▶ TSU fell to 2-3 on the season with a close 80-77 loss to CSUN on Tuesday night. Down by ten at the half, the Matadors increased its lead by as much as 20 in the second. Despite a jolt of energy and some hot shooting by the Tigers late in the game, TSU could not overcome CSUN's work in the paint, finishing with 34.

TENNESSEE STATE NEWS AND NOTES ►►

LAST TIME OUT

▶ Big Blue travelled to Northridge, Calif., a suburb outside of Los Angeles, to take on CSUN. The Tigers fell to the Matadors 80-77.

A late second half push, closed the 20-point gap CSUN had created early after leading at the intermission by 10.

The defensive efforts by the Tigers pushed them to register 10 steals on the night.

► More than half of Big Blue's points were off the bench, 39, led by redshirt junior guard Tripp Davis of Nashville, Tenn with 20.

Three Tigers posted double-digits: Kamar McKnight 13, Donte Fitzpatrick 11 and Tripp Davis (20).

TRIPPING

▶ Nashville, Tenn. native, Tripp Davis is having a breakout year, averaging 11.2 points per game.

▶ Prior to this season, the guard had yet to break 20 points for a season, and in the game versus Fisk, Davis scored a career and game-high 24 points. He also led the Tigers versus CSUN with 20.

LONG RANGE SHOOTING

- Eight different Tigers have made three pointers so far this season.
- ▶ JUCO transfer Michael Littlejohn leads TSU with eleven made three pointers.

The Tigers are averaging 32.5 attempts from three-point range per game through four games and are shooting 38.0 percent from distance.

▶ In this season's Battle of Jefferson Street versus Fisk, the Tigers hit 19-of-39, averaging .487 from beyond the arc.

WINS IN A THREE-YEAR SPAN

▶ TSU has won 53 games over the last three seasons.

▶ TSU's Division I record for wins in a three-year span is 56 set 1978-81.

Since joining the Ohio Valley Conference prior to the 1987-88 season, the most wins in a three-year span came 1992-95 when the Tigers posted 55 victories.

STAYING LOCAL

▶ The roster contains five players from Tennessee - Donte Fitzpatrick Dorsey (Memphis), Tripp Davis (Nashville), Demarcus Mitchell (Memphis), Jy'lan Washington (Smyrna) and Jalen Duke (Nashville).

ABOUT THE TIGERS

▶ TSU brings back six letterwinners from a year ago including starting point guard Armani

Chaney, who averaged 7.8 points, 3.7 assists and 3.1 rebounds per game last season.

▶ Chaney and the leading scorer among TSU's returners, guard Kamar McKnight (8.5 ppg), will form an experienced backcourt for the Tigers.

► Collins will work to blend a talented group of newcomers with the returners, including four players who redshirted in 2017-18.

ON THE COURT AFTER SITTING OUT

▶ Four players on TSU's roster redshirted last season and are getting a chance to play this season.

TSU's second leading scorer, Donte Fitzpatrick-Dorsey, sat out last season after transferring from Ole Miss.

▶ The three others who sat out last year are DaJion Henderson (injury), Dave Morris (redshirt) and Demarcus Mitchell (redshirt).

CHANEY READY TO LEAD

▶ TSU's most experienced player is senior point guard Armani Chaney.

▶ The 5'10" Chicago native is one of just four returners in the Ohio Valley Conference who averaged 3.5 assists or more per game last season.

- Chaney dished out 111 assists (3.7 per game) a year ago.
- ▶ In the season opener at Lipscomb, Chaney guided the TSU offense with five assists, and repeat at CSUN. He's averaging 2.0 assists per game this season.

BUZZ

- ▶ TSU men's basketball has been gaining interest at the local and national levels.
- ► A four-person dunk sequence featuring a passes from Tripp Davis, Donte Fitzpatrick-Dorsey, Kamar McKnight and Emmanuel Egbuta on photo day gained more than two million views on twitter and instagram.
- ▶ A dunk from Egbuta in the Oct. 31 exhibition game was also picked up by SportsCenter's snapchat.
- ▶ At TSU's Big Blue Madness, Head Coach Brian "Penny" Collins dunked twice, including a windmill, creating a buzz on social media.




