

## **NEWS & NOTES**

## **CMU NOTES**

- Central Michigan men's basketball continues its travels with a two-game road trip to Kentucky and Xavier. The Chippewas play in Lexington on Monday, Nov. 29, at 7 p.m., before playing in Cincinnati on Wednesday, Dec. 1. This will cap a sevengame road trip to open the season for CMU.
- This is the first season for coach Tony Barbee, who took of the CMU program in April, 2021. Barbee spent the previous seven seasons as a member of John Calipari's staff at Kentucky. His career includes head coaching experience at both Auburn and UTEP; at UTEP, he was named the Conference USA Coach of the Year after leading the Miners to a conference regular-season title and NCAA Tournament appearance in 2010.
- CMU welcomes 12 new members to the program with four individuals – Ralph Bissainthe, Aundre Polk, Dylan Jergens and Caleb Hodgson – returning from last year.

### AGAINST KENTUCKY

- This is the third meeting between CMU and Kentucky with the Wildcats winning the first two meetings.
- The last meeting came in 2008. Central Michigan jumped out to a 17-11 lead but the Chippewas couldn't get another field goal to fall through the hoop in the final 11 and a half minutes of the first half in an 84-52 setback. A Rupp Arena crowd of 22,944, the largest to ever watch a CMU game, saw the Chippewas jump out to an early nine-point advantage on three straight

three-pointers by Jordan Bitzer, Robbie Harman and Jeremy Allen. However, CMU scored only six points in the final 11 minutes of the opening frame, with the only field goal coming when a Kentucky defender was called for goaltending on a Marcus Van put back with 42 seconds left.

- Central Michigan is 0-9 against current members of the Southeastern Conference. The program is 0-2 against Kentucky & Missouri and 0-1 versus Alabama, Arkansas, Texas A&M and Vanderbilt. CMU played at Missouri in the season opener, dropping a 78-68 decision.
- The Chippewas last victory over a Power 5 opponent was at Northwestern, 80-67, on Dec. 17, 2014.

### **AGAINST XAVIER**

- This is the second meeting between Central Michigan and Xavier with the Musketeers winning the first meeting in 1997. That game was in Cincinnati which Xavier won 88-54.
- CMU already played one Big East squad this season, dropping a game at DePaul, 99-66.

## **AGAINST RANKED OPPONENTS**

- The Chippewas are 4-23 all-time against teams ranked in the Associated Press Top 25
- CMU's last victory over a ranked opponent was 69-68 at No. 23 Notre Dame in 2003.
- Central Michigan's last game against a ranked opponent was a loss to No. 1 Gonzaga last week in the Good Sam Classic.

## SCHEDULE NOTES

- One of Head Coach Tony Barbee's primary goals was putting together a challenging non-conference schedule for his squad.
- "We want to test ourselves and we want to play the best competition that we can find," said Barbee. "The nonleague portion of the schedule will help prepare us for a tough Mid-American Conference schedule, which is why we play it. It's arguably the most difficult nonconference schedule in the country and the most demanding attempted in decades at CMU."
- CMU's first seven regular season games are away from home including a neutral site game with No. 1 Gonzaga and a trip to No. 10 Kentucky.
- Central Michigan's Ione home nonconference games are against Western Illinois on Dec. 5 and Illinois-Chicago on Dec. 11.

## **MEMORABLE FIRST WIN**

- The first one was a memorable one Jermaine Jackson Jr.'s buzzer-beating layup lifted the Central Michigan men's basketball team to a dramatic 62-61 victory over Eastern Illinois on Monday at the Cougars' Lantz Arena.
- It was the first win of the season for the Chippewas (1-2) and for first-year coach Tony Barbee as his team overcame a 20-point first-half deficit.
- "What a comeback," Barbee said. "The guys fought. To go on the road against a team that was desperate for a win and to get down that big and to see the guys fight back like that, to scrap and claw in the second half – we did a lot of great things.
- Jackson and Cameron Healy scored 14 points apiece to lead the Chippewas,

- while Kevin Miller added 11, and Harrison Henderson had 10.
- CMU trailed, 32-12, with under seven minutes to play in the first half and was down, 42-29, at halftime. The Chippewas worked their way back into it with defense, outscoring the Cougars, 33-19, over the final 20 minutes.
- The Chippewas were still down 10, 53-43, with just over seven minutes remaining and finally seized the lead

   their first since 3-2 early in the game
   on a Kevin Miller pullup with 1:47 remaining, making it 60-58.
- CJ Lane hit a 3-pointer from the right corner with under 3 seconds to play to put Eastern Illinois back in front, 61-60, setting the stage for CMU's final dramatics.
- Jack Webb inbounded from under the basket after Lane's triple, launching a baseball pass to the 6-foot-11 Henderson who was stationed at the free throw line, three-fourths of the way down the court.
- The heavily guarded Henderson went up for the ball, which bounded off his hands and those of an Eastern Illinois defender. The loose ball came to Jackson on the right side. Jackson streaked to the basket and laid it in as the buzzer sounded.

## **REMEMBERING DICK PARFITT**

- Legendary men's basketball coach Dick Parfitt passed away in September at the age of 90.
- Parfitt became an assistant with the CMU men's basketball program in 1962 and then took over the head coach in 1971-72. He led the Chippewas to three Mid-American Conference championships during his 14 years in charge. CMU claimed the league crown in 1974-75, 1976-77, and 1978-79. His 14 CMU teams finished with a cumulative 192-179 record.
- He was named the MAC Coach of the Year in 1974-75. Parfitt was inducted into the Marcy Weston CMU Athletics Hall of Fame in 1990.

## HEAD COACH TONY BARBEE

**FIRST SEASON** 

Tony Barbee was named the head men's basketball coach at Central Michigan University on April 23, 2021.

Barbee, the 21st head coach in program history, comes to CMU from Kentucky where he spent the previous seven seasons as a member of John Calipari's staff. Barbee's career includes head coaching experience at both Auburn and UTEP; at UTEP, he was named the Conference USA Coach of the Year after leading the Miners to a conference regular-season title and NCAA Tournament appearance in 2010.

"Coach Barbee met all the criteria we had to find the right individual to re-energize our men's basketball program and get us back to competing for championships," Zyzelewski Family VP/Director of Athletics Amy Folan said. "He is a proven championship-caliber head coach, an elite recruiter who is well-versed in the national landscape and has a strong background in providing a great student-athlete experience on and off the court. I think the responsibility that coach John Calipari gave Tony to help run the Kentucky program speaks volumes."

During his time at Kentucky, Barbee served in three roles: associate to the head coach (2020-21), assistant coach (2015-20) and special assistant to the head coach (2014-15). He helped Kentucky win four Southeastern Conference regular-season championships and four SEC Tournament titles, and the Wildcats made five NCAA Tournament appearances including a Final Four berth in 2015.

Barbee also helped the Wildcats secure a top-three nationally ranked recruiting class every season he was with the program, including the nation's top class in 2016, 2017 and 2020. He coached 13 NBA Draft selections at Kentucky, including 10 first-round picks and eight players taken in the lottery.

"During the interview process, coach Barbee demonstrated his commitment to CMU student-athletes being students first — that competing and winning is important, but that we must also maintain an emphasis on academic success. He shares our goal



of seeing student-athletes with a championship ring on one hand and a diploma in the other," CMU President Robert Davies said. "We are excited to welcome coach Barbee, his wife Holly and their children, Hayden Alexandra and Andrew Marsh, into the CMU Chippewa community."

Barbee's four-year tenure as the head coach at UTEP saw the Miners increase their win total each season and average 20.5 victories per year. In 2009-10, UTEP finished 26-7, including 15-1 in C-USA play, winning their first regular-season league title in six years and earning an at-large bid into the NCAA Tournament.

"I'm humbled and excited to be the head coach at Central Michigan University," Barbee said. "It's been a dream of mine to be in the first chair leading another basketball program, and I'm grateful to President Davies and Athletics Director Amy Folan for their belief in me and my vision.

"The identity of our program will be built on sacrifice, accountability, respect, communication, winning and a family environment. I can't wait to engage with both

the current student-athletes and the former CMU Chippewas, get entrenched in the Mount Pleasant community and 'Fire Up' our great student section."

Barbee played for Calipari from 1989-93 at Massachusetts, where he was part of teams that won back-to-back Atlantic 10 regular season and tournament championships in 1992 and 1993. The Minutemen earned the conference's automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament both years and advanced to the Sweet 16 in 1992. Barbee earned All-Atlantic 10 Second Team honors in 1991 and 1993 and was an all-conference freshman team selection in 1990. UMass went 91-39 during his time with the program.

Barbee also had assistant coaching stints at Massachusetts, Wyoming and Memphis before becoming a head coach. He began as a graduate assistant at UMass (1995-98) before landing his first assistant job at Wyoming in 1998-99. He returned to UMass for one year and then went to Memphis, where he coached from 2001-06.


During Barbee's six seasons in Memphis, the Tigers won 148 games, two C-USA titles and made three trips to the NCAA Tournament including an Elite Eight appearance in 2006. Memphis boasted six consecutive top-10 nationally ranked recruiting classes; the 2001 class was ranked No. 1 in the country.

The Indianapolis native earned a bachelor of arts with a major in sports management and a minor in African-American studies from UMass in 1993. He played professionally in Spain and France before turning to coaching.

Barbee and his wife, Holly, have a daughter, Hayden Alexandra, and a son, Andrew Marsh.

"We are going to build a championship-level program and play an exciting style that will be fun for the fans and the players," Barbee said. "We will put together a tireless staff whose focus will be to help the players reach their goals and dreams and win championships along the way. Fire Up Chips!"

Shane Heirman joined the Central Michigan staff in May, 2021 and serves as the associate head coach under Tony Barbee.

Heirman spent the past four seasons as an assistant coach at DePaul and was part of a staff that in 2019-20 signed one of the top-25 recruiting classes in the nation. While at DePaul, Heirman coached All-BIG EAST selection Paul Reed and Romeo Weems, who was named to the BIG EAST All-Freshman Team.

Heirman helped lead the Blue Demons to a combined 35 victories over the '18-19 and '19-20 seasons, the highest two-season total for the program in more than a decade. In 2019, DePaul reached the final of the College Basketball Invitational in the program's first postseason appearance since 2007. In that season, the Blue Demons opened 12-1; the program's best nonconference record since 1991.

Prior to his arrival at DePaul, Heirman served for three seasons as the head coach La Lumiere School in LaPorte, Ind. At La Lumiere, he coached 23 players who went on to play NCAA Division I basketball including two McDonald's All-Americans.

Heirman is a Chicago-area native who played at Tulsa from 2008-11.



## CHRIS MCMILLIAN ASSISTANT COACH FIRST SEASON

Central Michigan men's basketball coach Tony Barbee named Chris McMillian to an assistant coaching position on his staff in May, 2021.

McMillian spent the past two seasons at Idaho State, helping lead the Bengals to a victory in the 2020 Big Sky Tournament. It marked the first time the program has won a game in the conference tournament since 2009.

Prior to his stint at Idaho State, McMillian served as the Director of Player Performance at Illinois-Chicago for four years, overseeing the design and implementation of the Flames' strength and conditioning program.

McMillian's resume also includes stops at the College of Southern Idaho and at Hawaii, where he served first as the strength coach and video coordinator before being promoted to the director of basketball operations. He began his coaching career as the director of operations at Centenary College in 2009-10.

McMillian, a Brea, Calif. native, was a four-year starter at Wyoming from 1998-2003. He played for Tony Barbee in his freshman season, when Barbee was an assistant coach on the UW staff. McMillian helped lead the Cowboys to two Mountain West Conference titles and an NCAA Tournament berth. He holds a bachelor's degree in communications from Wyoming, a Master's of Educational Administration from Hawaii, and is a certified member of the National Strength and Conditioning Association.

McMillian and his wife, Megan, have two daughters, Zoe Rae and Cameron Nicole.

Marlon Willamson was added to Tony Barbee's staff in May, 2021 as an assistant coach.

Williamson is a Detroit native and a graduate of Cass Tech High School who spent the last four years as an assistant at Long Island University-Brooklyn. He served as an assistant at UMass from 2012-14, during which the Minutemen finished 45-21 and made back-to-back postseason appearances, including an NCAA Tournament berth in 2014, the program's first in 16 years.

Prior to UMass, Williamson spent nine years working with The Family, a Detroit-based AAU program. He served as head coach and president of Youth Operations and also oversaw scouting, scheduling, academic progress monitoring, and counseling. Among the players who were members of The Family during Williamson's time with the organization are Joe Crawford (Kentucky), Jordan Crawford (Indiana/ Xavier), Chris Douglas-Roberts (Memphis), Draymond Green (Michigan State), Malik Hairston (Oregon) and James Young (Kentucky).

Williamson was a four-year letter winner at Youngstown State from 1999-2003. He was named the Penguins' most valuable player and earned a spot on the Horizon League All-Defensive Team during his senior year. He holds a Bachelor of Arts degree with a major in global studies from Youngstown State.



# MIKE FRAUENHEIM DIRECTOR OF BASKETBALL OPERATIONS FIRST SEASON

Mike Frauenheim was added to head coach Tony Barbee's staff as director of basketball operations in May, 2021.

Frauenheim worked alongside Barbee as the video graduate assistant at Kentucky for two seasons while Barbee was an assistant coach with the Wildcats.

Frauenheim played at York College of Pennsylvania from 2015-19, helping lead the Spartans to two NCAA Division III Tournament appearances including in 2018, when they captured the Capital Athletic Conference championship.

Frauenheim was named to the York All-Decade Team and is on the program's all-time top-10 list for assists, assists per game, steals and steals per game. He earned Academic All-CAC honors while earning his Bachelor of Science degree with a major in sport management and a minor in athletic coaching.

He holds a master's degree from Kentucky in kinesiology health promotion with a focus on sport leadership.
