@UGA_WBB defeated Tennessee for the first time since 2010 - a string of 10-straight games.

@UGA_WBB's Caliya Robinson is averaging 18.8 ppg in Georgia's 12 wins and 9.1 in 11 losses.

@UGA_WBB's three seniors combined to start just 29 games entering the 2016-17 season.

@UGA_WBB's Pachis Roberts scored in double figures 12 times before this season. This year, she has scored in double figures 19 times.

@UGA_WBB's Haley Clark has recorded 55 total assists in 10 SEC games (5.5 per game).

OPENING TIP

» Georgia takes its two-game win streak into a matchup against Kentucky on Thursday night at Stegeman Coliseum. The game is available on SEC Network Plus (WatchESPN).

» Thursday is \$1 hotdog night for fans. In addition, the first 300 fans in attendance will receive a rally towel.

» The Lady Bulldogs enter Thursday's clash after a thrilling 81-78 double-overtime victory against No. 25 Tennessee on Sunday. It marked Georgia's first win against the Lady Vols since 2010 -- a string of 10-straight games.

» Caliya Robinson is the reigning ESPNW National Player of the Week as well as the SEC Player of the Week for her performances in each of the past two contests. The Marietta native, who has averaged 24.5 points and 7.5 rebounds per game in that span, is only the second Lady Bulldog all-time to win National Player of the Week honors, joining Kedra Holland-Corn in 1997.

» Pachis Roberts enters the matchup with Kentucky on an 11-game double-figure score streak. Teammate Mackenzie Engram has scored in double figures in four of the last five games.

» Georgia leads the all-time series against Kentucky, 36-17, including a 17-5 mark in Athens. The Wildcats have won three-straight, with the Lady Bulldogs' last win coming in 2014 -- a 58-56 victory in Athens.

JONI TAYLOR

2016 SPALDING MAGGIE DIXON NATIONAL COACH OF THE YEAR

HIGHLIGHTS

- » NCAA Tournament appearance in first season as head coach
- » Only the 12th head coach in SEC history to win 20 games or more in his or her first season

On Sunday, April 12, 2015, Joni (Crenshaw) Taylor, a member of the Georgia Basketball Staff for four seasons, including three as associate head coach, was appointed just the second full-time head coach in the program's illustrious history.

In her first season at the helm of the Georgia Lady Basketball program, Taylor led her team back to the NCAA Tournament for the 32nd time in school history, compiling five wins against ranked opponents (most for a Georgia team since 2006-07) on their way to a 21-10 record and 9-7 mark in SEC action. The Lady Bulldogs, who were picked ninth by league coaches in the preseason poll, finished strong in 2015-16, winning seven of their last nine regular season games to earn a No. 6 seed (just one game out of fourth place) in the SEC Tournament.

Georgia's 21-10 final record marked only the 12th time in league history that a first-year head coach won 20 or more games in his or her inaugural season at an SEC school, while her 12-1 start to the year was the third-best start for any SEC head coach in his or her first year with a program.

Taylor was honored for her successful first year as head coach, earning the prestigious WBCA Maggie Nixon NCAA National Rookie Coach of the Year Award, the Atlanta Tipoff Club's Whack Hyder College Coach of the Year Award and the Advocates for Athletic Equity Rookie Coach of the Year honor.

Taylor entered her current position as Georgia's head coach with 13 seasons of coaching experience at the Division I level, including seven within the South-eastern Conference.

Taylor succeeded Andy Landers, the only previous full-time women's basketball coach in the program's history. Landers announced his retirement on Monday, March 16 after 36 seasons. Landers compiled a 862-299 record at Georgia, making him one of only seven college basketball coaches -- women's or men's -- to record 850 wins at a single NCAA Division I school.

Taylor herself was a highly sought after basketball prospect. She was the 1997 Gatorade Player of the Year for Mississippi after leading Meridian High to a 67-7 record during her junior and senior seasons. She also won three state titles in track and field and was selected as the school's Homecoming Queen.

At Alabama, Taylor was a significant contributor to four teams that reached post-season play -- the 1998 and 1999 NCAA Tournaments and the 2000 and 2001 WNITs. She was a two-year starter and scored 716 points, grabbed 555 rebounds and blocked 103 shots, which is No. 4 among the Tide's career leaders.

Taylor also was a standout off the basketball court. She was recognized as one of the most influential African Americans on the Alabama campus in 2001, was named to the SEC's Community Service team for women's basketball in 1999, 2000 and 2001 and was awarded a post-graduate scholarship from the SEC for her community service record. She received her bachelor's degree in Education from Alabama in 2002.

Taylor married her husband, Darius, on August 1, 2015. The couple welcomed their first child, Jacie Elise, on Nov. 3, 2016.

ESPNW National Player of The Week ... Caliya's Rare Feat

» **For only the second time in school history a Lady Bulldog has won National Player of the Week honors.** Georgia sophomore Caliya Robinson established herself among some of the top players in the nation with back-to-back 20-point performances this week -- one coming on the road at Arkansas and the other against Tennessee. The 6-foot-3 sophomore not only averaged 24.5 points and 7.5 rebounds per contest, she also recorded a career-high seven blocks in the win against the Razorbacks.

The only other Lady Bulldog to garner the prestigious honor was Kedra Holland-Corn in 1997. She won the award after scoring 24 points against No. 12 Virginia and 30 against No.4 Tennessee.

Tennessee Win The First Since 2010

» The Georgia vs. Tennessee rivalry is seen by many as the best in SEC women's basketball. Sunday's meeting will go down as one of the most intense between the two programs, with the Lady Bulldogs taking an 81-78 win in double overtime. **The victory marked Georgia's first against the Lady Vols since 2010, breaking a streak of 10-straight losses.**

Georgia trailed by six, 58-52, with 1:42 remaining in regulation, before Pachis Roberts drilled a 3-pointer with 1:01 left in the game. Caliya Robinson then scored on a tip-in with 14 seconds on the clock to make it 58-57. After Tennessee split a pair of free-throws, Haley Clark then drove coast-to-coast to score with two seconds remaining to send the game into overtime.

Robinson Breaks Through At Arkansas

» **Caliya Robinson saw her streak of four consecutive single-digit scoring performances finally come to an end against Arkansas.** Robinson led Georgia with 20 points, nine rebounds and seven blocks against the Razorbacks. Robinson stormed out to 11-straight double-figures scoring games to begin the season, but averaged just 5.8 ppg over the next eight contests. She is now averaging 24.5 per game over the last two contests and has scored 20 or more points seven times.

Pachis' Production Up In Senior Season

» **Just one glance at the stat sheet and it is easy to see Pachis Roberts' improvement in her senior season. She is averaging 14.2 points per game (16.2 per game in conference play) and has started all 23 contests.** In the previous three years combined, Roberts averaged just 5.0 ppg and started a total of 13 games. Below is a closer look at Roberts' improvement:

Engram Showing Consistency

» **Junior guard/forward Mackenzie Engram, who missed the last 16 games last season due to an illness, is starting to show glimpses of 2015, when she placed on SEC All-Freshman Team.** The Powder Springs native has scored in double figures in four of the last five games, averaging 14.4 ppg during those contests. Engram scored 18 points against Florida, 10 vs. #5 South Carolina, 19 at Ole Miss and 18 against #25 Tennessee.

Georgia Takes No. 5 South Carolina To The Wire

» **Georgia came within seconds of breaking South Carolina's then 26-game SEC win streak on Jan. 12.** In what was a back-and-forth game, the fifth-ranked Gamecocks never led by more than five points in the fourth quarter, with Georgia taking the lead at 55-53 with 4:51 remaining. **The Lady Bulldogs had a chance to tie the game with just five seconds remaining, but Haley Clark's second free-throw fell just short as USC held on for the win.**

Freshman Clutch At The Buzzer

» In a game that featured eight lead changes and four ties, **Georgia overcame a 13-point deficit in the first half to take down Vanderbilt.** Freshman Stephanie Paul played a crucial role, not just in the final seconds, in the win against Vandy. She scored eight points in the third quarter, including the go-ahead shot at the beginning of the second half that gave Georgia its first lead since it was 2-0 in the early going.

Defensive Numbers Carrying Over

» Georgia led the Southeastern Conference in most major defensive categories last season, pacing the league in field-goal percentage defense, 3-point field-goal percentage defense and scoring defense. Even though the team is mostly different from a season ago with the departure of four senior starters, some of those numbers have carried over. **Georgia has held 15 opponents at or below 40-percent shooting this season, including a season-low 35.9 percent shooting effort from Texas A&M and a 27.8 percent performance from Arkansas.** In the Joni Taylor Era, Georgia has held 44 of 54 opponents to the 40-percent clip.

Robinson Puts Her Name Among Georgia Greats

» **With her 24-point, 11-rebound effort against Samford on Dec. 22, Caliya Robinson became just the fourth Lady Bulldog since 2000 to record three or more 20-point, 10 rebound games in their careers, joining an elite group of former Lady Dogs — Tasha Humphrey, Christi Thomas and Kara Braxton.** Robinson already has 16 double-figure scoring efforts (surpassing last year's total) and five double-doubles.

» **Caliya Robinson became the first Lady Bulldog since Tasha Humphrey in 2008 to score 30 points in a single game.** Robinson had a career day against Minnesota on Nov. 24, scoring 30 points off a 14-for-27 shooting performance. Humphrey scored 32 points against Florida on Feb. 24, 2008.

Short Bench, Starting Five Shift for The Lady Bulldogs

» Georgia's roster features just eight scholarship players and one walk-on this season. The Lady Bulldogs lost four senior starters off last year's team and lost incoming freshman Kortney Eisenman due to a heart condition before the start of the season. **Georgia has used eight different starting lineup combinations so far with the most common being Haley Clark, Shanea Armbrister, Pachis Roberts, Mackenzie Engram and Caliya Robinson.**

» Matthew Mitchell's Kentucky Wildcats enter Thursday's game with a 16-8 record and 7-4 mark in SEC play. The Wildcats have lost two of their last three games, dropping out of the top-25 this past week. A 2016 NCAA Sweet 16 team which finished with a 25-8 record, Kentucky was picked to finish fifth in this year's league standings. Mitchell's teams have advanced to the NCAA Tournament a school-record seven-straight times. This year, Kentucky is led by four players scoring in double figures, including Makayla Epps' 17.2 points per game. Evelyn Akhator, who scored 24 points and had 16 rebounds in the last meeting with UGA, is second on the team with 15.0 ppg.

Joni Taylor Gives Birth To First Baby Girl

» Head coach Joni Taylor and her husband Darius welcomed their first child, Jacie Elise Taylor, into the world Nov. 3. She weighed 6 pounds, 5 ounces and was 20 inches long. Associate head coach Karen Lange took over head coaching duties in the interim through the first six games. Taylor was on the bench for each of those games, except when the team played in the Bahamas on Nov. 24 and 26. Jacie has made several appearances at Georgia games this season and takes a seat beside her father, Darius, behind the Georgia bench.

GEORGIA'S 2017 SIGNING CLASS RANKS NO. 10 NATIONALLY

The Lady Bulldogs' 2017 signing class currently ranks among the top-10 in the nation according to ESPN.com's Hoopgurlz. Head coach Joni Taylor and her staff have signed some of the top players in the country, with all four of this year's signees ranking in the ESPN top-100.

Que Morrison // Guard // Powder Springs, Georgia // ESPN.com Five Stars

Quanniecia 'Que' Morrison is one of the top high school players in the state of Georgia and a five-star prospect according to ESPN's HoopGurlz. Morrison, who helped Powder Springs, Georgia, powerhouse McEachern High School to a state championship this past year, is ranked as the No. 31 overall prospect and the No. 7 guard nationally in the 2017 class according to ESPN's Hoopgurlz.

Gabby Connally // Point Guard // San Antonio, Texas // ESPN.com Five Stars

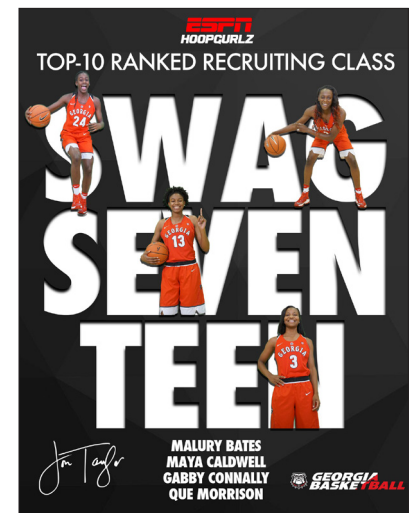

Kelly and Coco Miller Join UGA's Circle Of Honor

» Kelly and Coco Miller, twin sisters from Rochester, Minnesota who rank No. 4 and No. 5 respectively on the Lady Bulldogs' all-time career scoring list, were a dynamic duo that dazzled Georgia fans and helped the team to several remarkable accomplishments during their time in Athens. The duo will add to their impressive list of honors and will be enshrined into the University of Georgia's Circle of Honor at a ceremony on Feb. 11.

The Miller twins were each four-year starters for the Lady Bulldogs from 1997-2001 and helped Georgia advance to the 1999 Final Four, capture the 2000 SEC Championship and win the 2001 SEC Tournament title. Kelly (2,177 points) and Coco (2,131 points) are two of only five Lady Bulldogs to score more than 2,000 points. They also rank among Georgia's top-10 career leaders in field goals made and attempted as well as steals.

Georgia Replacing Production

» Entering 2016-17, the Lady Bulldogs had to replace four senior starters off of last year's team. Shacobia Barbee, Tiaria Griffin, Merritt Hempe and Marjorie Butler accounted for 65 percent of Georgia's scoring and over 50 percent of the team's rebounding a season ago. Barbee and Griffin were two All-SEC performers, while Butler played in all 31 games at the point guard spot. The group combined for 479 games played and made three NCAA Tournaments (Elite Eight in 2013).

Lady Bulldogs Go International

» Georgia's roster has an international feel to it this season with the addition of Romania native and Washington State transfer Bianca Blanaru as well as Portugal native Simone Costa. Shanea Armbrister, who is in her second season with the Lady Bulldogs, grew up in the Bahamas and will make a return trip home when Georgia travels to the Junkanoo Jam on Nov. 24-26.

Robinson Rises Among SEC's Top Up-and-Comers

» Georgia's Caliya Robinson completed a banner year in 2015-16. Robinson etched her name into the history books, moving ahead of UGA great Katrina McClain for the fifth-most blocked shots for a Georgia freshman with 48 -- a total that ranked third overall in the SEC last season.

She was an x-factor all season long and finished strong, recording four consecutive double-figure scoring games down the stretch. The 2016 SEC All-Freshman Team selection and three-time SEC Freshman of the Week honoree finished the year averaging 8.0 points per game to go along with 5.7 rebounds per contest.

Jan. 15, 2017 - LADY BULLDOGS FALL AT KENTUCKY

LEXINGTON, Ky. -- The Georgia Lady Bulldogs (10-8, 2-3) dropped an 82-61 contest to the Kentucky Wildcats (12-6, 3-2) Sunday afternoon at Memorial Coliseum in Lexington.

"We let Evelyn (Akhator) score the first eight points of the game and Kentucky didn't look back," Georgia head coach Joni Taylor. "Then we started pressing on offense, doing things outside of what we are comfortable doing as far as forcing things on offense and continuing to let them score on the other end. We talk about that all the time, getting off to a good start and being on the road. We just haven't figured out how to come out and throw the first punch."

Redshirt senior Pachis Roberts led the way for Georgia with 20 points and six rebounds, both team bests. Junior guards Shanea Armbrister and Simone Costa supplied the Lady Bulldogs with 13 points and 10 points, respectively.

Kentucky's Evelyn Akhator led all scorers with 24 points and 16 rebounds. Three other Wildcats contributed double-digit scoring outputs to pace the Kentucky attack.

TAYLOR TAKES LADY DOGS TO TOURNEY IN FIRST YEAR
Strong Start ... Even Better Finish

» Georgia stormed out to an impressive start last season under head coach Joni Taylor, rolling to a 12-1 record before conference play began on Jan. 3. The Lady Bulldogs finished the year with a 21-10 record and 9-7 mark in SEC play, putting Taylor's name in elite company for first-year head coaches. ***In fact, Taylor became one of just 12 coaches in SEC history to record 20 or more wins in his or her first year with their respective programs.***

Dominant Defense A Trademark Of 2015-16 Season

» Georgia paced the Southeastern Conference in nearly every defensive category last season. The Lady Bulldogs ranked first in scoring defense (54.1 points per game), field-goal percentage defense (35 percent) and 3-point field-goal percentage defense (24.3%). The 54.1 points allowed per game marks the second-best defensive points per game effort for a single season in school history.

20-Win Season The Usual For Georgia

» Georgia recorded 20 or more wins for the 30th time in the past 37 years with its 21-10 record in 2015-16, building on the great tradition and history of Lady Bulldog basketball. With their appearance in the 2016 NCAA Tournament, the Lady Dogs rank second all-time in NCAA history with 32 appearances -- a total that only trails Tennessee.

Five Top-25 Wins In 2015-16

» Georgia won five games over ranked opponents during the 2015-16 season for the first time since 2006-07. Four of those victories came against SEC foes, while one win came against then-No. 21 Seton Hall, who finished third in the Big East. UGA also had a victory against BYU, who won the West Coast Conference regular season title.

Taylor Gets Most Prestigious Honor For First Year Coach

» Georgia head coach Joni Taylor won several honors for her team's success in her first year as head coach. Among them was the 2016 Spalding Maggie Dixon National Rookie Coach of the Year award, which goes to the top first-year head coach in the country. Taylor also earned the Atlanta Tip-Off Club Georgia College Coach of the Year honor.

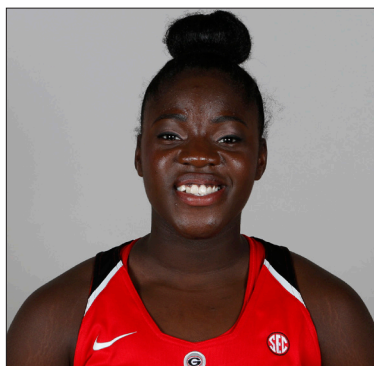
