Insell Secures Milestone Win No. 300

- Middle Tennessee Head Coach Rick Insell earned milestone win No. 300 with the victory at Vanderbilt.
- Insell is already the all-time winningest coach in program history. His record as head coach of the Lady Raiders is a sterling **306-102**.

Series History vs. Kentucky

- Middle Tennessee and Kentucky meet for the 19th time in program history.
- UK leads the all-time series, 14-4
- The Lady Raiders are 3-5 vs. Kentucky at Murphy Center.
- MT Head Coach Rick Insell is 2-7 vs. Kentucky.

Scouting Kentucky

- Kentucky is 8-5 under Head Coach Matthew Mitchell, whose next win will be his 250th leading the Lady Wildcats.
- The Lady Wildcats started the season 6-0 but they are 2-5 since, including four straight setbacks.
- Maci Morris leads UK in scoring with 16.2 ppg. She is one of three Lady Wildcats averaging double figures. Taylor Murray (11.3) and Tatyana Wyatt (10.6) also average double figures.
- UK has six players averaging eight points or more.
- UK is 2-3 away from home this season.

Vs. The SEC

- MT is 33-95 all-time against current members of the SEC, including a 1-1 mark this season. The Lady Raiders have won at Vanderbilt (65-54) and lost at Ole Miss (65-56) this season.
- MT is 11-24 against the SEC under Head Coach Rick Insell.
- MT has three wins against SEC teams ranked in the Top 10 at the time of the meeting - all under Insell: at No. 8 Georgia (70-62) in 2006; No. 8 LSU (67-56) in 2007; and No. 6 Kentucky (70-58) in 2011.

Injury Bug Bites Lady Raiders

- MT has had four players miss a total of 27-3/4 games due to injury this season.
- The injury bug has hit hard as three of the four players are starters, including C-USA Preseason Player of the Year Alex Johnson, and senior Abbey Sissom, a member of the 2016 C-USA All-Defensive team.
- Kyla Allison (foot), Alex Johnson (foot), Kara Meadows (ankle) and Abbey Sissom, who was cleared to return to the court by physicians after entering the athletic department's concussion protocol following the Ole Miss game(12/11), all have missed significant time due to injuries.

- In fact, the Lady Raiders have not had their full compliment of players at any point this season. Following is a breakdown of games missed due to injury:

Sissom, Louro earn All-Classic Honors

- MT guards Abbey Sissom and Jess Louro earned All-Conference honors at the UTRGV Holiday Classic following sterling performances.
- Sissom averaged 25 points and 3.0 assists, while shooting 44 percent from the field (16-of-36) and 50 percent (10-of-20) from 3-point range. Sissom played the full 40 minutes in both contests. Her 28 points vs. Canisius were a career-high, as were her 28 field goals. That followed a performance in which Sissom poured in a season high 22 points vs. USC. Her five 3-pointers in each game equal a season high.
- Louro also came up big in the UTRGV Holiday Classic in route to All-Classic honors.
- Louro almost averaged a double-double with 10.5 points, 8.0 rebounds per game. Louro registered her first career double-double vs. Canisius with 10 points and 11 rebounds. Shge also averaged 35 minutes and 2.0 steals.

Sissom Makes Strong Return to Lineup

- Senior guard Abbey Sissom returned to the starting lineup vs. Troy after missing three games due to injury in the Athletic Department's concussion protocol.
- Sissom made an immediate impact with season highs for points (18) and 3-point field goals (4), while tying her season high for field goals (5).
- The 18 points marked the fourth consecutive double-figure scoring game for Sissom this season.
- In the four games since her return, Sissom is averaging 18.8 ppg, 2.3 assists, while shooting 43 percent (24-of-56) from the field, including 44 percent (15-of-34) from 3-point range.

Johnson Returns to Injured Reserve

- Middle Tennessee junior standout Alex Johnson (foot) is back on the injured reserve list for the Lady Raiders. Johnson returned to the injury list prior to the Troy game. She has missed four straight games and six full games overall.
- Johnson suffered an ankle injury less than five minutes into the game at Vanderbilt and did not return. Johnson missed games for the first time in her collegiate career vs. Tennessee Tech and Lipscomb, before returning to action against UNC Asheville and logging 13 minutes.
- Johnson saw her most extensive action to date at Ole Miss, with 13 points in 20 minutes, and followed that up with 13 points in 22 minutes at Georgia Tech.
- Johnson returned to the starting lineup for games vs. Coppin State and Louisville before returning to the injured list for the Troy game.

Dominant at Murphy Center

- MT has enjoyed great home success under HC Rick Insell.
- The Lady Raiders are 157-26 at the Murphy Center under Insell, for an 86 percent winning ledger. That includes a 4-0 mark this season.
- The Lady Raiders have won eight straight at home dating back to last season.

Lady Raiders Complete Grueling Stretch

- The Lady Raiders completed a stretch that saw them play seven of nine games away from Murphy Center.
- MT started its stretch with three straight road games (at UNC Asheville, at Ole Miss and at Georgia Tech) before returning home to face Coppin State. The Lady Raiders played at No. 4 Louisville Dec. 9.
- MT capped it non-conference road slate with games at Tulane and against USC and Canisius in the UTRGV Holiday Classic in Edinburg, Texas.
- In all, the Lady Raiders were on the road for 15 of 26 days, between Nov. 25 and Dec. 21, and they played eight of the first 12 contests away from home.

Winnign With Defense

- With several top offensive performers missing time due to injury this season, including C-USA Preseason Player of the Year Alex Johnson, Middle Tennessee has had to rely on its trademark defense in order to enjoy success.
- MT is ranked second in C-USA and 32nd nationally in scoring defense, allowing just 55.9 points per game.
- The Lady Raiders have held five opponents to less than 50 points this season (Tenn. Tech, Lipscomb, Georgia Tech, Coppin State and Canisius).
- In contrast, the Lady Raiders held just one opponent under 50 points last season, and four squads to under 50 all of the 2015-16 campaign.
- MT also ranks in the Top 100 nationally for 3-point field goal defense (.272, 43rd) and field goal percentage defense (.365, 58th).
- MT held Coppin State to 39 points. Those were the fewest points allowed by the Lady Raiders since a 79-30 win vs. FIU (3/5/2015) - a span of 81 games.
- The Lady Raiders forced 22 turnovers and collected 15 steals at Georgia Tech.

Lady Raiders Throttle Nation's Top Offense

- MT put its Top 20 scoring defense on the line against Troy and its No.-1 ranked offense nationally (92 ppg).
- The Lady Raiders held Troy to 35 points below its average and a season-low 57 points.
- The Trojans were limited to 24.3 percent (17-of-70) shooting from the field, and 15.4 percent (4-of-26) shooting from 3-point range.

Lady Raiders Are C-USA Favorites

- MT was picked 1st in the C-USA Coaches Preseason Poll.
- It marked the 10th time in Insell's 13 seasons that MT has been picked to win the conference.

Johnson C-USA Preseason Player of the Year

- MT junior standout Alex Johnson was named the 2017-18 Preseason Player of the Year in C-USA.
- Johnson was the C-USA Freshman of the Year in 2016, and she was a First-Team All C-USA selection in 2017.
- Johnson became a member of program's 1,000-point club last season, becoming just the third sophomore to accomplish the feat.
- Johnson is the highest scoring four-year Lady Raider in program history after her first two seasons.

- MT junior standout Alex Johnson has been named to the 20-person watch list for the 2018 Katrina McClain Award, which recognizes the top power forwards in women's NCAA Division I college basketball.
- Johnson is the only in-state player and sole representative from C-USA on the list.
- Johnson scored double figures in 32 of 34 games as a sophomore with 15 games of 20-plus points.

MT Sixth Nationally In Average Attendance

• MT is ranked sixth nationally in average attendance as of Dec. 14 with 6,446 per game. That trails only South Carolina, UConn, Iowa State, Tennessee and Notre Dame.
 • MT has featured one of the nation's top fan bases since Rick Insell's hiring in 2005.
 • MT has realized a 626 percent increase in home attendance since Insell's hiring.
 • MT had the nation's largest increase in average home attendance in 2005-06, when it went from an average of 695 in 2004-05, to 2,699 in 2005-06. The top five increases in 2005-06 were Middle Tennessee, Oklahoma, Tennessee, North Carolina and UNLV.
 • The Lady Raiders have been ranked in the Top 30 in national home attendance in 10 of Insell's 12 seasons.

• Each week, the NCAA.com Starting Five recognizes some of the top women's basketball players in the country based on their performances.
 • Senior forward Gabby Lyon earned a spot on the NCAA.com Starting Five following her performance against Vanderbilt in the season opener.
 • Lyon was the Fans' Choice in online Twitter voting, receiving almost 50 percent of the more than 600 votes to beat out Jordin Canada, UCLA; Crystal Dangerfield, UConn; and A'ja Wilson, South Carolina.

Protecting Leads

• MT has been good with the lead and closing games out under HC Rick Insell.
 • The Lady Raiders are 263-21 (93 percent) when leading at the half under Insell. MT is 7-1 in such games this season with the lone setback coming at Ole Miss.
 • The Lady Raiders are 288-15 (95 percent) when leading at the five-minute mark under Insell, including a 7-0 ledger this season.

70 Magic Number

• When MT scores 70 or more under HC Rick Insell it is a staggering 210-15 for a 93 percent winning clip. That includes a 3-0 mark this season. The Lady Raiders have won eight straight and 21 of 22 overall when scoring 70 or more. The only setback was an 82-75 loss to WKU (2/16/17).

Louro Delivers Career-Best Effort at Ole Miss

• Junior guard Jess Louro had one of her best games as a Lady Raider at Ole Miss (11/29/17).
 • The Wall, N.J., native established career highs for points (19) and field goals (7). Louro also pulled eight rebounds, which is a season high and one board shy of her career high.
 • Louro drained four 3-pointers in the game at Ole Miss, two shy of her career high.
 • Louro leads the team in scoring (12.7) and rebounds (6.9).

Davis Enjoys Strong Debut

• Freshman Jadona Davis made her Lady Raider debut against Lipscomb.
 • The 6-foot-5 center impressed with eight points on 3-of-4 shooting from the field, including 2-of-2 from 3-point range.
 • Davis also added two rebounds and two blocked shots in 12 minutes of action.

Reuter Dominant vs. Tech

• Senior Rebecca Reuter had one of the better games of her career in the Lady Raiders' win vs. Tennessee Tech.
 • Reuter tied her career highs for points (23), field goals (8) and free throws (7) to lead MT to the victory.
 • Reuter is among C-USA leaders in scoring (15.0) and field goal percentage (59 percent, 10-of-17).

Lyon, Reuter Respond Big Time

• When junior standout Alex Johnson went down with an ankle injury early in the first quarter against Vanderbilt, seniors Gabby Lyon and Rebecca Reuter more than filled the void in leading the Lady Raiders to victory.
 • Lyon and Reuter combined for 16 points on 6-of-11 shooting, 16 rebounds, three steals and two blocked shots.
 • Lyon secured her second career double-double with 10 points and 10 rebounds
 • Reuter totaled seven points and six boards in the win.

Majors Returns From Injury

- MT sophomore forward Jordan Majors is back on the court following a season-ending knee injury in November, 2016.
- Majors played in four games before suffering the injury in a practice.
- Majors was granted a medical redshirt and is regarded as a redshirt sophomore.

HEAD COACH ■ RICK INSELL

13th Season at MT ■ 41st Season Overall (including Shelbyville HS)

THE INSELL FILE

No coach in Middle Tennessee women's basketball history has produced the success that Rick Insell has entering his 13th season. Since his arrival to Middle Tennessee in 2005, Insell has led the Raiders to nine NCAA Tournament appearances, three WNITs, coached five All-Americans and grew four WNBA Draft picks.

In his 12-plus years, the seven-time hall of fame inductee has established a track record unlike any other in the Blue Raiders' rich women's basketball history, while also creating lofty expectations. Entering his 13th season leading his alma mater's women's basketball program, Insell has also positioned Middle Tennessee as one of the winningest programs nationally.

Insell, the program's all-time winningest coach with 305 victories, is among the nation's leaders in his profession. Middle Tennessee's .766 winning percentage over the last five years is 18th nationally, and the program's .686 overall winning percentage is 17th best all-time.

Insell is one of nine Division I head coaches to average 25 wins per season with at least 10 years head coaching experience. The others are Geno Auriemma, UConn (30.5), Kim Mulkey, Baylor (29.3), Tara VanDerveer, Stanford (26.4), Jeff Walz, Louisville (26.3), Karl Smesko, Florida Gulf Coast (25.8), Brenda Frese, Maryland (25.5), Insell (24.8), Middle Tennessee, Joe Foley, UALR (24.8), and Mike McLaughlin, Penn (24.5).

Insell is listed ninth on the Division I all-time winningest coach list (by percentage) with a .756 ledger. His is listed 11th on the Division I winningest active coaches list.

Under Insell's watch, Middle Tennessee is the only program nationally to have the NCAA Division I scoring champion three consecutive years (Amber Holt, 2008, Alysha Clark, 2009, Alysha Clark, 2010). Clark's back-to-back reign made her just the third women's basketball player in NCAA history to accomplish the feat.

Middle Tennessee also has participated in a national postseason tournament in each of Insell's 12 previous seasons, playing in nine NCAA Regionals and three WNITs. The 2014-15 Blue Raiders won three postseason games and reached the quarterfinals of the WNIT.

Attendance has also spiked during Insell's tenure. Middle Tennessee has ranked among the Top 25 nationally in attendance in four of the last five seasons, and the Blue Raiders have been ranked in the Top 30 nationally in 10 of Insell's 12 seasons. The top 25 crowds in program history

all have occurred during Insell's tenure, and attendance at Middle Tennessee home games has increased 800 percent since his hire.

Insell surpassed Lewis Bivens as the program's all-time winningest coach with a 60-39 win at South Alabama (1/5/13), which was his 183rd victory at that time. On March 5, 2014, Insell secured his 1,000th career win, which includes his 775 victories at nearby Shelbyville Central High School.

His 100th victory came in the 2009 Sun Belt Tournament Championship game, as the Blue Raiders clinched the title over UALR. Insell also amassed an impressive Sun Belt ledger, posting a 142-18 (.888) mark during his tenure, including the league's last undefeated marks of 16-0 in 2011-12 and an 18-0 mark during the 2006-07 campaign. In eight Sun Belt Tournament appearances, Insell lost just three times in 22 tries.

Insell has collected seven regular-season championships (six in the Sun Belt, one in Conference USA) and seven tournament titles (five in the SBC, two in C-USA) to his mantle. The seven tournament titles also carried automatic berths into the NCAA Tournament. Insell's teams have also warranted two at-large NCAA Regional berths (2011, 2012). His 2008, 2015 and 2017 teams participated in the WNIT.

Middle Tennessee also has won at least 20 contests in each of Insell's 12 seasons, including a school-record 30 victories during the 2006-07 campaign. The Lady Raiders also owned the nation's longest winning streak at 27 games and didn't lose for more than 100 days during the season.

Middle Tennessee also had a 20-game win streak in 2011-12, which was the second-longest in program history. The four longest win streaks in school history have occurred under Insell and each has been at least 16 games. In 2013-14 his team strung together a 17-game win streak and finished the year with 29 victories, ranking second-most in program history.

Insell has also been the coach for four WNBA selections during his 12 seasons, including Alysha Clark, who was chosen 17th overall by the San Antonio Silver Stars in the 2010 Draft. She joined Amber Holt, selected ninth overall by the Connecticut Sun in 2008; Chrissy Givens, picked 31st overall by the Phoenix Mercury in 2007; and Cheyenne Parker, was selected fifth overall by the Chicago Sky in 2015.

All of Middle Tennessee's All-American selections also have been developed by Insell, starting with Givens in 2007, and Holt in 2008. Clark became the first player in the MT record books to garner All-America accolades in more than one season when she collected honors in 2009 and 2010. Most recently, Ebony Rowe was tabbed a Freshman All-American, becoming the first player in school history to receive the nod, in 2011. Rowe was named Honorable Mention All-American by AP and the WBCA.

Insell is married to the former Deborah Spry of Woodbury, Tenn. The couple has three sons - Tom, Kyle and Matt. Tom is married to the former Sarah Stewart of Shelbyville and they have two daughters, Carter and Caroline and one son
