- Olivia Dailey is fifth in the country and second in the SEC with 11.69 assists per set. Dailey is a three-time SEC Setter of the Week.
- UK blitzed Ole Miss for 55 total kills – the most in a three-set match in the 25-point rally era. It also tops a season high total, as Kentucky posted 54 against Mississippi State a few weeks ago. Six players registered six or more kills on the day to pace the attack.

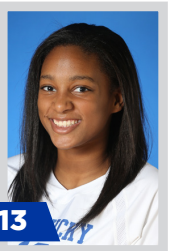

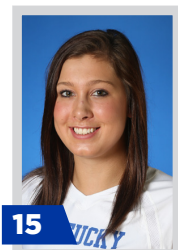

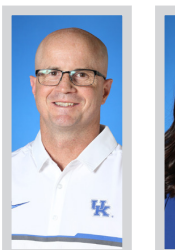

Scouting the Opponents

South Carolina (14-5, 2-5 SEC): After starting the season 12-0, South Carolina has picked up two Southeastern Conference wins this season. USC has swept LSU and defeated Tennessee, 3-2. UK has already faced the the Gamecocks once this season, and UK went into Columbia and took home a 3-1 win. Four Wildcats - Kaz Brown, Emily Franklin, Leah Edmond and Brooke Morgan - all hit double-digit kills during the win. South Carolina is led by Mikayla Shields with 2.91 kills per set.

Missouri (17-3, 8-0 SEC): Missouri is the only team other than Kentucky who is currently undefeated in league play. The Tigers sit on an 11-match winning streak. Melanie Crow leads the way for Mizzou with 3.80 kills per set, a team-best 0.51 service aces per set, 2.27 digs per set and 0.47 blocks per set.

Three-Set 25-Point Rally Era Kills' Record

During the sweep of Ole Miss, Kentucky set the three-set 25-point rally era kills' record. UK blitzed the Rebels for 55 total kills, which tops a season high total, as Kentucky posted 54 against Mississippi State a few weeks ago. Six players registered six or more kills on the day to pace the attack.

Dailey Sits Top-Five Nationally

Sophomore setter Olivia Dailey sits at No. 5 in the country in assists per set at 11.69, which is good enough for second in the SEC. The three-time defending SEC setter of the week had 46 assists in the match against Ole Miss, while adding six block assists and six digs. The 46 assists marks a new 25-point rally scoring era record for a three-set match.

Five SEC Freshman of the Week Awards

For the fifth-time in six weeks, Kentucky freshman Leah Edmond took home the SEC Freshman of the Week award. Edmond won the weekly honor after averaging a team-best 3.50 kills per set and 3.17 digs per frame during sweeps of Arkansas and Ole Miss. Edmond has reached double-digit kill totals in all but two matches. In SEC play, she is averaging a team-best 4.46 kills per frame on a .259 percentage.

Dailey Earns Honors in Three-Straight Weeks

Sophomore setter Olivia Dailey was named SEC Setter of the Week for the third-consecutive week after producing a combined 81 assists against Mississippi State and Tennessee. Dailey had 41 assists in the win over Mississippi State, three away from the 25-point rally scoring era three-set record. Dailey followed that performance with another 40 assists against Tennessee.

Edmond Named SEC Freshman of the Week (Again)

Freshman Leah Edmond earned SEC Freshman of the Week honors for the fourth time this season after racking up 33 kills in wins over Mississippi State and Tennessee. Edmond accounted for 19 kills, one off her career-high, for the second-time in two weeks in the win over the Bulldogs.

Top-25

Kentucky is nationally ranked for the third-straight week. After busting back into the AVCA Coaches Poll at No. 25 two weeks ago, the Wildcats picked up 328 points

and moved up to No. 21. This week marks the 94th week head coach Craig Skinner has led the Wildcats to a national ranking.

Double-Digit Digs

Junior libero Ashley Dusek has produced double-digit dig numbers in every contest this season for the Wildcats except one. Dusek has picked up 20 or more in three separate matches (Mississippi State, Marquette and Wyoming). The East Bernard, Texas native’s season-high is 27 against Mississippi State and she averages 4.52 digs per set.

Double-Digit Kills

Freshman outside hitter Leah Edmond has contributed double-digit kill totals in 17-of-19 matches this season. The Lexington, Kentucky, native has hit 15+ five times, including 19 in the wins over No. 5 Florida and Mississippi State. Edmond leads the squad in kills per set at 4.10. That total is good for third in the SEC and 41st in the nation.

Edmond Named SEC Player of the Week

Freshman Leah Edmond was named SEC Player of the Week after leading the team in kills in wins over No. 5 Florida and South Carolina. Edmond had 19 kills, one off her career-high, in the upset victory over the Gators. The Lexington, Kentucky native was also named Freshman of the Week for the third-time this season.

Third-Set Comeback

After going down 21-16 in the third set to South Carolina, Kentucky fought back to win the crucial set, 32-30. UK tied the frame at 24-24 with a kill by Emily Franklin, the game went back-and-forth until the set was tied at 30-30. Kills by Anni Thomason and Brooke Morgan, both assisted by Olivia Dailey, allowed the Wildcats to win the set. UK won the match 3-1 (25-22, 17-25, 32-30, 25-19).

Defense Stifles No. 5 Florida

Kentucky went into Gainesville and swept the No. 5 Florida Gators, 25-17, 25-18, 25-23. The defense shut down the Gators. UK had 11 team blocks, with junior Kaz Brown leading the charge with seven. Sophomore Brooke Morgan followed closely behind with six of her own.

Back-to-Back Wins in Gainesville

For the first time since the 1987 and 1989 seasons, UK has taken down Florida in back-to-back matches on its home court. Kentucky beat Florida 3-1 last season. The sweep of the Gators marked the first time Florida has been swept by UK since 1990.

Brown Earns SEC Offensive Player of the Week

Brown busted out in a big way offensively for the Cats in wins over Georgia and Mississippi State this week. The Waterloo, Iowa, native notched her first two double-digit kill efforts of the season. She posted a season-best 13 kills on a .579 attacking clip in a sweep of Georgia to begin the week. Brown added a team-best five blocks in the win. Against Mississippi State, she posted 12 kills while hitting .391, and chipped in four blocks.

Edmond Repeats as SEC Freshman of the Week

The 6-foot-2 outside hitter led the way for the Wildcats in wins over Louisville and Lipscomb to end the non-conference season with four-consecutive wins in the form of sweeps. Leah Edmond averaged 4.50 kills, 3.17 digs, 0.67 blocks and attacked at a .385 rate for the week. She’s posted 10 or more kills in 10 of 11 matches this season – including both that week. In her first taste of the rivalry match between Louisville, the calm, sure-handed freshman from Lexington, Kentucky, torched the Cards for a match-high 13 kills on .346 hitting. She added eight digs, the second most on the team, and a trio of blocks. Against Lipscomb, Edmond once again led the way with her third career double-double with match highs in kills (14) and digs (11). She posted a .423 attacking percentage, which was the second-highest of her career.

Non-Conference Season Ends in Style

Kentucky wrapped up non-conference action on Saturday with its fourth-consecutive win by way of a sweep, this time downing Lipscomb. UK was paced by the electric offensive play of its starting outside hitters in junior Darian Mack and freshman Leah Edmond. The duo teamed up for 24 kills and both boasted at least a .400 attacking percentage to pave the way for the Cats. Kentucky also limited an up-tempo Lipscomb offense to a mere .162 hitting and 35 kills on the night. UK posted seven blocks, four from junior Emily Franklin, while picking up 39 digs to frustrate the Bison all night. Edmond led the backline defensive effort with a

Make That Four in a Row

With a 3-0 win over Louisville in the annual matchup with the Cardinals, UK extended its streak to four in a row over its in-state rival. The Wildcats dominated in all phases of the match, including displaying a balanced offensive attack anchored by a steady presence defensively. Sophomore setter Olivia Dailey was the engineer to UK's crippling attack that boasted 46 total kills on a .358 attacking percentage. Dailey dished out 37 assists and added seven digs and a pair of blocks. Freshman Leah Edmond led the way with 13 kills, with Brooke Morgan and Kaz Brown adding nine apiece. Libero Ashley Dusek posted a match-high 15 digs, while junior Emily Franklin had a squad-best five blocks. In addition to the four-straight wins, UK has also taken six of the last seven overall and improved to 6-3 in the Skinner era.

Block Party at the Bluegrass Battle

Kentucky logged back-to-back matches of 16 or more blocks to conclude the Bluegrass Battle with sweeps of Virginia and Saint Louis. Junior middle blocker Kaz Brown broke out for 10 blocks in the win over the Cavaliers in which UK held the visitors to a negative hitting percentage. UK followed that performance with a 16.5 block party against Saint Louis. Brown had eight rejections, while classmate Emily Franklin joined in with seven.

Thomasson On Track for 1,000 Kill Club

In her final season with Kentucky, senior Anni Thomasson could become the 16th member of UK's 1,000 kill club, needing just 141 more to reach the milestone.

Edmond Named SEC Freshman of the Week

Freshman Leah Edmond enjoyed the most complete weekend of her young career in helping lead UK to a 2-1 mark at the Bluegrass Battle. She once again led the team in kills with a trio of 10+ kill performances, but she also registered a pair of double-doubles for the first time. In a loss to Marquette, Edmond posted 17 kills, just three shy of a career best, and broke out for a career-high 10 digs. Entering the weekend, she had registered just one dig in six combined matches. Against Virginia in a three-set victory she led the team with 11 kills, notched seven digs and then added a career-best seven blocks. Edmond followed that performance with 11 more kills in the win over Saint Louis that evening. She picked up her second career double-double as she added 10 digs and then she also contributed five rejections.

For the weekend, Edmond averaged 3.90 kills per set, 2.70 digs and 1.20 blocks per frame. She logged a team-high 4.60 points per set and utilized an efficient .243 attacking percentage on 107 attempts.

Cats Offense Catches Fire Against Creighton

Kentucky's offense was red-hot in the 3-0 sweep of then-No. 22 Creighton on Sept. 3. UK hit at a blistering .415 clip against the Bluejays. The match marked the first time since Nov. 4, 2014 that Kentucky hit .400 or better, when the Cats hit .449 against Morehead State. The team's efficiency was incredible as UK committed just five hitting errors the entire match, including a flawless third set. The last time Kentucky made five errors or less in a match was on Oct. 4, 2013, against Ole Miss.

Cats Close Opening Weekend with Pair of Wins

After a tough season opening loss to Washington State, 3-0 (17-25, 22-25, 17-25), the Kentucky Wildcats rallied, sweeping Wyoming, 3-0, before notching their first ranked win of the season in a 3-2 thriller over then-No. 20 Purdue. Freshman outside hitter Leah Edmond paved the way for UK on offense, hitting .316 with 3.91 kills per set over the weekend, while junior Darian Mack added 3.00 kills per frame. Sophomore Olivia Dailey filled the starting setter role, guiding the Cats to .258 hitting over the weekend, as UK notched the only win over a ranked opponent for any SEC team in the opening weekend. Junior middle blocker Emily Franklin led UK in both hitting percentage (.429) and blocks per set (0.73) during

Mack, Edmond Explode on Offense at Purdue

Kentucky's tandem of outside hitters in junior Darian Mack and freshman Leah Edmond had standout performances, pacing the offense in UK's upset of Purdue. Mack and Edmond each accounted for 20 kills in the 3-2 win over the Boilermakers, marking the first time since Nov. 7, 2008 in which a pair of Kentucky players had 20 or more kills in a single match (Sarah Mendoza, 24; Lauren Rapp, 23). It also marked the first time in a year that a Kentucky player had 20 or more kills in a single match - the last Wildcat to do so was middle blocker Kaz Brown, who posted 20 kills in the 2015 season opener against Michigan State.

Dusek Named Defensive Player of the Week

Following the season's opening weekend of play, the reigning Southeastern Conference Libero of the Year, Ashley Dusek, claimed the league's first Defensive Player of the Week honor.

Dusek anchored the Wildcats' defense with a team-best 46 digs over the weekend. In 51 reception attempts, she committed just one error. Dusek's weekend was highlighted by a 20-dig performance in three sets against Wyoming, four short of a Kentucky three-set record. The 20 digs in a three-set match were second most by an SEC player in three sets in the early season. Her passing led UK to hit .258 over the weekend and helped the Cats notch the SEC's lone win over a nationally ranked opponent in the opening weekend.

Wildcats Ranked in the Preseason Again

Kentucky enters the season ranked for a school-record fifth consecutive year, coming in at No. 24 in the initial AVCA preseason poll. Kentucky has now been ranked in 48 of the last 49 AVCA polls. UK will once again have one of the toughest schedules in the country this season, with six of its opponents ranked in the preseason top 25 and two more receiving votes.

Brown, Dusek Pegged Preseason All-SEC

Nine days prior to the season opener, the Southeastern Conference released its preseason polls, with juniors Kaz Brown and Ashley Dusek named to the All-SEC preseason team, while Kentucky was pegged to finish third in the SEC.

Brown, a middle blocker from Waterloo, Iowa, finished the 2015 season third in the nation in blocks per set (1.61) and seventh in total blocks (180). With 160 block assists last season, the All-SEC player ranked second in single-season block assists for Kentucky all-time, while claiming the most blocks ever by a UK player in a single season during the 25-point rally scoring era. She also notched two double-double efforts in the season, the first time a Kentucky middle had notched a double-double since 2007.

Dusek, the team's libero from East Bernard, Texas, led the Southeastern Conference in digs from wire-to-wire, averaging 5.05 per set during her sophomore campaign. The reigning SEC Libero of the Year's season was highlighted by a 40-dig performance at Auburn, breaking a 22-year-old UK record for most digs in a single match. Her 40 digs were the most in a single match for any player in the SEC last season and the only 40-dig performance from a player at a Power Five institution. Dusek was a model for consistency during the season, only registering two matches with less than 10 digs.

Wildcats Notch Second-Straight AVCA Academic Award

For the second consecutive season, the Kentucky Wildcats volleyball team earned the AVCA Team Academic Award, honoring the team's 3.383 cumulative grade point average for the 2015-16 school year. The Wildcats had an accomplished season in the classroom, surpassing the required 3.3 grade point average during both the fall and spring semesters. Additionally, eight members of the team held a 3.5 GPA or higher in both semesters, while three Wildcats posted individual GPA's of 3.9 or higher for the academic year. Kentucky was one of just four Southeastern Conference programs to be named award winners, with Alabama, Missouri and South Carolina also making the mark.

Kentucky Hauls in Another Top-10 Recruiting Class

Kentucky continues a tradition of stellar recruiting this season as the 2016 class was ranked the ninth-highest in the country earlier this year. The Cats boast the seventh-best prospect in the nation in Lexington native outside hitter Leah Edmond along with middle blocker Jordan Fry and defensive specialist Kylie Schmaltz.

With the top-10 class, Kentucky is just one of four schools in the country to have back-to-back top-10 recruiting classes, and the only school in the Southeastern Conference to do so. It also marks UK's seventh top-20 class under the guidance of head coach Craig Skinner. Skinner's rookies have always been able to make an impact, as Kentucky has placed a member of the team on the SEC All-Freshman team in each of the past 11 seasons.

Brown, Dusek Represent UK for Team USA

Wildcat junior duo Kaz Brown and Ashley Dusek both represented Kentucky as a part of the 2016 USA Collegiate National Team program. Brown was one of three middle blockers taken on the 12-person Chinese tour roster. A starter by the end of the tour, Brown helped guide the Collegiate National Team to the championship title after facing staunch competition in Shanghai, Nanjing and Beijing from June 18 - July 1.

Dusek was selected as one of six liberos at the Collegiate National Team's training program. The 36-member team trained and competed in conjunction with the USA Volleyball Girls' Junior National Championships, June 21-30 in Indianapolis. Dusek guided her squad to the championship of the event.

UKVB Earns SEC Sportsmanship Award

The Kentucky Volleyball team became the first UK team or individual to ever be honored with the SEC Sportsmanship Award earlier this year. The University of Kentucky volleyball team and support staff were named co-winners of the women's SEC Sportsmanship Award for their care of an injured LSU volleyball player last November.

During a pre-match warmup period, LSU senior Cati Leak suffered an ankle dislocation that was originally thought to be a compound fracture. Led by Kentucky athletic trainer Katy Poole, UK Athletics personnel leaped into action, providing immediate medical care and assistance to Leak's parents. UK personnel stayed with the family at a hospital throughout the medical evaluation period, and then provided hotel rooms to the family when it was determined surgery would be necessary. UK personnel remained with the family and Leak in the aftermath of the successful surgery.

In a follow-up gesture, Leak was honored at LSU's senior day three weeks later when Kentucky visited Baton Rouge. It was agreed upon by the teams to allow Leak to serve the first point of the match. UK deferred first serve to enable Leak to have the first serve of the match.

Tourney Time

Kentucky is one of just 10 teams in the country to advance to the NCAA tournament in each of the last 11 seasons. UK joins Colorado State, Florida, Hawai'i, Nebraska, Penn State, Southern California, Stanford, Texas and Washington in achieving the feat.

NCAA Revival Under Skinner

When head coach Craig Skinner arrived in Lexington prior to the 2005 season, UK had made six NCAA Tournaments, most recently in 1993 and never in more than two consecutive seasons. Eleven years later, the Wildcats have advanced to the postseason in each of Skinner's 11 seasons. Kentucky made its first NCAA Tournament under Skinner in 2005, won its first postseason match since 1992 in 2006 and advanced to the Sweet 16 in 2009. UK's Sweet 16 run in 2009 was UK's first regional appearance since 1993 and the first time the Wildcats had won two NCAA matches in the same season since 1989. Five times under Skinner's leadership, UK has earned a national seed and hosted the first and second rounds.

HEAD COACH CRAIG SKINNER

Since being tabbed Kentucky's head coach in December 2004, Craig Skinner has rejuvenated the Kentucky volleyball program into national prominence once again. Skinner has directed the Wildcats to **11** consecutive NCAA Tournaments - a feat only 10 other schools in the nation have achieved. That run includes **THREE** Sweet Sixteen appearances in the last six seasons. Furthermore, the Wildcats have captured **17 or more victories** in all **11** seasons under Skinner's direction, including tallying **20 or more wins** in **EIGHT** of the last **NINE**, including 2015.

He became the fastest coach in school allure to total 100 career victories in just his fifth season, and is the only coach in program history to advance to postseason play in each season at the helm. With the team's 3-1 victory over Georgia Southern on Sept. 13, 2014, he eclipsed Kathy DeBoer as the winningest coach in UK volleyball history.

Twelve players have garnered 18 All-America distinctions, while UK has hauled in 37 All-Southeastern Conference honors in his 10 seasons - including the 2008 SEC Player of the Year, 2006 SEC Freshman of the Year, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2014 and 2015 SEC Libero of the Year and the 2005 SEC Defensive Player of the Year.

The Wildcats have enjoyed unprecedented success which has included a school-record run of 47 consecutive weeks ranked in the top 25 of the American Volleyball Coaches Association poll, record-breaking attendance marks and a six time host of NCAA Tournament play including serving as one of four host sites for the 2011, 2013 and 2015 NCAA Regionals.

Playing in the friendly confines of Memorial Coliseum is a tremendous home-court advantage for the Kentucky volleyball team, which plays all of its matches in the historic facility.

The Wildcats have compiled a 406-155 record, good for a .724 winning percentage in their 40th season in the facility. In the last 12 seasons, Kentucky is an astounding 152-36 (.809) at home.

The Coliseum has played host to first-and second-round NCAA volleyball action as well as the 1983 NCAA Volleyball Final Four. It played host to NCAA Regionals in 2011, 2013 and 2015. Memorial also currently serves as the home court for the UK women's basketball and gymnastics teams. The storied gymnasium also housed some of the greatest moments in UK men's basketball history as its home for 26 seasons from 1950 to 1976.
