Chris Chiozza's triple-double off the bench vs. Missouri is the first triple-double by any player in the nation off the bench in nearly nine years, last accomplished by Chris Lowe of UMass on March 5, 2008. It was the first triple-double by a Gator since Nick Calathes vs. Georgia on Jan. 28, 2009.

The Gators' three straight wins by 30+ points marks the third such streak in school history. However, all three games in the first two instances were vs. mid- and low-major opponents in Gainesville. The current streak features all high-major opponents, including two on the road.

This marks Florida's fifth time hosting College GameDay, joining Duke, Kansas and Kentucky as the only four schools to host the show at least five times.

- Kentucky leads the all-time series, 99-37, including a 35-24 advantage for the Wildcats in Gainesville.
- The Gators enter the game following perhaps the most dominant three-game stretch in program history, winning by 35 at LSU, 32 at Oklahoma and 39 vs. Missouri. UF's win vs. Missouri was highlighted by Chris Chiozza's triple-double (12/12/10), UF's first since 2009 (Nick Calathes).
- UF earned an 84-52 win at Oklahoma in the SEC/Big 12 Challenge, handing the Sooners their worst home loss in 95 years. It also marked the first time in school history the Gators notched back-to-back road wins by a 30+ margin of victory.
- The Gators posted the most prolific 3-point shooting night in school history at LSU, knocking down 19 3-pointers at LSU. The 106-71 decision marked UF's highest-scoring conference game in nearly 42 years.
- Florida's non-conference schedule is rated the #3 toughest in the nation. UF has four RPI top-50 wins, including a road win at #28 Arkansas, and nine top-100 wins. Only one Gator loss is to a team outside the RPI top 20 (#48 Vanderbilt).
- UF posted its seventh all-time 5-0 start to SEC play, as Mike White became the fourth coach in school history to post such a start.
- No opponent this season has reached its season average in regulation against the Gator defense. Georgia is the only team to hit its scoring average, but needed overtime to do so.
- In wins against Alabama and Georgia, Florida posted a 92-22 advantage in bench scoring, including a 51-5 edge against Georgia that included Canyon Barry's 27-point output. Keith Stone recorded a team-high 14 at Alabama and a career-best 17 vs. Georgia.
- KeVaughn Allen was named SEC Player of the Week on Jan. 9, following Florida's wins vs. Tennessee and Ole Miss. Allen shot 4-for-4 from 3-point range in the second half vs. the Vols, leading UF with 23 points. Justin Leon chipped in a career-high 19 points vs. the Vols, as well.
- Florida won its SEC opener for the fifth straight season with an 81-72 decision at Arkansas, led by KeVaughn Allen's 21 points.
- The Gators came into league play off their first home game of the season, a 94-71 win vs. Little Rock in which they went 16-for-31 from 3-point range and had seven different players knock down a shot from long range.
- UF bounced back from its first loss of the season to defeat Miami after coming up short against 11th-ranked Gonzaga. The Gators posted a 31-17 advantage over the final 15 minutes to win the game, sparked by Keith Stone's 15 points and team-high eight rebounds off the bench.
- The Gators posted a hard-fought 81-76 win vs. Seton Hall, with KeVaughn Allen (21) and Canyon Barry (20) both topping 20 points.
- The Gators' depth has been on display all season as eight different players have led the team in scoring. UF boasts so many capable scorers that no player outright led the team in scoring in back-to-back games until Barry did so in the 17th and 18th games of the season.

The University of Florida hired Mike White as head men's basketball coach, on Thursday, May 7, 2015.



In his first season at the helm, White guided Florida to a 21-15 record, one of three active SEC coaches to post a 20-win season in their first year on the job. It also matched a Florida record for most wins by a first-year head coach.

Under White, the Gators returned to the postseason, advancing to the quarterfinals of the NIT before falling to eventual tournament winner George Washington.

The Gators entered the second year under White's leadership with a unique challenge in front of them, playing the first 11 games of the season away from home as the renovation of Exactech Arena at the Stephen C. O'Connell Center finishes. Florida has a total of just 10 home games this season.

White, the 2014-15 Conference USA Coach of the Year, came to the Gators after leading Louisiana Tech to a 101-40 record (.716) over his last four seasons, including three straight conference championships. Born in Dunedin, Fla., White brought a wealth of SEC experience to the Gators, as a four-year starter at Ole Miss and later an assistant coach for seven seasons under two different head coaches on the Rebels' bench.

"I got confidence from my teammates telling me to shoot, and they gave me confidence. Even though I had a bad start they kept telling me 'keep going, you're doing well,' and we just came together as a family."

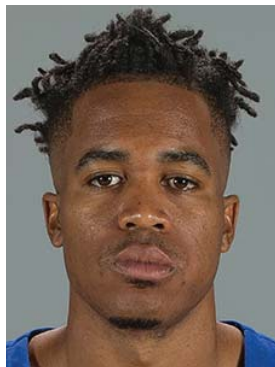

# MEDIA INFORMATION

The University of Florida appreciates the media coverage from all local, regional and national outlets. The Communications Office believes in developing mutually beneficial relationships with the media and we emphasize a positive and professional working environment with all entities. The ultimate goal of the Communications Office is to provide accurate and timely information about our athletic teams and to ensure that we assist the media to the best of our abilities while they cover our program.

## GAME COVERAGE

**CREDENTIALS:** Requests for credentials will be taken online and reviewed by Denver Parler. To access the credential request form, please visit [www.sportssystem.com/florida](http://www.sportssystem.com/florida). Once you have submitted your credential request, you will receive an automated email from the Communications Department acknowledging your request was received and is being reviewed. Once a decision on your request is made, you will receive an email with further information. Requests must be made by the day prior to a game (noon for afternoon games or 4:30 p.m. for evening games).

**CREDENTIAL PICK-UP:** Credentials will be mailed up until 10 days prior to the event or held at the Press Will Call window at Gate One of the O'Connell Center, which opens for pick-up 90 minutes prior to each game. Credentials can be overnighted at the expense of the media organization within 10 days of the event (by request).

**PARKING:** A limited number of parking spaces exist and can be requested online with your credential application. Please note that if you request to pick up your credentials at Press Will Call, we will be unable to provide a parking pass as you will have to park before visiting Press Will Call. Free parking is available in the deck next to the O'Connell Center and is generally still available 75-90 minutes before the game.

**MEDIA ROOM/INTERVIEW AREA:** Located between Gates 1 & 4 in the Martial Arts room near the loading dock, the media room includes work space, necessary electrical outlets, a television and wireless internet. A pre-game meal, snacks and soft drinks are also available in the media room. The pre-game meal begins 1:15 before tip. Post-game coach and player press conferences are also conducted in this area.

**FLORIDA LOCKER ROOM:** The Gator locker room is closed to the media with the exception of the SEC and NCAA Tournaments. Coach White and selected players will be available to the media following games in the media room/interview area. At Florida home games, players are available first while Coach White will follow with a post-game press conference in the Martial Arts/Media Room. If the visiting team chooses to utilize the media room, they will do so either directly before or after Florida players. Coach White will typically go last.

**VISITOR LOCKER ROOM:** Interview policies and procedures will be determined by visiting Sports Information Directors and coaches. Those procedures will be announced on game days.

**GENERAL GAME DAY MEDIA SERVICES:** Game program/scorecard, game notes, play-by-play, complete halftime and final statistics, coaches' & player quote sheets and post-game notes are all regular services on game days.

**SEATING:** Press seating is assigned, and all media members are asked to utilize their assigned seat. A limited number of front-row courtside press seats are available and will be provided to national publications, major daily newspapers and/or those who cover Florida basketball regularly. Additional seating will be at the front row table in the baseline bleachers near Gate 2 and in the second row courtside behind the press table. Photographers are restricted to two baseline locations closest to the team benches.

## Overview

## 2016-17 Highlights

- Made two massive plays on the defensive end in the final minute vs. St. Bonaventure to help the Gators secure the victory. With UF holding a two-point lead, Chiozza skied for a two-handed rebound and found John Egbunu heading down court for a dunk, then forced a turnover and ignited the break leading to a Devin Robinson dunk.

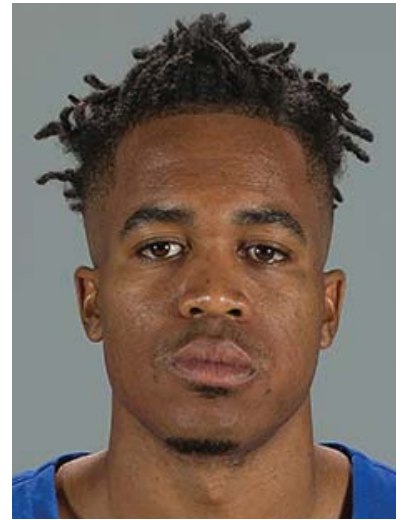
