- Kentucky is in its 47th season with a 857-552 (.608) all-time record.
 The Wildcats have had great success in Memorial Coliseum, sitting at 469-160 (.746) overall in the historic building.
- The Wildcats are ranked No. 15 in the latest Associated Press Top 25 and No. 14 USA Today/Coaches Top 25.
- Kentucky started league play with back-to-back wins against top-15 teams, defeating No. 10 Arkansas and No. 12 Mississippi State. It's the third time ever and the first since December 2013 that UK has defeated back-to-back top-15 teams. It's the first time UK has accomplished the feat with both teams being league opponents.
- UK started SEC play with four straight games against top-15 ranked teams. It is the first time in program history that UK has played four straight games against top-15 ranked opponents. UK went 2-2.
- Three Wildcats are averaging double figures this season in Rhyne Howard, Dre'una Edwards and Chasity Patterson. Howard is averaging 19.1 points per game with 6.7 rebounds per game, hitting a team-best 31 3-pointers. Edwards is averaging 11.8 points per game on 51.7 percent from the field, adding 7.1 rebounds per game. Patterson leads the nation with 61 steals, while she averages 12.9 points per game. Patterson has 55 assists, while Howard has 49 assists.
- In league play, Howard is averaging 22.1 points per game, 7.0 rebounds per game and hitting 48.7 percent from the field with 30 assists and 10 steals. She ranks fourth in the SEC in 3-point FGM and fifth in the SEC in points per game overall.
- In 46 years of women's basketball, Kentucky has 98 wins over ranked opponents. UK is 3-4 this season with a win over No. 13 Indiana, No. 12 Mississippi State and No. 10 Arkansas.
- Mitch Barnhart removed the interim tag and named Kyra Elzy the program's eighth head coach on Monday, Dec. 14. She was named interim head coach following the abrupt retirement of Matthew Mitchell. The 2020-21 season is the ninth for Elzy in the Kentucky program with most of that time coming as the associate head coach. Elzy has recruited some of the best players to ever wear the Blue and White and helped guide the Wildcats to the SEC Championship in 2012 and two NCAA Elite Eights.

- In SEC opener, played 17 minutes and scored nine points with two rebounds. Huge defensively vs. MSU, playing 21 mins with 6 points, 4 rebs.
- Earned her first career start against Marshall, scoring 10 points with five rebounds. Went 4-of-6 from the field and 2-of-2 from free throw line.
- Transfered to UK after two seasons at Maryland where she sat out her sophomore season due to medical issues. Played 16 games as a freshman.



ROBYN BENTON · 5-9 · JUNIOR · GUARD · CONYERS. GA.

- Big Shot Rob hit three 3s against Arkansas and Alabama and two against Miss. State. In seven SEC games, has 66 points, 12-of-28 from 3.
- Shined in Kentucky's win at Kansas State with 11 points, hitting two 3s with three steals and five rebounds. Had 12pts/6rebs at DePaul.
- Scored nine points in the fourth quarter to help UK earn the come-from-behind win vs. No. 13 IU. Ended with 12 points in the game with a 3.



KEKE MCKINNEY · 6-1 · SENIOR · FORWARD · KNOXVILLE. TENN.

- Scored 10+ in three straight games for first time in her career vs. AU, MSU, TAMU. Hit a 3 in six of seven SEC games. 7th all-time in blocks with 99.
- Big game against Arkansas with 10 points and seven rebounds, adding a block, steal and an assist in 37 minutes.
- Recorded her second career double-double vs. Belmont with 10 points and 10 rebounds. Averaging 32.2 minutes and 5.3 rebounds this season.



BLAIR GREEN · 6-0 · JUNIOR · GUARD · HARLAN COUNTY, KY. Strong 4th guarter vs. Arkansas, scoring 8 of her 10 points in the final stanza, including a 3-pointer and career-high three blocks. Hit 2 3s vs. MSU.

- Career game against Vanderbilt, scoring a career-high 22 points on 7-of-10 FG and 4-of-5 3FG. Added five rebounds and two steals.
- Led Kentucky in scoring in back-to-back games (Vanderbilt, at Auburn). Hit a 3 in 10 games, including four vs. Vandy. Has 3+ rebs in seven games.



RHYNE HOWARD · 6-2 · JUNIOR · GUARD · CLEVELAND. TENN.

- espnW POW after 24 points, 10 rebounds vs. Arkansas and then followed with 33 points, 10 rebs at MSU. Had 25 pts in 4Q and OT vs. MSU.
- Scored game-high 22 points at TAMU and followed with 32 points against South Carolina. In SEC play, avg. 22.1 points and 7.0 rebounds per game.
- Has scored 1,406 career points sitting 17th in UK history in points scored. She needs 27 points to tie 16th. Needs 96 more to move into the top 10.



TREASURE HUNT · 6-1 · FRESHMAN · GUARD · CHATTANOOGA TENN.

- First career start vs. Vanderbilt, scoring 11 points, grabbing five rebounds, forcing two blocks and dishing out two assists.
- Ranked as a top-10 player in the 2020 class by All Star Girls Report, while ESPN ranked her as a five-star player and the 28th best in the class.
- Averaged 24.7 points per game with 5.3 rebounds per game, 2.3 assists per game and 1.6 steals per game as a senior at Hamilton Heights.



JAZMINE MASSENGILL · 6-0 · JUNIOR · GUARD · CHATTANOOGA TENN.

- First UK player to come off bench and have at least seven assists in SEC game since Crystal Riley vs. Florida on Feb. 18, 2010. Has hit a 3 in 4 games.
- Played 21 minutes against Arkansas with five points, adding three assists, three blocks, two rebounds and a steal. Went 1-of-1 from the arc.
- Was going to sit out 2020-21 due to NCAA Transfer rules but with blanket NCAA waiver passed Dec. 16, she is eligible and will play this season.



TATYANA WYATT · 6-2 · SENIOR · FORWARD · COLUMBUS. GA.

- Made first start this season vs. Alabama, scoring nine points on 3-of-4 shooting, added two rbs, one blk, one ast. Played in 11 games this year.
- In first action of the season, Wyatt played 13 minutes with two rebounds and a steal, hitting a huge 3-pointer in the second half vs. Indiana.
- Last year, averaged 6.3 pts and 3.7 rbs per game hitting 39.4 percent from the floor with nine 3s. Will benefit from the post depth this season.



CHASITY PATTERSON · 5-6 · JUNIOR · GUARD · HOUSTON, TEXAS

- Has recorded 10+ pts in 12 games. Career-high 10 stls vs. Wofford. Second player in program history to record 10 or more steals in a game.
- Dished out seven asts vs. Vandy. Has recorded 8+ stls 3 times. Leads nation with 61 stls. Scored 30 pts in season opener with six rbs and eight stls.
- Was named the SEC 6th Woman of the Year last season after playing 19 games and averaging 11.5 points per game with 29 assists and 25 3s.



ERIN TOLLER · 5-7 · FRESHMAN · GUARD · LOUISVILLE KY.

- Played in the first two games this season scoring six points against Murray State with three steals hitting a 3.
- A talented point guard who is a floor general at the position and can score in a variety of ways ... In-state prospect from Louisville's Sacred Heart.
- First-team all-state by the Herald-Leader after a strong senior season hitting 84 3s with 16.4 points per game and 5.7 rebounds per game.



NYAH LEVERETTER · 6-3 · FRESHMAN · FORWARD · BLYTHEWOOD. S.C.

- Scored three points vs. Murray State in season opener, adding five rebounds and two blocks. Had 8 rebounds vs. Marshall in 22 minutes.
- Best season at Westwood High School was her senior year when she averaged 13.3 points per game and 11.0 rebounds per game.
- South Carolina Basketball Coaches Association AAAA All-State Team in 2019 after averaging 11.9 points and 9.8 rebounds as a junior.



KAMERON ROACH · 5-6 · JUNIOR · GUARD · HOPKINS. S.C.

- Scored her first points in nearly two years, playing 10 minutes vs. Marshall and hitting a 3. She also had two assists and a rebound.
- Played in 13 games in 2018-19 seeing 4.2 minutes per game before she tore her Achilles towards the end of 2018-19 and missed all of last season.
- Saw six minutes in the 2018-19 season opener vs. Alabama State with three steals, four rebounds and recorded her first 3 in a game



EMMA KING · 5-10 · FRESHMAN · GUARD · STANFORD. KY.

- Earned her first two career starts vs. Murrav State and Belmont ... Did not score but had 1 reb.. 3 asts, and 1 steal vs. MSU and 3 rebs vs. Belmont.
- Played in 15 games last season averaging 7.1 minutes per game ... Best game came in her debut against Mount St. Mary's, hitting two 3s with 7 pts.
- Led Lincoln County in scoring as a senior averaging 18.5 points and 7.3 rebounds while hitting 44.3 percent from the field and 38.2 percent from 3.



DRE'UNA EDWARDS · 6-2 · SOPHOMORE · FORWARD · LAS VEGAS. NEV.

- First UK player since 2016-17 to record three straight double-doubles: 14pts/10rebs vs. IU, 16pts/12rebs vs. K-State and 27pts/15rebs vs. Belmont.
- Has scored 10 or more points in 11 games and has 10 or more rebounds in five games. Had a career-best four blocks vs. DePaul and Vandy.
- Transfered to UK after her freshman season at Utah averaging 11.6 points and 6.7 rebounds en route to Pac-12 Freshman of the Year honors.

- Howard continued to show why she is the best player in women's college basketball, leading Kentucky in scoring in both games. In the league opener vs. Arkansas, Howard scored 24 points with 10 rebounds, adding four 3s made and four assists. The 24 points was a season high before she paced Kentucky at State with 33 points, adding 10 rebounds, six assists, a block and a steal. Against State, Howard put the team on her back late in the game scoring 25 of her 33 points in the fourth quarter and overtime. In fact, Howard scored 25 of Kentucky's final 31 points in the game, including 10 of the team's 14 overtime points.
- Howard is the first player in school history to score at least 33 points with 10 rebounds and six assists against an SEC opponent and the second player to accomplish the feat against any opponent, joining Belitta Croley. The native of Cleveland, Tennessee, had two double-doubles on the week, which were her second and third double-doubles of the season. Howard also led UK in assists in both games, while her eight 3s made during the week moved her up to fourth all-time in program history in 3s made in a career.

- The consecutive top-15 wins has given the Wildcats and junior guard Rhyne Howard national praise. Below is a collection of the awards UK and Howard have received this week.
- Kyra Elzy was named espnW National Coach of the Week

KENTUCKY. WOMEN'S BASKETBALL

- Kentucky was named USBWA National Team of the Week
- Rhyne Howard was named espnW National Player of the Week, Naismith Trophy National Player of the Week, College Sports Madness National Player of the Week and SEC Player of the Week.

DIFFICULT STRETCH TO START CONFERENCE ACTION

- Kentucky vs. South Carolina on Sunday, Jan. 10 was the fourth and final in a four-game stretch where Kentucky played four top-15 teams in 11 days. It marked the first time in program history UK played four straight games against top-15 ranked teams.
- UK started the stretch with a 75-64 win over No. 10 Arkansas before a 92-86 overtime win at No. 12 Mississippi State. The Wildcats ran out of gas down the stretch at No. 8 Texas A&M, falling 77-60 after the game was tied 31-31 at halftime and UK held a lead with just over 4 minutes to go in the third quarter. UK went 7:17 without scoring over the end of the third quarter and start of the fourth quarter against the Aggies. It led to a 14-0 TAMU run that all but sealed the victory. Kentucky had a nine-point lead on South Carolina at halftime, but went cold again from the field in the second half, allowing the Gamecocks to score 43 second-half points.
- Kentucky's back-to-back wins against top-15 ranked opponents marked the third time in program history the Wildcats have accomplished that and the first since Dec. 2013. It was the first time that UK has defeated consecutive top-15 SEC foes in program history.
- Kentucky and LSU are the only two teams that are currently scheduled to play four straight games against currently ranked league teams. UK went vs. Arkansas, at Mississippi State, at TAMU and vs. South Carolina. In February, LSU will go at South Carolina, at Kentucky, vs. Arkansas and vs. Mississippi State.

"HOME SWEET HOME" VS. "ON THE ROAD AGAIN"

- Kentucky is 9-1 at home this season and is playing its best basketball inside Memorial Coliseum. In the 10 home games, UK is averaging 79.9 ppg, hitting 46.8 percent from the field and 36.6 percent from 3. The Wildcats are hitting 7.8 3s per game at home with 16.5 assists per game, 8.9 steals per game and a +4.7 rebounding margin.
- In its six road games, UK averaged 70.5 points per game, hitting 42.1 percent from the field and 31.9 percent from arc. The Wildcats are hitting 7.7 3-pointers per game on the road with 13.7 assists per game, 11.0 steals per game and a -3.3 rebounding margin.
- UK has a +5.0 turnover margin at home and a +1.7 turnover margin on the road.

CATS END NON-CONFERENCE WITH WIN OVER WOFFORD

- Coming off its first loss of the season (at DePaul), Kentucky responded in a big way vs. Wofford, scoring a season-high 98 points while limiting Wofford to 37 points on 28.3 percent shooting. UK had four players in double-figures and earned 18 steals with 17 assists.
- It was Kentucky's third largest margin of victory in a game immediately following a loss in school history (61 points) (Kentucky defeated Grambling State by 63 points on Dec. 29, 2013 after losing to Duke by 8 points on Dec. 22, 2013; Kentucky defeated Chicago State by 62 points on Dec. 20, 1992 after losing to Oklahoma State by 4 points on Dec. 19, 1992).
- Kentucky went on four 10-0 runs or more in the game, including a season-long 18-0 run in the second half which followed a 15-0 run in the first half.
- UK held Wofford to single digits in the first and second quarters, marking the first time UK had accomplished that since holding LSU to six first-quarter points and nine second-quarter points on Feb. 24, 2019.
- For the first time this season, Kentucky scored 20+ points in all four quarters.
- UK won the rebounding battle 45-29 and has recorded 45 or more rebounds in back-to-back games for the first time since recording 45 in back-to-back games during the 2015-16 season. Kentucky's +16 rebounding margin was its largest since 2018 vs. Sacred Heart (+22).
- The Wildcats forced a season-high 33 turnovers and scored a season-high 49 points off turnovers in the game.

COMEBACK CATS STRIKE VS. NO. 13 INDIANA

- Trailing by 14 in the first half and 13 at halftime, Niya Butts challenged the team at halftime to get tougher and show the resilience that is preached in the program. The Wildcats responded by outscoring Indiana 49-32 in the second half, including 21-14 in the fourth quarter to earn the win. Elzy missed the game due to health concerns unrelated to COVID-19.
- Indiana led for 31:53 in the game, including a double-digit lead for a majority of the second half. IU's biggest lead was 14 at 6:44 in the second quarter. UK erasing that lead marks the 12th-largest comeback in school history. The 14-point comeback win is the largest for Kentucky since March 6, 2015 when it trailed Mississippi State by 15 and came back to win.
- The 14-point comeback win is the largest for Kentucky at Memorial Coliseum since Dec. 1, 2013 vs. Louisville when the Cats also trailed by 14.
- After Indiana went up 10 at 59-49 with exactly 7:00 to go in the game, UK went on a 11-0 run over the next 4:09 to grab a 60-59 lead with 2:51 to play. UK now has a 10-0 run or better in every game this season. Indiana grabbed its last lead of the game when it ended UK's 11-0 run with two free throws but Kentucky responded with a 6-0 run, including two Edwards free throws and back-to-back baskets by Howard and Benton to seal the victory.
- Kentucky went 12-of-14 from the free-throw line in the fourth quarter, including 10-for-10 in the final 2:51 of the game.

- Kentucky hit a then-season-high eight 3s in the game, going 8-of-16 from long range.
- The Hoosier had limited their first two opponents to a combined 77 points with UK nearly doubling that Sunday with 72.

4TH-QUARTER RALLY POWERS UK PAST K-STATE IN SEC/BIG 12 CHALLENGE

- After a cold night from the field where the preseason national player of the year went just 3-of-14 from the field and 0-of-7 from 3, the Wildcats were searching for an answer on the road at Kansas State heading into the fourth quarter. UK was clinging to a 43-41 lead heading into the final period before a K-State 3 gave them a one-point lead. It was then that UK kicked it into gear, outscoring K-State 17-5 the rest of the quarter, including ending the game on a 11-0 run to seal the win.
- All seven Wildcats that played in the quarter scored while Dre'una Edwards led the way with five points. Kentucky went 7-of-12 from the field while K-State was held to 3-of-12. Ten of UK's 17 points in the final guarter came in the paint while UK had four steals in the 4th.
- Edwards led the way with her second-straight double-double, scoring 16 points with 12 rebounds, while Chasity Patterson and Robyn Benton each had 11 points. Patterson added two assists while Benton hit two 3s and added three steals.

BIG DAWG POWERING KENTUCKY WITH DOUBLE-DOUBLES

- After only playing six minutes in Kentucky's season opener due to foul trouble, head coach Kyra Elzy told reporters postgame that they did not get to see how the real Dre'una Edwards in the game but would soon.
- She was right as Edwards led Kentucky the following game vs. Belmont, scoring 27 points with 15 rebounds, hitting two 3s with three steals in 29 minutes of play. Fifteen points and nine rebounds came in the second half alone. During the game, Edwards set a career high in field-goals made with 11 and attempted with 19. She also had a career high in 3s made with two. The double-digit scoring performance was the 19th of her career while it was the third 20+ performance for her. It was her eighth career double-double and she is the first Kentucky player with at least 27 points with 15 rebounds in a game since Evelyn Akhator vs. Miss. State on Feb. 23, 2017.
- Two more double-double performances immediately followed, as Edwards recorded 16 points and 12 rebounds vs. Kansas State and 14 points and 10 rebounds against Indiana.
- Edwards is the first UK player since Akhator in 2016-17 to record three straight double-doubles.
- The forward got her fourth double-double at DePaul with 18 points and 11 rebounds, adding a career-high four blocks with five assists.

PATTERSON BECOMING A STAR FOR WILDCATS

- Chasity Patterson scored UK's first nine points vs. Murray State, hitting two 3-pointers and completing an and-one to set the tone early in UK's season opening 86-60 vs. the Racers. Patterson played 28 minutes in the game with 30 points, going 8-of-13 from the field, 2-of-4 from 3 and 12-of-13 from the free-throw line. She also grabbed a career-high six rebounds and career-high eight steals with three assists. Her 30-point performance was one-point shy of the program record of points scored by a UK player in a season opener. Patterson was lights out in the first half, going 5-of-6 from the field, 2-of-2 from 3 and 9-of-9 from the free-throw line for 21 first-half points. She also had four rebounds and three steals.
- Patterson is the third player in school history to score at least 30 points in a season opener joining Leslie Nichols (31 vs. Marshall on Nov. 22, 1985) and Valerie Still (30 vs. UT-Chattanooga on Nov. 30, 1981.
- This season, Patterson has recorded eight steals vs. Murray State and DePaul before 10 vs. Wofford.
- Patterson is the third player in program history to record 10 or more steals in a game. Leslie Nichols holds the program record with 11 steals vs. UofL on Feb. 14, 1986.
- Patterson and Nichols are also the only players in school history to record eight or more steals in three or more games in a season.
- Patterson has 61 steals this season to lead the nation.
- Patterson has scored 10 or more points in every game but four this season Marshall, Arkansas, Texas A&M and Auburn.
- On Tuesday, Jan. 26, Patterson was named to the 2020-21 Naismith Women's Defensive Player of the Year Watch List.

"MORE CONFIDENT" GREEN

- So far this season, Kentucky coaches have raved about the confidence and performance of Blair Green, who came back to campus in July in shape, stronger and ready for a breakout season.
- Green started for Kentucky in the season opener againt Murray State, going 5-of-10 from the field and 3-of-5 from arc for 13 points. She added four rebounds, three assists, one block and one steal. It was the third time in Green's career she hit three or more 3s and the 11th 10+ point game.
- Green had a career game against Marshall, scoring a career-high 17 points with a rebound and two steals. Green also set career highs in field goals made with eight and tied a career high in field goals attempted with 13.
- Green scored 10 points against Arkansas, including eight in the fourth quarter. She hit a huge three late in the game to give UK a 66-60 boast, and she had a career-high three blocks.

- Green had another career game against Vanderbilt, scoring a team-high 22 points on 7-of-10 shooting, including a remarkable 4-of-5 from the arc, while she added five rebounds and two steals.
- The guard led the team in scoring in back-to-back games, first vs. Vanderbilt, and then at
- Auburn when she went 7-of-9 from the field, including 2-of-3 from the arc, to post 18 points. When Green scores, Kentucky wins. Green has scored 3 or less points six times this season vs. Indiana, at DePaul, at TAMU, vs. South Carolina, at Tennessee and vs. Alabama. When she scores 4 or more points, UK is 10-0. Kentucky is 9-1 when Green hits a 3-pointer.
- Green has hit a 3 in 10 games this season and is averaging 25 minutes per game.

KEKE MCKINNEY: THE LEADER

- Since the first day she stepped on campus, KeKe McKinney has been the obvious vocal leader for the Wildcats with her outgoing personality and natural leadership skills. The forward showed that yet again in UK's opener, playing a team-high 32 minutes with six points, three rebounds, four steals, two assists and two blocks. Her four steals tied a career high.
- Head coach Kyra Elzy talked postgame about how McKinney was key to UK's success in the season opener vs. Murray State: "I thought KeKe (McKinney) really stepped up to the plate in our black press, we scored off of our defense."
- McKinney followed with her second career double-double vs. Belmont, scoring 10 points with 10 rebounds. She had five points and eight rebounds against Kansas State. McKinney played 35 minutes vs. Indiana with five rebounds, three assists, two blocks and took a key charge late in the game.
- McKinney played 37 minutes against Arkansas, scoring 10 points with a 3 pointer adding seven rebounds. She was the defensive key for Kentucky, making sure things clicked.
- The forward continued to shine against Mississippi State with 11 points and four rebounds, hitting a career-high tying three 3s.
- McKinney scored 10+ in her third straight game for the first time in her career against Texas A&M, scoring 12 points with five rebounds and hit two 3s.
- McKinney scored 11 points on 4-of-6 shooting, including an impressive 3-of-4 from long range, adding three assists against Vanderbilt.
- McKinney ranks seventh all-time in program history with 99 blocks.
- In league play, McKinney is averaging 7.9 points per game, hitting 44.2 percent from the field and 12-of-26 from long range with 5.0 rebounds per game.

KENTUCKY RANKED NO. 10/8 AT START OF DECEMBER

- For the first time since 2016, Kentucky entered the top 10 of the Associated Press Top 25, ranking No. 9 for two weeks in early December.
- The Wildcats are ranked No. 15 in the latest Associated Press Top 25 and No. 14 USA Today/ Coaches Top 25.
- UK began the season ranked in the top 16 of both preseason listings, which was the highest preseason rankings for the Wildcats since the 2014-15 team started at No. 11 in the AP Top 25 and No. 10 in the Coaches' Top 25. UK has finished its season ranked in the top 25 of both major listings 10 of the last 11 seasons.
- In the AP poll, UK still will face No. 4 South Carolina, No. 20 Tennessee and No. 22 Georgia. In the coaches' poll, UK is scheduled to play No. 3 South Carolina and No. 22 Tennessee.
- UK is 3-4 vs. ranked teams in 2020-21 defeating No. 13 Indiana, No. 12 Mississippi State and No. 10 Arkansas. The losses were at No. 24 DePaul, at No. 8 Texas A&M, vs. No. 5 South Carolina and at No. 25 Tennessee.
- Kentucky has been a mainstay in the AP poll over the last 10 years. In the last 221 polls, the Wildcats have been ranked or receiving votes 204 times, only being left out of 17 polls.
- UK has been ranked 46 straight weeks the 10th longest active streak in the nation.

STRONG CAREER DEBUTS FOR HUNT, LEVERETTER, TOLLER

• All three true freshmen for Kentucky played in the season opener vs. Murray and performed well. Treasure Hunt led the way with 12 points, going 2-of-5 from 3. Her 12 points ties the 11th highest scoring output for a UK player in their varsity debut. Toller played nine minutes and scored six points with three steals, hitting a 3, while Leveretter played 17 minutes and grabbed five rebounds with three points and two blocks.

OWENS, BENTON IMPRESS

- Robyn Benton and Olivia Owens showed they are going to be impact players for UK in the season opener. Owens was the first sub off the bench for Kentucky and played 18 minutes with seven points and nine rebounds. Benton played 20 minutes and scored seven points with five rebounds, three assists and two steals. Both brought energy and played solid on the defensive end for the Wildcats.
- Benton hit her first 3 as a Wildcat against Belmont and scored nine points with five rebounds and led UK with four assists. Owens played 17 minutes and scored five points with two rebounds and two blocks.
- Against Kansas State, Benton was the spark UK needed off the bench scoring 11 points with five rebounds and three steals. Owens gave UK great minutes, playing 10 minutes with two points and two rebounds.
- Benton was huge in Kentucky's win against No. 13 Indiana, scoring 12 points, going 3-of-5 from the field and 1-of-2 from 3 with a rebound and a block. In the fourth quarter with Kentucky trailing 55-59, Benton hit a 3 and followed with two free throws the following pos-

- Owens and Benton both played huge minutes against Arkansas. Owens played 17 minutes with nine points and two rebounds. Benton played 14 minutes and went 3-of-4 from 3 with four rebounds and an assist.
- The two transfers were huge against Mississippi State. Benton played 20 minutes hitting two 3s for 10 points, while Owens played 21 points and scored six points with four rebounds.
- On her 21st birthday, Benton had a solid shooting day against Alabama at Rupp Arena. In less than 24 minutes, she scored a season-high 15 points on 6-of-10 shooting from the field and 3-of-5 shooting from long range, adding four rebounds, a steal and a block.

HOWARD EARNS ALL THE PRESEASON HONORS AND THEN SOME

- It seemed every day this preseason junior guard Rhyne Howard was receiving more and more preseason praise as the guard has headlined nearly every preseason watch list and been named SEC Preseason Player of the Year by league coaches and league media.
- Howard has been named to the 2021 Naismith Trophy Preseason Watch List, 2021 WBCA Wade Trophy Watch List and 2021 Chervl Miller Award Preseason Watch List. Howard was a finalists last season for the Naismith Trophy and Cheryl Miller Award.
- Howard became the first UK player to be named a first-team preseason All-American by the AP. She has also been named a Preseason All-American by Lindy's Sports.

- Rhyne Howard is at it again this season, showing she is the best player in college basketball. The guard has been amazing for Kentucky this season, averaging a team-best 19.1 points per game with 6.7 rebounds per game. RECAPPING HOWARD'S SENSATIONAL SOPHOMORE SEASON

- It was an amazing sophomore season for Rhyne Howard, who was a first-team All-America honoree by the AP, USBWA and Wooden Award and a finalist for the Naismith Trophy, Cheryl Miller Award and Ann Meyers Drysdale National Player of the Year award.
- Howard led the Wildcats and ranked second nationally with 23.4 points per game. The guard also led UK with 6.5 rebounds per game and 62 steals, while she was second on the team with 29 blocks and third on the team with 68 assists. Howard hit 84 3-pointers last season, which was the most in program history in a single season, topping the previous record of 81 set by Sara Potts in 2004-05. Her 3.1 3-pointers per game in 2019-20 ranked top-10 nation-

ally while her 633 total points ranked fifth nationally. Howard's 23.4 scoring average was the most for a UK player under Matthew Mitchell and the fourth-best in program history.

- Howard placed her name all over the Kentucky record books in 2019-20 as the only player in program history to score 25 or more points in five straight games while she was the second player to score 20 or more points in eight straight games. Howard had two stretches during the season of 20 or more points in eight straight games, including each of her last eight games played after missing three games with a finger injury.
- Two of the top-12 scoring performances in program history came last season by Howard. The first was her 37 points in UK's win vs. Tennessee followed by a school-record tying 43 points at Alabama. She is the only player in program history to score 37+ points in consecutive games and the first to hit seven or more 3-pointers in consecutive games. Howard earned six double-doubles last season and has 11 for her career.

KENTUCKY PICKED TO FINISH 2ND BY LEAGUE COACHES, 3RD BY MEDIA

 SEC coaches tabbed UK to finish second in the league standings this season while league media picked the Wildcats to finish third. Both league coaches and league media picked Rhyne Howard as the SEC Preseason Player of the Year and Preseason All-SEC First Team.

ELZY NAMED INTERIM HEAD COACH

- Following the abrupt retirement of Matthew Mitchell, who is the winningest head coach in program history, Kentucky Director of Athletics Mitch Barnhart moved quickly to named Kyra Elzy as the interim head coach. After a 6-0 start, Barnhart removed the interim tag on Dec. 14 as Elzy signed a contract to stay the program's head coach until 2025-26.
- Elzy spent eight seasons as an assistant coach for Kentucky, including six of those years as associate head coach. She has been a part of some of the best seasons in program history.
- In her eight years as an assistant coach at Kentucky, the Wildcats have been to the NCAA Tournament six times, including two NCAA Elite Eights. UK won the SEC Regular Season Championship in 2012 - only its second in program history. UK has had a winning season in seven of those eight season, including six 20-win seasons and six 10+ wins in league play.
- Under Elzy, UK won 181 games, including 78 league games and 23 vs. ranked teams.
- At Kentucky, Elzy has coached three SEC Player of the Year (Victoria Dunlap, A'dia Mathies, Rhyne Howard), three SEC Freshman of the Year (A'dia Mathies, Bria Goss, Rhyne Howard), one SEC Defensive Player of the Year (Victoria Dunlap), two SEC 6th Woman of the Year (Keyla Snowden, Chasity Patterson), two SEC Scholar-Athletes of the Year (Alyssa Rice and Maci Morris) and her players have earned 39 All-SEC honors overall.

THE MAGIC "80"

• UK holds a remarkable 363-25 (.936) record since 1974 when scoring 80 points or more. The last loss came at DePaul on Dec. 16, 2020 when the Cats fell 86-82. UK is 6-1 this year.

UK IN OVERTIME

• UK is 31-27 all-time in overtime games, including a 1-0 mark under Elzy.

KENTUCKY ALL-TIME

Kentucky is 857-552 (.608) in its 47th year of varsity women's basketball.

KENTUCKY ALL-TIME AT HOME

- UK is 496-177 all-time at home (.737). Kentucky is 469-160 (.746) all-time in Memorial Coliseum and 29-19 (.604) all-time in Rupp Arena.
- If you do the math, you will notice UK's losses in Memorial Coliseum and Rupp Arena are 2 more than UK has home losses. That reason is UK's NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 game vs. Washington at Rupp Arena on March 25, 2016 and its NCAA Tournament game vs. Indiana on March 18, 1983 at Memorial Coliseum cannot count towards UK's home record.

CATS SHINE IN THE CLASSROOM

• Kyra Elzy has put an emphasis on academics since arriving on campus as an assistant coach several years ago. The Wildcats have had a 3.0 team GPA or better each of the last 15 semesters. In nine season with Coach Elzy on staff, Kentucky has a 100-percent graduation rate among four-year players. UK had a 3.253 team GPA in the fall of 2020.

11 STRAIGHT YEARS TOP 20 IN ATTENDANCE

It was another magical year inside Memorial Coliseum and Rupp Arena for UK in 2019-20





as the Wildcats won 14 home games and finished with an average home attendance of 4,756 ranking 19th nationally. This marks the 11th straight year the Wildcats have finished in the top 20 in NCAA national average attendance.

- Throughout 17 home games two played inside historic Rupp Arena - Kentucky accumulated a total season attendance of 80,853, marking the 11th straight season the Wildcats have amassed 80,000 fans or more.
- Kentucky has averaged 4,500 or more fans every year since 2009-10. The Wildcats have continuously pushed the school's attendance numbers to new altitudes in the last 12 seasons. Kentucky was involved in two of the top-25 most attended games in the nation during the 2019-20 season, including 11,256 fans vs. Louisville at Rupp Arena which ranked 23rd.
- The Wildcats attracted large crowds not only in Lexington, but all across the country. A total of 135,443 fans attended Kentucky games, ranking the team 18th nationally.
- The Southeastern Conference once again led the nation in attendance with an average of 4,183 fans per game and a total attendance of 924,471. The Big 12 was second in the rankings with a average attendance of 4,046

ELZY CONTINUES SEC WIN CHALLENGE FOR WE BACK PACK

 For the ninth season. UK interim head coach Kyra Elzy and her husband Dexter, are leading the SEC Win Challenge to help raise awareness and funds for Alzheimer's research through the Pat Summitt Foundation. The 2019-20 SEC Win Challenge raised over \$25,000 for the foundation.

MITCHELL RETIRES AS WINNINGEST HEAD COACH

- Matthew Mitchell, who was the seventh head coach in program history and won 303 games at the helm of the program retired from coaching on Nov. 12 and thus resigned as head coach. Mitchell had brain surgery this offseason after sustaining a concussion and missed most of preseason practice. Mitchell briefly returned to practice this preseason, but after struggling to get back to full speed he elected to retire.
- Here are some of the accomplishments during Mitchell's 13-year tenure: Became UK's all-time winningest coach on March 3, 2013 with 139 wins in just six seasons ... Including the storied history of the UK MBB program, he was the third Kentucky Basketball head coach to win 300 games with the Wildcats joining Adolph Rupp and John Calipari ... Had 129 career SEC wins, which at the time of his retirement was 8th most in league history ... Two-time SEC Coach of the Year (2010 & 2019) ... Was the eighth coach in league history to win multiple honors ... Led UK to postseason play in 11 of his 13 seasons. (2 WNIT, 9 NCAA, 1 canceled NCAA) ... School-record eight consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances from 2010-2017 ... Three NCAA Elite Eight finishes. (2010, 2012 and 2013) ... Five Sweet 16 appearances. (2010, 201Thought 2, 2013, 2014, 2016) ... Led UK to its first SEC Regular Season Championship in 30 years during the 2011-12 season ... Twelve top-four finishes in the SEC in his 13 seasons ... 132 consecutive appearances in the AP Top 25 poll from 2009-10 to 2017 (8th longest streak in poll history.) ... Schoolrecord eight straight 20-win seasons from 2010-2017 ... Compiled an impressive 183-42 (.813) mark at home (includes Rupp) ... Led UK to a school-record 30 wins in 2012-13.

Memorial Coliseum (8,000)

- The Coliseum covers an entire city block and has as much space as a seven-story office building. It currently has a capacity of 8,000.
- The Coliseum was built in 1950 and serves as a memorial to every Kentuckian who lost their life serving their country.
- A massive new LED video board spanning approximately 1,800 square feet with dimensions of 30 feet by 60 feet was installed in Memorial Coliseum in 2018.
- Wildcat fans are passionate about their basketball, that's why UK has ranked in the nation's top 20 and in the SEC's top four in attendance 11 straight years.
- UK averaged 5,186 fans per game in 2017-18 which ranked 15th nationally.
- UK drew 116,164 fans for its home games in 2015-16 the second-highest total attendance in school history.



Rupp Arena (23,500)

- Rupp Arena is entering its 45th season.
- An awesome structure in sight and scope, the arena is divided into two seating areas. The lower level features 10,000 cushioned theater seats while the upper arena has new chairback seats on the sidelines. The latter can be visually isolated to provide more natural setting for small shows.
- The Wildcats command an exclusive and updated state-of-the-art locker room, while other amenities include six team-size dressing rooms and eight smaller units.
- In 2013-14, UK set the new single-game attendance record when 23,706 fans saw UK face No. 2 Duke in Rupp Arena on Dec. 22, 2013. The attendance marked the largest crowd ever to see a college women's hoops game in the Commonwealth the previous mark was 22,152 for the first Kentucky-Louisville game played in the KFC Yum! Center on Dec. 5, 2010.
- In 2015-16, Kentucky packed 17,150 fans in Rupp Arena on Dec. 20 against Duke, which was the fourth-largest home crowd in program history. On Dec. 10, the Wildcats had 14,425 fans at the historic arena, which was the sixth-largest home crowd in school history.

- Named espnW National Coach of the Week on January 4, 2021, after back-to-back top-12 wins to start conference action (then-No. 10 Arkansas and then-No. 12 Mississippi State). It marked the first time Kentucky has ever earned back-to-back wins against teams ranked in the top-12 of the AP poll.
- Became the eighth head coach in UK women's basketball history as UK AD Mitch Barnhart named her head coach on Dec. 14, 2020 following the retirement of Matthew Mitchell.
 Has been a huge key to the program's success the last 12 years as she has spent nine sea-
- Has been a huge key to the program's success the last 12 years as she has spent nine seasons on the Kentucky staff. Started as assistant coach from 2008-2010 then associate head coach 2010-2012. Returned to UK in 2016 as the associate head coach.
- In her eight years as an assistant coach at Kentucky, the Wildcats have been to the NCAA Tournament six times, including two NCAA Elite Eights. UK won the SEC Regular Season Championship in 2012 - only its second in program history. UK has had a winning season in seven of those eight season, including six 20-win seasons and six 10+ wins in league play.
 As an assistant at UK, Elzy helped UK win 181 games, including 78 league games and 23 victories over ranked teams.
- At Kentucky, Elzy has coached three SEC Player of the Year (Victoria Dunlap, A'dia Mathies, Rhyne Howard), three SEC Freshman of the Year (A'dia Mathies, Bria Goss, Rhyne Howard), one SEC Defensive Player of the Year (Victoria Dunlap), two SEC 6th Woman of the Year (Keyla Snowden, Chasity Patterson), two SEC Scholar-Athletes of the Year (Alyssa Rice, Maci Morris) and her players have earned 39 All-SEC honors overall.
- Elzy married Dexter Lander in August 2012 and the couple have one son Jackson, who was born in 2016.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Kyra Elzy is in the Kentucky High School Basketball Hall of Fame for her storied career at Oldham County High School. During her high school days, she was a two-time All-American selection by Parade Magazine and Street & Smith and considered by some to be the best high school basketball player in Kentucky history. She led her Oldham County team to two KHSAA regional titles and a semifinal appearance in the 1993 KHSAA Sweet 16. Overall, she scored 3,000 points with 1,700 rebounds, 449 assists and 516 steals over a stellar career.
- An all-around athlete, Kyra also saw success in cross country and track and field where she was a state champion in the 400-meter dash as a junior in high school.
- Elzy holds a bachelor's degree in psychology from Tennessee in 1999 and a master's degree in cultural studies and education with an emphasis in sports psychology from UT in 2001.
- As a student-athlete at UT from 1996-2001, Elzy's game excelled under Hall of Famer Pat Summitt. A four-year letterwinner, Elzy was a member of two national championship teams (1997, 1998), a national runner-up squad (2000), four SEC regular-season championships (1998, 1999, 2000, 2001) and three SEC Tournament titles (1998, 1999, 2000).
- During her time in Knoxville, she played in 126 games and earned the Holly Warlick Defensive Player of the Year award in 1997 and the Unsung Hero Award in 1998. Elzy became just the fifth freshman in Tennessee history to start her first game as a Lady Vol when she started at guard in the 1996-97 season opener against Austin Peay. She also earned another distinction during her playing career, becoming the first UT player to earn her master's degree while still playing.
