OXFORD, MISS. – After trailing by seven in the fourth quarter, the Alabama women's basketball team drained three-consecutive threes to take control of the game and edge Ole Miss, 57-56, on Sunday afternoon inside The Pavilion in Oxford, Miss. The victory is the third Southeastern Conference win for the Crimson Tide (13-9, 3-6 SEC), while the Rebels (7-15, 0-9 SEC) are still seeking their first victory of 2020.

The Tide used a balanced scoring effort with five players scoring eight or more points. Junior Ariyah Copeland led the team with 11 points, while sophomore De'Sha Benjamin and senior Ashley Knight each added 10 points off the bench. Knight also grabbed eight boards while blocking three shots.

From Coach Curry

"I thought our bench really helped us," head coach Kristy Curry said. "Cierra (Johnson) came off the bench and really played well. She made some great decisions, played smart and showed some maturity. We have some kids that need to play better earlier in the game and down the stretch I went with Cierra's experience. De'Sha (Benjamin) was really good today, we shortened our bench in the second half and I think that was the difference."

Quarter-by-Quarter

The Crimson Tide found themselves in a battle from the start as the Rebels kept it close in the first quarter and only trailed 18-15 after the first 10 minutes of action.

The two sides went back-and-forth in the second quarter with Alabama only leading by as many as five at the beginning of the period. Ole Miss took the 30-28 lead with just over two minutes left in the half, before a jumper by Benjamin knotted things at 30-30 at the break.

Neither team could separate itself from the other in the third period, until the Rebels scored the final five points of the quarter to go up 48-42.

Ole Miss held the 51-44 advantage with over seven minutes to go when Alabama knocked in three-straight three-pointers to take the

53-51 lead with 5:59 to go. The Rebels countered with a three of their own to gain the 54-53 edge. Copeland scored two buckets in two minutes to put Alabama back on top 57-54 with under four in the game.

The Rebels cut the lead to 57-56 with 1:44 to go, however, the Tide held on for its third SEC victory of the season.

Player Spotlight

The post players for Alabama showed out as Copeland and Knight combined for 21 points on 8-of-12 shooting to go along with 13 rebounds. Sophomore Megan Abrams contributed solid minutes while putting in nine points and three assists.

Key Notes & Stats

The Crimson Tide tends to get to the free throw line more than its opponent and it did so against the Rebels. Alabama went 14-of-17 (82.4 percent) from the line, while holding Ole Miss to just three attempts.

Alabama won the battle in the paint, outrebounding the Rebels, 39-30. The Tide also scored more points in the paint, 30-16 and second chance points, 24-8. The UA bench outscored its opponent for the 21st time this season. The Alabama reserves outscored the Rebels' bench, 24-12.

OPENING TIP

 Alabama is ready to play against No. 15 Kentucky for the second time this season when the team flies to Lexington, Ky., on Thursday night at 7 p.m. ET/6 p.m. CT in Memorial Coliseum. The Crimson Tide (13-9, 3-6 SEC) and Wildcats (17-4, 6-3 SEC) last met on Jan. 9 in Coleman Coliseum with UK coming out on top 81-71.

• In the Tide's last game, Alabama held on for the 57-56 road victory against Ole Miss on Sunday, Feb. 2, while the Cats fell to unranked Florida without star Rhyne Howard who is sidelined with a wrist injury. Howard had a career-high 43 points in the first meeting against UA on Jan. 9.

• With the win in January, UK extended its winnning streak over the Tide to eight games. The last time the Crimson Tide defeated the Wildcats was in Lexington on Jan. 23, 2014, 57-55. Kentucky leads the overall series 32-17.

"FREE" THROWS

• Crimson Tide sophomore Megan Abrams has converted 19 of her last 20 free throw attempts, dating back to the South Carolina game on Jan. 5.

• Alabama is one of the best in the country at getting to the free throw line. The Crimson Tide is No. 26 in the nation in free throw attempts (439) and No. 22 in makes (308). UA is knocking down its attempts at a 70.2 percent clip which is good enough for fourth in the SEC.

LEWIS DOES IT ALL

• Redshirt junior Jordan Lewis became the program's 29th 1,000-point scorer on Jan. 20 at Tennessee. She currently has 1,045 career points. • The Crimson Tide has played its best basketball on Sundays by compiling an 8-1 record on the year. All three of Alabama's conference wins have come on Sunday with victories over Auburn, Vanderbilt and Ole Miss.

THE GAUNTLET TO START SEC PLAY

• The Crimson Tide had one of the toughest schedules to start Southeastern conference play with five out of its first eight games coming against top-25 teams. Six of the seven of the teams the Tide has played are in the top-50 in RPI, which included, Arkansas, Texas A&M, Tennessee , Kentucky (22), South Carolina (2) and LSU.

RECORD-BREAKING PERFORMANCE VS. VANDY

• The Crimson Tide had a record-breaking performance against Vanderbilt on Sunday, Jan. 26, with the Tide putting up the most points against an SEC team since 1999 after exploding for a 98-61 win over the Commodores. The 37-point victory was the largest margin of victory against an SEC team since Alabama defeated Mississippi State 97-64 on Jan. 13, 1996. Alabama was on fire from beyond the arc going 12-of-17 (70.6 percent) which is a school record for three-point percentage in a game with a minimum of eight three-pointers made.

KNIGHT BECOMES ALL-TIME BLOCK LEADER AT ALABAMA

• With three blocks against UNC (12/15), senior Ashley Knight passed Alabama great Yolanda Watkins for the most blocks in UA history. She currently has 210 career blocks, which is the most actively in the SEC. She still holds the single-season block record with 90 her freshman year.

• Knight is currently averaging 1.86 blocks per game which is No. 51 in the nation and sixth in the SEC. Her 41 blocked shots this season are good enough for No. 39 in the country and sixth in the conference.

DAVIS EARNS NATIONAL RECOGNITION

• In the win over North Carolina (12/15) Davis dropped a career-high 23 points on an impressive 10-of-12 shooting, which earned her multiple awards and recognition.

• On Dec. 16, College Sports Madness named Davis the National Player of the Week for her performance. On Dec. 17, the Southeastern Conference tabbed Davis as the SEC POW and then on Dec. 18, the NCAA placed her on the Starting Five, which is the top 5 players in the country for the week.

CURRY PICKS UP 100TH WIN AT ALABAMA

• Head Coach Kristy Curry picked up her 100th win of her career at Alabama on Nov. 17 against Mercer. Curry is in her seventh season with the Tide and is the program's No. 2 winningest coach in history. She is one of 10 coaches nationally to lead three different programs to 100 wins.

• Curry picked up her 400th career victory last season on Dec. 16 against Northwestern State.

ALABAMA ADDS TWO IN EARLY SIGNING PERIOD

• Myra Gordon is a 6-0 guard from Fort Worth, Texas, that had an incredible junior season at L.D. Bell High School in 2018-2019, averaging 27 points, eight rebounds, three assists, and two steals while leading her team to a district championship, under the direction of head coach Andy Bloodworth. For her efforts, Gordon was named Texas Girls Coaches Association All-State & Coaches All-State, while also


