QUICK HITTERS

> Mount St. Mary's begin its 46th season of women's basketball competition with a first-time opponent in the Kentucky Wildcats. The Mount comes into the season closing in on 750 all-time victories and a .586 winning percentage.

> The Mountaineers rounded out the 2018-19 season at 15-16 overall and 8-10 in the NEC. The 15 wins are the most for the Mountaineers since 2013-14 they went 19-14 overall and earned the program's only-ever trip the WNIT.

> 11 of the 13 Mountaineers from the 2018-19 season return for 2019-20, including NEC All-Rookie selection Michaela Harrison, leading rebounder Rebecca Lee, and versatile performer Jatarrikah Settle.

MOUNT ST. MARY'S NEWS AND NOTES

ABOUT THE MOUNT

>>> The Mountaineers rounded out the regular season at 15-16 overall and 8-10 in the NEC and secured the No. 6 seed heading into the playoffs. The 15 victories are the most for the program since the 2013-14 campaign, when the Mountaineers went 19-14 overall and earned the program's only-ever trip the WNIT.

>>> Mount St. Mary's averaged 66.6 points per game, good for third-most in the conference, and sat in the middle of the pack in both field goal percentage (.389) and three-point percentage (.325).

>>> On the boards, Rebecca Lee (7.3 rpg) and Jatarrikah Settle (6.2 rpg) led the way, as the pair combined for 16 double-digit rebound performances on the season.

SERIES BITS

>>> This is the first-ever meeting between Mount St. Mary's and the Kentucky Wildcats.

>>> The Mount holds a 1-2 all-time record against the Southeastern Conference, but haven't played a game against the SEC since 2003. The Mountaineers defeated Florida 74-67 in 1988, lost to Alabama in an NCAA Tournament game 82-55 in 1994 and fell to Ole Miss 81-64 in 2003.

SEASON OPENERS

>>> Mount St. Mary's holds a 22-23 all-time record in season openers, with an 11-20 mark since the jump to Division I in 1988-89.

>>> Coach Marchesano is 1-1 at the Mount to open campaigns, with a loss at Notre Dame and a win at home against Washington College .

>>> The most common opponents for the first game are Maryland, Virginia and West Virginia - whom the Mount has played three times each.

PRESEASON COACHES POLL

>>> The Mount was picked to finish tied for third in the Northeast Conference Preseason Coaches Poll.

>>> Last year's champion Robert Morris

was tabbed the unanimous preseason favorite (10 first-place votes), while reigning NEC runner-up Saint Francis U was picked second.

>>>The ranking is the highest for the team since the 2013-14 NIT season.

NON-CONFERENCE SLATE

>>> A win over Radford on January 2, 2019 gave the Mount a 6-5 record to close out its non-conference slate last season.

>>> It marked the first winning record for the Mountaineers in non-conference play since the 1999-00 season, when they also finished at 6-5.

>>> For out of conference contests, the Mount holds a 96-51 combined record all-time against their opponents, and three first-time meetings (Kentucky, Indiana, Old Dominion).

>>> Seven of the 11 games will be played away from Knott Arena with five true road games and a pair of neutral site matchups.

KEY RETURNEES

>>> The Mountaineers returns 11 players from last year's roster, including four starters in Jatarrikah Settle, Michaela Harrison, Bridget Birkhead and Rebecca Lee.

>>> Harrison enjoyed an excellent freshman campaign, earning a selection to the NEC All-Rookie Team, averaging 13.3 points, 3.5 rebounds, 2.4 assists and 1.5 steals a game.

>>> Rebecca Lee recently joined the Mount's all-time top-10 list for most blocks in a season. The junior center had 29 blocks on the year, which is tied for seventh-most in a season by a Mountaineer.

KEY DEPARTURES

>>> The Mount lost two members of the 2018-19 team to graduation and transfer. Juliette Lawless was the team's leading scorer with 15.2 PPG while being third in rebounds with 4.5 per game. Lawless earned Second Team All-NEC honors in her senior year. Daly Sullivan averaged 6.2 points a contest with 1.8 assists and 1.3 rebounds before transferring.

>>> Mount's two newcomers are twins from the Land Down Under. Mikayla and

WELCOME BACK

>>> Three Mountaineers will return/debut for the squad after sitting out last season. Kayla Agentowicz was injured and medically redshirted her junior season. Aryna Taylor will see game action for the first time collegiately after two years worth of injury, and Kendell Breese is set to compete after sitting out last season following a transfer from George Washington.

ROOKIE RECORD

>>> Michaela Harrison's 84 three-pointers in 2018-19 are the most by a player in a single season in Mount program history.
>>> The previous record of 79 was set by Myriam Baccouche during the 2003-04 campaign.
>>> The mark also beats the 75 triples for a freshman, set by Daly Sullivan during the 2017-18 campaign.

ON THE MARCHESANO

>>> Maria Marchesano collected her 100th career victory as a head coach in the team's win over Wagner on February 18th last year.
>>> Marchesano recorded 27 wins in two seasons at Urbana University, 52 in three seasons at Walsh University, and currently has 24 at the Mount.

MILESTONES TO MEET

>>> Mount St. Mary's first victory in 2019-20 will be Coach Marchesano's 25th at the school.
>>> The program can also achieve 750 all-time wins with just 12 victories on the season.

COACHES CONNECTION

>>> Assistant Coaches Ciara Geiger and has a connection to Head Coach Maria Marchesano prior to Mount St. Mary's.
>>> Geiger was a player under Marchesano at Urbana University, and went on to coach alongside Marchesano at Walsh University during the 2015-16 season.

A FAMILIAR NAME

>>> Third-year Assistant Coach Julie

Kaufman is the older sister of former Mount St. Mary's standout, Jessie Kaufman.

>>> Jessie, who played for the Mountaineers from 2010-14, ranks sixth all-time in program history in three-pointers made (158), ninth in blocked shots (67) and 33rd in career points (837).

WEEKLY AWARDS

>>> Michaela Harrison won seven total weekly awards in 2018-19 -- six Rookie/Co-Rookie of the Week honors and one Player of the Week Award.
>>> Juliette Lawless is the other Mountaineer to be honored with weekly distinction this past season. The senior guard was named Player of the Week on a pair of occasions.
>>> Both were honored by the NEC postseason teams. Lawless made Second Team All-Conference while Harrison earned All-Rookie honors.

HOME VS. ROAD

>>> For the 2019-20 season, Mount St. Mary's plays 13 contests in Emmitsburg and 16 on the road.
>>> The Mountaineers played well at home last season, posting a 9-4 record at Knott Arena, averaging 72.0 points per game and shooting 40.1 percent (36.5 percent from long range). They are scoring over 10 points more per game at Knott Arena compared to on the road.
>>> The Mountaineers owned a 5-11 mark on the road, as they averaged 61.4 points per game, shot 37.3 percent from the floor and 29.2 percent from three-point territory.

MARIA MARCHESANO BIO

Maria Marchesano was named the sixth head coach in Mount St. Mary's women's basketball history on May 1, 2017. In her first two seasons at the helm, Marchesano guided the squad to a 24-36 overall record and a 14-22 mark in Northeast Conference play. Under Marchesano's guidance, the Mount averaged its most points per game since the 2013-14 season. Marchesano mentored and developed guard Juliette Lawless, who was named the NEC Most Improved Player and earned an All-NEC Third Team Selection and NEC All-Rookie Team members Daly Sullivan and Michaela Harrison.

Marchesano came to the Mount following a stint as an associate head coach at IUPUI, where she helped guide the squad to the most wins in a season in program history in 2016-17, as the Jaguars finished at 24-9 overall and 12-4 in Summit League play. IUPUI made its first appearance in the conference championship game since 2008, and also earned a berth in the Women's National Invitation Tournament (WNIT) to cap off the outstanding season. During the campaign, the Jags collected seven wins versus RPI top-100 teams and earned their highest RPI ranking in program history (53). Marchesano coached three All-Summit League honorees and one Academic All-Summit League member during her season with the Jags.

Prior to her time at IUPUI, Marchesano served for three years as the head coach at Walsh University in North Canton, Ohio. Marchesano led the team to 52 wins during her three seasons, including back-to-back 20-win campaigns in 2014-15 and 2015-16. The Cavaliers made two GLIAC Tournament Final Four appearances, won three-straight Mayor's Cup titles, and defeated a pair of Division I teams (Butler & Kent State) during Marchesano's tenure at the helm.

In her final season at Walsh, she guided the Cavaliers to a 20-9 overall record and 16-6 mark in GLIAC play, as they earned home-court advantage for the first time ever in the conference tournament. During the regular season, the Cavaliers registered an upset-victory over third-ranked Ashland University, which was the highest-ranked opponent Walsh had ever defeated as a Division II program.

Marchesano got her first experience as a head coach at Urbana University in Urbana, Ohio midway through the 2011-12 season. She inherited a 2-8 team in January, before turning the season around, guiding the Knights to a 12-7 record after taking over the helm, which included an eight-game winning streak at home. The team qualified for the D-II Ohio Independent Championships, and Marchesano was named the D-II Independent Coach of the Year. The following season, Marchesano led the Knights to a G-MAC Conference Tournament Championship.

Before her time at Urbana, Marchesano served as an assistant coach for both the women's basketball and softball programs at Manchester College in North Manchester, Indiana from 2010-12.

During her collegiate career, Marchesano was a four-year letter winner at Butler University in women's basketball, and also played one season on the softball team. The Fort Wayne, Indiana native was named the Butler Freshman Female Athlete of the Year, earned Horizon League All-Newcomer Team honors, and was a recipient of the Butler Team Community Service Award. Marchesano finished her career as the second-best three-point shooter in program history. Following her collegiate career, she went on to sign three professional basketball contracts and five professional softball contracts in the Italian Federation.
