#### **QUICK NOTES**

- Kentucky is in its 45th season with a 820-537 (.604) all-time record.
- The Wildcats have had great success in Memorial Coliseum, sitting at 452-158 (.740) overall in the historic building, including a 161-29 (.847) mark under head coach Matthew Mitchell.
- UK has won 22 games this season marking the ninth time in Matthew Mitchell's 12-year tenure that the Wildcats have won 20+ games. Prior to Mitchell's tenure, UK had 10 20-win seasons in 33 years of varsity basketball.
- UK's five-game SEC win streak is the best active streak in the league.
- UK is 15-0 this year when shooting a higher percentage from the field than its opponent and 5-0 when they shoot 50% or higher.
- Kentucky won the 2018 Paradise Jam Island Division with a 3-0 record and wins over then-No. 17 South Florida, (rv) UCLA and UNC.
- UK has been impressive from long range this season, averaging 7.5 3-pointers per game. Currently, UK has hit 202 3s this season which ranks third most in program history. The Wildcats need 38 more 3s this season to tie the program record and are on pace to break it.
- Kentucky has forced 588 turnovers this season averaging 21.8 turnovers forced per game and have scored 618 points off those miscues. The Cats +8.3 turnover margin is fifth in the nation. UK also ranks 13th in the nation and second in the SEC with 292 steals.
- Three Wildcats are averaging 12 points or more per game this season including freshman guard Rhyne Howard who is averaging 16.8 points per game with a team-best 6.8 rebounds per game. Senior guard Maci Morris is averaging 15.8 points per game with a teambest 65 3-pointers, while fellow senior Taylor Murray is averaging 12.7 points per game and leads UK in assists and steals.
- In 45 years, Kentucky has 92 wins over ranked opponents, including 51 of those wins coming under Mitchell.
- Matthew Mitchell became UK WBB's all-time winningest head coach in March of 2013 and now has 278 career wins at UK. Including the storied history of the UK MBB program, he is the fifth Kentucky Basketball head coach to win 250 games with the Wildcats joining Adolph Rupp, Joe B Hall, Tubby Smith and John Calipari.

#### TAYLOR MURRAY $\cdot$ 5-6 $\cdot$ SENIOR $\cdot$ GUARD $\cdot$ ODENTON, MD.

- Top 10 semifinalist for Naismith National Defensive Player of the Year ranking top 10 nationally and first in the SEC in steals with 86.
- Has 1,292 career points ranking 20th most in program history while her 424 career assists ranks 7th most and 270 career steals ranks 6th most.
- Paradise Jam All-Tournament Team, National Player of the Week by College Sports Madness (11/26) and SEC Player of the Week (11/27).



#### MACI MORRIS · 6-0 · SENIOR · GUARD · BELL COUNTY, KY.

- Leads SEC and ranks 15th nationally in 3PFG% while her 65 makes rank fourth in the SEC. She has hit at least one 3 in 104 of 123 career games.
- Has 1,620 career points which ranks 6th most all-time in school history. She needs 170 more points to tie Makayla Epps for 5th all-time.
- Has hit 242 career 3s which ranks second most in program history and currently sits first in 3-point FG percentage in program history at .409.



#### RHYNE HOWARD - FRESHMAN - GUARD - CLEVELAND. TENN.

- Scored game-high 23 points at Alabama going 9-of-14 from the field with four 3s. Has hit 5+ 3s in five games this season and 4+ in seven games.
- Game-winning jumper and steal vs. Arkansas with 1.3 left scoring 18 points with 14 rebounds. Has scored 15+ points in 21 games and 20+ in 8 games.
- Most 3s by a freshman in school history. Third-most points by a rookie with 438. League record holder with 7 SEC Freshman of the Week honors.



#### KEKE MCKINNEY · 6-1 · SOPHOMORE · FORWARD · KNOXVILLE. TENN.

- Scored 9 points with seven rebounds at Texas A&M. Has five or more rebounds in five of her last seven games, including 10 boards vs. S. Carolina.
- Scored six points with five rebounds, three steals and three assists at LSU. Scored the final four points of the game, including game-winning 3.
- Career game against Middle Tennessee with a career-best 13 points and five blocks. Leads UK this season with 27 blocks.



#### TATYANA WYATT · 6-2 · SOPHOMORE · FORWARD · COLUMBUS. GA.

- Great game against Missouri scoring 11 points with six rebounds, hitting a big 3-pointer in the 4th quarter. Eight+ points in 3 of last 6 games.
- Scored 10 points against Alabama going 4-of-9 from the field with two rebounds and two steals.
- Scored nine points at highly ranked Mississippi State in 21 minutes of action. Had nine points with three rebounds in just 15 minutes at LSU.



#### LASHAE HALSEL $\cdot$ 6-0 $\cdot$ SENIOR $\cdot$ FORWARD $\cdot$ BOWLING GREEN, KY.

- Impressed the coaches during open tryouts and received a walk-on spot in the fall of 2016 and was given a scholarship in the summer of 2018.
  - Played in 10 games during the 2017-18 season scoring in four games with a rebound in three games.
- Has played in 26 career games during her time with Kentucky scoring 12 career points.



#### SABRINA HAINES · 5-10 · RS-JUNIOR · GUARD · PHOENIX, ARIZ.

- Electric guard that will be a scoring threat when she returns to the court after sitting out the 2018-19 season due to NCAA transfer rules.
- Transferred to Kentucky from Arizona State in June of 2018 and spent the summer working out with the team as she returns from a knee injury. Played in 75 career games with 38 starts at Arizona State before her third season was cut short after only nine games due to injury.



#### PAIGE POFFENBERGER · 5-8 · SENIOR · GUARD · MORGANTOWN, W.VA.

- Medically retired from the game of basketball prior to the start of the 2018-19 season but is still in the program and with the team.
- Joined the program as a walk-on in the fall of 2016 and immediately impressed the coaching staff with her hard-nosed style of play.
- Played in 35 career games the last two seasons, averaging 5.6 minutes per game and scoring 32 total points.



#### BLAIR GREEN · 6-0 · FRESHMAN · GUARD · HARLAN COUNTY. KY.

- Was a perfect 5-of-5 from the field and 2-of-2 from long range at Auburn scoring 12 points with three rebounds, a block and an assist.
- Played a season-high 33 minutes against Florida scoring eight points with five rebounds and two steals playing at the top of UK's press.
- Scored 13 points in the season opener, which was tied for the seventh most points by a UK player in their varsity debut in program history.



#### AMANDA PASCHAL · 5-7 · RS-JUNIOR · GUARD · BROOKLYN. N.Y.

- Played 27 minutes against Florida recording a career-high nine rebounds with six points and one steal.
- Scored three points hitting a 3 to start the game at LSU with four rebounds, four assists and two steals in a career-high 36 minutes.
- Had a great game against HPU with six points, three rebounds, three assists and a steal.



#### CHASITY PATTERSON $\cdot$ 5-6 $\cdot$ SOPHOMORE $\cdot$ GUARD $\cdot$ HOUSTON, TEXAS

- Mid-year transfer from Texas who will have to sit out the 2018-19 season but be eligible following the fall semester of 2019.
- The top ranked point guard in the class of 2017 according to ESPN.com and the Big 12 Preseason Freshman of the Year last season at Texas.
- Incredible high school career at North Shore High School in Houston where she finished as the school's all-time leading scorer with 3,177 points.



#### DORIE HARRISON $\cdot$ 6-3 $\cdot$ SOPHOMORE $\cdot$ CENTER $\cdot$ NASHVILLE, TENN.

- Is out indefinitely for personal health reasons with no timetable on her return.
- Played in 32 games with eight starts last season averaging 6.7 points and 3.8 rebounds per game. Had 10 or more points in eight games.
- Was named the SEC Freshman of the Week once last season after 15 points, five rebounds vs. Alabama and 16 points, four boards vs. Arkansas.



#### OGECHI ANYAGALIGBO · 6-1 · RS-JUNIOR · FORWARD · MIAMI. FLA.

Career night against Tennessee with 13 points on 6-of-7 shooting with three rebounds and one steal in 24 minutes. Miss UF and AU due to illness.

Had six points, three rebounds and an assist going 3-of-4 from the field against Southern and a UK career-best 10 rebounds against Murray State.

Six points on 3-of-3 shooting against USF adding three rebounds in 22 minutes of action. Missed time after game due to ankle injury.



#### KAMERON ROACH · 5-6 · SOPHOMORE · GUARD · HOPKINS. S.C.

- Played six minutes in the season opener with four points and four rebounds adding an assist and three steals.
- Played in 15 games last season as a freshman averaging 7.3 minutes per game.
- Saw a season-high 16 minutes against Sacramento State with three assists, one steal and six points going 4-of-4 from the charity stripe.



#### JAIDA ROPER · 5-6 · JUNIOR · GUARD · MEMPHIS. TENN.

- Played 27 minutes at Tennessee and scored 10 points with three assists hitting a huge 3-pointer with under a minute to go to seal the UK win.
- Spark plug for UK against USF with 13 points, three rebounds and two 3s, while she went 3-of-4 from long range against UCLA with nine points. Scored a career-high 15 points on 5-of-8 shooting against Murray State adding six assists. Career-best seven assists against WCU.



#### NAE NAE COLE $\cdot$ 6-3 $\cdot$ RS-JUNIOR $\cdot$ CENTER $\cdot$ GAINESVILLE, VA.

- Transferred after three years at NC State in May 2018 and spent the summer impressing the coaching staff with her work ethic.
- Strong, physical post player that will help give the Wildcats depth in practice as she sits out the 2018-19 year due to NCAA transfer rules.
- Played in 61 career games for the Wolfpack from 2015 to 2018 averaging 7.0 minutes per game during her career.

#### **GAME NOTES**

#### SERIES HISTORY VS. LSU

- LSU leads the all-time series in games played against Kentucky, 33-16, including a 12-7 mark
  in games played in Lexington. UK has won four of the last five games in the series. Last year,
  LSU took down UK 72-70 inside Rupp Arena but earlier this season UK won at LSU, 64-60.
  The Wildcats played without Taylor Murray and Rhyne Howard in the game.
- The home team had won seven straight in the series but the road team has won each of the last three meetings.

#### SENIOR DAY HISTORY AT UK

- Sunday's game against LSU will be UK's annual Senior Day game as the program honors seniors Paige Poffenberger, LaShae Halsel, Maci Morris and Taylor Murray for their hard work and dedication to the program.
- Kentucky is 32-11 all-time in regular-season home finales (1974-75 season not included). The
  Cats have won 12 of their last 15 games on "Senior Day."

#### WILDCATS GETS HUGE ROAD WIN AT NO. 13 SOUTH CAROLINA

- For the first time since 2012, the Wildcats earned a key road win at South Carolina, defeating the Gamecocks 65-57 on Thursday. UK trailed 43-40 heading into the fourth quarter and outscored USC 25-14 to get the win. Rhyne Howard and Taylor Murray each had 17 points with Howard hitting two 3s and getting three steals while Murray had eight rebounds, five assists and four steals.
- In the second quarter, with UK leading by one, Howard went on an 8-0 run all by herself to push the Cats' lead to nine with 4:21 to go. UK held on to a six-point lead at the half, 30-24, as Howard led all scorers with 10. The 24 points by South Carolina were the fewest points scored in either half this season. UK held the Gamecocks to a season low 57 points.
- The Cats hit 13-of-14 free throws in the game (92.9 percent), their highest percentage of the season.

#### HOWARD'S GAME-WINNING SHOT, STEAL LIFT CATS PAST ARKANSAS

- After hitting 52% from the field against Auburn and 46% against Alabama, Kentucky struggled from the field against Arkansas hitting just 34% but freshman Rhyne Howard connected on a jumper with 1.3 seconds left and grabbed a steal on Arkansas ensuing possession to power the Wildcats to a 61-59 victory last Sunday in Memorial. The win clinched a .500 finish or better for Kentucky in the league for the 10th time under Coach Mitchell.
- Howard ended the game with 18 points and 14 rebounds for her fifth double-double of the season. She led Kentucky in points, steals, rebounds, assists and blocks.

#### TWO WINS ON ROAD TRIP TO AUBURN, ALABAMA

- The Wildcats shot 51.9% against Auburn, including 11-of-20 from 3, and followed that with 46.4% against Alabama with eight 3s.UK hit its first eight 3 attempts vs. Auburn and has now hit 10 or more 3s in seven games this season. UK is 6-0 when it shoots 50 percent or better from the field and 14-0 this season when it shoots a higher percentage than its opponent.
- After a 6-0 run by Auburn at the end of the first quarter and start of the second quarter, UK answered with a 14-0 run to take a 36-20 lead with 5:22 left in the half and force an Auburn timeout. UK's 42 first-half points were the most in the first half of an SEC game this season.

#### CATS REBOUND VS. FLORIDA

- After two straight losses, Kentucky got back in the win column against Florida, earning a
  62-51 victory in Rupp Arena. The Wildcats got 16 points from Rhyne Howard and 13 from
  Taylor Murray in the win. UK forced UF into 24 turnovers and scored 31 points off those miscues while only shooting 31.7 percent from the field.
- The Cats also won the rebounding battle against Florida and had a 16-8 edge in 2nd-chance points. After being outrebounded in five straight games to start league play including by 24 at MSU and 18 at UT Kentucky has won the boards four of the last seven games. UK has also earned a 88-64 edge in second-chance points in the last seven games.

#### MURRAY LEADS COMEBACK WIN VS. MIZZOU

- Kentucky scored a season-low 18 first-half points against Missouri but stayed positive at
  halftime and scored 18 points in the third quarter including 12 from Taylor Murray to take
  control of the game and earn its third top-25 win of the season.
- UK went 7-of-25 from the field in the first half but responded in the second half by going 12-for-29. UK really excelled in the specialty stats in the second half. After 10 points in the



- paint, 6 points off turnovers and 6 second-chance points in the first half, UK had 16 points in the paint, 15 points off turnovers and 11 second-chance points in the second half.
- Murray was the catalyst for Kentucky, scoring the first six points of the second half to give UK its first lead of the game, which it would not relinquish.

#### INJURY BUG HITS WILDCATS VS. OLE MISS, LSU

- Riding high off its win at Tennessee, UK found out how hard life is in the SEC with its first
  home loss of the season to Ole Miss 55-49. Mitchell made no excuses postgame only crediting Ole Miss, however, the Wildcats were short handed with Morris not playing due to knee
  pain and Murray not starting and not playing full strength.
- The UK offense struggled to score posting a season-low 49 points on a season-low 26% from the field. UK entered the game averaging 79.1 ppg and hitting 43.7% from the field.
- The Wildcats then played without Rhyne Howard and Taylor Murray (averaging a combined 29.2 points per game) against LSU due to injury. Morris was a game-time decision and played 35 minutes scoring a game-high 20 points with five rebounds and three steals. Jaida Roper scored 10 points and Blair Green and Tatyana Wyatt each scored nine but sophomore KeKe McKinney scored the final four points of the game, including a big corner 3 with :20 left to seal the UK win.

#### **OVERALL TEAM WIN IN KNOXVILLE VS. NO. 13 TENNESSEE**

- It was an overall team win for the Wildcats over No. 13 Tennessee earning the program's
  fourth ever win in Knoxville against the Lady Vols. With Murray only playing 16 minutes due
  to injury, Howard playing 14 minutes due to foul trouble and Morris fouling out with five
  minutes left it was UK's bench that scored 29 points and secured the win.
- Kentucky led by 17 points in the first quarter before Morris and Howard missed most of the
  first half with two fouls and Murray got injured and did not return. The Lady Vols would
  mount a furious comeback, cutting the lead to two with just over a minute to go before Jaida
  Roper hit a clutch 3 with:55 left to all but seal the UK win.
- Roper finished with 10 points, three assists and one steal while fellow junior Ogechi
  Anyagaligbo came off the bench and scored a UK-career best 13 points on 6-of-7 shooting
  with three rebounds. Before she fouled out, Morris was fantastic scoring 27 points on 10-of16 shooting including four 3s. She added three rebounds and three steals.

#### **'LAST YEAR, BEST YEAR' FOR MORRIS**

- Maci Morris is having a great senior season averaging 15.8 points per game while hitting a
  team-best tying 65 3s. The guard has scored in double figures in 22 games, including eight
  games of 20 or more. Morris' best game came at Tennessee where she played 31 minutes
  before fouling out and scored 27 points with four 3s, three rebounds and three steals.
- Morris scored 25 first-half points against Morehead St. which is the most in the first half by any UK player since at least 1982-83 (prior halftime statistics are incomplete before that).
- Morris ranks 5th in the league in FG attempts, 11th in FG made, 9th in points, 10th in points per game, 3rd in 3s made, 3rd in 3s made per game and 1st in 3PFG percentage.
- Morris missed Kentucky's game vs. Ole Miss due to knee pain. It was only the second game
  of her career that she has not played in with the other being at Vanderbilt on Jan. 15, 2018.

#### **MORRIS IN THE CAREER RANKINGS**

- Morris has 1,620 career points to rank 6th all-time. She needs 170 more points to tie Makayla Epps (2003-17) for 5th all-time.
- Morris ranks second with 242 career 3s made. She needs 29 more to tie Sara Potts for first.
- Morris has a career 3-point field-goal percentage of 40.9% which is first in program history.
- Morris has a career free-throw percentage of 85.1% which is second in program history.

#### MORRIS NAMED ON TWO WATCH LISTS

• Maci Morris has been named one of 10 players to the 2019 Ann Meyers Drysdale Award Watch List and one of 30 players to the Citizen Naismith Trophy Watch list.

#### **MURRAY SHINNING IN FINAL SEASON**

- Taylor Murray started her senior season with 14 straight double-figure scoring games. The
  native of Odenton, Md., has been great for UK averaging 12.7 points per game while leading
  UK with 97 assists and 86 steals. Murray is hitting 47.6 percent from the field and is averaging 3.5 rebounds per game.
- Murray's best outing this season came against UNC when she posted 23 points with 10 assists, seven steals and six rebounds. She also shined against Missouri with 21 points 19 in the second half with four steals and four rebounds. Against SC, she scored a game-high

- The guard has 424 career assists which ranks seventh all-time at UK. She needs 1 more to tie Amber Smith for 7th all-time at 425.
- Murray is a career 83.3% shooter from the FT line, which ranks 3rd best in program history.
- In just 19 games played this season, Murray had more steals in 2018-19 than she had in 32 games played last season (67). The strong defensive performance by Murray has moved her up the career steal lists, sitting 6th all-time in program history with 270 career takeaways.  Taylor Murray has been tabbed one of 10 semifinalists to the Naismith Women's Defensive Player of the Year Award.

#### **MORRIS, MURRAY PRESEASON ALL-SEC**

- Morris and Murray have been recognized by league coaches as two of the top performers in the SEC this preseason as both have been named to the 2018-19 Preseason All-SEC Team.
- Morris was tabbed to the first team after being named to the second team following last season. Murray earned second-team honors for the second straight year after being on the SEC All-Defensive team last season. The Wildcats were picked to finish seventh in the league.

#### HOWARD TIES SEC RECORD FOR FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK HONORS

- Rhyne Howard has been named SEC Freshman of the Week seven times this season, setting the program and league record for most rookie of the week awards. The SEC honors came on Nov. 13, 27, Dec. 11, 23, Jan. 8, Feb. 12 and 19. She was named National Freshman of the Week on Dec. 26 by USBWA, the first player in program history to accomplish that feat.
- Howard is the first UK freshman in the Mitchell era to score at least 10 points in each of her
  first 10 games. She ranks 1st on the team in ppg with 16.8 and leads in rebounds with 6.8,
  while she sits tied for first in 3s with 65 and 2nd in steals with 59. She has scored in double
  figures in 22 games and has five double-doubles. She has scored 20+ points in eight games.
- Howard ranks high in the league sitting 6th in FGs made, 10th in FG%, 5th in points, 5th in points per game, 3rd in steals, 4rd in 3s, 3rd in 3s per game and 3rd in 3-point percentage.
- Howard missed the LSU game in concussion protocol but returned vs. Missouri and played great against Texas A&M with 21 points, hitting five 3s with eight rebounds and four steals.
- She has a three-game stretch of scoring 17+ with 19 points and five 3s against Auburn before 23 points and four 3s vs. Alabama. She had 18 points and 14 rebounds against Arkansas, hitting the game-winning shot with 1.3 second left and then getting a steal to seal the win. Against South Carolina, she had 17 points with four rebounds an three steals.
- Howard is all over nearly every UK freshman single-season record, sitting third in points, second in ppg, fourth in rebounds per game, first in 3s, second in 3PFG%, fourth in steals, fifth in double-figure scoring games and fifth in double-figure rebounding games. More on pg 13.

#### **SOPHOMORE CLASS KEY TO SUCCESS**

- Kentucky's group of sophomores are going to be key to the success of the 2018-19 season as
  they all look to improve on strong rookie campaigns. With Harrison out indefinitely, more of
  the focus will be on posts KeKe McKinney and Tatyana Wyatt. McKinney played in 30 games
  with 17 starts last season averaging 4.7 points and 3.7 rebounds per game, while Wyatt
  played in 24 games with four starts averaging 6.6 points and 3.5 rebounds per game.
- So far this season, both players have played well with McKinney averaging 5.2 rebounds per and 4.8 points per game while Wyatt is averaging 3.6 rebounds and 5.8 points per game.
- McKinney hit a huge 3 with :20 to go vs. LSU and hit a free throw to seal the UK win.

#### ROPER, GREEN GIVING UK KEY MINUTES OFF BENCH

• Kentucky owns a 505-312 edge in bench points this season and most of that can be attributed to the play of junior guard Jaida Roper and freshman guard Blair Green. Both players have performed well this season with Roper averaging 7.2 points per game with 22 3s, 64 assists and 19 steals. Green started slow but has really been shooting well as of late, averaging 6.0 points and 2.2 rebounds per game. Green is hitting 50% from the field in SEC play.

#### **DEFENSE POWERING CATS**

- The Kentucky defense has been strong, allowing just 58.0 points per game. UK allowed 176 total points in the first four games of the season, which was its fewest since 1974-1975 (147).
- Kentucky limited four straight opponents to 51 points or less for the first time in the Matthew Mitchell Era to start the season. UK hasn't accomplished the feat since limiting seven straight opponents to 51 points or less during the 2006-07.
- In 108 quarters of play this season, UK has limited its opponent to 10 points or less in 25 quarters and 12 points or less in 37 quarters. Meanwhile, UK has scored 20 points or more in 45 quarters, including a season-best 29 in the 3rd quarter vs. URI and 2nd quarter vs. WCU. UofL scored 31 points in the third quarter, which is the most UK has allowed this season.
- UK has limited three straight SEC foes to 59 points or less for the first time since 2013-14.

#### **TURNOVERS TELL THE TALE**

- In 27 games, Kentucky has forced 588 turnovers and scored 618 points off turnovers.
- UK scored 41 points off 29 Southern turnovers and had 51 points off 43 Alabama State turnovers. Against Virginia, UK forced 32 turnovers and scored 32 points off turnovers. Against UNC, UK forced 27 turnovers and forced 34 points off those miscues. The Wildcats forced URI into 30 turnovers and scored 21 points. UK forced Miss. State into a season-high 24 turnovers and scored 28 points off those Bulldog miscues. UK had 20 points off 24 Bama miscues. UK forced South Carolina into a SEC-game high 21 turnovers.

#### YOU GET AN ASSIST AND YOU GET AN ASSIST ...

- Kentucky recorded 22 assists in each of its first two games to start the season. It was the first time Kentucky has started a season with back-to-back 20+ assists games since 2012-13.
- UK has 10+ assists in every game but two this season, including a season-high 27 assists against WCU. UK ranks 2nd in the SEC in assist-turnover ratio and 4th in assists.

#### **CATS LIGHT IT UP FROM LONG RANGE**

- After hitting 10 3-pointers vs. Alabama State and 13 treys vs. Southern, UK had 10 or more 3s in back-to-back games for the first time since Nov. 25 and 28 of 2012. That 2012-13 team went on to set the program record for most 3s in a season with 240.
- The 13 3s made vs. SU tied for the second most 3s made in a game in program history and the first time UK has accomplished that feat since hitting 14 against Mississippi St. in 2012.
- Kentucky has hit nine or more 3s in nine games this season. After 27 games, UK is averaging
  7.5 3s per game which ranks third in the league while their 202 total 3s made ranks third in
  the league. The 37.8% ranks 11th nationally and first in the SEC.
- If the high percentage keeps up, UK is on pace to break the school record for 3s made in a season (240). Each of the top 7 best 3-point teams in UK history have come under Mitchell

#### KENTUCKY RANKED INSIDE TOP 20 IN BOTH MAJOR POLLS

- Following its impressive run through the 2018 Paradise Jam Island Division with wins over three teams that have been ranked or receiving votes this season, UK entered the national rankings week 3 and are currently ranked No. 16 (AP)/No. 17 (Coaches).
- Week 3 was the first time UK has been ranked in the AP poll since Dec. 4, 2017.

#### WILDCATS VS. THE RANKED IN ASSOCIATED PRESS TOP 25

 UK is scheduled to play one more game against teams currently ranked or receiving votes in the national listings. That game will be vs. No. 21/22 Texas A&M. UK is 4-4 vs. ranked foes this season with wins vs. then-No. 17 USF, at then-No. 13 Tennessee, vs. then-No. 25 Missouri and then-No. 13 South Carolina.

#### CATS END NON-CONFERENCE PLAY WITH RECORD 13 WINS

- UK ended the non-conference portion of the schedule with a 13-1 record. The 13 wins mark the most in a season before Jan. 1 in program history.
- UK started the season 9-0, which is its best start to a season since starting 11-0 in 2015-16.
- This was the fifth time that Kentucky has started a season 9-0 or better under Coach Mitchell. Each of the previous four times the Wildcats have started 9-0 or better under Mitchell they have advanced to the Sweet 16, including two Elite Eight appearances.

#### HOT SHOOTING TO END NON-CONFERENCE PLAY

- UK shot 50% or better from the field in three straight games (vs. MTSU, vs. WCU, vs. MSU) for the first time since November 2013. The hot stretch started with 56.8% against MTSU before 58.6% against WCU and 50.7% against MSU. The only prior time UK had shot over 50 percent from the field this season was in its second game of the season vs. Southern.
- The Wildcats were red hot from long range during the stretch, going 48.2 percent from long range during those three games (27-56). UK went 6-of-10 from 3 vs. MTSU before hitting 11 3s against WCU and 10 3s vs. Murray State.

#### MORRIS LEADS CATS PAST MOREHEAD STATE, RHODE ISLAND

- Maci Morris scored 25 first-half points against Morehead State, which potentially could be a school record but halftime statistics are incomplete prior to the 1982-83 season. The senior went 10-of-14 from the field and 4-of-6 from long range in the first half. In the second quarter alone, Morris scored 19 points. Overall, Kentucky scored 52 first-half points and earned the 87-57 win over the Eagles.
- A week later, Morris scored 29 overall including 15 in the first half against Rhode Island to guide Kentucky to a 75-52 win. The senior hit five 3s in the game adding five rebounds and four assists. Fellow senior Taylor Murray scored 11 points against URI while freshman Rhyne Howard had 19 points, seven rebounds and seven steals.

#### COMEBACK FALLS SHORT AT HIGHLY RANKED LOUISVILLE

Rhyne Howard scored 25 points and had 10 rebounds for her third double-double of the season but it was not enough for Kentucky, who nearly erased an 18-point second-half deficit in its 80-75 loss at Louisville. UK outrebounded the Cardinals, 32-28, including 12-6 on the offensive glass with a 20-6 edge in second-chance points.

#### PARADISE JAM ISLAND DIVISION CHAMPS!

- Kentucky earned the 2018 Paradise Jam Island Division Championship with a 85-63 win over No. 17 USF, 75-74 overtime win vs. (rv) UCLA and 85-75 comeback win vs. North Carolina.
- The Wildcats were paced by Rhyne Howard, who led UK in scoring all three games including two 20-point performances, earning MVP honors. Howard averaged 21 points and hit the game-tying layup off an offensive rebound to send the UCLA game to overtime before eventually winning the game with a free throw. Taylor Murray was named to the all-tournament team after averaging 18.7 points during the three-day event. Murray had an incredible stat line against North Carolina with 23 points, 10 assists, seven steals and six rebounds.
- Kentucky dominated against then-No. 17 South Florida, outscoring the Bulls 24-8 in the sec-

- ond quarter to take control of the game. UK's 85 points against USF was the most the Bulls had allowed this season while their 63 points were the second fewest they have scored.
- UK had a double-digit lead against UCLA in game two before being outscored 35-25 in the second half. UCLA dominated in the paint, 48-22, but UK scored 19 points off turnovers.
- The Wildcats trailed 60-47 against UNC late in the third quarter before rallying for the ninth largest comeback in the Matthew Mitchell Era behind a 38-15 run over the final 13 minutes of play. It was UK's defense that turned the tables on the Tar Heels, forcing 27 turnovers and scoring 34 points off those miscues.

#### **HOWARD LEADS UK PAST SOUTHERN WITH 29 POINTS, SEVEN 3S**

- Freshman Rhyne Howard scored a career high 29 points, including a school-record-tying seven 3-pointers, as UK beat Southern 91-41 to move to 2-0 on the season.
- Howard is the first freshman in program history to hit seven or more 3s in a game. Her effort vs. SU marks the most points scored by a UK freshman since 2014.

#### **DEFENSE SHINES IN SEASON OPENING WIN VS. ALABAMA STATE**

- UK forced 42 turnovers the fourth most in a game in program history and scored 51 points
  off those miscues to earn their 10th straight win in a season or home opener vs. Alabama St.
- UK had 23 steals in the game, which is the sixth most steals in a game in program history. It
  was the first time Kentucky had recorded 20 or more steals since 24 vs. Georgia Southern on
  Nov. 13, 2013.

#### **ROOKIES HAVE HISTORIC DEBUT**

- Both of Kentucky's freshmen scored 13 or more points in their varsity debut against Alabama State, which is the first time in program history that has happened.
- Howard scored 15 points, adding six rebounds, three assists, three blocks and two steals. Howard's 15 points were the fifth most in a player's UK varsity debut. Green had 13 points in the game, which tied for the seventh most in a UK player's varsity debut.

#### RECORD MARGIN OF VICTORY FOR KENTUCKY

- The Wildcats won each of their first two games to start the season by 50+ points. It was the first time in program history UK has won consecutive games by 50 or more points. UK defeated Alabama State 87-35 and Southern 91-41.
- Kentucky has tied the school record for most wins by at least 50 points in a single season (three) (Also accomplished in 2012-2013, 2013-2014, 2015-2016).

#### HOWARD WINS GOLD, MVP HONORS IN MEXICO CITY FOR TEAM USA

- Rhyne Howard was chosen to play for the USA U18 Team in the 2018 FIBA Americas U18 Championship and helped lead the USA to gold and won MVP honors.
- Howard shined in every game of the tournament, starting with six points, two rebounds, one assist and a steal vs. Argentina before seven points with eight rebounds, three assists, two blocks and a steal vs. Chile. In the final game of pool play vs. Puerto Rico, Howard had 11 points with six rebounds, six steals and one assist. The guard continued to play well in the elimination rounds with eight points, six rebounds, four assists, two blocks and a steal in the quarterfinals vs. El Salvador before 14 points, including 4-of-7 from long range with five assists, two blocks and two steals against Colombia. She locked up the top honor after five points, four rebounds, four assists and two blocks vs. Canada.

#### **CIAO! WILDCATS GAIN EXPERIENCE IN ITALY IN AUGUST**

- August was a month of growth for Kentucky WBB as the Wildcats traveled to Italy for its first
  foreign tour in the Matthew Mitchell Era. UK played three games over 10 days in Italy, going
  2-1 on the court and gaining numerous off-the-court benefits. Kentucky is now 22-3 all-time
  in international play after finishing the trip 2-1.
- UK started the foreign tour with a 73-41 victory over the Bosnia and Herzegovina National
  Team in Rome before a 64-46 loss to the TK Hannover professional team. The trip ended
  with a 81-64 win over Marghera Select. The Wildcats started the tour in Rome for three days
  before two days in Florence and two nights in Venice before ending the trip in Lake Como.

#### WILDCATS RETURN CORE FROM LAST SEASON

- Matthew Mitchell and Co. returned a majority of its team from last season, including its top
  four scorers in Maci Morris, Taylor Murray, Dorie Harrison and Tatyana Wyatt. In all, UK
  returned 10 of the 13 players that saw time last season, not including redshirt junior Ogechi
  Anyagaligbo, who missed last season due to injury.
- In all, UK returned 81% of its scoring, 80% of its assists, 74% of its rebounding, 75% of its





3-point shooting and 80% of its made field goals. Morris and Murray lead the returners after Morris averaged 17.3 points last season while Murray averaged 11.5 points.

#### THE MAGIC "80"

• The Wildcats hold a remarkable 348-23 (.937) record since 1974 when scoring 80 points or more. The last loss came at South Carolin on Feb. 26, 2017 when the Cats fell 95-87 in the regular-season finale. UK is 102-5 (.952) under Mitchell when scoring 80 points or more.

#### **UK IN OVERTIME**

• UK is 30-26 all-time in overtime games, including a 11-3 mark under Mitchell, who is 13-5 in his 11-year career as a head coach in OT.

#### KENTUCKY ALL-TIME

• Kentucky is 820-537 (.604) in its 45th year of varsity women's basketball, including 278-122 (.695) in 12 seasons under Matthew Mitchell.

#### MITCHELL MOVES INTO ELITE SEC COMPANY

- Kentucky's dominating 89-57 victory over Ole Miss on Jan. 26, 2017 was an historic one for Kentucky head coach Matthew Mitchell. The win was his 97th all-time in SEC play as a head coach, which ranked him 10th alltime on the SEC's career wins list. UK's win at Arkansas on Feb. 16 was Mitchell's 100th career SEC win.
- · Since arriving in Lexington in 2007, Mitchell has led Kentucky to unprecedented success. On top of leading UK to its first SEC Regular Season Championship in 30 years in 2012, Mitchell has four SEC Tournament title game appearances, nine top-four finishes in the league and has coached 18 all-conference performances, including four SEC Player of the Year honorees.

#### MITCHELL TURNS PROGRAM AROUND

- In 2009-10, Coach Mitchell implemented the "40 minutes of dread" style of play and it started Kentucky on an impressive run of success over the last 10 seasons.
  - Advanced to a school-record eight straight NCAA Tournaments (2010-2017), including three Elite Eight trips during that span with 15 NCAA Tournament wins.
  - Eight top-four SEC finishes, including winning the SEC regular season title in 2012, its first in 30 years.
  - Advanced to the SEC Tournament championship game four times

#### 20+ WIN SEASONS UNDER MITCHELL

The Wildcats have won 20 or more games 19 times in 45 years of varsity basketball, including a school-record eight in a row from 2010-2017. It's important to note that UK had just 10 20-win seasons in its first 33 years of varsity women's basketball, but has nine in 12 seasons of the Matthew Mitchell era.

#### **DUNLAP ENSHRINED IN HALL OF FAME CLASS OF 2018**

 Victoria Dunlap was enshrined in the UK Athletics Hall of Fame in September of 2018 becoming the first Matthew Mitchell coached player to be inducted into the prestigious hall of fame.

#### **VALERIE STILL IN WBB HALL OF FAME CLASS OF 2019**

- The all-time leading scorer in both men's and women's basketball history at Kentucky - Valerie Still - has been announced as one of seven 2019 inductees into the prestigious Women's Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Although Still played long ago (1979-83), she remains the top Wildcats in UK's women basketball annals. She was honored as such on Jan. 12, 2003 with a jersey retirement ceremony at halftime of the Alabama game. She became the first female letter winner in any UK sport to have her jersey retired.

#### THE KENTUCKY WBB COACHING STAFF HAS ...

• Combined the Kentucky women's basketball staff has compiled over 80 years of experience at the Division I level, including coaching or playing in a combined 38 NCAA Tournaments with eight Final Fours, four national championships and a WNBA Championship. Elzy and Butts are in their second stint in Lexington after serving on Mitchell's staffs before. Butts was an associate head coach on Mitchell's first staff at Kentucky before Elzy joined the staff for four successful seasons. Amber Smith is in her first year as an assistant coach but has been a part of the Kentucky program for nearly a decade. Dunn, who is a Women's Basketball Hall of Famer, has over 40 years of coaching experience, including three decades in the collegiate ranks. Dunn is now the special assistant to the head coach after serving as an assistant coach the last two seasons.

#### CATS SHINE IN THE CLASSROOM

Matthew Mitchell has put an emphasis on academics since arriving on campus as the Wildcats have had a 3.0 team GPA or better each of the last 11 semesters. In the fall of 2016, the Wildcats posted a 3.517 team GPA, which was the highest GPA for a semester in the Mitchell era. UK followed that with a 3.464 team GPA in the spring with four players earning 4.0s. UK earned a 3.3 team GPA in the fall of 2017. Under Mitchell, 38 Wildcats have been tabbed to the SEC Academic Honor Roll and 100 percent of Mitchell's players have received their degrees.

- Big Blue Nation continues to show its massive support for Kentucky WBB as UK ranked 15th in average attendance during the 2017-18 season with 5,187 fans per game, marking the ninth straight year the Wildcats have ranked in the top 15 in average attendance nationally. UK has ranked top 25 in average attendance for 15 straight seasons.
- Overall in 16 homes games including three inside Rupp Arena –
  Kentucky amassed a total attendance of 82,984, which ranked top-20
  nationally in total home attendance for 2017-18. Kentucky did not
  amass 100,000 for the seventh straight year, but played four fewer
  home games in 2017-18 than previous years.
- Kentucky's attendance numbers have reached impressive heights the
  last decade as the Wildcats have averaged 5,000 or more fans every
  year since 2009-10, while seven of the eight most-attended home
  games in program history have all come the past few years under
  head coach Matthew Mitchell.

#### MITCHELLS DONATE \$1 MILLION TO UK ATHLETICS

• In June of 2014, Coach Matthew Mitchell and his wife, Jenna, pledged \$1 million over the next 10 years to the University of Kentucky Athletics Department. The donation will provide UK Athletics \$100,000 per year over the next 10 years to be used for a variety of capital projects, including updates and renovations for football. The donation is the largest ever given by a UK athletics employee to the athletics department.

#### Rupp Arena (23,500)

- An awesome structure in sight and scope, the arena is divided into two seating areas. The lower level features 10,000 cushioned theater seats. The upper level has 13,000 seats on epoxy-coated metal bleachers. The latter can be visually isolated to provide more natural setting for small shows.
- The Wildcats command an exclusive and updated state-of-the-art locker room, while other amenities include six team-size dressing rooms and eight smaller units.
- In 2013-14, UK set the new single-game attendance record when 23,706 fans saw
  UK face No. 2 Duke in Rupp Arena on Dec. 22, 2013. The attendance marked the
  largest crowd ever to see a college women's hoops game in the Commonwealth —
  the previous mark was 22,152 for the first Kentucky-Louisville game played in the
  KFC Yum! Center on Dec. 5, 2010.
- In 2015-16, Kentucky packed 17,150 fans in Rupp Arena on Dec. 20 against Duke, which was the fourth-largest home crowd in program history. On Dec. 10, the Wildcats had 14,425 fans at the historic arena, which was the sixth-largest home crowd in school history.
- Kentucky will play two games inside Rupp Arena in 2018-19 after playing three games inside the historic building last season.




