THE YOUNG GUNS

Today's game features two of the youngest Division I teams. Kentucky has eight new players on its roster, while Morehead State features 10 newcomers. The Eagles return four players from 2016-17, but only Division I start among those four.

SPRADLIN ERA CONTINUES

After leading Morehead State to a 12-9 record and a second-place finish in the OVC East as the interim head coach, former Kentucky graduate assistant and assistant operations director Preston Spradlin will be in his first official season as head coach at Morehead State.

PRESEASON PREDICTIONS

Both the members of the media and the coaches/media relations directors have selected Morehead State for a ninth-place showing in the Ohio Valley Conference race in 2016-17.

NEW VENUE FOR OVC TOURNAMENT

After 24 consecutive years playing the Ohio Valley Conference Tournament at two different venues in Nashville, Tenn., the league's eight-team postseason event moves to Evansville, Indiana this season. The men's and women's tournament will take place at the Ford Center Feb. 28-March 3.

SHARPSHOOTER WALKER

Sophomore guard **Jordan Walker** led the OVC in three-point percentage as a true freshman last year. Walker nailed 49 percent from beyond the arc, hitting 38-of-77 triples. In fact, just more than half of his total field goal attempts (77 of 150) were taken from beyond three-point range.

HARRIS TABBED PRESEASON ALL-OVC

Junior forward **Lamontray Harris** has been selected to a preseason All-Ohio Valley Conference team by College Sports Madness. Harris was tabbed to the third-team squad. Last season, Harris played in all 30 games, with one start. He averaged 9.4 points and 5.2 rebounds a game. Harris ranked 20th in the OVC in rebounding (156 total rebounds). He registered two double-doubles (against Asbury on Dec. 28 and at Belmont on Feb. 18). He had a nice night with 20 points and seven rebounds at SEC foe Mississippi State, starting 7-of-8 from the floor before finishing 7-of-11. Harris also scored a career-high 22 points at Eastern Washington.

MSU'S PRO CONNECTIONS

Former Eagle guard Brent Arrington has been chosen to suit up for the NBA G-League's Greensboro Swarm, giving Morehead State 18 former players who played at some professional level since the 2010-11 season. NATIONAL AUDIENCE ON EPSN

The Eagles' game at Murray State on Thursday, Jan. 25 has been selected as the league's game of the week for ESPNU. Tipoff that evening at the CFSB Center will be at 7 p.m. ET. Morehead State could also appear at least twice more on the ESPN family of networks if the Eagles reach the semifinals or championship of the OVC Tournament in Evansville, Ind. The semifinals (on March 2) will air on ESPNU, and the championship game (on March 3) will air live on ESPN2 at 8 p.m. ET.

FOUR MORE ON NATIONAL TV

MSU will make two appearances on the national television carrier CBS Sports Network in 2017-18. The two contests are part of a seven-game Ohio Valley Conference package. The Eagles' first exposure will also give fans and students a chance to showcase the Johnson Arena atmosphere as the Eagles will host Jacksonville State on Jan. 18. Morehead State's other appearance on CBS Sports Network will come on Saturday, Feb. 17 at 8 p.m. ET at Belmont. In addition, the Nov. 10 game at Xavier will be on Fox Sports, and the Dec. 19 game at Butler will air on Fox Sports 1.

FORMER EAGLE INDUCTED INTO KENTUCKY HIGH SCHOOL HALL OF FAME

Harold Sergent, a former standout for the Eagles, was inducted into the Kentucky High School Basketball Hall of Fame July 22. Sergent helped lead the 1961 Ashland High School team to a state championship. He went on to star at Morehead State from 1962-65, compiling 1,469 career points to rank 11th all-time on the 1,000-point club list. He also ranks ninth all-time with 363 free throws made during his career.

PRESTON SPRADLIN -- MOREHEAD STATE HEAD COACH

12-9, .571 at Morehead State (second season as head coach, fourth with program) / 12-9, .571 as head coach (second season)



Preston Spradlin is his first season as full-time head coach after spending the majority of the 2016-17 season as interim head coach. He is in his fourth season overall with the Morehead State men's basketball program and his ninth year working with a Division I program.

Spradlin officially took on the interim head coaching position on Dec. 15, 2016, nine games into the 2016-17 season after the Eagles opened with a 2-7 record. He then guided Morehead State to a 12-9 record the rest of the way and a 10-6 mark in OVC play, which ranked second in the league.

During his three years as assistant coach, his time was spent in a variety of areas, including recruiting, scouting, practice/game preparation and academics monitoring.

Following the 2015-16 season, Spradlin was named to the National Basketball Coaches Association (NABC) 2016 Under Armour 30-Under-30-Team, which recognizes 30 men's basketball coaches across the country that are under the age of 30.

Spradlin came to Morehead State after five seasons with national power Kentucky. He spent two campaigns (2009-11) as a graduate assistant with the Wildcats before three years as the assistant director of operations (2011-14). His duties included film breakdown, creating and maintaining playbooks, assisting with opponent scouting and day-to-day operations.

In his final post at Kentucky, Spradlin was responsible for film exchange and created a variety of opponent and self-scouting edits for coaches and players. He also worked with personnel from the National Basketball Association, while assisting in other aspects of basketball operations.

Spradlin, a native of Pikeville, Ky., served as director of the John Calipari Basketball Camps and Clinics from 2012-14. He was the primary contact for satellite tour stops across the state of Kentucky and coordinated the first-ever Basketball Fantasy Experience for UK's head coach.

Spradlin earned a bachelor's degree in history from Alice Lloyd (Ky.) in 2009 and master's degree in kinesiology and health promotion, with a sports leader-ship emphasis, from Kentucky in 2011. He was a four-year men's basketball letterwinner for the NAIA Eagles from 2005-09.

Spradlin, a 2005 graduate of Betsy Layne High School (Ky.), is married to the former Misty Tackett. The couple has one son, Bentley, who was born on June 19, 2012.






