## HOKIE NOTES

### About Today's Game

The Hokies enter the game 9-1 on the season ... The Wildcats are 8-1 overall ... Kentucky is ranked eighth in the AP poll and fifth in the USA Today coaches poll ... The Hokies are receiving votes in both polls this week.

### Last Time Out: VT 93, UMES 40

The Hokies defeated Maryland-Eastern Shore, 93-40, in Cassell Coliseum on Sunday afternoon ... Tech took a 32 point lead into intermission and never looked back in the win ... **Chris Clarke** led four Hokies in double figures with 18 points and **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** added 16 points ... **Ahmed Hill** had 15 points and **Justin Bibbs** scored 10 points in the win ... Tech held the Hawks to 27.8 percent from the field and 15.4 percent from three-point range ... The 53-point margin of victory is the largest for the Hokies under **Buzz Williams**.

### The Hokies vs. Kentucky

Kentucky leads the all-time series, 3-1 ... Tech lost the last meeting, 84-60, in the second round of the 1996 NCAA Tournament in Dallas, Texas ... The Hokies are 1-1 all-time in Lexington, but have never played in Rupp Arena ... Tech won the last meeting in Lexington, 80-77, defeating the third-ranked Wildcats in Memorial Coliseum to open the 1962-63 season.

### Threes Company

The Hokies are averaging 10.3 three-point field goals per game this season and shooting 46.8 percent from beyond the arc ... Both would be new school marks ... Tech has five games this season in which it has made at least 10 three-pointers ... Tech is second nationally in three-point field goal percentage.

### Cousins

Today's game will feature a match-up of first cousins ... The Hokies' **Nickeil Alexander-Walker** will face off against Shai Gilgeous-Alexander for the first time on the collegiate court ... The freshmen Canadians played high school ball together at Hamilton Heights Christian Academy in Chattanooga, Tennessee the last two seasons ... **Nickeil's** mother is the sister of Shai's father ... **Nickeil** has the upper-hand in scoring, averaging 14.4 ppg to his cousin's 10.1 ppg and rebounding, 4.2 rpg to 3.8 rpg ... Both cousins are shooting better than 50 percent from the field and 40 percent from three-point range.

### Tech vs. SEC

With the win over Ole Miss on Dec. 2, Tech is now 53-57 all-time against teams currently in the SEC ... Ole Miss was the first of two games against SEC teams this season ... Though not a counting regular season game, Tech defeated South Carolina, 86-67, in Columbia in an exhibition game on Nov. 5 ... The Ole Miss game was the Hokies' first road game at an SEC opponent since Dec. 9, 2008, when Tech lost at Georgia, 67-66 ... Prior to the Ole Miss game, the Hokies' most recent road win at an SEC opponent was a 73-64 win at Tennessee on Dec. 28, 1994, but Tech has only played one road game at an SEC opponent since then (the Georgia game in 2008) ... Tech is 4-5 against SEC foes since joining the ACC in 2004 ... **Buzz Williams** is 2-1 against SEC opponents at Virginia Tech.

### Raining Threes

In the Hokies' win over Maryland-Eastern Shore, Tech made 15 three-point field goals, marking the second time this season Tech has made at least 15 threes ... **Chris Clarke** was 3-of-3 from beyond the arc, setting new career highs in both categories ... **Ahmed Hill** also made three, three-pointers ... So far this season, Tech individual players have made at least three, three in a game 17 times ... Hill was 11-of-15 from three-point territory in the two games in Madison Square Garden in the 2K Classic.

### Hokies in National Stats

As of Dec. 14, the Hokies lead the nation in field goal percentage, scoring offense and scoring margin, are second in three-point field goal percentage and fourth in assists per game ... Tech is 13th in assist/turnover ratio and 27th in three-point field goals per game.

### Tech vs. AP Poll

Today is Virginia Tech's first game of the season against a team ranked in the AP poll ... Tech is 35-178 all-time against ranked teams ... The Hokies were 3-6 against ranked teams last season ... Tech is 0-9 against teams ranked eighth nationally ... Tech's most recent game against an eighth-ranked team was a 94-90 loss at Louisville last season.

### Call It a Comeback

The Hokies defeated Ole Miss in Oxford on Dec. 2, 83-80, in overtime ... In doing so, the Hokies fought back from a 16-point second half deficit ... The 16 point comeback is the largest for Tech game since coming back from a 16-point deficit to defeat NC State in the first conference game of the 2015-16 season ... Tech's ACC record for largest comeback victory is 18 points, in a 91-87 overtime win over NC State on Feb. 8, 2009 in Cassell Coliseum.

### Sharing is Good

In the win over The Citadel, the Hokies recorded 36 assists ... That set a new school record for assists in a game, breaking the old mark of 31, set against South Carolina State on Dec. 18, 1982 ... The Hokies assisted on 75 percent of their made baskets in The Citadel victory ... In the win over Washington, the Hokies assisted on 23 of their 30 made baskets, good for 76.7 percent ... For the season, Tech has 199 assists on 320 made field goals, for 62.2 percent ... So far this season, the Hokies' three point guards are a combined 92 assists and 35 turnovers ... Tech has eight players with at least double figures in assists this season ... The Hokies are second nationally in assists per game.

### Perfect from the Line

**Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, was 11-for-11 from the free throw line in the win over Radford ... This is the ninth time in school history that a Hokie has shot at least 10 free throws in a game and made every free throw attempted ... The record is 18-for-18 from the line by Rod Wheeler against Richmond on Dec. 28, 1990.

### A String of Threes

**Justin Bibbs** has now made at least one three-point field goal in the last 24 games in which he has played, tops currently in the ACC ... **Ahmed Hill** has made at least one three-pointer in each of his last 11 games, second-best in the ACC behind Bibbs ... The Virginia Tech school record for most consecutive games with a three-point field goal is 73, by Wally Lancaster.

### Big Margin

The Hokies defeated Maryland-Eastern Shore, 93-40 ... The 53-point margin of victory is the largest by a **Buzz Williams**-coached team, surpassing the 42-point margin of victory over The Citadel last season ... The 40 points scored by Maryland-Eastern Shore are the fewest by an opponent against Virginia Tech under Williams ... The previous low point total for a Tech opponent in the Williams era was 45 points by Arkansas-Pine Bluff on Dec. 5, 2015 ... The 53-point margin is the largest for the Hokies since Jan. 2, 2011, when the Hokies defeated Mount St. Mary's 99-34 ... That is also the last game the Hokies held an opponent to 40-or-fewer-points in a game ... The Hokies had a 54-point lead in the win over UMES, the largest since a 72-point lead in the MSM game in 2011.

### They Are Free, After All

The Hokies made 67 of their first 100 free throw attempts, for 67.0 percent ... Since then (beginning with the win over Washington) Tech has made 152 of their last 193 free throw attempts (78.8 percent) ... Tech is currently shooting 74.7 percent from the line for the season.

### A Lid on the Basket

In Tech's win over UMES, the Hawks shot 27.8 percent from the field, a season low for a Tech opponent ... They shot 15.4 percent from three-point range, second-lowest of the season ... The last time the Hokies held an opponent to a lower field goal percentage in a game was on Nov. 21, 2015, when they held VMI to 25.7 percent from the field ... The last time Tech held an opponent to a lower three-point field goal percentage was on March 2, 2016, when Tech held Pittsburgh to 14.3 percent from beyond the arc.

### The 90s

The Hokies have scored 90-or-more points in seven games already this season ... The last time the Hokies registered seven games of 90-or-more-points was the 1988-89 season, when Tech had 14 such games.

### Analytics and All

As of Dec. 14, the Hokies are ranked 28th by Kenpom.com ... Tech leads the nation in effective field goal percentage and raw offensive efficiency, second in three-point percentage and fourth in free throw rate ... Tech is seventh in two-point percentage and 10th in length of possession ... Tech is 17th in adjusted offensive efficiency, 19th in assist percentage and 28th in raw tempo.

**Buzz Williams** has announced the signings of **Jonathan Kabongo**, **Jarren McAllister** and **Landers Nolley II** to National Letters of Intent ... The trio will enroll at Virginia Tech in the fall of 2018 ... Kabonogo is a 6-4, 180 lbs., guard from Toronto, Ontario and Putnam Science Academy in Putnam, Connecticut ... McAllister is a 6-4, 185 lbs., guard from Heritage High School in Wake Forest, North Carolina ... Nolley is a 6-7, 210 lbs., shooting guard at Langston Hughes High School in Fairburn, Georgia.

### Providing Relief

The Virginia Tech men's basketball team participated in the "Hoops 4 Hurricane Relief" exhibition game against South Carolina in the Colonial Life Center in Columbia, South Carolina on Nov. 5 ... The exhibition event raised funds for those impacted by the recent storms, as net proceeds from the game supported hurricane relief efforts in Texas, South Florida and Puerto Rico ... Tickets for the game were \$10 for a general admission seat ... Funds raised from the game and the online donation will be directed to organizations benefitting the affected areas ... At halftime, both head coaches made sizable donations to the cause.

### What's Next?

The Hokies return to Cassell Coliseum on Tuesday night, as they host Presbyterian ... Tip is at 7 p.m. and the game will be shown live on ACC Network Extra and the ESPN app.

### What is a Hokie?

That's the most frequently asked question regarding Virginia Tech athletics ... The answer leads all the way back to 1896 when Virginia Agricultural and Mechanical College changed its name to Virginia Polytechnic Institute ... With the change came the necessity for writing a new cheer and a contest for such a purpose was held by the student body ... Senior O.M. Stull won first prize for his "Old Hokie" yell which still is used today ... Later, when asked if "Hokie" had any special meaning, Stull explained the words he used had no hidden or symbolic meaning, but had been thought up in an effort to get attention ... Hokie soon became a nickname for all Tech teams and for those people loyal to Tech athletics.

### Working Overtime

The 83-80 overtime win at Ole Miss on Saturday was Tech's first overtime game of the season ... This was the Hokies' first overtime game since defeating No. 12 Virginia, 80-78, in double overtime on Feb. 12, 2017 ... Tech is now 66-49 overall in overtime games and 6-3 in overtime games under **Buzz Williams** ... Tech is 30-11 in home overtime games and 16-8 in overtime in ACC games ... Tech is 28-25 in road overtime games ... The Ole Miss victory was Tech's first over an SEC school in an overtime game (Tech is now 1-2 against SEC schools in overtime).

### It Was a Big Week

The Hokies defeated Ole Miss of the SEC 83-80, in overtime on Saturday after defeating Iowa of the Big Ten, 79-55, on Nov. 28 in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge in Blacksburg ... This marked the first time since the 2012-13 season that Tech played back-to-back games against Power 5 competition in less than a calendar week not part of an exempt tournament ... In that season, the Hokies defeated Iowa, 95-79, in Cassell Coliseum in the ACC/Big Ten Challenge on Nov. 27 and followed that with an 81-71 home win over No. 15 Oklahoma State ... The last time Tech played such teams in which one of the games was a road game was the 2011-12 season, when Tech lost at Minnesota, 58-55, in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge and lost at home to Kansas State, 69-61, five days later.

### Powerful Wins

With the Hokies' win at Ole Miss, Tech is one of three ACC schools that have recorded at least three wins this season against non-conference Power 5 teams ... Duke has four such wins and North Carolina also has three such wins ... Tech has two of the three wins away from Cassell Coliseum this season ... Tech had three non-conference Power 5 wins last season.

### P.J. Comes Through in the Clutch

When **Kerry Blackshear Jr.**, picked up his second foul just five minutes into the Iowa game, freshman **P.J. Horne** stepped up and came through with the best performance of his young career to date ... Horne scored a career-high 16 points, including 12 points in 14 minutes of action in the first half ... He was 6-of-7 from the floor and made four of his six free throw attempts ... The front court duo combined for 23 points and 12 rebounds in the win and made eight of their 10 shots.

### Doubling Up

**Chris Clarke** recorded his second double-double of the year and his eighth career double-double with 16 points and 12 rebounds in the win at Ole Miss ... Clarke's eight career double-doubles are tops among current Hokies ... Clarke recorded the Hokies' first-ever triple-double last season in the win over The Citadel.

### Home is Where the Wins Are

With the Hokies' win over UMES, Tech is now 7-0 at home this season ... Tech was 15-2 in Cassell last season ... Since **Buzz Williams** arrived in Blacksburg for the 2014-15 season, Tech is 45-16 (.738) in Cassell Coliseum and is 36-7 (.837) since the beginning of the 2015-16 season ... Tech has won 15 consecutive home non-conference games.

### Not Marginal at All

The 24-point winning margin against Iowa marked the second time in as many games this season that Tech has defeated a Power 5 conference opponent by 24 points ... Tech downed Washington, 103-79 in Madison Square Garden earlier in November ... The 24-point margin of victory is the largest ever for Tech in the Big Ten/ACC Challenge.

### Lots of Minutes

Two Hokie players are two of the most experienced ACC players in the league this season ... **Justin Bibbs** has played a total of 3,284 minutes at Virginia Tech and **Devin Wilson** has played 2,939 minutes as a Hokie ... Tech has another player, **Ahmed Hill**, who has played 2,239 in just two-plus seasons at Virginia Tech ... **Justin Robinson** passed the 2,000 minute mark in the win over Iowa.

### Defense Wins

With the 79-55 win over Iowa, the Hokies have now won their last six games when holding an opponent to 55-or-fewer points ... Tech is 7-1 under **Buzz Williams** in such games.

### Continuing to Climb

In the Hokies' win at Boston College last season, **Justin Bibbs** scored his 1,000th career point, becoming the 45th Hokie to score 1,000 career points ... He currently has 1,186 points, 32nd on the list, after passing Jeff Schneider and Jarell Eddie in the win over UMES ... He has scored in double figures in all eight games he has played this season ... Bibbs is currently shooting 43.8 percent from three-point range for his career, which is first on the Virginia Tech all-time list and second on the ACC list

### Less Than a Third

The Hokies held Iowa to just 33.3 percent from the field on Nov. 28 ... It is the lowest field goal percentage for a Power 5 team against Tech since Nov. 27 of last year, when the Hokies held Nebraska to 29.8 percent in the Wooden Legacy in Anaheim, California ... Tech held the Cornhuskers to 19.0 percent from three-point range that game.

### Century Marks

The Hokies defeated Washington, 103-79, on Nov. 17 ... The 103 points is the most points Tech has scored against a current Power 5 school in a regulation game since a 109-68 victory over South Carolina on Jan. 25, 1985 in Cassell Coliseum ... It is the first time that they have achieved that feat away from Cassell Coliseum since a 106-75 win over the Gamecocks in Salem, Virginia on Dec. 22, 1960, the only other time this has occurred ... Tech scored more than 100 points in three of its first four games for the first time in school history ... Tech has scored 100-or-more points three times this season for the first time since 1988-89.

### Bede Steps Up

In the Hokies' 99-73 win over Houston Baptist, freshman **Wabissa Bede** took every advantage of his time on the court ... Playing 11 minutes, all in the second half, Bede scored a career-high 13 points on 3-of-4 from the field, including making his only three-point attempt ... He also was a perfect 6-of-6 from the free throw line ... All three true freshmen on this year's squad scored in double figures at least once in the first five games this year.

### Lots of Options

So far this season, the Hokies have had nine players record double figures in at least one of the eight games played ... One other player has scored nine points in two separate games ... Last season, Tech had eight players score in double figures at least one ... Tech has four players with at least 20 points in a game and **Justin Bibbs** scored 30 points in the win over Washington.

### Buzz Williams

**Buzz Williams** is 62-49 in his fourth year as the Hokies' head coach and an overall record of 215-135 record in 10-plus seasons as a collegiate head coach ... He won his 200th career game last season against Boston College on Jan. 29 in Cassell Coliseum.

Buzz Williams has proven that hard work, determination and an eye for details are key aspects in building an elite-level collegiate basketball program. The head coach of the men's squad begins his fourth season in Blacksburg, and he has the Hokies poised to continue their growth as a program in the toughest conference in college basketball. He and his staff take a simplistic, yet very effective approach – "Get Better."

Though his program has earned growing acclaim nationally, Williams does not focus on such external praise. He wakes up every morning with a sense of purpose to make the Hokies the best that they can be.

On Jan. 29, 2017, the Hokies defeated Boston College, 85-79, to give Williams his 200th career victory. Beginning his 11th season as a collegiate head coach, Williams has an overall record of 215-135. Williams has compiled a 62-49 record in his fourth season in Blacksburg.

The Hokies are coming off their most successful season in the last decade. Tech finished the season 22-11 overall and earned their first NCAA Tournament bid since 2007. Tech was 10-8 in the ACC regular season for the second consecutive

season. The Hokies claimed three top 25 victories against ACC foes and finished with an impressive 11-1 in non-conference regular season action.

Williams led the Hokies through many of the usual obstacles that beset college basketball programs each season. Injuries were one such obstacle, but the Hokies weathered the injuries and continued to achieve. Towards the end of the season, with just a handful of healthy bodies, Tech thrived and earned its at-large NCAA Tournament berth through its efforts.

In his second season, the Hokies were one of the most improved teams in the Atlantic Coast Conference and the NCAA. Predicted, once again, to reside near the bottom of the league standings, the Hokies finished with a 20-15 overall record under Williams, including a 10-8 mark in the ACC. Tech advanced to the second round of the 2016 NIT, defeating Princeton at home in overtime before falling at BYU two days later.

In his inaugural season at Virginia Tech, Williams led the Hokies to an 11-22 overall record. He began building the culture that would allow the Hokies to enjoy future successes. The team went a long ways toward establishing an

identity – one predicated on hard work, accountability both on and off the court and playing with a tough, competitive nature.

"The continued growth of our basketball program under Buzz Williams has been dramatic and noticeable on a national level," Virginia Tech Director of Athletics Whit Babcock said. "With the daily mantra of 'Get Better', this program has accomplished so much in his three seasons in Blacksburg. Buzz recruits and develops responsible, respectful student athletes who achieve and are successful on the court and in our community. Our future is very bright under Buzz's leadership"

Recruiting is the lifeblood of any intercollegiate athletics program, and Williams has led the Hokies to new heights in this area. While he has been able to attract elite recruits, he is less focused on national perception and more focused on finding what he likes to call, "OKGs", or "our kind of guys."

Williams came to Virginia Tech following six seasons as the head coach of the Marquette Golden Eagles. At Marquette, he had a record of 139-69 and led the team to five NCAA Tournament appearances, including a trip to the regional

Player of the Year. UNO claimed fourth place in the Sun Belt's Western Division and advanced to the league tournament quarterfinals. The squad claimed as many victories on the road that season as it had in the previous three seasons combined. His recruiting class for the 2007-08 season was ranked in the top 50 nationally by HoopScoopOnline.com.

Prior to UNO, Williams served as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Texas A&M for two seasons (2004-05 and 2005-06) under head coach Billy Gillispie. Both of his recruiting classes with the Aggies were ranked among the best in the nation and featured some of the top-ranked talent at the prep level. The squad made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in

25 years in 2005-06. The previous team posted the top turnaround in the nation, improving its win total in 2004-05 by 14 games compared to 2003-04.

Williams spent four seasons (2000-01 through 2003-04) at Colorado State, where he served as an assistant the first three seasons before being promoted to associate head coach in 2003-04. Two of his recruiting classes were ranked among the 40 best in the nation, including the 2003 group, which was tabbed No. 1 in the Mountain West Conference. Colorado State made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 13 years during his tenure, and HoopScoopOnline.com named him one of the top assistants in the country.

The Van Alstyne, Texas, native was previously an assistant at Northwestern State (1999-2000), Texas A&M-Kingsville (1998-99) and Texas-Arlington (1994-98). He earned a bachelor's degree in kinesiology from Oklahoma City University in 1994 before completing his master's work in the same field at Texas A&M-Kingsville in 1999.

Williams is married to the former Corey Norman and the couple have two daughters, Zera and Addyson, and two sons, Calvin and Mason.

finals in the 2012-13 season – the same season that the team won the Big East Conference regular-season title. Williams led the Golden Eagles to a 69-39 Big East Conference record during his time in Milwaukee. During Williams' tenure, six Marquette players made it to the NBA.

Williams was an assistant at Marquette during the 2007-08 season. MU concluded the year 25-10 and advanced to the second round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003.

His coaching career has included stints as an assistant, associate head and head coach. He has been at the NCAA Division I level for 21 seasons, and 2017-18 will mark his 11th campaign as a head coach. Williams has recruited and coached more than 20 players who have earned all-conference accolades, including two league Players of the Year, two conference Freshmen of the Year and four Associated Press All-Americans.

Williams arrived in Milwaukee after serving for one season as the head coach at the University of New Orleans. He guided the Privateers to a 14-win campaign in 2006-07. His roster featured Bo McCalebb, the Sun Belt Conference
