THE STARTING LINE-UP

SETTING THE SCENE

- Central Michigan (0-0, 0-0) will open the 2018 regular season on Saturday when it heads to SEC-foe Kentucky (0-0, 0-0) at Kroger Field.
- The contest is scheduled for a 3:30 p.m. kickoff and will be broadcast on ESPNU with Kevin Brown (play-by-play) and Andre Ware (color analyst) calling the action.
- This is the first time since 2013 that Central Michigan has started the season on the road. CMU lost that opener to Michigan (59-9). The last time the squad has opened the season with a victory on the road was 1996 at Boise State, 42-21. It has dropped seven road season openers since that game.
- Coach Bonamego is 2-1 in season opening games with victories over Rhode Island (30-27, 2017) and Presbyterian (49-3, 2016) and a loss to Oklahoma State in 2015 (24-13).
- CMU is 4-2 in its last six road openers with all four victories coming over Power 5 opponents. The program is on a two-game winning streak with victories over Oklahoma State (30-27, 2016) and Kansas (45-27, 2017).
- CMU enters this game having won five-straight regular season games. The last time that the Chippewas won six-straight regular season games was the 2009 season when they won seven straight early in the year.

HONORARY CAPTAIN

- Today's honorary is Deon Butler, a member of the program from 2011-14 and was a four-year letterwinner at tight end.
- Butler finished his career with 52 receptions for 651 yards and a pair of touchdowns. His best season was in his final year with 30 catches for 424 yards and one touchdown.
- He was a part of one of the craziest plays in CMU history, the Hail Mary touchdown on the final play of regulation of the Popeye's Bahamas Bowl. Butler was the second receiver to handle the ball during the 75-yard touchdown. The play was nominated for the Best Play at the 2015 ESPYs.
- Butler was also a nominee for the Allstate American Football Coaches Association Good Works Team.

CENTRAL MICHIGAN-KENTUCKY SERIES

- Kentucky leads the series with CMU, 6-0.
- All six meetings have come in Lexington including a 27-13 UK victory in 2011. The other Wildcat wins were:
2006 – 45-36
1992 – 21-14
1990 – 20-17
1988 – 18-7
1983 – 31-14

- CMU and Kentucky have met four others times to open a season (1992, 1990, 1988 and 1983)
- CMU is 0-7 against current members of the SEC including 0-1 versus Florida.
- This is the first time that Coach Bonamego has faced a SEC team while at CMU as head coach.

ABOUT THE WILDCATS

- Kentucky finished the 2017 season 7-6 overall and 4-4 in the SEC (3rd, East). It finished the season with a 24-23 loss to Northwestern in the Music City Bowl.
- Mark Stoops is in his sixth season with the Wildcats. He is 26-36 overall and 12-28 in SEC play. He has never faced CMU.
- The Wildcats are 86-36-5 all-time in season openers and 3-2 under coach Stoops. They are 19-3 all-time versus MAC opponents with the last loss coming in to Ohio in 2004, 28-16.
- Running back Benny Snell Jr. leads the UK offense, rushing for 1,333 yards and 19 touchdowns last year. He earned Associated Press All-SEC first team honors and was selected second team all-conference by the coaches.
- On the defensive side, UK is led by linebacker Josh Allen who is on the Bednarik Award and Butkus Award watch lists. Allen finished the 2017 season with 65 tackles in 13 games, including 9.5 tackles-for-a-loss and seven sacks. Kentucky also returns all four starters in the secondary and three starters on the defensive line.
- The Wildcats return 19 starters overall.

THE LAST TIME CMU AND UK MET

- Central Michigan jumped out to an early 13-3 lead but a decisive fourth-down stop in the third quarter flipped the momentum and Kentucky scored 24 unanswered to end the game, winning 27-13.
- Ryan Radcliff led CMU, going 24-45 for 295 yards and one touchdown. Jerry Harris had six catches for 91 yards and a TD while Cody Wilson tallied seven receptions for 71 yards. Zurlon Tipton was CMU's leading rusher with 42 yards on 16 carries.
- The defense was led by Mike Petrucci with 7.5 tackles while Jahleel Addae had six stops. Taylor Bradley had a pair of turnovers, tallying an interception and a fumble recovery.
- Josh Clemons led the Kentucky attack, racking up 126 yards on 14 carries. His 87-yard touchdown run with 23 seconds left in the third quarter gave UK its first lead of the game.

NEWS & NOTES

FOOTBALL NAMES FOUR PERMANENT CAPTAINS FOR 2018 SEASON

- Malik Fountain, Mitch Stanitzek, Shakir Carr and Devon Spalding have been named the permanent captains for the 2018 season.
- Fountain is a senior linebacker from Chicago. He is a two-time All-MAC selection and a three-year starter. Fountain has 248 career tackles and 17.0 career tackles-for-a-loss.
- Stanitzek is a senior defensive end from Grand Rapids, Mich. A two-year starter, he has made 59 tackles and 6.0 sacks during his career.
- Carr is a senior offensive lineman from South Bend, Ind. He has made 17 starts for CMU.
- Spalding is a senior wide receiver from Canton, Mich. He played at running back in his first three seasons at CMU, racking up 1,475 yards on 298 carries and 13 touchdowns.
- CMU's fifth captain each game will be the individual who earns the honor of wearing Derrick Nash's No. 21 jersey.

WARD BREAKS OUT

- Jonathan Ward had a break out season in 2017 and enters the 2018 season as one of the top dual-threat running backs in the country.
- Ward earned second team All-MAC honors last year after rushing for 1,019 yards on 214 carries and 10 touchdowns. He was also CMU's second-leading receiver with 48 receptions for 470 yards and three touchdowns.
- Ward is the Mid-American Conference's top returning rusher after finishing third in the conference in total rushing yards last year. He

was also fourth in rushing touchdowns in the MAC.

- The junior is trying to become the first CMU player to have back-to-back 1,000 yard rushing season since Jerry Seymour in 2003 and 2004.

POLJAN TAKES THE REIGNS

- Tony Poljan joins Dan LeFevour and Ryan Radcliff as underclassmen to start a season as CMU's starting quarterback since 2006. A fourth, Cooper Rush, got his first start three games into his freshman year.
- Here is how each player fared his first year as starter:
 - LeFevour (Fr. Year) – 247-388, 3,031 yards, 26 TDs, 10 INTs
 - Radcliff (So. Year) – 282-466, 3,358 yards, 17 TDs, 17 INTs
 - Rush (Fr. Year) – 177-312, 2,349 yards, 15 TDs, 15 INTs
- LeFevour also ran for 521 yards and seven touchdowns.

FILLING THE GAP, PART 1

- The Chipewas lost their top three wide receivers and top tight end off last year's team.
- The trio of Mark Chapman, Corey Willis and Eric Cooper combined for 133 catches for 1,829 yards and 16 touchdowns last year. Willis was an undrafted free agent with the Arizona Cardinals while Chapman was the top overall pick in the CFL draft and currently is in camp with the Denver Broncos.
- Tyler Conklin was selected by the Vikings with

the 20th pick in the fifth round of the 2018 NFL Draft. He finished the 2018 season with 35 catches for 504 yards and five touchdowns. He averaged 14.4 yards per catch and 63 yards in receptions per game.

- Leading the group at wide receiver is Brandon Childress, who got off to a strong start last year before getting injured in game 2 and missing the rest of the season. Devon Spalding has moved from running back to wide receiver to add depth while Cam Cole is the top returning wide receiver from last year with six catches for 104 yards. As a unit, CMU's returning wide receivers made 20 receptions for 214 yards and 2 touchdowns last year.

- Senior Logan Hessbrook, who was recently put on scholarship, is CMU's top returning tight end. He had 10 catches for 132 yards and a touchdown last year despite missing the final 10 games due to injury. Freshmen Bernhard Raimann and Keegan Cossou are expected to

FILLING THE GAP, PART 2

- Central Michigan lost three of its top defensive players from last season, first team All-MAC selections Joe Ostman and Amari Coleman and second team selection Josh Cox.
- Ostman finished 2017 ranked second in the nation with 14 sacks among his team-best 20.5 tackles-for-loss. He had 69 total tackles and signed with the Philadelphia Eagles in May.
- Coleman tallied three interceptions, defended 11 passes, broke up eight passes and made 44 tackles last year. He is currently with the Tampa Bay Buccaneers.
- Cox led CMU with six interceptions while breaking up four passes and making 87 tackles.
- The duo of Michael Danna and Mitch Stanitzek leads the defensive line. Danna had four sacks and 8.5 tackles-for-a-loss in 2017 while Stanitzek notched 3.5 sacks and seven TOF.
- The defensive backfield is led by juniors Sean Bunting and Xavier Crawford. Bunting was second on the team with five interceptions last year while Crawford, a transfer from Oregon State, earned All-PAC-12 honors as a freshman.

150 TEAM RUSHING YARDS = VICTORY

- Central Michigan is 24-4 since 2011 when it rushes for at least 150 yards as a team.
- CMU was 5-0 in games last year when it hit this mark. This included four games during CMU's five-game winning streak to end the regular season.
- The Chippewas' last loss when they had more than 150 rushing yard was a 41-39 defeat at Western Michigan in 2015.

BOWL OPPORTUNITIES THIS SEASON

- Central Michigan and the rest of the Mid-American Conference squads will have at least five different opportunities to play in a postseason bowl this year.
- The Raycom Media Camellia Bowl is scheduled for Montgomery, Ala., on Dec. 15 against a Sun Belt opponent.
- The Frisco Bowl is set for Dec. 19 against an American Athletic Conference foe.
- The Makers Wanted Bahamas Bowl is on Dec. 21, also versus a Conference USA opponent.
- The Famous Idaho Potato Bowl is against a Mountain West squad in Boise, Idaho on Dec. 21.
- The Dollar General Bowl is Dec. 22, in Mobile, Ala., against a Sun Belt team.
- During the 2018 bowl season, the MAC will have a backup with the Cheribundi Tart Cherry Boca Raton Bowl, the Quick Lane Bowl and all ESPN owned and operated bowl games.

CHIPPEWAS IN THE NFL

- 16 former Chippewas currently reside on NFL rosters.
- Antonio Brown serves as the No. 1 receiver for the Pittsburgh Steelers and is quarterback Ben Roethlisberger's top target. Brown earned first team All-Pro honors in 2017 after leading the NFL in receiving yards and receptions. He is a six-time Pro Bowler and five-time NFL All-Pro selection. Brown was selected to be of the 2018 Madden video game this past summer.
- Eric Fisher, the No. 1 pick in the 2013 NFL Draft, along with linebacker Frank Zombo, a former Super Bowl champion with the Green Bay Packers, are members of the Kansas City Chiefs.
- Offensive tackle Joe Staley, CMU's first-ever first round draft choice, played in Super Bowl XXVII as a member of the San Francisco 49ers. He is a three-time All-Pro and six-time Pro Bowl selection.
- Linebacker Nick Bellore is a key special teams player and fullback for the Detroit Lions.
- Safety Jahleel Addae, a three-time All-MAC

selection, made the San Diego Chargers' 53-man roster as an undrafted rookie free agent in 2013 and has started at safety the past few seasons..

- Leterrius Walton was a sixth-round pick of the Pittsburgh Steelers in the 2015 NFL Draft and is a consistent force on the Steelers defensive line.
- Thomas Rawls joined the New York Jets this past offseason after spending the first three years with the Seattle Seahawks.

- This past April, tight end Tyler Conklin was a 5th round selection by Minnesota. Joining him on NFL rosters as undrafted free agents were Joe Ostman (Philadelphia), JP Quinn (Minnesota), Corey Willis (Arizona), Mark Chapmen (Denver) and Amari Coleman (Tampa Bay).

REMEMBERING DERRICK NASH

The CMU football program lost an important member of the program on June 22, 2015 – Derrick Nash.

- Nash, a defensive back from Saginaw, was diagnosed with acute lymphoblastic leukemia in May 2013 as he neared the end of his senior year at Carrollton High School.
- Nash was a standout running back at Carrollton High School, leading the state of Michigan in 2012 with 1,967 rushing yards and 28 touchdowns.
- After undergoing chemotherapy treatment, Nash played in the Chippewas' annual Maroon and Gold Spring Game. He was on schedule to claim a spot on the active roster when the leukemia returned. He began treatment in October 2014.
- Nash served as CMU's honorary captain for the Popeyes Bahamas Bowl in 2014.
- After Nash's untimely passing, new head coach Bonamego made a promise that Nash would always be a part of the CMU football family.
- To honor Nash, 30 different Chippewas have worn Nash's No. 21 in each of CMU's 13 games in the 2015, 2016 and 2017 seasons.
- Six Chippewas have had the honor of wearing No. 21 twice: defensive back Kavon Frazier, quarterback Cooper Rush, defensive linemen Joe Ostman, defensive back Amari Coleman, tight end Tyler Conklin and wide receiver Corey Willis.
- One athlete has had the honor of wearing the No. 21 Jersey three time,s and that is Nash's close friend and former teammate, defensive back Josh Cox.
- Stefon Armstead was the first to wear the No. 21 Nash jersey.

HEAD COACH JOHN BONAMEGO

FOURTH SEASON 21-18

In three seasons as a collegiate head football coach, John Bonamego has led Central Michigan to three bowl games, a victory over a Top-25-ranked team, two victories over opponents from Power 5 conferences, and one Mid-American Conference West Division co-championship.

Bonamego became the 28th head coach in Central Michigan football history on Feb. 8, 2015. He played at CMU for the legendary Herb Deromedi in the mid 1980s, and he proclaimed the position his "dream job" as he became the first CMU alum to lead the program since Bill Kelly from 1951-66.

Just months after being named to lead the Chippewas, Bonamego was diagnosed with cancer and underwent chemotherapy and radiation treatments. Bonamego was pronounced cancer free in November 2015, just as the Chippewas were surging down the stretch, winning five of their last six regular-season games.

Bonamego led the Chippewas to an 8-5 finish including 6-2 in the Mid-American Conference in 2017, and to a berth in the Famous Idaho Potato Bowl.

Included in CMU's victories was a 45-28 road triumph over Big 12 member Kansas, and a mid-late season surge during which the Chippewas won six of seven games.

Among the Chippewas' wins was a dramatic come-from-behind 35-28 victory over bitter rival Western Michigan in Kalamazoo before a national television audience.

"I cannot put into words how humble, grateful, and proud I am to be the head coach at Central Michigan University. For me this is not, never will be, and never has been, a job. For me, this is the job.

"This is a place that, when I left a long time ago, it never left me. It has been a part of who I am, a part of everything I've done and I've passed it on with every player that I have ever touched. I'm very proud to be here and to call myself your football coach. I plan to be here a very, very, very, very, very long time."

HEAD COACH JOHN BONAMEGO (CONTINUED)

CMU also topped in-state rival Eastern Michigan. That victory, coupled with the win over Western, gave the Chippewas the Michigan MAC Trophy.

In his first season in charge of the program, Bonamego led the Chippewas to a 7-6 finish, the Mid-American Conference West Division championship and a berth in the Quick Lane Bowl at Ford Field in Detroit.

In 2016, CMU stunned No. 22-ranked Oklahoma State, winning on a no-time-on-the-clock final catch and lateral touchdown. The play was featured for days on televised sports shows and discussion over the penalty that led to CMU's last-gasp play continued throughout the season. The Chippewas finished the season with an appearance in the Miami Beach Bowl.

CMU placed 13 players on the Academic All-MAC football team in 2017, and nine were named to the all-conference team. Two of those players, cornerback Amari Coleman and defensive end Joe Ostman, landed on the All-MAC First Team Defense.

Overall, 45 CMU players have earned Academic All-MAC honors and 23 have been named to All-MAC teams in Bonamego's three seasons at CMU.

Among the standouts who have been mentored by Bonamego at CMU is quarterback Cooper Rush, who is now a member of the Dallas Cowboys of the NFL. Tight end Tyler Conklin was selected in the fifth round of the 2018 NFL Draft by the Minnesota Vikings, and wide receiver Mark Chapman was taken by the Hamilton Tiger-Cats with the first overall pick in the 2018 CFL Draft.

CMU is one of six institutions to have produced both a No. 1 pick in the NFL Draft and a No. 1 pick in the CFL Draft.

Under Bonamego, the CMU football program continues to lend a hand in the Mount Pleasant Community and the region. Players and coaches volunteer for the annual Special Olympics games each spring, and helped with renovations and cleanup in March at Eagle Village, a home for teens, in Hersey, Mich.

Prior to taking the reins of the CMU program, Bonamego, who graduated from Paw Paw High School in southwest Michigan, spent 16 years in the National Football League as an assistant, primarily as a special teams coordinator. His NFL stops:

- Detroit Lions, 2013-14, special teams coordinator. He helped punter Sam Martin record the top-two single-season marks for net punting average in team

history with a 40.4-yard average in 2013 and a 40.1 mark in 2014.

- Jacksonville Jaguars, 2012, special teams coordinator. He was instrumental in the development of rookie punter Bryan Anger, who set franchise records for punting average (47.8) and net punting average (40.8), with both totals leading all rookie punters.
- New Orleans Saints, 2011, assistant special teams coordinator in a year the Saints went 13-3.
- Miami Dolphins, 2008-10, special teams coordinator. Bonamego developed young specialists, including kicker Dan Carpenter, punter Brandon Fields, and kick returner Ted Ginn Jr. Carpenter was selected to the 2009 Pro Bowl after making 25 of 28 field goals. Fields set a franchise record for net punting average (39.9), and Ginn was the first NFL player in 42 years to have two returns for touchdowns in the same quarter. The Dolphins won the 2008 AFC East crown as they put together the biggest turnaround in NFL history, going from 1-15 in 2007 to 11-5 in '08.
- New Orleans Saints, 2006-07, special teams coordinator. Bonamego was part of one of the most important games in NFL history: the first post-Katrina game in the Superdome. The Saints' Steve Gleason blocked a punt vs. Atlanta, and the ball was recovered for a touchdown in the first quarter. New Orleans also blocked a field goal later in that game.
- Green Bay Packers, 2003-05, special teams coordinator. The Packers had four game-winning field goals in 2004, the most by the team since the 1970 NFL-AFL merger.
- Jacksonville Jaguars, 1999-2001, assistant special teams coach. Bonamego worked as the assistant special teams coach under legendary NFL special teams coach Frank Gansz and was promoted to special teams coordinator in 2002.

Bonamego earned his degree in health fitness from CMU in 1987 and turned to coaching immediately. He received an honorary doctorate degree from Central Michigan after serving as the university's commencement speaker in May 2009.

He got his start in college coaching as an assistant at Maine from 1988-91. He went to Lehigh in 1992, and spent five years as an assistant with Army from 1993-98.

Bonamego and his wife, Paulette, have three children, Javier, Giovanni and Bellina.
