In 2018, LHP Zack Thompson became the eighth Kentucky baseball player to wear the Stars and Stripes, playing for the United States Collegiate National Team.

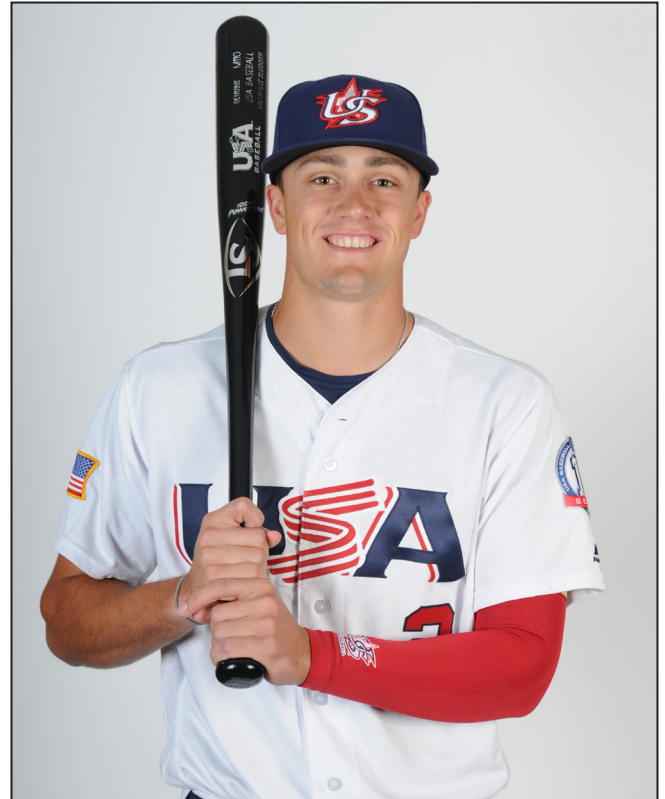
Thompson appeared in three games, going 1-0 with a spotless ERA of 0.00 in 8.2 innings against Chinese Taipei, Japan and Cuba. He allowed just three total hits and the team went 12-3 for the summer.

In 2016, 1B/OF Evan White started 15 of 19 games against international competition as the team's primary first baseman. In 2012, Austin Cousino led the USA in hitting while pacing the club to the bronze medal during Honkbal Week in the Netherlands. He also was on the team in 2013.

In 1996, Chad Green represented the USA in the Olympic Games, and, in 1999, John Wilson traveled throughout the US and Japan as a national team member. Additionally, Tom Deller and Terry Shumpert were part of the program in 1986 and Billy White in 1989. Former UK stars Collin Cowgill and John Shelby also participated in training with Team USA.
