CATS CLOSE REGULAR SEASON WITH VISIT FROM #2 VANDERBILT

- Coach Nick Mingione has 103 career victories, the most for a UK coach in his first three years.
 The Cats are riding a 116-game streak without being shutout and have scored in 192 of the last 193 games (the lone shutout was a seven-inning game) dating to April 2016. The current streak is the second-longest in UK history (see page five for list).
 UK's strength of schedule currently is rated ninth nationally.
 The Cats have played 30 games against RPI Top 35, the most in the country. They have played 14 against the RPI Top 10 and 20 against the Top 15.
 Freshman INF Austin Schultz posted a 27-game reached base streak this season, just the eighth time a UK player has had streak of at least 25 games since the start of 2012. He has reached in 40 of the past 42 games and 13 straight.
 Sophomore C/INF Coltyn Kessler has at least one RBI in 10 of his last 12 games.
 Junior LHP Zack Thompson ranks 16th in career strikeouts/9 inn. among all active Division I pitchers (12.23) and sixth in total strikeouts (121) this season.
 Thompson has 259 career strikeouts and ranks fourth on school's all-time list.
 Thompson's 121 strikeouts in 2019 are the most by a UK LHP in single-season. They rank tied for third overall and 12 behind the record of 133 set by Joe Blanton in 2002.
 Thompson was named a Golden Spikes Award semifinalist this week.

• Freshman LHP Cole Daniels is second in the SEC in appearances with 27.
• In 16 games since being inserted into the starting lineup, senior OF Ryan Johnson is hitting .370 with an on-base pecentage of .554 and OPS of 1.163.
• Nineteen of UK's 35-man active roster are first-year players and 14 are freshmen.
• Junior DH T.J. Collett has been named to the SEC Community Service Team for the season straight year.
• The Cats have had college baseball's most MLB Draft picks (21) and top 10-round picks (12) over the nast two years. The 13 selections in last summer's draft also were tons in the nation.
