Quick Hits

- The RMU men's basketball team opens play in the Kentucky Classic Friday with a 7:00 p.m. tip against No. 10 Kentucky in Lexington, Ky., at Rupp Arena. The Colonials will also travel to Ohio (11/15) and host Mount St. Mary's (11/19) at the UPMC Events Center as part of the tournament.
- RMU opened its 2021-22 season and 46th year of NCAA Division I basketball with a 69-59 setback @ Central Florida (11/10/21). Sophomore guard Enoch Cheeks recorded his first career double-double against the Knights with 12 points and a career-high 10 rebounds.
- In his first game as a member of the Colonials, fifth-year guard Rasheem Dunn tied Cheeks for team-high honors in scoring with 12 points @ UCF (11/10/21). He also added five rebounds and three assists.
- Senior forward **Kahliel Spear** chipped in **10** points, **five** caroms, **three** assists and a **pair** of blocks in the season opener against the Knights. He shot **3-for-7** from the floor and was true on each of his **four** attempts at the charity stripe.
- The trio of Cheeks, Dunn and Spear combined to shoot **93.8** percent (**15-for-16**) at the free-throw line in the season opener @ UCF (11/10/21). Cheeks was a perfect **6-for-6**.
- Led by 12th-year RMU Pat Gallagher Head Coach Andrew Toole, the Colonials return two starters and three letterwinners in 2021-22, including sophomore guard Kam Farris and senior forward Kahliel Spear. The duo combined to score 319 points in 2020-21. Farris did not play in RMU's season opener @ UCF.
- The Colonials return **28.6** percent (393-of-1,374) of their scoring, **26.2** percent (169-of-646) of their rebounding and **15.7** percent (47-of-299) of their assists from the 2020-21 campaign.
- Senior forward Kahliel Spear, a transfer from Bucknell, averaged 9.9 points and 5.2 rebounds per game in 18 games for RMU last year, including 10 starts. He ranked fourth in the Horizon League with an average of 1.28 blocks per game, recording 23 rejections on the season.
- A total of nine new Colonials are part of the 2021-22 roster for RMU, including graduate transfers Rasheem Dunn and Ferron Flavors, Jr. Dunn, a transfer from St. John's who began his career at St. Francis Brooklyn, has scored 1,419 career points at the NCAA Division I level.
- Flavors, Jr., a transfer from Oklahoma State who has also spent time at the NCAA
 Division I level at Fairfield and Cal Baptist, owns career totals of 911 points and
 209 three-pointers. During the 2019-20 season at Cal Baptist, Flavors, Jr., led the
 Western Athletic Conference (WAC) in three-point field goal percentage (.439).

Pat Gallagher Head Coach Andrew Toole 12th Season • Penn, 2003 • @Coach_AndyToole

Presiding over the golden age of RMU men's basketball is Andrew Toole, who is in his 12th season as the Pat Gallagher Head Coach of the Colonials in 2021-22. Introduced as the eighth head coach in the program's 45-year NCAA Division I history at a press conference at the Charles L. Sewall Center May 11, 2010, Toole has posted an overall record of 192-170 (.530) in 11 seasons leading the Colonials.

Toole has overseen the most successful stretch in school history during his 15-year tenure at RMU. Named an assistant coach under former head coach Mike Rice in 2007, Toole was elevated to associate head coach the following season before taking over the reigns as head coach in 2010.

During Toole's 11 seasons as head coach at RMU, the Colonials have claimed two Northeast Conference (NEC) regular-season championships (2013, 2014), appeared in five NEC Tournament championship games (2011, 2012, 2014, 2015, 2020) and have made six national postseason appearances. Toole has led RMU to a pair of automatic bids to the NCAA Tournament (2015, 2020), two appearances in the National Invitation Tournament (NIT) (2013, 2014) and two spots in the CollegeInsider.com Postseason Tournament (2012, 2019).

Toole helped RMU usher in a new era in historic fashion in 2019 with the opening of the UPMC Events Center. The Colonials opened the building in front of a sold-out crowd against Pitt in November and closed the home season with a 77-67 victory over Saint Francis U in front of 4,034 fans to help RMU claim its league-high ninth NEC Tournament championship and automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament. Overall in 2019-20, the Colonials finished with a record of

Six of RMU's seven victories in a national postseason tournament have come under the watchful eve of Toole, In 2011-12, his second year as head coach, Toole led the Colonials to an overall record of 26-11 (.703). RMU tied a school record for victories by advancing to the guarterfinals of the 2012 CIT thanks to road wins over Indiana State and Toledo.

In 2012-13, RMU claimed its 10th NEC regular-season championship with a ledger of 14-4 (.778) in conference action and overall finished 24-11 (.686). The Colonials earned a spot in the 2013 NIT, advancing to the second round thanks to a landmark 59-57 victory over Kentucky in front of 3,444 fans at the Charles L. Sewall Center.

RMU earned its second consecutive NEC regular-season crown in 2013-14 with a record of 14-2 (.875) in league play and finished 22-14 (.611) overall. For his efforts, Toole was named the 2014 NEC Jim Phelan Coach of the Year. Led by a career-high 38 points from 2014 NEC Player of the Year Karvel Anderson (2012-14), the Colonials notched a win in the first round of the NIT for the second consecutive year with an 89-78 victory at St. John's.

Toole guided RMU to an overall record of 20-15 (.571) in 2014-15, including a mark of 12-6 (.667) in the NEC. The Colonials finished in a tie for second place with Bryant in the league standings and as the No. 2 seed claimed the 2015 NEC Tournament title with a 66-63 win at No. 1 seed St. Francis Brooklyn. RMU earned its first NCAA Tournament victory since 1983 and second overall in program history by posting an 81-77 victory over North Florida as part of the 2015 NCAA First Four at UD Arena in Dayton, Ohio. Two days later the Colonials fell to eventual 2015 national champion Duke, 85-56, in Charlotte, N.C.

During the 2018-19 season, Toole led RMU to an overall mark of 18-17 (.514), including a mark of 11-7 (.611) in the NEC. The Colonials accepted their second invite to the CIT, posting a 98-89 overtime win over Cornell at the North Athletic Complex for its third victory in program history in the tournament.

Toole was a four-year starter at the NCAA Division I level, playing for Elon (1998-00) before transferring to Penn (2000-03). Over his fouryear career, Toole averaged 12.3 points per contest, finishing with 1,341 points in 109 games. Toole and his wife, Brooke, reside in Pittsburgh, Pa., with their two sons, Ryan and Colin.

Central Florida Notes - The season opener between the Knights and Colonials marked the first meeting between the two programs ... RMU held a **44-34** advantage on the glass, including a **17-10** edge in offensive caroms ... The Colonials posted **11** assists on their **20** field goals and also notched **four** steals ... UCF shot 53.1 percent (17-for-32) from the field in the first half but were held to 34.4 percent (11-for-32) after the break ... RMU shot **32.8** percent (**20-for-61**), including **4-for-23** (**17.4%**) from deep ... The Colonials dipped to **21-25** (**.457**) all-time in season openers, including **4-8** (**.333**) under 12th-year RMU Pat Gallagher Head Coach **Andrew Toole.**

Block Party - Forward **Kahliel Spear** picked up right where he left off from last year in RMU's season opener @ UCF (11/10/21) in his ability to protect the rim. Spear posted **two** rejections against the Knights and in **19** career games for the Colonials has recorded **25** blocks, an average of **1.32** per game. Overall in four seasons at the NCAA Division I level, Spear owns **55** blocks in **65** contests, an average of **0.85** per game. His performance @ Central Florida in the 2021-22 season opener marked the eighth time in an RMU uniform he has finished with at least two rejections in a game.

Defense Wins Championships - The numbers bear out that following in the footsteps of defending is victories. Over the last 15 years, RMU owns a record of **202-57 (.780)** when holding opponents under **70** points since the beginning of the 2007-08 season. Under 12th-year head coach **Andrew Toole**, the Colonials own a mark of **151-50 (.751)** when turning the trick. Overall the last 15 years, RMU has held its opponent to under 70 points **55.6** percent **(259-of-466)** of the time after holding UCF to 69 points in its 2021-22 season opener.

Did You Know? RMU is **55-21 (.724)** in **12** seasons under RMU Pat Gallagher Head Coach **Andrew Toole** when hitting at least **10** three-pointers in a game. The Colonials knocked down a season-high **13** triples in a 102-88 victory @ Purdue Fort Wayne (12/26/20) in its first game as a member of the Horizon League and finished **2-2 (.500)** last season when hitting at least **10** three-pointers in a contest.

Close and Late - A common theme in the 12 years that RMU Pat Gallagher Head Coach Andrew Toole has been at the helm of the program has been playing close games late. During Toole's tenure, the Colonials have posted a record of 66-47 (.584) in games decided by five points or less, including a mark of 9-7 (.563) in games decided by just a single point.

Board Games - Part of following the formula in regard to being successful for RMU over the last **15** seasons has been the program's ability to crash the boards. Since the beginning of the 2007-08 campaign, RMU owns a record of **175-51 (.774)** when the Colonials are even or better in rebounding in a game, including a **166-44 (.790)** mark when outrebounding their opponent.

In The Clutch - You certainly could say that the Colonials have a flair for the dramatic. In a two-game home set with Youngstown State at the UPMC Events Center, RMU forced overtime in both games by hitting a key basket with under 15 seconds in regulation. Senior guard **Jon Williams** drilled a three-pointer to tie the game, 71-71, as time expired in the second half in the opener. The next night, junior guard **Cameron Wilbon** hit a floater with 1.1 second remaining to knot the score, 58-58. The pair joined the list of Colonials to convert a field goal or a free throw in the final **15** seconds to give RMU a victory or send the game to overtime. A closer look ...

RMU Historical Tidbits

In The Beginning - RMU was the first institution to jump directly from the junior college ranks to NCAA Division I. RMU played basketball at the junior college level for 13 seasons from 1963 to 1976, posting a record of 287-58 (.832) under head coach Gus Krop. Krop led the Colonials to a record of 30-1 (.968) in 1968-69 in its sixth season as a junior college program, with its only loss a 79-76 setback to Paducah (Ky.) in the national title game. In his time leading RMU, Krop coached nine All-Americans and also recruited Earl Cureton, a native of Detroit, Mich., who played one season with the Colonials when it was a junior college program (1975-76) as well as the first season of Division I basketball in 1976-77.

The Entire History - The 2021-22 campaign marks the 59th season of intercollegiate basketball at RMU. The Colonials compiled an overall record of **287-58** (.832) in 13 years as a junior college program from 1963 to 1976 and since moving to Division I with the 1976-77 campaign have posted an overall record of **653-685** (.488). Combined, RMU posted a record of 816-610 (.572) over its first 50 years as an intercollegiate program from 1963 to 2013. In honor of 50 years of intercollegiate basketball, Robert Morris enshrined the 1981-82 Colonials, the first squad to qualify for the NCAA Tournament, into the RMU Athletic Hall of Fame Feb. 15. 2014.

The First Superstar - Don Mackey (1963-65) was the only player in junior college history to score over **1,000** points in his two seasons with the program. A native of Homestead, Pa., Mackey finished his two years with the Colonials by scoring 1,034 points, and his 43 points in a 125-111 win over Walsh Jan. 30, 1965, stood for over 53 years as the most points scored in a game by a player in an RMU uniform. He went on to finish his collegiate career at Gannon University and was inducted into the RMU Athletic Hall of Fame Oct. 9, 2010. Mackey is one of nine junior college players in the RMU Athletic Hall of Fame.

The Twirl - Arguably the best basketball player in school history, in his one season at the NCAA Division I level in an RMU uniform **Earl** "**The Twirl**" **Cureton (1975-77)** averaged 17.2 points and 10.5 rebounds per game in 1976-77. Cureton still owns RMU single-season records for rebounds (**274**) and rebounding average and was the first player in the program's Division I history to average a double-double. He transferred to the University of Detroit Mercy to continue his career and was drafted by the Philadelphia 76ers in the third round of the 1979 NBA Draft. He went on to play 12 seasons in the NBA, earning a pair of championship rings, one with the 76ers in 1983 and the other with the Houston Rockets in 1994.

Charter Member - RMU played independently as a Division I program for five seasons before becoming a charter member of the ECAC Metro Conference in 1981, which changed its name to the Northeast Conference (NEC) in 1988. The Colonials won nine NEC Tournament titles and automatic bids to the NCAA Tournament, the most in league history, from 1981 to 2020. In July of 2020, RMU joined the Horizon League in 10 of its 16 intercollegiate programs.

Dynamic Duo - Led by guards **Chipper Harris (1980-84)** and **Forest "Bay" Grant (1980-84)**, RMU claimed the first two ECAC Metro Conference Tournament championships in 1981 and 1982. In four seasons, Harris and Grant combined for career totals of **3,434** points, **869** rebounds, **991** assists and **782** steals. Harris scored 1,940 points and owns the RMU career record for steals (450), while Grant is the program's all-time leader in assists (555) and scored 1,494 points. The pair helped the ECAC Metro Conference garner its first victory in the NCAA Tournament, as the Colonials upended Georgia Southern, 64-54, in a play-in game at the University of Dayton in Dayton, Ohio, in the 1983 NCAA Tournament.


Walk On The Ocean - Former guard Myron Walker (1990-94) continued RMU's lineage of stellar guards when he arrived on the scene in the fall of 1990 and was a key part of a 1991-92 squad that claimed the program's fifth NEC Tournament championship and berth in the NCAA Tournament. In his second year with the program, Walker scored 614 points en route to being named the 1992 NEC Player of the Year, the first sophomore in league history to earn the honor. Walker went on to become the program's all-time leading scorer with 1,965 points and also owns the single-season record (20.1 ppg as a senior in 1993-94) and career (18.7 ppg) records for scoring average.

Keep On Rockin In The Free World ... RMU opens play in the Kentucky Classic Friday against the Wildcats at Rupp Arena, one of 16 arenas that the Colonials have played in that has also featured a concert by Pearl Jam since the band's formation in 1990. Also included is the Times Union Center (Albany, N.Y.), John Paul Jones Arena (Charlottesville, Va.), PPG Paints Arena (Pittsburgh, Pa.), the Pan American Center (Las Cruces, N.M.), Time Warner Cable Arena (Charlotte, N.C.), The L.A. Sports Arena (Los Angeles, Calif.), the Verizon Center (Washington, D.C.), the FedExForum (Memphis, Tenn.), the Palace at Auburn Hills (Detroit, Mich.), the Prudential Center (Newark, N.J.), Savage Arena (Toledo, Ohio), the Wolstein Center (Cleveland, Ohio), the Bryce Jordan Center (State College, Pa.) and A.J. Palumbo Center (Pittsburgh, Pa.).

Who Was Robert Morris?

Robert Morris, Jr. (January 20, 1734 – May 8, 1806) was a Liverpool-born American merchant and signer of the Declaration of Independence, the Articles of Confederation and the United States Constitution. He was elected to the Pennsylvania Assembly, was chosen as a delegate to the Second Continental Congress, where he served as chairman of the "Secret Committee of Trade," and as a member of the Committee of Correspondence. From 1781 to 1784, he served as the Superintendent of Finance, managing the economy of the fledgling United States. As the central civilian in the government, Morris was, next to General George Washington, "the most powerful man in America." His successful administration led to the sobriquet, "Financier of the Revolution." A look at his legacy:

- A portrait of Morris appeared on U.S. \$1000 notes from 1862 to 1863
- Morris and Roger Sherman were the only two people to sign all three significant founding documents of the United States, the Declaration of Independence, the Articles of Confederation, and the U.S. Constitution.
- The dollar sign ("\$") was in common use among private merchants during the middle of the 18th century. It referred to the two columns draped with scrolls on the Spanish milled dollar, which predated the U.S. Dollar. Morris was the first to use that symbol in official documents.
