

THIS WEEK

The University of North Dakota men's basketball team wraps up its quick, two-game road swing with a visit to Lexington, Ky. to battle No. 10 Kentucky on Wednesday evening from historic Rupp Arena to open the Ohio River Valley Showcase.

BROADCAST **C**OVERAGE

All UND men's basketball games, home and away, can be heard on stations across the UND Sports Home of Economy Radio Network, as well as through the iHeart Radio app. The flaghsip station for the network is 96.1 FM (The Fox), but games can also be heard on 1440 KKXL AM (The Fan) and 100.3 KSNR FM (Cat Country) in the Grand Forks area. Fans in the Fargo-Moorhead region can tune into the Fighting Hawks on 740 AM (KNFL) and 790 AM (KFGO). **Paul Ralston** will be entering his 10th season on the call for all North Dakota men's basketball games.

In addition, all home men's basketball contests will be televised regionally and nationally for the first time in program history, thanks to the partnerships with Midco Sports Network® (MidcoSN®) and FOX Sports North.

Wednesday's matchup with the Wildcats will be carried live on the SEC Network as Tom Hart and Jon Sundvold have the call from Rupp Arena. You can also stream the contest through the WatchESPN app. If you'd like to listen to the radio, Paul Ralston will have the call on 100.3-FM in Grand Forks and statewide on 790-AM.

The Wildcats are 1-1 on the season, falling to current No. 1 Duke, 118-84, in Indianapolis to open the season before bouncing back with a 71-59 triumph over Southern Illinois on Friday.

UK enters this week with a No. 10 ranking in the AP Poll after beginning the season as high as second.

Keldon Johnson has been the leader for the Wildcats through a pair of tilts so far, leading the team in scoring in both games. The freshman opened his collegiate career with a 23-point night against Duke before following it up with 15 points against Southern Illinois.

Last season, UK finished with a 26-11 mark and 10-8 record during SEC play to advance to the NCAA Tournament where the Wildcats fell to Kansas State in the Sweet 16.

KENTUCKY COACHING STAFF

John Calipari enters his ninth season as head coach of Kentucky and 26th season as a collegiate coach.

Calipari has spent time as the leader for UMass, Memphis, and now Kentucky where he has guided six teams to the Final Four, 46 NBA draft picks, and a national championship.

SERIES **H**ISTORY

Wednesday will the first all-time meeting between North Dakota and Kentucky as well as UND's first meeting against an opponent currently in the SEC.

The Fighting Hawks have played both Missouri and Texas A&M in their history, but neither while they were members of the SEC.

Poll Position

UND is not currently ranked in any polls across the country, but sees a few opponents cracking the rankings.

Kentucky, UND's next opponent, is currently slotted No. 10 in the AP Poll while Marquette, UND's challenge on Dec. 18, enters at No. 24.

While the poll has not been updated since the start of the season, Summit League foe South Dakota State is ranked No. 3 in the CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25.

HELLO! MY NAME IS...

With 11 players on the roster who had never played in a collegiate basketball game entering the season, nine made their debut against Northland College (Nov. 6): Davids Atelbauers, Elijiah Hazekamp, Ethan Igabugo, Marko Coudreau, Aanen Moody, Zac Saddler, Bentiu Panoam, Jal Bijiek, and Carter Brooks all donned the green and white for the first time.

Filip Rebraca was cleared by the NCAA just hours prior to the victory over Milwaukee (Nov. 10) and was made his debut against the Panthers.

Bench Press

In the victory over Northland (Nov. 6), the Fighting Hawks recorded 68 points from their bench. That total is the most in a game since at least the turn of the century.

Also, UND was able to perfectly use its rotation

as everyone played at least 10 minutes while only **Davids Atelbauers** saw more than 20 minutes of action (21).

In the win over Milwaukee (Nov. 10), UND's bench finished with 14 of the team's 63 points, but provided a nice defensive spark with multiple strong rebounding efforts.

KEEPING IT 100

The victory over Northland (Nov. 6) was the fourth time in the Division I era (2008-present) that UND has crossed the 100-point plateau and the first time since 11/20/17 vs. Presentation college. The Hawks are 4-0 when scoring 100+.

The 56-point triumph is also the second largest margin of victory in the DI era.

QUIETING THOSE ROAD BLUES

The victory over Milwaukee (Nov. 10) was the first win over a non-conference opponent in a true road game outside the state of North Dakota since Dec. 5, 2016 at Bradley.

UND has collected back-to-back wins over NDSU in Fargo during that time, but has lost its last nine nonconference road contests outside the Peace Garden State.

BYE BYE, BIG SKY

The 2017-18 season marked the final one as a member of the Big Sky Conference for North Dakota Athletics. The Fighting Hawks finished their six-year run of Big Sky regular-season games with a 58-54 record, including its best showing of 14-4 during its title run in 2016-17. Last season's No. 8 seed in the postseason tournament was the lowest UND had ever carried into the event.

REMEMBERING RENO

While it was only the host for a short few seasons, Reno will have a special place in UND lore as the Fighting Hawks usually saved its best play of the season for "The Little Biggest City in the World."

Despite an exit in the quarterfinals last season, the Fighting Hawks finished with a 6-2 all-time record in games played in Reno, including winning four straight from 2017-2018. In those six victories, UND won by an average of 12.2 points and both of its losses came either in overtime or by less than 10 points.

Reno will most likely be remembered as the site of UND's first Big Sky Conference Tournament title in 2017 when the Fighting Hawks rattled off three wins in a trio of days to claim the title. After a blowout win over No. 8 seed Portland State, the top-seeded Hawks needed a key 3-pointer from Corey Baldwin in the final minute of play to lift UND past No. 4 seed Idaho in the semifinals. Saturday's title matchup with No. 3 seed Weber State turned out to be a classic as the Fighting Hawks battled back from double-digit deficits in both halves to complete the overtime victory and defeat a Wildcat team that had knocked UND out of the postseason tournament in three straight seasons.

Last season, UND pulled out a final piece of magic in the Reno Events Center during the opening round contest against No. 9 seed Montana State as **Marlon Stewart** scored a career-high 29 points to help North Dakota storm back from a 19-point, second half deficit to defeat the Bobcats, 76-74. **Kienan Walter** came off the bench to score 10 points and his five-foot jumper in the paint with seven seconds to play provided the difference for UND.

SWEET NEW SUMMIT

On July 1, the University of North Dakota officially joined The Summit League for all of its varsity sports (except for football and hockey). The Summit League moved its offices from the Chicago suburbs to Sioux Falls this summer and is in its 37th season, starting as the Association of Mid-Continent Universities (AMCU) in 1982 before rebranding as the Mid-Continent Conference in 1989. In 2007, the conference changed its name to The Summit League.

There are nine schools with full membership in The Summit League, including five that are former North Central Conference foes. North Dakota rejoins conference rivalries against North Dakota State, South Dakota, South Dakota State and Omaha, all of whom transitioned to Division I following the dissolving of the NCC. Denver, Western Illinois, Purdue Fort Wayne and Oral Roberts make up the other schools in the conference.

THE ROAD MOST TRAVELED

UND will be traveling plenty up and down Interstate 29 in the coming years as members of The Summit League and the men's basketball program will look to continue its success over the rivals located along that stretch. UND owns winning records against the other four The Summit League teams that are located on I-29: North Dakota State, Omaha, South Dakota and South Dakota State. five games.

You RPI Bro?

Here's a look at how the Big Sky's RPI stacks up against The Summit League's RPI since the 2012-13 season when UND joined its membership. This past season was the only time that the Big Sky held an advantage in the head-to-head comparison, finishing with a 0.4800 rating, while The Summit League was top heavy with a .4765 rating. The Fighting Hawks owned a RPI of 221 last season, which would have been fifth highest in The Summit League. UND was seventh among the 12 Big Sky teams.

A Town Called Sioux (Falls)

Sioux Falls, S.D., has hosted The Summit League Tournament every year since 2008-09. The Denny Sanford PREMIER Center plays host to the three-day, eight-team championships in a neutral-court setting for both the men's and women's tournaments.

UND will look to continue its success in league tournaments under Head Coach **Brian Jones**. Coach Jones has guided his team to six semifinals in the last seven years, appeared in four title games and won three championships (2011 Great West, 2012 Great West and 2017 Big Sky). Jones' overall record in DI conference tournaments is 14-5, including a 9-4 mark during the Big Sky era.

HOW THEY STACK UP

Five current members of the UND roster have seen action against Summit League foes, most often coming against in-state rival North Dakota State. **Conner Avants** has played in a team-high six contests against his new league, averaging 12.5 ppg and 4.3 rpg while **Marlon Stewart** is posting 17.3 ppg in a trio of meetings.

level for the program (2008-09) and the Fighting Hawks are 154-167 in those contests.

10's ALL AROUND

Last season, UND was one of only 21 teams in the country with five players averaging double figures. Each of those five players has started at least 25 of the team's 30 games, but not once have all five of them reached double figures in the same game. In fact, the only two times UND has had five players reach double figures in the same game were the Fighting Hawks only two road wins of the season.

In Aa-nen

Redshirt freshman Aanen Moody made his first game at UND a memorable one, scoring a game-high 20 points on a 6-for-10 shooting night from downtown against Northland (Nov. 6).

CONNER 4 REAL

After going without a double-double in his first two collegiate seasons, senior **Conner Avants** registered a team-leading three last season. Two of those came against Northern Colorado, who he scored 19 points on and pulled down a career-high 12 boards against on Feb. 24. He picked up his second double-double of the season in the home loss to Montana (Feb. 3) just four games after picking up the initial one of his career at UNC (Jan. 20).

In his final five games of the season, Avants finished 32-for-53 from the floor (60.4 percent) and is averaging 15.4 ppg and 8.8 rpg. The junior was forced to miss the final contest of the year vs. No. 1 seed Montana in the Big Sky Conference Tournament Quarterfinals due to an injury.

The senior brought his strong end of last season into 2018-19, scoring nine points and grabbing nine boards in just 12 minutes of action vs. Northland (Nov. 6).

Avants led all UND players with 14 points in the win at Milwaukee (Nov. 10). The senior connect-

ed on 6-of-9 from the field while also grabbing seven rebounds and dishing out two assists.

WALTER'S WORLD

Junior **Kienan Walter** ended last season on a high note as the forward hit the game-winner vs. Montana State in the opening round of the Big Sky Conference Tournament and averaged 7.4 ppg in UND's last five contests. Walter went 4-for-4 from the field vs. the Bobcats and scored 10 points off the bench. UND is 4-0 all-time when he reaches double figures against Big Sky foes. The junior will get two looks at old conference mates Montana State (Nov. 27) and Idaho (Dec. 1) this season.

The Vancouver, Wash., native reached double figures with 10 points on a 3-for-6 shooting effort from the field. He matched Avants with seven rebounds to finish second on the team while also finishing with a trio of blocks.

BILLY BILLY!

Junior **Billy Brown** had not reached double figures in UND's first 27 games last season, but the sophomore finished with a pair of double-figure scoring games in the last six outings. In the victory at Sacramento State, Brown scored a career-high 12 points in a career-high 33 minutes. He hit a trio of 3-pointers for the second time in 2017-18 as well.

Brown made his first-career start in the win over Northland (Nov. 6), scoring two points in 15 minutes.

80 = Win (Most of the Time)

80 has proven to be the magic number for the Fighting Hawks over the last three seasons.

The Fighting Hawks own a 25-4 record in those contests and their first two losses were against ranked opponents (100-82 vs. Arizona; NCAA Tournament and 89-83 OT loss at Gonzaga).

Last year, the Fighting Hawks were 8-3 when scoring 80-plus with all three of those losses coming in overtime.

STARLON MARLON

After his career-high 29-point outburst in thhe opening round win over Montana State, junior **Marlon Stewart** finished third on the team in scoring at 11.7 ppg and had five 20-point plus scoring games last season.

He dropped in a career-high 24 points against Utah Valley (Nov. 25) and reached double figures 15 times last year. He twice went for 20 or more against in-state rival NDSU during the home-and-home series with the Bison, scoring a team-high 23 in the home loss and 20 in the road win. He was also second on the team in assists (95; 3.0/g) and steals (42; 1.3/g). He enters the season as the top-returning scorer for the Fighting Hawks.

THE GANG'S ALL HERE

For the first time since leading North Scott to the 2015 Iowa Class 4A State Championship, senior **Cortez Seales** and redshirt junior **Marlon Stewart** were on the floor again as teammates last season.

Stewart played his first collegiate season at Creighton (2015-16), then sat out at UND (2016-17) due to NCAA transfer rules. The duo earned Class 4A First-Team All-State honors after averaging 17.4 and 17.0 ppg, respectively.

BALLIN' JAL

Incoming freshman **Jal Bijiek** comes to North Dakota after signing his National Letter of Intent last November to announce his decision to attend UND. He leads a strong freshman class that hopes to replace the losses of starters **Dale Jones** and **Geno Crandall**.

Bijiek averaged 15.2 ppg as a senior at Des Moines North en route to collection Iowa Class 4A All-State third-team honors. He led Iowa's highest classification in blocks with 82 and helped the Polar Bears to their first state tournament appearance in 26 years.

Equipped with a 7-foot-1 wingspan, Bijiek also garnered All-Central Iowa Metro League second-team accolades.

Bijiek made his debut vs. Northland (Nov. 6), scoring eight points, grabbing three boards, and pair of blocks.

LATVIAN FLAVOR

Incoming freshman **Davids Atelbauers** is a 6-foot-1 combo guard that has played for the Latvia Youth National Team and led that squad in scoring three different seasons. A native of Ogre, Latvia, Atelbauers was a five-time Latvian Youth Basketball League All-Star and has played several seasons for BK Ogre.

Atelbauers became the first freshman in the DI era to start at point guard on opening night for UND, logging a game-high 21 minutes, dishing out five assists, and scoring two points in the win over Northland (Nov. 6).

REBRICA REBRACA

A native of Sombor, Serbia, incoming freshman **Filip Rebraca** spent this past season at Williston Northampton School in Easthampton, Mass., where he was named the Dale Lash Team MVP (Easthampton, Mass.) and earned Class A All-NEPSAC accolades. The 6-foot-9 center is the son of Zeljko Rebraca, who played for three teams in the National Basketball Association from 2001-06.

After being cleared by the NCAA less than 24 hours prior to the team's contest at Milwaukee (Nov. 10), Rebraca tallied a teamhigh eight rebounds and added four points off the bench in his debut.

SADDLING SADDLER

JUCO-forward **Zac Saddler** will strengthen UND's frontcourt in 2018-19, joining the Fighting Hawks after spending last season at Western Texas College where he started 21 of 28 contests and averaged 7.8 ppg for the Westerners. He reached double figures in nearly half of those contests, scoring a season-high 14 against South Plains College.

Saddler, who will have three seasons of immediate eligibility, also had five double-dou-

bles during his lone JUCO-campaign. A New Braunfels, Texas native, Saddler spent the 2016-17 at the University of Milwaukee where he redshirted for the Panthers. The 6-foot-7 forward signed with the Horizon League program after a distinguished prep career at New Braunfels High School where he was a two-time, all-district first team honoree for the Unicorns.

Saddler averaged 14.1 ppg and 7.8 rpg, while knocking down 44.9 percent of his shots as a senior and averaged 20.4 ppg and 6.2 rpg as a junior. He finished his prep career with more than 1,000 points and graduated as New Braunfels career leader in blocks and rebounds.

While he didn't hit a shot from a field, Saddler hit all four of his shots from the charity stripe as well as grabbing five boards against Northland (Nov. 6).

Marko! Polo!

Incoming freshman **Marko Coudreau** will become the first French citizen to don the green and white for UND as the Marseille native is set to join North Dakota for the upcoming season.

Coudreau has appeared in 25 international games for his country, including playing for French's Under 16 National squad in the 2016 European Championship. He played for the U-18 team at the event this Summer.

He played for CFBB Paris from 2015-18 and trained at the National Institute of Sport (IN-SEP), which is located just outside of Paris. INSEP has produced a handful of notable NBA players, including Tony Parker of the San Antonio Spurs.

Coudreau recorded three points, four rebounds, three assists, and two steals in his debut vs. Northland (Nov. 6).

An Anchoarage, Alaska native, **Bentiu Panoam** graduated from Bartlett High School in 2016 and spent one season in the prep school ranks at Impact Basketball Academy in Las Vegas before moving onto the junior college ranks for the 2017-18 season.

During his time at Bartlett, Panoam, who checks in at 6-foot-2 and 160 pounds, earned Class 4A All-State honors as a junior (second team) and senior (first team). As a senior, he was also named to the American Family Insurance All-USA Alaska Boys Basketball Team and the Cook Inlet Conference Player of the Year after averaging 20.7 ppg to go with 6.4 rpg and 4.2 apg.

In his only season at Northwest Kansas Tech, Panoam averaged 10.7 ppg and 3.7 apg in 29 starts, while shooting 46.2 percent from beyond the arc. He saved his best scoring game of the season for his finale, dropping 25 against Independence Community College College.

Panoam will have three seasons of eligiblity to play for the Fighting Hawks beginning this season.

HOLY SCHMIDT

Incoming freshman **Lucas Schmidt** enters the 2018-19 season after being a four-year varsity player, earning All-Monterey Bay League honors as a sophomore (second), junior (first) and senior (first) at Monte Vista Christian High School. He was also named the MBL's Gabilan Division Freshman of the Year as well following the 2014-15 season.

In his final prep season, Schmidt averaged 11.3 ppg and 11.7 rpg, while blocking 70 shots. As a junior, he averaged 13.5 ppg and 12.6 rpg. Schmidt was also starting pitcher for the Mustangs' baseball team the past two seasons.

IN A HAZEKAMP

The final freshman to begin with the Fighting Hawks this season is **Elijah Hazekamp**, a 6-foot-6 forward that prepped at Bishop Heelan High School in Sioux City, lowa.

The Sioux City, lowa, native wrapped up his prep career by being named the Sioux City Journal Player of the Year and earning Class 3A first team all-state accolades for the second consecutive season. He averaged 21.5 ppg and 13.0 rpg during his senior season, recorded 19 double-doubles and made 45 percent of his 3-point attempts (46-102). Hazekamp finished his four-year varsity run with career averages of 16.3 ppg and 10.9 rpg.

It was a strong debut for Hazekamp, scoring 14 points on 4-of-7 shooting and finishing with eight rebounds, including four on the offensive glass.

The 2016-17 Big Sky Coach of the Year led the Fighting Hawks to their first league regular season and tournament titles, which resulted in the program's first NCAA Tournament appearance.

UND has reached DI postseason play in six of its 10 seasons at that level and Jones has amassed 16 wins in conference and postseason tournaments during his tenure. UND's 22 wins in 2016-17 were also a DI-program record and were the most wins by a UND team since 1999-2000.
