SEC TOURNAMENT FORMATS

1977-86

Top two teams from each division earned bids in a double-elimination draw. East No. 1 faced West No. 2 and West No. 1 faced East No. 2 in first round.

1987-92

Top six teams overall earned bids in a double-elmination draw.

1993-95

Each division played its own tournament with all six teams earning bids in a six-team double-elimination draw.

1996-97

Nos. 5-8 squared off in two playin games to earn final two spots in six-team double-elimination draw. The top four seeds were awarded automatic bids.

1998-2011

Top eight teams overall earn bids into two four-team double-elimination draws. First-round match ups include No. 1 vs. No. 8 and No. 4 vs. No. 5 in one group with No. 2 vs. No. 7 and No. 3 vs. No. 6 in the other. There is a championship game between the winner

of each group.

2012

Top 10 teams overall earn bids into the field, with the division winners earning the No. 1-2.

2013-current

Top 12 teams overall earn bids into the field. Seeds 5-12 meet in a single-elimination format on Tuesday, followed by traditional double-elimination play Wednesday-Friday. The tournament will return to single elimination on Saturday.
