Team Notes/Up Next

- The LSU women's basketball program earned its 900th win on Jan. 28 with a 70-59 victory over then-No. 10/10 Tennessee. LSU became the 26th NCAA Division I women's program to hit the milestone on Sunday, beating Duke by approximately one hour as the Blue Devils hit the milestone as well on Sunday. LSU is fourth, at 901, among SEC schools behind Tennessee (1,337), Georgia (955) and Auburn (908).

- Junior guard Chloe Jackson has been named a Top 10 candidate for the inaugural Ann Meyers Drysdale Award.

- LSU's next victory will be head coach Nikki Fargas' 200th career win. She is 127-89 in her seventh season with the Lady Tigers and 72-26 in three previous years at UCLA.

• In SEC Play

- LSU is currently in a three-way tie for fourth place;
- LSU is averaging 4.1 3-point field goals made per game and shooting 30.8 percent from long range;
- LSU is forcing opponents to commit 17.1 turnovers per game and stealing the ball 9.6 times per game;

- Chloe Jackson is averaging 20.9 points per game for second place in league action and has the best free throw percentage on the team at 82.4 percent;

- Ayana Mitchell is averaging 9.6 rebounds per game, good for fifth in conference play, and is seventh in SEC action in field goal percentage at 56.5;

- Faustine Aifuwa is sixth in blocked shots with 1.6 in conference play.

- Raigyne Louis is the former Raigyne Moncrief. She married former LSU football player Lamar Louis over the summer and will go by her married name during her senior year.

- This will be the 48th meeting between LSU and Kentucky. LSU leads the series 32-15 and holds a 10-8 lead in Lexington. Kentucky is 12-11 overall and 4-5 in SEC play. The Wildcats have won four of the last five games in the series, including last season's 55-42 win in Baton Rouge.

- **UP NEXT:** The Lady Tigers travel to Auburn on Thursday, Feb. 8. Tip time is set for 6 p.m. CT on the SEC Network Plus (SEC+) and the LSU Sports Radio Network.

Career Numbers For Louis

Raigyne Louis is the only player in LSU history to record 1,500 points, 600 rebounds, 250 steals and 300 assists in a career.

She became the 14th Lady Tiger to log 1,500 career points against Tennessee on Jan. 28, 2018. It was the 116th game of her LSU career. She joined the 1,000-Point club in her 85th career game in purple and gold at Texas A&M on Jan. 22, 2017.

* Louis currently totals 1,528 career points at LSU, which ranks 13th all-time, passing Allison Hightower (1,508; 2006-10);

- Is 5 points away from moving into 12th place with Madeline Doucet (1,533; 1981-85);

- Needs 72 points to become the 10th LSU player to score 1,600 points.

* Her 669 rebounds have her in 14th place.

- Needs 55 to move into 13th place with Seimone Augustus (728; 2002-06);

- Is 31 boards away from becoming the 14th Lady Tiger with 700 career boards.

* Louis ranks third on the all-time steals list with 274.

- Is 26 swipes away from becoming the third LSU player with 300 career steals;

- Needs 52 steals to move into second place with LSU legend Joyce Walker (326; 1980-84).

* She cracked the top-15 on the LSU career assists list at Tulane on Dec. 10. Louis has dished out 315 assists for 13th place.

- Is 55 assists away from moving into 12th place with Brenda McGuffee (370; 1976-78).

Statistically Speaking ...

• Ironwomen: Head coach Nikki Fargas has said that it will be a rare occasion for Raigyne Louis or Chloe Jackson to not be on the court. The pair are the only LSU players averaging over 30 minutes per game - Jackson with 36.2 and Louis at 32.6.

• LSU is 17-6 when Ayana Mitchell scores 10 or more points in a game. When she doesn't, LSU is 17-12.

• When Raigyne Louis, Chloe Jackson and Ayana Mitchell score 10 or more points in the same game, LSU is 12-3.

• Raigyne Louis and Chloe Jackson have scored 20 or more points in the same game six times. LSU is 4-2 in those games.

• LSU has stolen the ball more times than their opponent in 17 games this season. The Lady Tigers stole the ball a season-high 17 times against Vanderbilt on Dec. 31.

• LSU has forced its opponents to turn the ball over 20 or more times in nine games this season, including a season high 30 by Southeastern Louisiana.

• The Lady Tigers have held the advantage on the boards in nine games this season. The largest margin was +21 against Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 12.

• LSU has shot 45.0 percent or better from the field in five games with a season-high of 51.5 against Southeastern Louisiana on Nov. 12. The Lady Tigers have shot at least 35.0 percent in every game this season.

• From the free throw line, LSU's best performance of the season was 81.0 percent at Missouri on Jan. 4 in Columbia. Against Saint Louis on Nov. 25, both teams attempted at least 20 free throws in the game. Against Vanderbilt on Dec. 31 is just the second time this year that both teams attempted at least 20 free throws.

• The Lady Tigers' best performance of the season from long distance was on Dec. 27 against Sam Houston State - 52.9 percent. It was also the most three-point field goals made by LSU (9) since Jan. 5, 2014 against Tulane.

Wins Against Top 10

The Lady Tigers 70-59 win over No. 10/10 Tennessee on Jan. 28 was LSU's first win over a Top-10 team since Jan. 18, 2015 when they beat #10 Kentucky, 84-79.

Wins Against Top 25

The Feb. 1 win over No. 17/18 Georgia, 71-60, marked the first time since the 2014-15 season that LSU has defeated more three or more Top-25 teams in one season. It is also the last time that LSU has put together back to back wins over nationally-ranked teams.

The Georgia victory followed the Jan. 28 win over No. 10/10 Tennessee, 70-59. The first win against a nationally-ranked team this season was the Jan. 4 road victory at No. 15/15 Missouri, 69-65.

season-high of 25 points. It was also the fourth game this season that Jackson and Raigyne Louis each scored 20 or more points as Louis added 20 in the 83-70 loss to the Bulldogs.

Jackson's seventh 20-point or more performance of the season was 22 in a 69-65 victory over No. 15/15 Missouri on Jan. 4.

Jackson produced a season-high 25 points against Vanderbilt on Dec. 31 for her sixth 20-point or more game of the season. It was the third game this season that Jackson and Louis dropped 20-plus points each a game. Louis added 21 points in the 85-65 victory.

Jackson earned her fifth 20-plus game of the season in a 56-37 win at Little Rock on Dec. 20. She scored a team-high 23 points, matching her then-season high. Her fourth 20-plus performance was on Dec. 10 in a 73-50 win at Tulane with 20 points.

Jackson and Louis got on a roll against Saint Louis on Nov. 25 and produced matching 23-point performances. It was the second game in a row that the pair put up the 20-plus scoring games. The last time two LSU players scored 23 or more points in a game was Feb. 7, 2010 against Ole Miss. Allison Hightower scored 31 and LaSondra Barrett scored 23 in the triple overtime, 102-101 loss.

Jackson and Louis earned their second 20-plus scoring games of the season on Nov. 24 in a 75-66 loss to nationally-ranked Texas. Jackson scored a team-high 23 points, 15 in the second half, while Louis scored 20, including the Lady Tigers first nine points of the game.

Louis produced the second 20+ point game of the season against Southeastern on Nov. 12 with 21 points in the home opener. It was the second game in a row that a Lady Tiger had scored 20 or more points in a game.

Jackson led LSU with 21 points against No. 23/22 USF in the season opener. She scored 15 of the Lady Tigers' 25 points in the first half.

Rookie Starters

Three true freshmen have made at least one start so far this season. Khayla Pointer and Raven Farley have started three games, Nicholls, Texas and Saint Louis, while Jailin Cherry made her first start in a Lady Tiger uniform on Nov. 10 at No. 23/22 USF. Redshirt freshman Faustine Aifuwa has made six starts, against Southeastern and at Northern Colorado early in the season and the last four SEC games.

Lady Tigers in Regular Season Tournaments

LSU is 46-14 in regular season tournaments since 1996, including Preseason WNIT games. LSU went 1-1 in the 2017 South Point Thanksgiving Shootout on Nov. 24-25 in Las Vegas. The Lady Tigers lost to nationally-ranked Texas, 75-66, then beat Saint Louis, 71-59.

Scoring Streak

Raigyne Louis' consecutive game streak of scoring in double digits ended at Little Rock on Dec. 20 at 25. The streak began on Jan. 12, 2017 against Missouri with 23 points. Her high during the streak was 25 points against nationally-ranked Mississippi State in the 2017 SEC Tournament.

Scoring Double Figures

For the first time in the 2017-18 season, four players scored double-figures in a single game. Against Nicholls on Nov. 21, Raigyne Louis led all scorers with 17 points, followed by Ayana Mitchell with 12 and Chloe Jackson and Faustine Aifuwa with 10 points each.

SEC Opener History

LSU is 24-12 in SEC openers dating back to the 1982-83 season. In addition, LSU is 12-5 in SEC openers at home. This season was the first time the Lady Tigers had opened SEC action in the PMAC since 2013 and the first time to face Vanderbilt in a SEC season-opening game.

Fargas in Non-League Games

Head coach Nikki Fargas is now 66-32 in games against non-SEC foes in her seventh season at LSU. Here is a breakdown of non-conference foes each season:

LSU is 13-6 in Season Openers on the Road

The season opener was the 19th time that the Lady Tigers opened their season on the road in the 43-year history of the program. LSU is 13-6 in road season-opening games. This was the third season in a row the Lady Tigers started the season on the road.

Preseason Polls

LSU was picked seventh in the SEC by league coaches, and by members of the media in the preseason. The Lady Tigers closed the 2016-17 campaign ranked seventh in the SEC with an 8-8 record.

Preseason in Italy

The Lady Tigers made a three-game trip to Italy in early August before the start of the Fall 2017 semester. LSU opened the exhibition competition with a 76-40 win over an Italian All-Star team in Rome. Game Two was a 87-32 victory in Trieste against the Interclub Muggia Basketball squad. The trip wrapped with a 83-50 win in Milan against Holland's FSG Academy Royal Eagles.

Richard-Harris On SEC Leadership Council

Sophomore Jaelyn Richard-Harris is recognized not only as a leader for the Lady Tigers, but also for the SEC. She is a member of the SEC Women's Basketball Leadership Council, which provides student-athletes with additional opportunities to engage with campus leaders and Conference office staff.

Nikki Fargas knows success and what it takes to be successful. In her seventh season at the helm of the Lady Tiger Basketball program in 2017-18, Fargas vows to place the Lady Tigers back into national prominence.

"We're going to do everything in our power to make sure that LSU Women's Basketball is back at that elite level, that we are competing for SEC championships, and that we are positioning ourselves to cut down nets," said Fargas.

Fargas has produced four 20-win seasons and an overall record of 113-83 in six seasons at LSU. Her 113 victories ranks her as the second-winningest Lady Tiger basketball coach in school history in terms of total wins, just behind legendary coach Sue Gunter. Over the six seasons, LSU has secured five NCAA Tournament appearances highlighted by back-to-back trips to the NCAA Sweet 16, and 19 victories over ranked opponents.

Fargas, who won national championships as both a player and an assistant coach at Tennessee and turned UCLA into a national power in just three years, has that combination of outstanding in-game coaching ability and tremendous recruiting competence. In addition, Fargas has been a leader off the court in the Baton Rouge community, helping the Lady Tigers connect with the city of Baton Rouge while donating their time and efforts to making a difference. She and her Lady

Tigers were heavily involved in assisting residents and local church communities following the devastating flood in August 2016 that impacted thousands of people in the area.

In the classroom, LSU has been a shining example of the definition of student-athlete. The Lady Tigers have recorded a perfect score of 100 in graduation success rate released by the NCAA during three seasons under Fargas. For players who have exhausted their eligibility at LSU, Fargas boasts a 100-percent graduation rate. Over the last five years, the Lady Tigers have earned 21 SEC Academic Honor Roll accolades.

Well respected in coaching circles, Fargas has twice been selected by the USA Women's Basketball Committee to serve as an assistant coach for USA National Teams. In the summer of 2012, she became the first coach in LSU history to serve on a USA U18 team staff since the squad's inception in 1988. That team claimed the gold medal at the FIBA Americas Championship. In the summer of 2013, most of that group reunited to lead the USA U19 National Team to a gold medal at the FIBA World Championships in Lithuania. Fargas is the only coach in LSU history to claim multiple USA gold medals during her tenure as Lady Tiger head coach.

Fargas has a championship and winning pedigree at every level of her career and owns an impressive

590-184 record as a player, graduate assistant, assistant coach and head coach dating back to her freshman season at Tennessee. She played, coached and studied under one of the game's greatest figures, the legendary Pat Summitt at Tennessee and she assisted Women's Basketball Hall of Famer Debbie Ryan at Virginia.

Widely recognized as one of the nation's top assistant coaches during stints at Tennessee and Virginia, Fargas took over at UCLA in 2008. In three years with the Bruins, she turned around a UCLA program that had won only one NCAA Tournament game in the nine years prior to her arrival. Fargas led the Bruins to a 72-26 (.735) overall mark, reached the NCAA Tournament twice and finished second in the Pac-10 Conference in both 2010 and 2011.

Off the court, Fargas is a passionate crusader for breast cancer awareness. She and Tennessee head coach Holly Warlick founded the non-profit organization, Champions for a Cause. Since 2007, they have raised over \$300,000 through Cruisin' for a Cause, a long-haul motorcycle adventure to raise dollars and awareness for a cure for breast cancer.

Fargas, was raised in Oak Ridge, Tenn., by her mother, Jean Caldwell. She and her husband Justin Fargas are the proud parents of a five-year-old daughter, Justice Simone Fargas.
