WILDCATS NICKNAME

The nickname "Wildcats" became synonymous with UK shortly after a 6-2 football victory at Illinois on Oct. 9, 1909. Commandant Philip Carbusier, then head of the military department, told a group of students in a chapel service following the game that the Kentucky football team had "fought like wildcats." The nickname grew in popularity and was adopted by the university.

MASCOTS

The Wildcat mascot originated during the 1976-77 year at Kentucky. Gary Tanner was the original Wildcat, entertaining fans at Commonwealth Stadium, Rupp Arena and Memorial Coliseum during athletic events. Today, the Wildcat mascot also attends academic functions and generally serves as a friendly ambassador for the University. Scratch, another costumed mascot, was unveiled in August of 1996. During UK games, the Wildcat and Scratch entertain with enthusiastic dances and cheers. In the past, UK had a live wildcat mascot that has resided in the Kentucky Department of Fish and Wildlife's Salato Wildlife Center three miles west of Frankfort on US 60. The most recent live mascot was named "Blue." Through the years, UK has had other official live mascots with colorful names. Records indicate that the first wild animal, named "Tom," was given to the University in 1921. Other live mascots followed, including "TNT," "Whiskers," "Hot Tamale" and "Colonel."

SINGING THE FIGHT SONG

Matthew Mitchell introduced a new tradition to the Kentucky women's basketball team when he became the head coach in 2007. After each victory, the Wildcats gather at mid-court and sing the UK Fight Song with the fans.

CHEER AND DANCE TEAMS

The UK Cheer and Dance programs are recognized as two of the finest programs in America. On the UK campus, they are recognized as some of the finest athletes in the University's sports programs, and as public relations ambassadors of UK and the entire Commonwealth of Kentucky. The Kentucky cheerleading squad won an unprecedented 24th national cheerleading championship in 2019 at the competition sponsored by the Universal Cheerleaders Association.

100% GRADUATION RATE

Kentucky has a 100% graduation rate since 2007 and have secured a team GPA better than 3.0 each of the last 1 semesters.

SENIOR DAY

Senior Day at Kentucky has become one of the most celebrated ceremonies in college basketball. Honoring the senior class, UK's event is one of the most elaborate and moving programs of its kind. The pregame ceremony begins with player introductions. Once they all have burst through banners bearing their likenesses, their families join them at center court. Then the state song, "My Old Kentucky Home," is sung as the home crowd bids farewell.

BLUE AND WHITE

The University of Kentucky adopted blue and white as its official colors in 1892. Originally, however, UK students had decided on blue and light yellow prior to the Kentucky-Centre College football game on December 19, 1891. The shade of blue, which is close to a royal blue, was chosen when a student asked the question, "What color blue?" At the time, Richard C. Stoll (who lettered in football at UK in 1889-94) pulled off his necktie and held it up. The students then adopted that particular shade of blue. A year later, UK students officially dropped the light yellow color for white.

THE BIG BLUE NATION

UK fans, also referred to as the Big Blue Nation, are known for the electric atmosphere they create at all athletic events. Not only do the players feed off of their energy, but opposing teams often fear the intimidating roar of the UK crowd. For the 11th straight season, the University of Kentucky women's basketball team ranked in the top 20 nationally in average attendance, sitting 19th overall with 4,756 fans per home game during the 2019-20 season. UK averaged 6,454 fans in 2015-16, which was the second-best mark in program history behind 6,727 during the 2013-14 season. Throughout 17 home games – two played inside historic Rupp Arena – Kentucky accumulated a total season attendance of 80,853, eclipsing the 80,000 mark for the 11th straight season. Kentucky has averaged 4,500 or more fans every year since 2009-10.

UK PEP BAND

With more than 80 members, the University of Kentucky pep band is one of the largest in the nation. Performing at both home football and basketball games, the pep band has been named by Southern Living magazine as one of the "top 10 bands in the South." The Alumni Band, composed of former UK band members, also is an important part of the UK WBB experience. The Alumni Band plays at several home games each year.



MEMORIAL COLISEUM RECORDS

- The Coliseum covers an entire city block and has as much space as a sevenstory office building. It currently has a capacity of 8,000.
- The Coliseum was built in 1950 and serves as a memorial to every Kentuckian who lost their life serving their country.
- A massive new LED video board spanning approximately 1,800 square feet with dimensions of 30 feet by 60 feet was installed in the fall of 2018.
- Wildcat fans are passionate about their basketball, that's why UK has ranked in the nation's top 20 and in the SEC's top four in attendance 11 straight years.
- The Cats are 160-28 (.851) at home over the last 10 seasons (including 12 games in Rupp Arena).
- UK averaged 4,756 fans per game in 2019-20 which ranked 19th nationally.
- UK drew 116,164 fans for its home games in 2015-16 the second-highest total attendance in school history.
