HISTORY AND RECORDS

TOURNAMENT OVERVIEW

The Bettie Lou Evans Invitational has been held 29 times, dating all the way back to 1979. The most recent edition took place in 2018 with 12 teams competing for the title.

The Wildcats have won the tournament 12 times, including in 2018 with a 54-hole tournament record score of 858. Leonie Bettel won the individual title in 2018 with a 54-tournament record score of 205.

The tournament, formerly known as the Wildcat Fall Invitational, began in 1979 (there were actually two tournaments in 1976 and 1977 before women's golf became a varsity sport at UK) and was played every year until a four-year break from 1998 to 2001. The Kentucky tournament also took one-year breaks in 2008 and 2010. There were five seasons without the tournament following the 2011 edition until the Bettie Lou was revived in 2017.

THE UNIVERSITY CLUB

Opened in 1992, the University Club is a semi-private club licensed by UK. The U-Club is the official home of the men's and women's golf teams and is the host site for all of UK's tournaments.

Internationally renowned golf course architect Arthur Hills designed the renovations to the 36-hole championship course. The University Club features the Big Blue Course and the Wildcat Course. The courses are complemented by a dozen lakes and ponds, providing players with a beautiful and challenging round of golf.

For the Bettie Lou Evans Invitational, teams will compete on the Big Blue Course, which will play as a par 72 with a yardage of 6,114 yards.

The clubhouse is filled with UK memorabilia and contains private meeting rooms that serve to host a variety of university-related conferences, events and meetings.



With so many picturesque, challenging holes on the Big Blue Course, it would be unfair to call the eighth hole the University Club's signature hole. With that said, golfers will find a difficult time playing a more entertaining hole. The green on this par 3 is surrounded by water on all sides. With an elevated tee box, golfers have to be precise with their yardage.

BIG BLUE COURSE



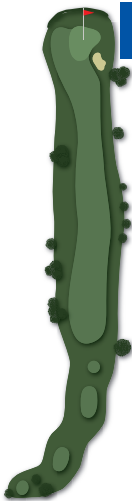
A good drive to this generous fairway will set up a short iron approach to a large, rather flat green. This hole offers a good scoring opportunity!



An accurate drive is required to hit this narrow fairway. Second shots play slightly downhill.



This medium-length par three plays downhill, but you must hit enough club to carry the deep front bunker. Par is a good score here.



A well-struck tee shot down the left side of the fairway will set up a middle iron approach. Take your time reading the subtle breaks on this green.



This hole is a big hitter's dream. Aim down the left side and let it loose! With a well-struck tee shot you can go at the green in two. However, if a layup is necessary, avoid the cross bunker guarding the front of the green at all costs.



Going with a fairway wood or long iron is usually the preferred play off the tee. A good drive sets up a middle to short iron approach to a very undulating green. Do not be short!



After safely playing a tee shot to the right of the water hazard, the lay up second shot must avoid the fairway bunkers down the right side, leaving a wedge for your approach shot and a chance for birdie.



This tee shot is the scariest one on the course! This short par three plays considerably downhill but gives you no margin for error. Aim for the middle of the green and hope that the wind is not blowing when you get here.



Long hitters can cut the corner and get very close to this deep green. However, a tee shot played into one of the bunkers on the left is nearly impossible to put on the green. Instead, go with an iron to the fairway, leaving a wedge approach shot.

HOLE 10 PAR 4 YARDS 350

Drives must be played between the fairway bunkers. The blind second shot plays slightly uphill. Stay beneath the hole here!

HOLE 11 PAR 4 YARDS 372

This par four offers one of the few scoring opportunities on the back nine. An accurate tee shot will leave a short iron approach.



HOLE 12 PAR 3 YARDS 125

Club selection is critical here. Take enough club to carry the water on this long par three, but do not be careless. A very tricky pitch shot awaits if you make a mistake long.

HOLE 13 PAR 5 YARDS 464

Another scoring chance! Avoid the fairway bunker off the tee and this hole will offer a good opportunity for birdie.

HOLE 14 PAR 4 YARDS 327

A fairway wood from the tee to an ample landing area will set up a short approach to this sloping green. Even with a wedge, this shot will test your nerves with water surrounding the green from all angles.



HOLE 15 PAR 4 YARDS 384

Two good shots are required here. Keep the ball down the left side off the tee to shorten the second shot. An approach shot towards the front left side of the green is the smart play. Par is a great score.

HOLE 16 PAR 5 YARDS 509

This is a three-shot par five. The tee shot must avoid the fairway bunkers on the right. Lay up your second shot to a good wedge yardage. Shots short or long of this small, undulating green will yield bogey or worse.

HOLE 17 PAR 3 YARDS 170

This is the longest of the par three holes. A well-struck long iron or fairway wood is required to reach the large, flat green.

HOLE 18 PAR 4 YARDS 371

What a finish! A strong accurate tee shot will leave a middle iron to this small, tricky green. The green is extremely fast from back to front. Keep the ball beneath the hole for a good putting opportunity.

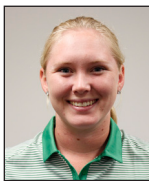

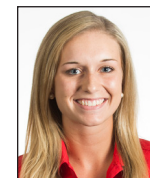
