» The last time Auburn was ranked and Kentucky wasn't was Dec. 27, 1999 when the Tigers were No. 4.

» Ranked Auburn teams are 1-1 all-time against unranked Kentucky teams as the No. 17 Tigers defeated the Wildcats 61-60 in Auburn on Feb. 20, 1960, and 20th-ranked Auburn lost 75-71 at Kentucky on Feb. 4, 1987.

» Auburn is looking to win consecutive home games against Kentucky since defeating the Wildcats 77-75 on Feb. 20, 1989, and 74-70 on Jan. 24, 1990, in Beard-Eaves Memorial Coliseum. The Tigers won the last meeting between the two teams in Auburn 75-70 on Jan. 16, 2016.

» Auburn has something that is rare among its competition in the SEC. The three-guard lineup of Bryce Brown (16.6), Mustapha Heron (16.3) and Jared Harper (13.3) all average over 13 points per game this season. The Tigers are the only team in the league to have three players with 13 or more points per game. The trio of guards are the only backcourt in the SEC to all average over 12 points per contest.

GAMEDAY EXPERIENCE: AUBURN ARENA

» Built at a cost of \$86 million, Auburn Arena seats 9,121 fans for basketball games. Auburn Arena replaced the old Beard-Eaves Memorial Coliseum as home of Tiger basketball for the 2010-11 season. The furthest seat in Auburn Arena is just 43 feet away from the court. A full two-thirds of the seats in the facility are less than 27 feet in elevation from courtside. The Arena features a team store, six concession stands, three elevators, 94 HD televisions plus family restrooms and customer service kiosks on all seating levels. For special events, 12,000 square feet of banquet space, including tailgate and super suites, is available. For the teams, Auburn Arena offers an office suite for the coaches, locker rooms and a 13,970-square foot practice facility and weight room.

BRUCE PEARL » HEAD COACH

- Has advanced to postseason play in 18 of 22 years as a head coach
- Set single-season wins records at three different schools (29 at Southern Indiana in 1995; 26 at Wisconsin-Milwaukee in 2005; 31 at Tennessee in 2008)
- Bruce Pearl's teams have led their conference in scoring 16 of the 22 years that he has been a head coach. His squads were the SEC's scoring champion in four of his six seasons at Tennessee, averaging 77.4 ppg while allowing 70.5 ppg
- One of just seven active head coaches who has led his teams to at least 10 NCAA Sweet 16 appearances (10 total)
- Bruce Pearl is ranked second in the SEC among current head coaches in career winning percentage (.718), fifth in winning percentage as a SEC head coach (.622), fifth in average wins per year as a SEC head coach (21.0) and fifth in SEC games only win pct. (.540, 81-70)
- Bruce Pearl's 506-199 (.718) overall record is the second-best winning percentage out of the 14 current SEC head coaches
- Bruce Pearl's 189-115 (.622) record as a SEC head coach is the third-best winning percentage out of the current SEC head coaches
- Under Bruce Pearl, Auburn has had 12-of-12 graduating players in Malcolm Canada, Chris Denson, Asaun Dixon-Tatum, KT Harrell, Allen Payne, Cinmeon Bowers, Jordon Granger, Josh Dollard, Dylan Spencer, C.J. Holmes, Jonathan Walker and Tahj Sham-sid-Deen
- Auburn had a perfect 1000 APR in Bruce Pearl's first season in 2014-15
- Auburn reached its first tournament final since winning the 2002 San Juan Shootout in this season's Cancun Challenge
- In 2015-16, for the first time in 48 years since 1967-68, Auburn defeated Kentucky, Alabama, Tennessee, Georgia and Arkansas in the same season
- Auburn defeated Kentucky and Alabama in back-to-back games for the first time since 1967 in 2016 and for only the third time in its 110 seasons of basketball
- Auburn has sold out of season tickets for the third straight time in 2016-17, all under Pearl, to continue the school record streak. Prior to Pearl, the only other time the Tigers sold out of season tickets came in the 1999-2000 season
- Auburn averaged 8,216 in its 15 home games in 2015-16, which is 90 percent capacity at Auburn Arena. Auburn ranked second in the SEC in percent capacity behind Kentucky for the second straight season
- In 22 full years as a head coach, Bruce Pearl's teams have finished either first or second in conference play 15 times
- In the 2015 SEC Tournament, Auburn won three games in three days for the first time in 30 years and reached the semifinals for the first time since 2009. The Tigers defeated Mississippi State and two postseason teams Texas A&M (NIT) and LSU (NCAA) before falling to undefeated Kentucky
- At the Division I level, Pearl's teams have topped the 100-point mark 16 times, including a high of 124 in 2009 as well as 121 in the 2007 NCAA Tournament. In his second year as a coach at Southern Indiana the team averaged 101.7 ppg
- Has coached a league's leading scorer 3 times: KT Harrell, Auburn, 18.5 ppg – 2015; Dylan Page, UWM, 20.9 ppg – 2004; Chris Lofton, UT, 20.8 ppg - 2007

• Bruce Pearl has raised \$1 million in only four golf tournaments at Auburn. Pearl and his wife, Brandy, have remarkably raised \$770,000 in the last three years benefitting Children's Harbor in Birmingham through the Bruce Pearl For the Children Golf Classic. The mission of Children's Harbor is to help children with serious illness and their families. Over \$200,000 was raised in the Bruce, Barkley & Basketball Golf Classic Oct. 23-24, 2016, benefitting the Auburn Basketball program.

• Pearl started AUTLIVE at Auburn in 2015-16 to benefit cancer patients in the fight to beat cancer. AUTLIVE raises the awareness of cancer prevention and detection while t-shirt sales and donations raise money to benefit cancer patients. He initiated the OUTLIVE program in 2009 at Tennessee in recognition of former Vol Chris Lofton, who beat testicular cancer through early diagnosis and treatment and went on to play the entire 2007-08 season while recovering from his battle with the disease.

• The Bruce Pearl Family Foundation in conjunction with L5 Foundation, an organization dedicated to addressing the essential and basic needs of cancer patients, donated \$20,000 to five charities in a ceremony in Knoxville in August 2015. Pearl accepted a \$10,000 donation to an endowed scholarship in his name to Camp Koinonia, an outdoor education program for children with disabilities.

• The Pearl family announced on Feb. 27, 2007, a \$100,000 donation to endow a scholarship in the name of former Tennessee player Dane Bradshaw. The Dane Bradshaw Athletic Scholarship Endowment is awarded to the male or female student-athlete at UT who best epitomizes the characteristics of the 2006-07 senior captain.

» Junior Desean Murray has been crucial to Auburn's success thus far into the season. The Stanley, N.C native touts averages of 11.0 points and 6.9 rebounds per game. Where Murray has shown the most improvement is at the free throw line. » Prior to last season, the Tigers scored 90 points in a regular season SEC game just seven times over the previous 17 seasons combined. Auburn's four 90-point games in SEC play in regulation are one fewer than the rest of the league combined (in regulation) and two more than any other team.

» Auburn scored 94 at Tennessee, 91 at Missouri, 95 vs. LSU and 93 vs. Vanderbilt. Tennessee scored 92 at Vanderbilt and 94 vs. Ole Miss. Arkansas scored 97 vs. Ole Miss, while both LSU and Ole Miss scored 94 and 93, respectively, against Arkansas.

» Auburn leads the SEC and is 14th nationally with a +13.0 scoring margin. The Tigers scoring margin is 4.2 points per game better than any other SEC team. Auburn has an 11.1 scoring margin in SEC play, which is 6.3 points per game better than any other team. Auburn has won 17 games by double digits, which surpasses the Tigers' total from the previous three seasons combined (14), including eight of the Tigers' 10 SEC wins.

» Auburn leads the SEC with a 10-2 mark. It is the latest Auburn has held sole possession of first place in the SEC since the Tigers won the 1998-99 regular-season crown.

DOWN, BUT NOT OUT

» Auburn's win at Tennessee was the first time the Tigers have overcome a deficit of at least 14 points to win since defeating Xavier 89-88 in 2OT in Auburn on Dec. 20, 2014, after also trailing by 14.

» On Jan. 20, Auburn trailed by as many as 16 against Georgia, but outscored the Bulldogs 55-25 in the second half to come back and win by 15. It was largest deficit the Tigers have overcome in an SEC game since overcoming a 19-point deficit against Mississippi State, Feb. 12, 2011.

» Sophomore Mustapha Heron was named the SEC Player of the Week, announced by the league office Jan. 8 and Jan. 29. Heron is the first Auburn player to earn two player of the week accolades from the conference since Korvotney Barber during the 2006-07 season.

» Heron scored in double figures in his first 25 games last season, breaking the record for the most for a freshman to begin a season previously held by Wesley Person (14 games in 1990-91). Heron has had 10+ points in 52 of 56 games (vs. Florida, 2017; vs. Temple, 2017; vs. Gardner-Webb, 2017; at Alabama, 2018).

» In addition, Heron has reached the 20-point plateau 12 times in his young career. The Waterbury, Conn. native scored 20-plus points six times during his freshman campaign and has already accomplished the feat six times during the 2017-18 season (22 vs. Hofstra, 31 vs. Winthrop, 21 at Dayton, 21 vs. LSU, 23 vs. Vanderbilt, 28 vs. Texas A&M).

» At Georgia, Heron scored 19 points on 8-of-14 shooting, including 2-of-4 from 3-point range. Heron has averaged 21.4 points over his last five games, shooting 39-of-66 (59.1 percent) over that span. He is 16-of-37 (43.2 percent) from deep over his last seven games.

HOT SHOT

» Auburn shot 29-of-57 (50.9 percent) from the field at Georgia, the third straight game and fourth time in five games the Tigers have shot at least 50 percent. FOREVER 34: CHARLES BARKLEY

» After retiring his jersey in 2001, the Tigers went a step further in honoring Charles Barkley's legacy on The Plains. On Nov. 25, 2017, Auburn Athletics unveiled a statue of the NBA Hall of Fame basketball player in front of Auburn Arena. Barkley, from Leeds, Ala., played at Auburn from 1981-84 and won All-American honors on his way to becoming an Olympic gold medal winner and being named one of the NBA's 50 greatest players in the league's 50th anniversary season. A first-round draft pick by the Philadelphia 76ers, Barkley was the 1993 league's Most Valuable Player, and an 11-time All-Star. He is one of four NBA players who had 20,000 points, 10,000 rebounds and 4,000 assists, joining Kareem Abdul-Jabbar, Wilt Chamberlain and Karl Malone.

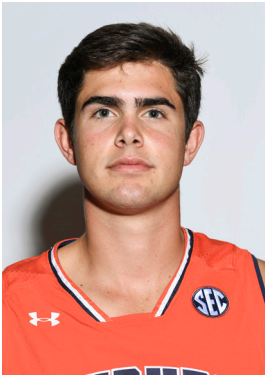

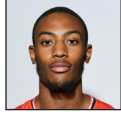
