STARTING FIVE

- After leading the USA Basketball team to a perfect 7-0 record and a gold medal at the 2019 FIBA U19 World Cup in Bangkok, Thailand, Jeff Walz was announced as a recipient of the 2019 USA Basketball National Coach of the Year award. With Walz at the helm, the USA U19 women topped its competition by an average of 25.2 points per game, including beating Australia 74-70 in overtime in the gold medal contest. Kentucky's Rhyne Howard was named to all-tournament team.
- Dana Evans ranks second in the ACC with 19.1 points per game and leads the league and ranks 10th in the country with 30 made 3-pointers. She is shooting 49 percent from beyond the arc, which also leads the league and ranks 16th in the country. Her 3.1 assists per game rank 14th in the ACC. She has scored in double figures every game. She was named espnW, USBWA and ACC Player of the Week following her MVP performance at the Paradise Jam. She finished the week averaging a tournament-best 21.3 points, while shooting 47 percent from the floor, 11-21 (.524) from 3-point range and 17-18 (.944) from the free throw line.






- Louisville's senior class is looking to become just the third senior class in program history to finish their careers with a 4-0 record against Kentucky. The Cardinals' 2008 and 2009 classes also went undefeated against UK as UofL won five straight games against the Wildcats from 2004 to 2008 (12/5/04 - UofL 66-49 at UofL; 12/28/05 - UofL 64-55 at UK; 12/3/06 - UofL 83-75 at UofL; 12/20/07 - UofL 80-65 at UK; 12/14/08 - UofL 75-59 at UofL)

- Sunday's game marks the seventh time since Walz became head coach that the Cardinals and Wildcats meet when they are both in the AP Top 25. Since 2011-12, only twice have the two teams met and not both been in the Top 25. Louisville has won the last two games when both teams are in the Top 25 and are 2-4 overall under Walz.

- Louisville's 31 points in the third quarter against Northern Kentucky tied the most points in a quarter this season. They led 37-35 at half and then outscored the Norse 31-9 in the third quarter to open up a 68-44 lead. They also had 31 points in the first quarter against Boise State.

ABOUT THE WILDCATS

Kentucky is off to a 10-0 start, which ties the second-best start for the Wildcats under head coach Matthew Mitchell. UK has started 11-0 three times under Mitchell (2015-16, 2013-14, 2009-10). On Wednesday, they beat Winthrop 91-36 and scored a season-high 32 points in the first quarter. They went 13-of-23 from the 3-point line, marking the third straight games and the fifth time this season UK has hit 10 or more 3s in a game. They had 11 makes in the first half, which tied a program record for makes in a half. UK also hit 11 in the first half vs. Detroit on Dec. 1, 1993. They forced Winthrop into 35 turnovers. The Wildcats rank third in the NCAA in scoring defense (45.6 ppg), third in turnover margin (+10.8), sixth in scoring margin (+29.2) and 13th in FG% defense (32.9%). Sophomore Rhyne Howard was named WBCA National Freshman of the Year last season. She leads the Wildcats and ranks 23rd in the country with 19.6 points per game. She also leads UK with 30 made 3-pt field goals, which ranks 10th in the NCAA, 5.6 rebounds and 2.3 steals. Redshirt senior Sabrina Haines ranks second on the team with 11.6 points, while adding 5.1 rebounds. She is shooting a team-best 47 percent from 3-pt range and has 21 makes.

■ **Series History** - UofL is 20-34 all-time against UK. The Cards are 5-20 in Lexington and 2-2 at Rupp Arena (L-OT, 84-80, 12/3/02; W, 64-55, 12/28/05; W, 80-65, 12/20/07; L, 72-54, 12/10/15). Walz is 6-6 against UK. Louisville has won the last three games, an 80-75 win at the KFC Yum! Center on Dec. 9, 2018, an 87-63 win in Lexington on Dec. 17, 2017 and a 69-67 overtime win at the KFC Yum! Center on Dec. 4, 2016. Prior to recording wins the last three seasons, UofL had lost five straight and six of seven. Only two other times has UofL won three or more consecutive games against UK. They won three straight in 1979 and five straight from 2004 to 2008.

■ **Back at Rupp** - UofL is playing at Rupp Arena for first time since beating Stanford and Oregon State in the 2018 regional semifinals and finals to advance to the program's Final Four.

■ **Both Teams in Top 25** - Sunday's game will mark the seventh time since Walz became head coach that the Cardinals and Wildcats meet when they are both in the AP Top 25. Since 2011-12, only twice have the two teams met and not both been in the Top 25. Louisville has won the last two games when both teams are in the Top 25 and are 2-4 overall.

■ **The Last Meeting (Dec. 9, 2018)** - Asia Durr scored 32 points, as Louisville took down arch-rival Kentucky, 80-75 for their third straight victory over the Wildcats on Sunday afternoon inside the KFC Yum! Center. Jazmine Jones hit a 3-pointer to begin the second half for the Cards, as Louisville used a 21-10 run in the third quarter to take a 57-39 lead. The Cards took a 67-52 lead into the fourth quarter and held on to a five-point win.

APPROACHING MILESTONES

■ **Seeking all-time win No. 900** - With 887 wins, UofL is 13 wins shy of 900 all-time.

■ **Walz seeks 350th win** - At 340-101, Jeff Walz is 10 victories shy of win No. 350.

■ **Shook moving up block list** - Kylee Shook recorded five blocks against Central Michigan to pass Audrey Baines (144, 1976-80) for second place all-time in program history. She has 156 blocks for her career and needs six to tie Angel McCoughtry (2006-09) for first all-time with 162.

■ **Jones seeks to play more games than any Cardinal in history** - Jazmine Jones has played in 122 games and is 20 games played away from tying Myisha Hines-Allen (2014-2018) and Shoni Schimmel (2010-14) for most games played with 142.

■ **Jones looks to add name to 1,000-point club** - Jazmine Jones has 925 career points and is 75 points shy of becoming the program's 30th 1,000-point scorer.

JAMMIN' WITH JAZ

Jazmine Jones ranks third in the ACC with a 57.9 shooting percentage. She leads the team with 3.5 assists and 1.7 steals per game, and ranks second with 13.6 points per game and fifth with 4.8 rebounds. She shot 9-of-10 en route to a game-high 21 points in the win over Northern Kentucky. She did not make the start at NKU on 12/8, which ended a streak of 84 consecutive starts. She shot just 7-of-24 (.292) in the previous three games, including 2-of-10 vs. Oklahoma State and 1-of-8 against Ohio State. She had just 16 points in those three games as she battled foul trouble against Oregon and Ohio State, and her average has dropped from a season-high 16.5 points to 12.8 points over the stretch. She shot 17-of-27 (.630) over a two-game stretch against Boise State and UT Arlington, shooting 9-of-15 vs. UTA (24 points) and 8-of-12 against BSU (22 points). She shot 16-of-19 (.842) in a two-game stretch against Murray State and Central Michigan. She was a perfect 6-of-6 against Murray State en route to scoring a team-high 14 points. She followed that by shooting 10-of-13 for a team-high and career-high 25 points against Central Michigan.

AGAINST THE SEC

Head coach Jeff Walz is 17-10 all-time against SEC schools and has won five of his last six games against the SEC, the lone loss in that span was to Mississippi State in the 2018 Final Four. Overall, Louisville is 43-75 all-time against the SEC.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN

UofL has won 165 games away from home since head coach Jeff Walz's arrival in 2007-08. UofL boasts a 165-75 (.688) record in those contests (includes 51-25 record for neutral site games).

■ Last Year: UofL went 16-3 away from the KFC Yum! Center (includes 5-2 neutral record).

MORE ON THE ROAD

UofL is 25-3 in true road games over the last two-plus seasons. Prior to the loss at Ohio State, their only losses came to No. 1 teams (1/10/19 at No. 1 ND, L, 82-68; 2/12/18 at No. 1 UConn, L, 69-58). Their last road loss to a non-No. 1 team was an 85-66 setback at No. 7 Notre Dame on 2/16/17. Their last road loss to an unranked team was a 71-69 loss at Western Kentucky on 11/21/15. The Cards went 11-1 in true road games last season and 7-1 in ACC road games.

DE-FENSE, DE-FENSE

UofL is giving up 57.9 points per game, which ranks fifth in the ACC, and have held opponents to 67 points or less in all but one game. The Cardinals are holding opponents to 26.8 percent shooting from 3-point range, which ranks third in the league.

■ Louisville held Oregon to just 62 points in the 72-62 win. The Ducks' previous smallest point total was 81 in an 81-64 win over No. 17 Syracuse. Oregon entered the game averaging 93.0 points. Last season, they scored less than 67 points just five times and went 2-3 in those games.

DON'T GET SHOOK

Kylee Shook has scored in double figures in five of 10 games this season. She has four double doubles on the year and 10 for her career. In the win over Oregon, she had a season-high 18 points and tied a career-high with 15 rebounds. She had three straight double doubles against Murray State, Central Michigan and Chattanooga. She is nearly averaging a double-double on the season with 9.6 points per game and 8.2 rebounds. Her 8.2 rebounds per game rank 12th in the ACC, while her 1.9 blocks lead the ACC.

NON-CONFERENCE SUCCESS

UofL is 9-1 in non-conference play and they had a 21-game non-conference winning streak prior to the loss at Ohio State. Their previous loss was a 69-58 loss at No. 1 UConn on 2/12/18. They are 35-2 in non-conference play over the last three seasons. Last year, they finished undefeated in non-conference play (13-0) and it marked the first time in program history that they finished regular season play unbeaten out of league play. Walz has compiled an impressive 156-34 record (.821) against non-conference foes.

NOVEMBER TO REMEMBER

Louisville finished November unscathed (8-0) for the third consecutive season and are 22-0 in November over that span. All-time, head coach Jeff Walz is 74-13 (.851) in November.

DECEMBER SUCCESS

Louisville is 1-1 this December after going 14-0 in December the previous two seasons. UofL is 75-14 in December all-time under head coach Jeff Walz.

BOARDED UP

Louisville is averaging 15.5 offensive rebounds per game, which ranks third in the ACC, and their +11.3 rebounding margin ranks fifth. They have outrebounded their opponent in all 10 games. Their 43.2 rebounds per game rank eighth in the ACC.

HEAD COACH JEFF WALZ

Head coach **Jeff Walz**, in his 12th season as a head coach, has compiled a 340-101 (.771) record as the Cardinals' leader. He has led Louisville to nine NCAA Sweet 16 appearances, five Elite 8's, three trips to Final 4 (2009, 2013, 2018), two of which culminated with NCAA runner-up finishes (2009, 2013). Walz, who is averaging 27.6 wins per season, became the winningest coach in program history in 2013-14. He also has the most 20-win seasons in school history (11) and the top-six entries for most victories in a season (36 in 2017-18, 34 in 2008-09; 33 in 2013-14; 32 in 2018-19; and 29 in 2012-13 and 2016-17).



Hired on March 27, 2007, the Bluegrass State native took the program to its first NCAA Sweet 16 and it culminated with Louisville earning the No. 12 ranking in the final ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll. For his efforts, Walz was named the WBCA Maggie Dixon Rookie Coach of the Year.

Prior to taking the reins at Louisville, Walz spent time on four other coaching staffs: Western Kentucky (1996-97), Nebraska (1997-01), Minnesota (2001-02), and Maryland (2002-07). He helped Maryland win the program's first national title in 2006.

UofL is 237-23 when surpassing the 70-point plateau under Walz. They have scored 70-plus in eight of 10 games this season and are 8-0 in those games. Last year, they scored 70-plus in 29 of 36 games and went 26-3 in those games. Their 79-73 loss to Miami ended a 49-game winning streak when scoring 70-plus points.

50/50

UofL shot 54 percent against BSU and 53 percent against Northern Kentucky, the only times they have shot over 50 percent this year. They are 2-0 in those games. Overall, they boast a 112-1 record when shooting 50 percent or better from the field under Walz. Their lone loss came on Nov. 29, 2008 at Nevada when they shot 50.8 percent (L, 85-82). Last year, UofL shot over 50 percent in 12 of 36 games and went 12-0 in those games.

UNBEATEN START

Following an 8-0 start, Louisville fell for the first time this season at Ohio State. The previous two seasons, they have won at least their first 14 games. Last season, they started off at 14-0 and in 2018-19 they started the season off with a program-best 20-0 record.

BACK-TO-BACK 30 WIN SEASONS

Louisville is coming off of back-to-back 30-win seasons for the first time in program history, going a combined 68-7 over the last two seasons, the best two-year stretch in program history. They have finished the last two seasons with 30-plus wins, an ACC regular season championship and as a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

ANOTHER 20-WIN SEASON

After going 32-4 in 2018-19, head coach Jeff Walz now has 11 20-win seasons in 12 years, adding to what was already the most in school history. In the 9-year stretch that begins with the 2010-11 season, Louisville has compiled a 258-67 mark (.794).

■ **Longest stretches in school history** - UofL has won at least 20 games for nine consecutive seasons, the longest stretch in program history. The longest run previously was three, achieved just twice in school history. They have reached the NCAA Tournament nine straight times, which is also the longest stretch in program history.

QUICK HITTERS

- In the last two-plus years, UofL is a combined 77-8. Prior to the loss at Ohio State on Thursday, the previous seven losses had all come to AP Top 25 teams, five to Top 5 teams.
- The Cardinals are shooting 74.5 percent from the free throw line which leads the ACC.
- Louisville's 58 points in the first half against Boise State marked the most points in the first half since they also had 58 against UT Martin on Dec. 4, 2018 in a 102-62 win.
- UofL's 49-point win (W, 86-37) over Chattanooga marked their largest margin of victory since their 55-point win over Tennessee State (W, 107-52) on Dec. 2, 2018.

B BRINGING HER "A" GAME

In the loss at Ohio State, Bionca Dunham had 10 points and 11 rebounds for her first double-double of the season and second of her career. Her other double-double came against Murray State (19 pts., 16 reb.) on 11/24/17. After failing to record double digit rebounds in the first six games, she has 10-plus rebounds in the last three of the last four contests. Over the last four games, she is averaging 6.0 points and and 9.8 rebounds.

UOFL'S SUCCESS BY DECADES

With Walz at the helm of the program, the Cards are averaging 27.6 victories per season (887-492). Louisville has been most successful under Walz's watch and since the 2000s. During the current decade, though not finished, the Cardinals boast a 79.6 winning percentage.

WIN OVER NO. 1

UofL's 72-62 win over No. 1 Oregon marked its second ever win over a No. 1 team, first since their 82-81 victory over No. 1 Baylor in the 2013 NCAA Tournament. The Cards are 2-11 all-time against AP No. 1 teams (1-0 vs. Baylor, 1-0 vs. Oregon, 0-10 vs. UConn, 0-1 vs. Notre Dame).

MOVING UP TO NO. 2 IN BOTH POLLS

UofL moved up six spots in the AP poll to No. 2 and seven spots in the USA Today poll to No. 2 following their win over No. 1 Oregon. It matched their highest ever ranking in both polls. Four other times Louisville has been ranked second in the AP poll, three times last season and once in 2017-18. Five other times, they have been second in the USA Today, three times last season, once in 2017-18 and at the end of the 2008-09 season.

TOP FIVE WINS

Louisville's win over No. 1 Oregon marked Walz's 11th against a top five team in his tenure.

WALZ VS. AP TOP 25

Walz has 61 wins over AP Top 25 teams and 50 in the last nine years.

STAYING IN THE TOP 10

Louisville has remained in the AP Top 10 for 44 straight polls and the USA Today Top 10 for 44 straight polls. Louisville had remained in the AP Top 5 for 37 consecutive weeks (Nov. 13, 2017-March 18, 2019) prior to being picked ninth in this year's preseason poll. They were in the USA Today Top 5 for 36 consecutive weeks (Nov. 27, 2017-March 18, 2019) before being picked sixth in last year's final poll.

PRESEASON AP/USA TODAY POLLS

UofL was picked ninth in the preseason AP and USA Today polls. They were also picked ninth in the preseason AP poll in 2017-18. That season they finished with a program-best 36-3 record and advanced to the final four.

SUCCESS AGAINST AP TOP 25 IN 2018-19

Louisville was 8-4 against AP Top 25 teams last season. The win over No. 2 UConn marked their second straight win over a top 5 team at the KFC Yum! Center, following the win over No. 2 Notre Dame in 2017-18.

SENIOR CLASS HAS CHANCE TO SET NEW STANDARD

Bionca Dunham, Jazmine Jones, Jessica Laemmle and Kylee Shook have an opportunity to be the third straight senior class to conclude their career as the most accomplished class in program history. They are 106-16 (.869), just 17 wins shy of tying the program-record 123 wins. They are on pace to set program-record for winning percentage and with less than six losses the rest of the way, will set the program-record for fewest losses. This year's class is 9-3 all-time in the NCAA Tournament and are just two tournament wins shy of setting the program-record for wins in a four-year period. The record is 11 by the 2015-16, 2014-15 and 2013-14 classes. They also have the opportunity to be the first class in program history to advance to the Sweet 16 all four years.

■ **Last year's historic senior class** - Arica Carter, Asia Durr and Sam Fuehring finished their career as the most accomplished senior class in program history, going 123-23 (.842) overall in the last four years, which marks the most wins by a class ever, surpassing Myisha Hines-Allen, who wrapped her career with a 118-26 (.819) record. They also finished their careers with the fewest losses and the best winning percentage in program history. Last year's senior class went 10-4 all-time in the NCAA Tournament.

RETURNING POINT PRODUCTION

After losing three players to the WNBA Draft (Durr, Carter, Fuehring), UofL returns 39.4 points per game, 50.6 percent of their production from a year ago. Last season, they returned 60.6 points per game, which was 79.0 percent of their production.

RETURNING STARTERS

The Cardinals return two starters from a year ago (Bionca Dunham, Jazmine Jones). Jones started all 36 games last year and has started all 75 games the last two seasons. She entered the season with 76 career starts to lead Louisville. Dunham started 31 of 36 games a season ago. Dana Evans made five starts last season en route to being named ACC Sixth Player of the Year, while Kylee Shook made three starts, and Yacine Diop and Mykasa Robinson had two starts each. Shook entered the year with 17 career starts after making 13 starts as a freshman. Elizabeth Balogun and Elizabeth Dixon started all 30 games for the Yellow Jackets last season.

THE NEWBIES

On the season, 29.4 percent of the scoring has come from newcomers (Balogun - 9.9, Dixon - 6.8, Konno - 5.9).

BALOGUN NAMED TO CITIZEN NAISMITH WATCH LIST, PICKED #23 ON ESPNW'S TOP 25
Elizabeth Balogun was named to the Citizen Naismith Top 50 Watch List, along with being picked #23 on espnW's list of the Top 25 players in the country.

EVANS NAMED TO WOODEN AWARD WATCH LIST

Dana Evans was named to the Wooden Award Top 30 Watch List. The list is comprised of 30 student-athletes who are the early front-runners for college basketball's most prestigious honors.

LOUISVILLE PICKED FIRST IN ACC PRESEASON POLLS

UofL was picked first in the league in both polls after claiming back-to-back regular season titles. The Cardinals received 34 of 49 first-place votes from the Blue Ribbon Panel for a total of 713 points and 13 of 15 first-place votes from the head coaches to finish with 223 points to lead the voting. Louisville was chosen as the preseason favorite for the first time since joining the conference prior to the 2013-14 season.

Elizabeth Balogun and Dana Evans were selected to the 2019-20 Preseason All-ACC Team, while Nyah Green was named to the Newcomer Watch List.

■ **Balogun** - Balogun comes to Louisville after being named 2018-19 ACC Freshman of the Year in her lone season at Georgia Tech. She started all 30 games for the Yellow Jackets last year, averaging 14.6 points per game, which led the team and ACC freshman and ranked eighth in the country among freshmen. at North Carolina.

■ **Evans** - Evans was named ACC Sixth Player of the Year and to the ACC All-Academic team a year ago after averaging 10.4 points. She ranked third in the ACC in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.2), 10th in 3-pt. field goal percentage (.385) and eighth in assists (4.0 per game).

BEST FANS IN THE COUNTRY

With 8,304 fans against Western Kentucky, 7,922 fans against Murray State, 7,605 fans against Central Michigan, 7,703 against Chattanooga and 8,331 against Boise State, UofL has the top three crowds, and four of the top five in the ACC this season. They are averaging 7,884 fans per game, which is top in the ACC and ranks fifth in the country.

■ **Last season** - Louisville averaged 9,531 fans per game with a 162,021 accumulative attendance last season, both of which ranked third in the country. It marked the third highest average attendance at the KFC Yum! Center and the highest since they averaged 10,670 in 2011-12 and 10,859 in 2010-11. They welcomed in 17,023 fans for the win over UConn, which marked the third largest women's basketball crowd last season and fourth biggest crowd for a women's basketball game at the KFC Yum! Center. They had three of the top eight crowds in all of women's basketball last season. Overall, they welcomed in 10,000-plus seven times last season. The seven 10,000-plus crowds games marked the second-most in program history. They had eight 10,000-plus crowds in 2011-12.

OPENING AT HOME

The Cardinals opened the season with their first five games at the KFC Yum! Center, hosting Western Kentucky on Nov. 5, Murray State on Nov. 8, Central Michigan on Nov. 14, UT Chattanooga on Nov. 21 and Boise State on Nov. 24. It marked the first time in program history that they opened the season with five consecutive home games.

HOME COURT ADVANTAGE

UofL boasts a 144-16 record (.900) at the KFC Yum! Center. All-time at the venue, UofL holds a plus-22.7 scoring margin. Through 160 games, Louisville averages 9,307 per contest and has welcomed nearly one million and a half fans through the doors of the KFC Yum! Center.

LOUISVILLE TO HOST USA WOMEN'S NATIONAL TEAM

Louisville will host an exhibition game against the USA Women's National Team on Sunday, Feb. 2 at 2 p.m. It marks the first time that Louisville will play the national team.

CARDINALS WELCOME TRIO OF TRANSFERS

Louisville welcomes in a trio of transfers with Georgia Tech's Elizabeth Balogun and Elizabeth Dixon, and California's Kianna Smith. Smith will sit out the 2019-20 season, but Balogun and Dixon will be eligible immediately. Balogun was last year's ACC Freshman of the Year, while Dixon was named to the ACC All-Freshman Team.

CHALLENGING SCHEDULE

Seven of the Cardinals' opponents this season are ranked in the Associated Press' preseason top 25 (No. 1 Oregon, 12. Florida State, 13. Kentucky, 14. NC State, 16. Notre Dame, 18. Miami, 21. Syracuse). An additional three opponents received votes in the poll (Boise State, Duke, North Carolina). Oklahoma State, who the Cards will face in the Virgin Islands, received a vote in the USA Today poll.

■ **Postseason Play** - The Cardinals face seven non-conference opponents that reached postseason play a season ago, seven that won 20-plus games and four that played in the NCAA Tournament. Arguably the top conference for women's basketball, the ACC saw eight teams win 20-plus games in 2018-19. In addition, eight ACC squads earned berths in the NCAA Women's Basketball Championship.

COACHING STAFF CHANGE

After six straight seasons of having the same assistants, Walz was forced to make a new addition after Samantha Williams was named head coach at Eastern Kentucky following eight seasons at UofL. Jonneshia Pineda arrives from Georgia Tech and is in her first season on Walz's staff. Sam Purcell enters his seventh season, while Stephanie Norman has been with Walz all 13 seasons.

MELTING POT

Louisville's 2019-20 roster continues last year's pattern of being diverse. Of the 16 student-athletes on its roster, eight are from different states (California, Colorado, Florida, Indiana, Kentucky, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Texas). Yacine Diop is from Dakar, Senegal and Norika Konno is from Sendai, Japan, while Elizabeth Balogun was born in Lagos, Nigeria.

CARDS EARNED NO. 1 SEED FOR SECOND CONSECUTIVE SEASON

Last year, UofL was a No. 1 seed in the NCAA Tournament for the second consecutive year and for the second time in program history. They advanced to the Elite Eight for the fifth time in program history and for the second straight year. In 2017-18, as a No. 1 seed they advanced to the Final Four after winning their four regional games by an average margin of 27.5 points. UofL is 7-2 all-time in the NCAA Tournament as a No. 1 seed.

WINNING A SECOND STRAIGHT ACC REGULAR SEASON TITLE

Last season, with the 67-40 win at Pitt, the Cards concluded ACC play with a 14-2 record and clinched their second straight ACC regular season title. It marked the program's seventh regular season conference crown and the first time in program history that they have won back-to-back.

HISTORY IN BIG DANCE

Last season, UofL made its 22nd NCAA Tournament appearance and 11th in 12 seasons under Walz. The Cardinals made their ninth straight NCAA Tournament and 14th in the last 15 years. Louisville is 34-22 all-time. They were 4-11 in their first 11 appearances and are 30-11 in their 11 appearances with Walz. They have moved on to the Sweet 16 nine times, Elite 8 five times and advanced to the NCAA Final Four three times (2009, 2013, 2018). With three Final Fours in the last 11 years, UofL ranks fourth in the country behind UConn (11), Stanford (6) and Notre Dame (6).

CARDINALS WELCOME IN COCHRAN, RUSSELL, SMITH AND VAN LITH

Louisville signed four top players to their 2020 class for the No. 5 class per espnW HoopGurlz - Olivia Cochran, a 6-foot-3 forward from Columbus, Ga., Merissah Russell, a 5-foot-11 guard from Ottawa, Ontario, Ahlana Smith, a 5-foot-9 guard from Charlotte, N.C., and Hailey Van Lith, a 5-foot-7 guard from Wenatchee, Wash.

■ **Cochran** comes to Louisville as the No. 18-ranked player in the class of 2020, according to espnW HoopGurlz. The five-star prospect is tabbed as the fourth-best player at the forward position. Prospects Nation ranks her No. 10 overall and as the third-best forward, while she is ranked No. 26 by PASS Scouting Service. She was named a first team Class 4-A All-State selection by the Atlanta Journal Constitution in 2018 and 2019, while being named honorable mention as a freshman in 2017. She was also named Georgia Class 4A All-State in 2018 and 2019.

■ **Russell** is ranked as the 29th best guard by espnW. She is listed as a four-star prospect by Prospects Nation and is rated No. 54 overall by PASS Scouting Service. She played for Canada's U19 team at the 2019 FIBA Women's Basketball World Cup in Bangkok, Thailand. She was also a member of Canada's Senior National team and participated as the youngest player on the roster in a five-game European exhibition tour in Belgium and Great Britain.

■ **Smith** is a 5-foot-9 shooting guard playing for Gulf Coast State junior college during the 2019-20 season. She spent the 2018-19 season at UCLA, where she played in 32 games, the most of among freshmen on the team. She averaged 12.6 minutes, 3.0 points and 1.9 rebounds on the year. At Mallard Creek High School, she was named First Team All-MeCKa 4A and State Tournament MVP as the Mavericks went 29-1 overall in her junior year.

■ **Van Lith** is a consensus top-10 player in the 2020 class and was a member of the U19 USA squad that won a gold medal in the FIBA World Cup in July. She has been a part of four USA gold medal teams (2019 FIBA U19 World Cup, 2019 FIBA 3x3 U18 World Cup, 2018 Youth Olympic Games, 2018 FIBA U17 World Cup). She is ranked as the No. 2 prospect in the nation by Prospect Nation and No. 8 overall and the top guard by espnW HoopGurlz. She was the Gatorade Player of the Year in Washington last season.
