## STORYLINES

- Kim Rosamond and Kentucky head coach Matthew Mitchell will meet for the first time as Division I head coaches, but they have known each other off the court for much longer -- the pair were classmates at Winston Academy and grew up together in Louisville, Mississippi. Ole Miss men's basketball head coach Andy Kennedy and Louisiana-Lafayette head coach Mark Hudspeth are two other active coaches from Louisville (its population was estimated at 6,324 in 2016).
- The Golden Eagles held Georgia to 56 points Monday night, UGA's lowest point total of the season so far. The eight-point difference in the score was the closest Tech has come to defeating Georgia in its 12-game series history since Dec. 12, 1999 when UGA won 77-72 in Cookeville. Monday night's game was also the tightest in Athens since Georgia beat Tech 79-62 on Feb. 2, 1994 - before any of Tech's current players were born.
- The Golden Eagles welcome nine newcomers to the 2017-18 roster, seven of which are true freshmen. The other two, Kentoria Alexander and Lacy Cantrell, are junior college transfers from Tennessee JuCos.
- Tech returns six student-athletes, two of which were full-time starters last season (Yaktavia "Shug" Hickson and Akia Harris). Hickson was named to the preseason AllOVC team after earning first-team honors in 2016-17.
- Tech has been picked to finish fifth in the OVC by league coaches after being chosen 11th last season in head coach Kim Rosamond's first year at Tech.

## AN EXCLUSIVE CLUB

Tech is among a small group of Division I programs who have at least seven true freshmen on their roster this season. Among them are Fordham (eight), Northern Kentucky (seven), Presbyterian (seven), Long Beach State (seven), Savannah State (nine), Air Force (10), Eastern Kentucky (eight), Furman (seven), Incarnate Word (eight), Alabama A\&M (nine), Southern (seven) and Coastal Carolina (seven).

## FLEDGLING GOLDEN EAGLES

After its huge 2016 signing class, Tech has signed just two to Na tional Letters of Intent, both coming in the 2017 early signing period. Two-time state champion Taylor Lamb of Greeneville, Tennessee, and two-time state finalist Hannah Garrett of Jamestown, Tennessee, will join the Golden Eagles prior to the 2018-19 season.

## FRESHMAN DUO MAKES HISTORY IN FIRST COLLEGE GAME

In Tech's season opener this year versus Tennessee Wesleyan, freshmen Kesha Brady and Jordan Brock combined for 41 points in their first-ever collegiate game. This was huge, as Nov. 22, 2002 was the last time two Tech freshmen each scored 20 points or more in a de-
but. Two local products, Jenna Baltimore of Livingston and Courtney McFarlin of Mount Juliet, put up 21 and 23 points, respectively, in a 74-56 win over East Tennessee State.

## BRADY KICKS OFF REGULAR-SEASON AWARDS

After her outstanding debut, Kesha Brady was named the adidas ${ }^{\circledR}$ Ohio Valley Conference Freshman of the Week on Nov. 14. Along with Brock, Brady became the first Tech freshman to score 20+ points in her inaugural game since Kellie Cook put up 22 points against Alabama on Nov. 13, 2009.

## RAINING THREES

Also against Tennessee Wesleyan, Tech hit 11 of its 25 3-point tries ( 44.0 percent). The last time the Golden Eagles made at least 11 3-pointers was Nov. 30, 2013 against Ball State in a neutral-site game, where Tech went 11 of 19 from long range.

## INCHING CLOSER TO 1,000

Senior guard Yaktavia "Shug" Hickson enters the Georgia game with 969 points in her career, just 31 away from 1,000.

## HEAD COACH KIM ROSAMOND

Kim Rosamond enters her second season as the head coach of Tennessee Tech women's basketball in 2017-18. Coming to Cookeville after nine years as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Vanderbilt and 22 years total immersed in basketball, Rosamond sought out to change the culture of the Tech program.

Initially voted to finish 11th in the 2016-17 Ohio Valley Conference preseason predictions, the Golden Eagles tied for sixth in the final OVC standings and also returned to the conference tournament for the first time since the 2013-14 season.

Rosamond guided Tech players to a number of accolades in her inaugural season. Junior Yaktavia "Shug" Hickson was named to the 2017 All-OVC first team and had the fifth-best scoring average of all OVC players in conference play (16.9 points per game); senior Hannah Goolsby became the 29th member of the Golden Eagles' 1,000 -point club; and rookie Akia Harris was selected as the adidas ${ }^{\circledR}$ OVC Freshman of the Week three times.

University president Dr. Philip Oldham and director of athletics Mark Wilson introduced Rosamond as the program's sixth head coach on March 31, 2016.

Upon arriving at Tech, Rosamond had nine years of experience as an assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Vanderbilt University, 19 seasons of experience in the tough Southeastern Conference as a player and coach and 21 seasons overall in women's college basketball. Those credentials, coupled with a resume stuffed with success on the court, in the classroom, and on the recruiting trail, led to Rosamond being selected as the perfect fit to take the reins of the tradition-rich Tennessee Tech women's basketball program.
"I am truly honored and humbled to be only the sixth head coach of Tennessee Tech women's basketball," Rosamond said at her introductory press conference. "Over the last 13 years, the state of Tennessee has become my home. It is a dream come true to be able to stay home and lead a program with the standard of excellence and rich tradition of Golden Eagle basketball.
"I would like to thank Dr. Oldham and Mark Wilson, as well as everyone involved in the process, for believing in me and giving me the chance to work with a tremendous group of young women," she said. "Our players will understand the responsibility that comes with wearing Tennessee Tech on their chest, and we will work relentlessly on and off the court to make our university, alumni and the Cookeville community proud."

During the 2015-16 season, her ninth on the Vanderbilt staff, Rosamond helped the Commodores post an 1814 overall record, including a pair of victories over top-25 teams, beating No. 12 Kentucky and No. 24 Missouri. Vanderbilt also recorded two wins in the SEC Tournament.

Hired at Vanderbilt before the 2007-08 season, she consistently helped the Commodores land highly rated signing classes. Those highly decorated players enabled Vanderbilt to maintain its status as one of the nation's top women's basketball programs.

Rosamond arrived at Vanderbilt with 10 years of SEC experience as a player and coach under her belt, and her contributions to the Commodore staff included a wide variety of duties, ranging from scouting to player development to on-court strategy.

The recruiting classes that Rosamond helped coordinate were ranked among the nation's best each year since she took on the role. The 2016 signing class was ranked No. 7 by Blue Star Report and No. 10 by Prospects Nation. Among her other signing groups, the 2014 Vanderbilt recruiting class earned a No. 9 national ranking according to Blue Star Report, and the 2013 signing class helped Vanderbilt earn its 15th-consecutive berth in the NCAA Tournament at the end of the 2013-14 season.

Before her post at Vanderbilt, Rosamond spent two seasons on the staff at Middle Tennessee as an assistant coach from 2003-05 and served as the interim head coach for one month in 2005. During her tenure in Murfreesboro, the Lady Raiders had consecutive 24-win seasons while capturing a pair of Sun Belt Conference championships and a pair of first-round NCAA Tournament upsets over North Carolina and NC State.

Rosamond spent five years as an assistant at her alma mater, Ole Miss, prior to her time at MTSU. She was added to the staff in 1998 just months after graduating with a degree in journalism and advertising, and following four seasons on the Rebel roster. She was promoted to recruiting coordinator in 2001.

Rosamond was responsible for bringing a pair of top-50 classes to Oxford. Two Tennessee Miss Basketball selections were included in her Lady Rebel classes, with her final group of signees having reached the NCAA Elite Eight in 2007.

Rosamond attended high school at Winston Academy in Louisville, Mississippi, where she was recruited to Ole Miss and became a four-year letterwinner for the Lady Rebels (1995-98). Following her senior year, Rosamond was the recipient of the team's Lady Rebel Award, which is given to the player who excels on and off the court.
