Finale In Sanford Stadium

The matchup between the Bulldogs and Wildcats is Georgia's final home game of the 2017 season. Currently, this year's Bulldog seniors have 37 career victories and are in pursuit of their fourth consecutive postseason victory. This class has bowl victories over Louisville (Belk Bowl), Penn State (TaxSlayer Bowl) and TCU (Liberty Bowl).

In this span, the 2017 SEC Eastern Division champion Bulldogs have eight wins over top-25 opponents, including two this year. Also of note, they have claimed Georgia's first SEC division title since 2012 and will take aim at the school's first conference title since 2005. The 2017 Bulldogs enjoyed a 9-0 start, which was the best for the team since 1982. Georgia is coming off a 40-17 loss at #10 Auburn this past Saturday.

Series History

In the all-time series history with Kentucky, Georgia leads 56-12-2, including a 27-4-2 mark in Athens. Georgia has a seven-game winning streak in the series with Kentucky's last victory coming in 2009 in Athens (34-27). The Bulldogs won 27-24 in Lexington last year and in 2015, Georgia posted a 27-3 victory in Athens.

A Glance At The Wildcats

Kentucky has played six games this season decided by a touchdown or less and won four of them. The losses came to Ole Miss and Florida as they scored the go-ahead touchdown in the final minute of the contest. The Wildcats had one last shot against the Gators but missed a 57-yard field goal as time expired.

Kentucky scored a season-high 44 points to top Vanderbilt in Nashville last weekend. The Wildcats rushed for 232 yards, the defense registered five sacks and special teams play was highlighted by a 93-yard kickoff return.

Sophomore running back Benny Snell Jr., who is second in the SEC in Rushing Yards (1,113), was on the watch lists for the *Maxwell Award* and the *Doak Walker Award*. He is the third player in SEC history to have at least 1,000 rushing yards and at least 13 rushing touchdowns in his freshman and sophomore seasons, joining Georgia's Herschel Walker (1980-81) and Knowshon Moreno (2007-08).

FLASHBACK: Georgia Edges Kentucky 27-24

With the game tied at 24-all at the 2:42 mark in the fourth quarter, the Bulldogs had the ball at their own 25. Freshman QB **Jacob Eason** marched Georgia 69 yards on nine plays. Eason was 4-for-4 for 42 yards on the drive. **Rodrigo Blankenship** then stepped up and hit a 25-yard field goal as time expired to cap the comeback. This was Blankenship's fourth field goal in the contest and he became the 10th player in Georgia history to make four field goals in the game.

Both squads had success running the ball as Georgia's **Sony Michel** had 127 yards on 19 carries and UK freshman Benny Snell Jr. had 114 yards on 21 attempts and two touchdowns. Eason finished 17-of-31 for 245 yards and a touchdown. His primary target was **Javon Wims**, who posted career highs of five catches for 90 yards. Georgia's defense had a goal-line stand late in the game as UK was forced to a game-tying field goal.

KIRBY SMART

Head Football Coach



When Georgia looked for a new head football coach after the 2015 season, the arrows pointed to Kirby Smart, longtime University of Alabama defensive coordinator and former UGA player and assistant. After one season, he has not disappointed.

In his first year leading the Bulldogs, Georgia extended its school record to 20 consecutive bowl appearances and posted five fourth-quarter comebacks including wins over No. 8 Auburn and No. 22 North Carolina. He led UGA to an 8-5 final record, which included a victory overTCU in the Liberty Bowl.

He has also made an immediate impact in recruiting circles posting the nation's third-ranked class in 2017 following his first class in 2016 generally considered among the top ten. In addition to his coaching duties, Smart oversees the Kirby Smart Family Foundation, which is focused on being champions in the community by supporting and giving back to needy children and families.

Smart officially came home to Georgia on Dec. 6, 2015. But he still had unfinished business at Alabama, which was chasing a national title. He juggled two jobs for a month until January 11, 2016, when the Tide won its fourth national championship in a seven-year span. Twelve hours later, he was at work in Athens, where he is one of nine head coaches at schools from Power 5 conferences that are coaching at their alma mater.

*The Bulldogs' No. 2 AP ranking in 2017 was the team's top AP ranking since week three of the 2008 season when Georgia was No. 2. The Bulldogs were ranked No. 1 in the preseason in '08.

Bulldog Offense Averaging 34.6 Points Per Game

Georgia enters the Kentucky game having already clinched the Eastern Division with an SEC record of 6-1. The Bulldogs are averaging 34.6 points/game overall. The Bulldogs lead the nation in Red Zone Offense, going 37-for-38, including 27 touchdowns.

Freshman QB **Jake Fromm** is 8-1 as a starter and is ranked fourth in the SEC in Passing Efficiency at 163.4. Georgia leads the SEC and ranks sixth nationally in Third Down Conversions at 48 percent. Six of Fromm's 16 touchdown passes have covered at least 30 yards. Fromm took over for sophomore **Jacob Eason** after he went down with a knee injury in the first quarter of the season opener versus Appalachian State.

Fromm is a two-time recipient of *SEC Freshman of the Week* honors. He earned the accolade in victories over #17 MSU and versus Missouri. In the era of RPOs, Fromm has three rushing touchdowns to go with his passing stats.

Fromm is only the seventh true freshman Bulldog quarterback to start a game, including just the second to do it on the road in his first career start. Fromm joined Eric Zeier (1991) as the only true freshmen to have their first career start on the road.

Fromm's first career start came at #24 Notre Dame. Trailing 19-17 with 6:47 left in the contest, Fromm directed a nine play, 63-yard drive to set up the go-ahead field goal. He was 3-for-4 for 45 yards during the drive.

Chubb, Michel Highlight Bulldog Rushing Attack

The centerpieces of the Bulldog backfield are seniors **Nick Chubb** and **Sony Michel** (for a complete look at Chubb's career, see pg. 4). Chubb, a *Maxwell Award* semifinalist, ranks fourth in SEC history with 4,318 career rushing yards.

Here's the top five active rushing leaders in NCAA FBS:

- 1. Royce Freeman (Oregon), Sr., 49 games, 5,364 yards, 54TDs
- 2. Justin Jackson (Northwestern), Sr., 48 games, 4,973 yards, 38TDs
- 3. Jarvion Franklin (W. Michigan), Sr., 50 games, 4,700 yards, 51 TDs
- 4. Nick Chubb (Georgia), Sr., 42 games, 4,318 yards, 39TDs 5. Larry Rose III (New Mexico St.), Sr., 39 games, 4,246 yards, 32TDs
- 16. Sony Michel (Georgia), Sr., 42 games, 3,142, 26 TDs

Georgia ranks second the SEC and is 10th nationally in Rushing Offense at 256.0 yds/game. Chubb leads the SEC with 16 runs of 15+ yards this season.

Michel went for 137 yards and two touchdowns on just six carries in the win over Florida to become only the sixth Bulldog in school history to rush for more than 3,000 yards.

Chubb and Michel are the first Bulldog teammates to each have 1,000-yard rushing seasons in their career.

A Look At The Line

Georgia ranks second in the SEC in Rushing Offense at 256.0 ypg. A week after facing #10 Auburn, who has one of the best Rushing Defenses in the league, the Bulldogs now face a Kentucky front who ranks fourth surrendering 121.9 yards/game. The Bulldogs tallied 292 yards and four touchdowns on the ground against Florida. Coming into the contest, the Gators had allowed just four rushing TDs on the year, which ranked third nationally. Against Missouri, the Bulldogs piled up 370 rushing yards and finished with the second-most total yards (696) in UGA history. The unit paved the way for a season-high 423 rushing yards on 54 carries (7.8 avg.) against Vanderbilt, the sixth most in UGA history and the most since 1987 when Georgia had 454 yards versus VU.

Georgia has started the same combination at LT, C and RT in 2017 with **Isaiah Wynn**, who was named a Midseason All-American by *The All-American*, junior **Lamont Gaillard** and freshman **Andrew Thomas**, respectively. Thomas became the first true freshman to start on the offensive line for the Bulldogs since John Theus in 2012. Junior LG **Kendall Baker** started his eighth straight game versus South Carolina while redshirt freshman RG **Solomon Kindley** has started the last five.

An Array Of Targets

A total of 16 Bulldogs have caught a pass this season, including eight different players in the win over South Carolina. Senior **Javon Wims** leads the team lead with 27 receptions for 471 yards and four touchdowns. Junior **Terry Godwin** has a team best fiveTDs and 476 yards on 23 catches. Eleven of his catches are for 20+ yards. He made an acrobatic one-handed grab for a five-yardTD at No. 24 Notre Dame, which was No. 1 on *ESPN SportsCenter*'s "Top-10 List."

Sophomore **Mecole Hardman** converted to WR from DB after 2016 and is showing his versatility of late, including tallying 203 all-purpose yards at #10 Auburn. He had his best game of his career against Missouri, accounting for two catches for 71 yards, including a 59-yard touchdown. He also scored his first rushing touchdown, a 35-yard scamper, and added 66 return yards on three kickoffs. Hardman notched a 20-yardTD catch versus the Gamecocks.

Defense Setting The Tone

In Scoring Defense, the Bulldogs are fifth nationally (14.5 points/game). The Bulldog defense had a stretch during the 2017 season of holding opponents without a touchdown for 31 straight drives. The streak started in the final quarter of the Samford game and continued until the first half of the Vanderbilt game. This was the longest streak of its kind since 2006. The Bulldogs had a shutout of Florida until just under three minutes left in the contest. At that point, Georgia was up 42-0 and the final was 42-7.

In Red Zone Defense, Georgia is fourth in the SEC at 81 percent. Florida had a 15-play, 82-yard drive going when the Bulldog defense stopped them on fourth down on the 4 yard line. This marked the first time the Gators had been stopped in the Red Zone all year.

The Bulldogs blanked the Volunteers 41-0 in Knoxville, which snapped the nation's fourth-longest active scoring streak and sixth-longest streak in college football history. The Vols had scored in 289 games in a row dating back to 1994.

LBs Anchor Bulldog Defense

Junior ILB Roquan Smith, who was named a Midseason All-American and a *Bednarik Award* semifinalist, is on pace to lead UGA in tackles for the second year in a row. In 2017, Smith has the most tackles of any Bulldog with 82, including a 12-tackle performance at #10 Auburn. He led the team in tackles (95) in 2016. This marked the first time a sophomore led UGA in tackles since 2008 (Rennie Curran, 115). Senior Reggie Carter was the second-leading tackler in the win over USC with seven stops, including aTFL. Junior Natrez Patrick returned to action versus the Tigers and had three stops.

Senior OLBs Lorenzo Carter matched his career high with a team-high nine tackles against Florida, including a sack. He and Davin Bellamy wreaked havoc at #24 Notre Dame, as the defense forced their first two turnovers of the year. Carter now has 13.5 career sacks. Both Smith and Lorenzo Carter have been named Butkus Award semifinalists.

Take A Look At The Guys Up Front

The anchor is senior nose John Atkins, who has 25 stops for the frontline. Junior Trenton Thompson missed the wins over Missouri and Vanderbilt due to a MCL sprain and has 26 stops on the year, including three TFLs. Sophomore DL Tyler Clark and Julian Rochester played a part in the Bulldogs having a season-high five sacks in the win over the Gators.

In Georgia's 20-19 road win at #24 Notre Dame, the Irish totaled only 55 yards on the ground, the least recorded by the Irish since 2011. Then, UGA held the Vols to 142 yards in total offense, the lowest ever in the Kirby Smart era and the first shutout since 2014 (34-0, Missouri).

Tackles, And Now A Touchdown For Reed

Redshirt sophomore J.R. Reed ranks second on the team with 58 tackles and two interceptions. He is coming off a career-best 11 tackle game at #10 Auburn. Reed started in the 42-7 demolition of Florida and scooped up a fumble and returned it three yards for a touchdown and was named the SEC Co-Defensive Player of the Week. He added nine tackles against the Gators.

Reed enjoyed a big night in the 31-3 win over #17 MSU with 10 tackles and three pass breakups. He followed that up with his first career INT (followed by a 34-yard ret.) and fumble recovery to go with three tackles in the road shutout of UT. Reed added a blocked field goal against Samford. He also had a sack and a forced fumble in the same play against App State.

Sanders Sets One Record, Creeping Up On Another

Senior safety **Dominick Sanders**, a *Thorpe Award* semifinalist, set the Bulldog record for career interception return yardage after picking off his 14th career pass and returning it 18 yards versus Missouri. After snagging his 15th career interception a game later during the rout of Florida, Sanders emerged as the NCAA active career leader and is third on the UGA all-time list. Sanders collected his first interception of the year against #17 MSU and had a 15-yard return. Sanders is now tied for sixth in school history for non-kickers at 48 starts and has started the last 28 contests.

After not having an interception in the first three games, the Bulldogs now have eight picks on the year.

Nizialek Headlines Punting Game

Graduate transfer Cameron Nizialek (NYE-zuh-lek) arrived in Athens during the preseason and earned the starting punting job. This year, he has posted a 44.4 average on 41 punts, including placing 20 inside the 20. Opponents have had just eight punt returns for 40 yards. Georgia is sixth nationally in Net Punting at 42.4. The Bulldogs are lingering around the school's Net Punting record (42.6, Collin Barber, 2013).

Nizialek spent his first three seasons at Columbia University where he finished with a degree in Economics. In his career with the Lions, Nizialek averaged 41.3 yards on 149 punts in three seasons. He averaged 44.8 on his punts in 2016.

Busy Season For Blankenship

With one of the SEC's best offenses scoring 34.6 points/ game, redshirt sophomore PK Rodrigo Blankenship has been busy, booming 64 kickoffs, 42 PATs and 12 field goals. In his busiest night, he tallied 17 points in Georgia's win over Missouri on Oct. 14. The Groza Award semifinalist booted four field goals and five PATs, which ranks second on the school's all-time list. Blankenship earned the starting job before the 2017 opener and received the news before the Notre Dame game in week two that he had been awarded a scholarship. He hit the game-winning 30-yard FG at the 3:34 mark in the fourth quarter on the road in the 20-19 victory over the #24 Irish.

This year, 47 of Blankenship's 64 kickoffs this year have been touchbacks. He has had a streak of 18 consecutive touchbacks. Last year, he totaled 21 touchbacks for the year.

Senior DB **Aaron Davis** has been named to the *2017 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team*. Davis is one of 11 players from the NCAA FBS selected based on their commitment to community service. In addition, the Luella HS graduate has been included as one of 10 semi-finalists for the *Burlsworth Trophy*, which honors college football's most outstanding player who began his career as a walk-on.

Davis, a Finance graduate and native of Locust Grove, Ga., is one of four players from the SEC on the FBS 2017 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team. Georgia leads the nation in Allstate AFCA Good Works Team honorees with 18 since the award's inception in 1992, including four straight and six in the last seven years. That year, Georgia played all five of its home games under the lights and went 5-0 with victories over Presbyterian twice, Tennessee Tech, Wake Forest and Howard.

Georgia played its first night game at Miami (W, 26-0) in 1937. It played host to its first contest under the lights versus Kentucky (T, 7-all) in 1940.
