TALON TIDBITS

- The game will mark the first official game head coach **Preston Spradlin** will coach against his former bench boss in John Calipari. Spradlin served five years on the staff before coming to Morehead State. The teams met in a charity exhibition game in 2017-18, Spradlin's first official year as MSU's head coach.
- Morehead State is still searching for the program's first-ever win over its Commonwealth foe Kentucky. The Eagles are 0-10 lifetime against the Wildcats.
- Morehead State joins five other OVC schools - Austin Peay, Jacksonville State, Eastern Kentucky, Southeast Missouri and UT Martin - with three players who are eligible this year who already have at least one season of Division I experience. The Eagles have **KJ Hunt, Jr.** (McNeese State), **Jaylen Sebree** (Florida Atlantic) and **Skyelar Potter** (Wright State.)
- Senior forward **James Baker, Jr.** is the lone senior listed on the roster. **DeVon Cooper** is also a fourth-year player but redshirted in 2019-20 due to injury and is a redshirt junior. It marks the lowest number of seniors on a Preston Spradlin-coached roster since his first year in 2017-18 when there were no seniors.
- James Baker, Jr.** enters the season ranked fourth in career blocked shots in program history with 104. As a sophomore in 2018-19, his 55 rejections led the OVC in games against league foes.
- Of Morehead State's 2,208 points scored in 2019-20, 35 percent (793) came from players who are active in 2020-21.
- MSU finished the regular season ranked No. 2 in the league in fewest turnovers per game (12.5) last season. The Eagles had 10 games with 10 giveaways or less.
- Morehead State has a 2-6 record in multi-team events in the last two seasons. The Eagles took part in the 2K Empire Classic in 2018-19 and the Hall of Fame Classic last season.
- Junior **Jaden Stanley-Williams** was raised on the Rocky Boys Native American Reservation in Montana. He eventually moved to Great Falls, Mont., and then Atlanta, Ga., to continue his basketball career.
- Four Eagles have prior experience on the Rupp Arena court. **James Baker, Jr.** (Meade County), **Jaylen Sebree** (Christian County), **Jacob Rice** (Johnson Central) and **Skyelar Potter** (Bowling Green Central) all played in the KHSAA Sweet 16 in Lexington during their prep careers.

The Eagles are happy to have reshirt junior **DēVon Cooper** back in the mix this year after an injury sidelined him in 2019-20. As a sophomore in 2018-19, Cooper shot 36 percent from three-point range and registered 16 double-figure scoring performances.

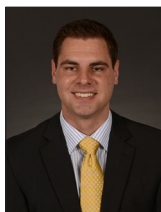

HEAD COACH PRESTON SPRADLIN

Preston Spradlin is his fourth season as full-time head coach after spending the majority of the 2016-17 season as interim head coach. He is in his seventh season overall with the Morehead State men's basketball program and his 12th year working with a Division I program.

Spradlin officially took on the interim head coaching position on Dec. 15, 2016, nine games into the 2016-17 season after the Eagles opened with a 2-7 record. He then guided Morehead State to a 12-9 record the rest of the way and a 10-6 mark in OVC play, which ranked second in the league.

During his three years as assistant coach, his time was spent in a variety of areas, including recruiting, scouting, practice/game preparation and academics monitoring. Following the 2015-16 season, Spradlin was named to the National Basketball Coaches Association (NABC) 2016 Under Armour 30-Under-30-Team, which recognizes 30 men's basketball coaches across the country that are under the age of 30.

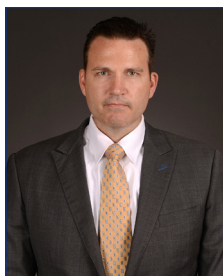
