2020-21 AT A GLANCE

- Florida looks to bounce back after its first SEC loss of the season, renewing the rivalry against Kentucky with a rare early-season meeting. Saturday marks the first January meeting between UF and UK in Gainesville since 2010, and Jan. 9 is the earliest date the teams have met since a Jan. 2, 1999, contest. Florida hasn't hosted UK this early on the calendar since a Jan. 3, 1979, meeting.
- Colin Castleton had a breakout week with the start of SEC play and earned co-SEC Player of the Week honors, scoring 23 against Vanderbilt and 21 vs. LSU. In both games, Castleton hit his stride in the second half of both games, scoring 17 second-half points vs. the Commodores and 19 against the Tigers.
- Castleton's offense was efficient in Nashville, going 11-for-13 from the field with five dunks. After early foul trouble limited Castleton to two points in two minutes during the first half vs. LSU, he scored the Gators' first 15 points of the second half over a six-minute span and totaled 19 of his 21 points after the break.
- The Gators rank #1 in the SEC in field goal percentage (.497) and #3 in scoring (81.7).
- Florida opened its SEC schedule with a 91-72 win at Vanderbilt, improving to 5-1 in SEC openers under White. The Gators' .618 field goal percentage was the team's best in a road SEC game since a .642 performance at South Carolina in 2007.
- UF's 83-79 win vs. LSU marked the fifth time in six meetings between the teams that the outcome was decided by five points or fewer.
- The COVID-19 pandemic scrambled the start of the Gators' non-conference schedule, pushing UF to its first December start since 1992 and its latest start since a Dec. 2 tip to the 1977-78 campaign.
- In the Gators' fourth game of the season, Keyontae Johnson's medical emergency became the focal point of
 the team's energy for the following weeks, and the remaining non-conference games were postponed (no
 makeup dates announced). Johnson was discharged from UF Health on Dec. 22 and is expected to be on the
 Gators' hands Saturday.
- Head coach Mike White looks to get back to his roots and push the pace this season and has the personnel to
 do it. In White's four seasons at Louisiana Tech, his teams averaged in the top-40 nationally in adjusted tempo
 (per KenPom). The Gators sat just outside the top 100 in tempo each of White's first two seasons at UF before
 slowing the pace in recent seasons.
- Florida opened the season with a win vs. Army, knocking off some rust en route to a 76-69 win while overcoming a 12-point deficit in the second half. Tre Mann had a career-best 19 points and five steals, the first Gator with a 19-point, five-steal game since Michael Frazier (2/3/15 at Vanderbilt).
- The Gators had a solid 90-70 win vs. Boston College with five Gators scoring double figures, including a 24-point, 12-rebound performance by Keyontae Johnson, which marked just the eighth 24/12 game by a Gator since 1996.
- The Gators have played the most challenging non-conference schedule of any power conference team over the
 course of Mike White's tenure. UF's schedule strength this season extends to the SEC slate where eight of 18
 games scheduled are vs. teams receiving votes in the preseason Top 25, five on the road and three at home.



The Communications Office believes in developing mutually beneficial relationships with the media and we emphasize a positive and professional working environment with all entities. The ultimate goal of the Communications Office is to provide accurate and timely information about our athletic teams and to ensure that we assist the media to the best of our abilities while they cover our program.

MEDIA COVERAGE

CREDENTIALS: Requests for credentials will be taken online and reviewed by Florida communications. All requests for the 2020-21 season will be on a game-by-game basis, and a health screening questionnaire must be completed as part of the process.

To access the credential request form, please visit www.sportssystems.com/floridahoops. Once you have submitted your credential request, you will receive an automated email from the Communications Department acknowledging your request was received and is being reviewed. Once a decision is made on your request, you will receive an email with further information.

CREDENTIAL PICK-UP: All media admittance will be via a will-call list at the loading dock entrance below Gate 3 for the 2020-21 season.

INTERNET CREDENTIALS: Only official websites of each participating institution, along with networks holding contractual broadcast rights to a game and websites affiliated with a national publication or news outlet, will be issued credentials.

PLAYER/STAFF INTERVIEWS: All interview requests for players or coaching staff should be coordinated through Denver Parler at least 24 hours in advance. Interviews will be arranged before or after practice according to class and meeting schedules during the preseason and once the season begins, players will typically be available at least once a week plus game days. Please contact Parler for player availability during the season.

The Communications Office will not give out home or cell phone numbers for any players, and players may not be contacted directly by phone, text, email or social media. Members of the media are not permitted in team areas. Team locker room, training room and strength complex are considered private work areas. These areas, as well as players' housing (on-campus and off-campus), are off-limits to media representatives.


