## Kentucky Makes First Trip to WVU Since 1970 in Big 12/SEC Challenge

- WVU is 1-3 in the Big 12/SEC Challenge. WVU defeated Texas A&M in Morgantown last season, lost at Florida two years ago, fell to LSU at home three years ago and lost at Missouri four years ago.
- WVU was 1-1 in the Big East/SEC Challenge. WVU defeated Auburn in Birmingham (2007) and lost at Miss. State (2011).
- With a win at Oklahoma State on Dec. 29, Bob Huggins moved past Jim Phelan for seventh place all-time on the NCAA Division I winningest coaches list. Huggins' record now stands at 835-334 in his 36th season as a head coach.
- Huggins is the third-winningest active Division I coach behind Mike Krzyzewski and Jim Boeheim.
- On Dec. 21, the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame announced that Huggins is one of six collegiate coaches eligible for the Class of 2018. Huggins is the only active coach in the group.
- Jevon Carter is the only player in the country to average more than 16 points, six assists and three steals per game.
- West Virginia is 129-33 at the WVU Coliseum under Bob Huggins, including a 65-29 mark in league games.
- WVU is 538-153 (.782) all-time at the WVU Coliseum and 170-39 at the WVU Coliseum in the last 14 seasons.
- West Virginia is 98-6 at home against non-conference teams in the last 16 years, including 79 of its last 83.
- West Virginia is 113-27 in non-conference regular season games under Bob Huggins, including a 64-4 mark at home.
- West Virginia is 144-33 against non-conference teams in regular season games in the last 15 seasons.
- West Virginia is 173-37 in its last 210 games against unranked teams, including 90 of its last 101 at the WVU Coliseum.
- West Virginia has made at least one 3-point field goal in 616 consecutive games.
- Bob Huggins has wins over 41 ranked teams at WVU, including 16 wins over Top 10 teams and three over No. 1.
- WVU is 10-8 in its last 18 games vs. AP Top 25 teams, with two wins over No. 1, one vs. No. 2, two wins over No. 6 and one win over No. 7.
- Jevon Carter leads the country in steals with 68, and he has played in 127 career games, the second-most games played among active college basketball players this season.
- In the latest NCAA stats, WVU ranks second in turnover margin (7.0), is fourth in forced turnovers (19.1), is seventh in steals per game (9.3) and is second in offensive rebounds per game (14.6).
- West Virginia is forcing its opponents to turn it over on 25.5 percent of their possessions, second in the country.
- West Virginia has nearly forced more turnovers (382) than its opponents' made field goals (423).
- Carter and Daxter Miles Jr. have played more games (247 combined) than any other Power 5 backcourt in the country.
- The Mountaineers have been ranked 91 weeks in the AP poll under Bob Huggins, including 37 weeks in the AP Top 10. Huggins has had WVU ranked more weeks than any other coach in school history.
- Dating back to last year, WVU has been ranked for 47 consecutive weeks in the AP poll and 64 of the last 67 weeks in the AP rankings. WVU has been ranked 67 consecutive weeks in the USA Today Coaches poll.
- This is WVU's second longest streak of ranked weeks in the AP poll, behind 56 weeks from March 1956 to March 1960.
- WVU's streak of 47 weeks in the AP rankings is the fourth longest active streak in the country.
- In the last two seasons, WVU has finished second in the Big 12 Conference regular season and postseason tourney.
- WVU has had back-to-back seasons of single-digit season losses. The last time that happened was in 1982-83.
- Jevon Carter was named the Big 12 Defensive Player of the Year last year. Carter was named to the All-Big 12 Defensive Team for the third year in a row. Carter is just the third player in Big 12 history to earn three selections on the All-Big 12 Defensive Team. Carter was the NABC Defensive Player of the Year and the Lefty Driesell Defensive Player of the Year.
- Jevon Carter became West Virginia's 51st 1,000-point scorer on Feb. 27. He now ranks 19th all-time with 1,456 points.
- Daxter Miles Jr. became WVU's 52nd 1,000-point scorer on Dec. 20. He now ranks 39th all-time with 1,108 points.
- Sagaba Konate has already posted 62 blocks this season. He had 53 his entire freshman season a year ago.
- Konate has had at least five blocks in six games this season, one of five players nationally to complete that feat.
- The Mountaineers have won 72 of their last 74 games when holding opponents to 69 points or less.
- WVU is 193-31 under Huggins when holding opponents to 69 points or less. WVU has won 82 of its last 85 and 138 of its last 150 games when holding opponents under 69 points.
- West Virginia has allowed its opponent to shoot 50 percent or better only 61 times under Bob Huggins (368 games).
- West Virginia is 64-4 under Bob Huggins when shooting 50 percent or better from the field.
- West Virginia is 191-34 under Bob Huggins when leading at halftime.
- West Virginia is 198-22 under Bob Huggins when leading by 10 or more points in a game.
- West Virginia is 169-11 under Bob Huggins when posting a higher shooting percentage than its opponent.
- The Mountaineers are 182-35 under Bob Huggins when scoring 70 or more points in a game.
- West Virginia is 181-43 under Bob Huggins when outrebounding its opponent.
- WVU is 12-13 all-time on Jan. 27. The Mountaineers are 508-325 in the month of January.

## Bob Huggins

- Huggins is WVU's 21st head basketball coach.
- Huggins is a Morgantown native and a 1977 graduate of West Virginia University.
- Huggins has won 835 games in 36 seasons as a head coach.
- Huggins ranks third in total victories among active Division I head coaches.
- Huggins ranks seventh among the NCAA's all-time winningest coaches.
- Huggins' teams have participated in postseason play in 31 of 35 seasons, including 23 NCAA Tournaments.
- His squads have won 20 or more games in all but seven of his 35 campaigns, including 30 or more twice.
- Huggins averages 23.9 victories a season.
- Huggins has made two NCAA Final Fours and four NCAA Elite Eight appearances.
- Huggins has been named national coach of the year six times.
- Huggins' teams have finished in the Top 10 final rankings nine times.
- Huggins has coached 12 All-Americans and 66 all-conference selections.
- Huggins has coached 18 NBA draft picks, including six first round selections and four lottery picks.
- Huggins has won 13 conference regular season titles.
- Huggins has won 10 conference tournament titles.
- Huggins has led West Virginia to eight NCAA Tournament appearances.

## Scouting Kentucky

- Kentucky is 15-5 overall and 5-3 in the SEC following a 78-65 win over Mississippi State on Tuesday.
- The Wildcats are 2-2 in road games this season and 1-2 on neutral courts.
- John Calipari is 264-58 in his ninth season at Kentucky and 677-196 in his 26th season as a head coach.

## Series Record

- Kentucky leads the series with WVU that began in 1923-24 by a 15-5 margin.
- The last meeting took place on March 26, 2015, a 78-39 Kentucky win in the 2015 NCAA Sweet 16 in Cleveland.
- The two teams met on March 19, 2011 in the NCAA Third Round in Tampa, Florida, a 71-63 Kentucky win.
- The two teams met in 2010 with the Mountaineers defeating the top-seeded Wildcats, 73-66, in the Elite Eight in Syracuse, New York, sending the Mountaineers to their first Final Four since 1959.
- Kentucky has won nine of the last 10 meetings in the series.
- Kentucky's last visit to Morgantown was a 106-100 Wildcat win on Dec. 7, 1970.
- UK's only other visit to Morgantown was on Jan. 11, 1941, a 56-43 WVU win at Mountaineer Field House.
- Bob Huggins is 8-3 all-time against John Calipari (1-2 at WVU). When Huggins was at Cincinnati, he had a 2-0 record against Calipari's UMass teams and a 5-1 record against Calipari's Memphis teams.
- Huggins is 1-5 all-time against Kentucky (1-3 at WVU and 0-2 at Cincinnati).
- Calipari is 12-7 against WVU (10-6 while at UMass and 2-1 at Kentucky).

## WVU Basketball Tradition

- This is the 109th season and 115th year overall for West Virginia basketball, which began in 1903.
- The Mountaineers own a 1,746-1,072 all-time record in intercollegiate basketball competition, ranking the Mountaineers 22nd in wins among all Division I schools.
- WVU has earned 28 NCAA berths and 16 NIT trips since 1941, and has finished in the Top 25 20 times, including an amazing nine straight years from 1955-63.
- In the past 13 years, WVU has reached the Sweet 16 in 2017 & 2015, NIT First Round in 2014, NCAA Second Round in 2012, NCAA Third Round in 2011, the NCAA Final Four in 2010, made the NCAA Tournament in 2009, reached the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2008, won the NIT in 2007, reached the NCAA Sweet 16 in 2006 and made it to the NCAA Elite Eight in 2005.
- In 1958, the Mountaineers finished the regular season ranked No. 1 in both polls and in 1959, West Virginia, led by All-America guard Jerry West, lost in the NCAA finals to California.
- West Virginia has had 11 first team All-Americans, headlined by West, who went on to become one of basketball's all-time greats with the NBA's Los Angeles Lakers.
- Most recently, Juwan Staten was named to the Lute Olson All-America team in 2015. Da'Sean Butler earned All-America first team honors in 2010 by John Wooden and *Basketball Times* and Kevin Jones earned All-America first team honors in 2012 by John Wooden.
- Besides West, some of basketball's biggest names have been affiliated with the Old Gold & Blue, including former Lakers coach and general manager Fred Schaus, former NBA President of Basketball Operations Rod Thorn and former Utah Jazz broadcaster and NBA Hall of Famer "Hot Rod" Hundley.
- West Virginia has played in four different home venues: the ROTC Armory (1903-15), The Ark (1916-27), Stansbury Hall (1928-69) and the WVU Coliseum (1970-present). When the WVU Coliseum was closed due to asbestos removal during the 1999-2000 season, WVU played home games in Charleston, Wheeling and Fairmont.

- West Virginia has finished with a winning non-conference mark for the 26th consecutive season.
- West Virginia is 144-33 against non-conference teams in regular season games in the last 14 seasons.
- The last time WVU did not post a winning non-league record was 1990-91, when WVU went 4-4 outside of conference.
- WVU is 113-27 in non-conference games under Bob Huggins.
- WVU has finished with one loss during non-conference play in eight different seasons. They were: 1981-82 when West Virginia went 11-1 out of the Atlantic 10, 1957-58 when WVU lost only to Duke in going 11-1, 1996-97 when the Mountaineers were 7-1, losing the season opener at Minnesota, 2004-05 when WVU went 10-1 outside the Big East, 2006-07 when the Mountaineers went 12-1 with their only loss to Arkansas, 2009-10 when WVU was 11-1 with its only loss at Purdue, 2014-15 when the Mountaineers had a one point home loss to LSU, finishing 12-1 and in 2016-17 when WVU finished 12-1 with a four-point loss to Temple in Brooklyn, New York.
- WVU has had one perfect non-conference regular season, 10-0, in 1997-98.

- West Virginia is ranked No. 7 in the Associated Press poll and No. 7 in the USA Today Coaches poll.
- WVU's No. 2 AP ranking on Jan. 8 was its highest since a No. 2 ranking on Dec. 29, 1959.
- WVU began the season ranked No. 11 in the Associated Press poll and No. 10 in the USA Today Coaches poll.
- The Mountaineers have been ranked 91 weeks in the AP poll under Bob Huggins, including 37 weeks in the AP Top 10. Huggins has had WVU ranked more weeks than any other coach in school history.
- Dating back to last year, WVU has been ranked for 47 consecutive weeks in the AP poll and 64 of the last 67 weeks in the AP rankings. WVU has been ranked 67 consecutive weeks in the USA Today Coaches poll.
- This is WVU's second longest streak of ranked weeks in the AP poll, behind 56 weeks from March 1956 to March 1960.
- West Virginia has been ranked 111 weeks since Jan. 3, 2005 in the AP poll, and 225 weeks total in school history.
- WVU was No. 6 in the final AP poll in 2010, its highest final ranking since a No. 5 ranking in 1959-60.
- In 2010, WVU was ranked in the Top 10 for nine straight weeks - the most consecutive weeks in the Top 10 since 1960.

- WVU's win at No. 6 Virginia last season was its first non-conference road win over a Top 10 team since winning at No. 5 Kentucky on Dec. 20, 1957.
- WVU became the fourth team in the AP poll to beat an AP No. 1 and No. 2 team by at least 15 points each in a season.
- Last season, West Virginia became the first team since Indiana in 2011-12 to beat No. 1 and No. 2 in the same season.
- Last season marked the first time WVU had defeated three AP Top 10 teams in the same season, and the first time WVU had ever beaten three AP Top 6 teams in the same year.
- WVU owns 97 wins over AP-ranked teams.
- Since 1995, the Mountaineers have played 192 nationally ranked teams. WVU has played 305 total games against nationally ranked competition. That means more than 63 percent of the games against the best teams in the country have come during the last 24 seasons.
- WVU has played 143 ranked teams since the start of the 2004-05 season, winning 55 of those games.
- Bob Huggins has faced 93 ranked teams during the regular season in 11 years, the most in school history. Gale Catlett faced 66 ranked teams during the regular season in 25 years, while John Beilein faced 34 ranked teams during regular season play in five years.

- West Virginia defeated Missouri, 83-79, in the championship game of the AdvoCare Invitational in Lake Buena Vista, Florida, on Nov. 26.
- The Mountaineers also defeated UCF, 83-45, Marist, 84-78, and Long Beach State, 91-62, in a non-bracketed game during the event.
- WVU has now won four in-season tournaments under Bob Huggins: 2009 76 Classic in Anaheim, California, 2014 Puerto Rico Tip-Off, 2015 Las Vegas Invitational and the 2017 AdvoCare Invitational.
- Jevon Carter was named MVP of the AdvoCare Invitational, while Daxter Miles Jr. was named to the All-Tournament Team.

## Preseason Bits

- West Virginia was predicted to finish second in the Big 12 Conference preseason coaches' poll.
- Last year, the Mountaineers were predicted to finish second and finished second in the Big 12 regular season and conference tournament. WVU has finished second in the regular season and conference tournament for two consecutive years.
- In 12 of the last 15 seasons, the Mountaineers have finished higher than or equal to their preseason prediction.
- Senior guard Jevon Carter was a unanimous selection to the Preseason All-Big 12 Team.

- Thirty-nine of the last 40 seniors on the WVU men's basketball team have graduated on time or early since 2004.
- Jevon Carter was named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District II First Team in 2016-17.

- Bob Huggins has posted 45 conference road victories in 11 seasons at WVU, including two this season, five Big 12 road wins last season, six Big 12 road wins two years ago and four Big 12 road wins three years ago.
- WVU has won at least 25 games for three consecutive seasons. WVU is 95-32 since the beginning of 2014-15 season.
- WVU is 41-21 in the Big 12 regular season in the last four seasons, including a 30-14 mark in the last two-plus seasons.
- West Virginia is 110-78 under Bob Huggins in conference regular season games (Big 12 and Big East).
- Bob Huggins is 66-48 in Big 12 Conference games. He is 56-42 at WVU, and was 10-6 at Kansas State in 2006-07.
- WVU has made 13 postseason appearances in the last 14 years, including the NCAA Final Four in 2010.
- Last year was WVU's eighth NCAA appearance in the last 10 years and 10th appearance in the last 13 seasons.
- WVU has reached the Sweet 16 in seven of its last 11 NCAA appearances (2017, 2015, 2010, 2008, 2006, 2005, 1998).
- Under Bob Huggins at the WVU Coliseum, WVU is averaging 82.2 ppg while holding its opponents to 62.4 ppg.

## Press Virginia

- Press Virginia is back for the Mountaineers for the fourth season in a row.
- In 2016-17, WVU led the country in turnover margin (7.7), turnovers forced (20.0), total steals (371) and steals (10.0). WVU ranked third in scoring margin (14.8), fifth in offensive rebounds (14.3), 21st in assists (16.4) & 23rd in scoring offense (81.5).

- Huggins will be paid \$3,750,000 this season, \$3,850,000 in 2018-19, \$3,950,000 in 2019-20, \$4,050,000 in 2020-21 and \$4,150,000 in 2021-22.

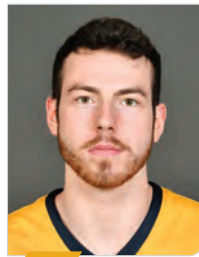
