

QUICK NOTES

- Kentucky is in its 48th season with a 869-560 (.608) all-time record.
- Rhyne Howard and Dre'una Edwards are leading UK this season as both are averaging an impressive 18.3ppg. Howard is adding 6.9 rebounds per game, while Edwards is earning 8.6 rebounds per game. Robyn Benton is earning 13.2ppg, while Jada Walker is at 11.3ppg.
- For just the second time under Kyra Elzy, the Wildcats have lost backto-back games. After falling to DePaul 94-85 at Rupp Arena, the Wildcats battled hard but fell at top-five ranked UofL on Sunday, 64-58.
- Kentucky and USC-Upstate will meet for the third time in program history Sunday. UK owns the all-time record 2-0. USC-Upstate is the second Big South opponent UK has played this season having already defeated Presbyterian 81-53.
- The Wildcats are currently ranked No. 19 in the Associated Press Top 25 and No. 19 in the USA Today/Coaches Top 25.
- Rhyne Howard entered the season as a preseason first-team All-American by the AP while league coaches and league media tabbed her the SEC Preseason Player of the Year. Howard is also on the Cheryl Miller Award, Wooden Award, Wade Trophy and Naismith Trophy Watch List. She has won back-to-back SEC Player of the Year honors.
- Howard has 1,820 career points which ranks fourth most in program history. She passed Leslie Nichols and Makayla Epps against Merrimack. She needs 26 points to tie Victoria Dunlap for third all-time.
- In 46 years of women's basketball, Kentucky has 99 wins over ranked opponents. UK is 0-2 so far this season with six games left vs. teams currently ranked or receiving votes in the AP Top 25.
- Kentucky will be without senior guard Blair Green this season after she sustained a ruptured Achilles in a scrimmage in November.
- Kyra Elzy is the eighth head coach in program history and the first to
 lead the team to the NCAA Tournament in their first season. Elzy was
 named the WBCA Rookie Head Coach of the Year for her efforts. Elzy
 has been apart of some of the best seasons in program history, including the SEC Championship team in 2012. In nine years with Kentucky,
 the Wildcats have been to seven NCAA Tournament and had eight
 winning seasons. Elzy is the second coach in program history to win at
 least 20 of his/her first 30 games, joining Terry Hall.

OLIVIA OWENS \cdot 6-4 \cdot RS-JUNIOR \cdot CENTER \cdot ALBANY, N.Y.

- Strong 16 minutes against WVU with seven points and four rebounds, going 3-of-4 from the field.
- Played in 25 games with five starts, averaging 4.4 points and 2.8 rebounds per game last season.
- Scored 10 or more points twice during the 2020-21 season and led UK in rebounds three times and in blocks twice.
- Transfered to UK after two seasons at Maryland where she sat out her sophomore season due to medical issues. Played 16 games as a freshman.



ROBYN BENTON · 5-9 · SENIOR · GUARD · CONYERS, GA.

- Has scored 10+ in eight games this season. Scored 22 points against DePaul on 11-of-15 shooting with seven rebounds and four steals.
- Strong 2020-21 season, playing in 26 games and averaging 18.0 minutes per game.
- Averaged 6.6 points per game, hitting 23 3s and went 29-of-37 from the free-throw line.
- On her 21st birthday against Alabama at Rupp Arena, scored a season-high 15 points on 6-of-10 shooting, including three 3s in 23 minutes.



JAZMINE MASSENGILL · 6-0 · SENIOR · GUARD · CHATTANOOGA TENN.

- First double-figure scoring game of the year against Merrimack, scoring 13 points with 8 assists and three steals. Tied a career-high with three 3s.
- Had seven assists in the opener vs. Presbyterian, adding eight points with four steals and two 3s made. Second in nation in assist-turnover ratio.
- Played in 19 games with eight starts, averaging 5.1 points per game and 3.3 assists per game.
- Earned her first start for Kentucky against Tennessee at Rupp Arena, scoring 11 points on 4-of-7 shooting and an impressive 3-of-5 from long range, and added three assists, while all of her points and assists came in the second half.



KRISTEN CRENSHAW-GILL · 5-9 · FRESHMAN · GUARD · YOUNGSTOWN, OHIO

- Saw her first career action vs. UNA, playing two minutes and hitting a 3-pointer.
- Came to the team during open tryouts in September 2021 and earned a spot on the team as a walk-on.
- Played high school basketball at Valley Christian High School in Youngstown, Ohio.



BLAIR GREEN · 6-0 · SENIOR · GUARD · HARLAN COUNTY, KY.

- Will miss the 2021-22 season after sustaining a ruptured Achilles in UK's closed scrimmage vs. EKU in late October.
- Played in 27 games with 18 starts last season for the Wildcats, averaging 6.0 points per game.
- Hit 33 percent from long range (21-of-63) and scored 10 or more points seven times, 15 or more points three times and had one 20-point game.



RHYNE HOWARD · 6-2 · SENIOR · GUARD · CLEVELAND, TENN.

- Shined against WVU with 27 points, adding seven rebounds, four assists and three steals. Went 5-of-7 from 3 against the Mountaineers.
- Third player in program history with a triple-double vs. Winthrop, scoring 22 points with 10 rebounds and 10 assists.
- Preseason SEC Player of the Year by league media and league coaches. Also preseason All-America first-team by the AP, Lindy's and The Athletic.
- Has scored 1,799 career points, which ranks fourth most all-time. To see her other career standings go to page 13.
- Averaged 20.7 points and 7.3 rebounds last season as the only player in the nation averaging those numbers along with 90 assists and 60 steals.



JADA WALKER · 5-7 · FRESHMAN · GUARD · RICHMOND, VA.

- Gave UK a spark against West Virginia, hitting a 3 and then getting a steal and a and-one in the second quarter. Had 18 points against DePaul.
- Performed like a veteran at Indiana, coming off the bench to score 16 points on 7-of-13 shooting with two steals. Has 10+ in five games.
- Strong game vs. UNA with 13 points, adding five assists, one steal and three rebounds. Provided UK with much-needed defensive energy.
- Energetic and talented point guard that should add immediate depth to the 2021-22 roster.
- · Has made a huge impression on the team and staff so far and should see immediate minutes, especially with the injury to Blair Green.



TREASURE HUNT · 6-1 · SOPHOMORE · GUARD · CHATTANOOGA TENN.

- Great start to the season with a career-high 18 points, adding nine rebounds and career-high five assists. Had career-high 10 boards vs. UNA.
- Strong improvement as her rookie season went on and finished the year playing her best basketball, seeing time in 15 games with one start.
- Played for 24 minutes against Florida in the second round of the SEC Tournament, scoring nine points of 4-of-8 shooting, while grabbing seven rebounds, leading the team with four assists and earning one block.



NYAH LEVERETTER · 6-3 · SOPHOMORE · FORWARD · BLYTHEWOOD. S.C.

- Missed the first five games of the season due to a non-COVID illness. Played eight minutes vs. WVU with four rebounds.
- Played 14 games, averaging 6.7 minutes per game last season.
- Led Kentucky against Marshall, grabbing a career-high eight boards.
- Scored a career-high seven points and recorded a career-high nine rebounds against Wofford.



EMMA KING · 5-10 · JUNIOR · GUARD · STANFORD. KY.

- Scored 7 points with 2 assists, going 3-of-5 from the field. Three FGs made were career high. Had two blocks vs. UNA, which was a career-high.
- Made her first career start in 20-21 season opener against Murray State, playing for 16 minutes, with three assists, one rebound and one steal.
- Also started against Belmont with three rebounds and a steal.
- Scored against Idaho State in the NCAA Tournament, going 2-of-2 from the free-throw line.



DRE'UNA EDWARDS · 6-2 · REDSHIRT-JUNIOR · FORWARD · COMPTON. CALIF.

- Has four straight double-doubles becoming first player since Evelyn Akhator in 2016 to accomplish the feat. Had 14pts, 14rebs at UofL.
- Continues to show she is a beast all over the floor with 27 points against UNA, adding five rebounds and two steals. Career-high 12 FGs vs. UNA.
- Scored 18 of her 20 points in the opener in the second half, adding six rebounds. Went 9-of-11 from the field in the game. Has 20+ in three games.
 Impressed playing her first action as a Wildcat, playing in 27 games with 11 starts, averaging 9.7 points per game and 6.1 rebounds per game.
- Hit 12 3s during the year and had 21 blocks and 24 steals while scoring 10 or more points 12 times during the year, including 15 or more six times.

GAME NOTES

SERIES HISTORY VS. USC UPSTATE

- Kentucky leads the all-time series in games played vs. USC Upstate, 2-0.
- The first meeting was Nov. 7, 2007 when UK earned a 74-59 victory. The last meeting was Nov. 25, 2012 with UK earning a 100-34 victory. Both games were in Memorial Coliseum.
- USC Upstate is the second Big South opponent UK has played this season. UK already has a win over Presbyterian 81-53 inside Memorial Coliseum.

KEY STATS TELL THE TALE

- In Kyra Elzy's short tenure as Kentucky's head coach, a few key stats help tell the tale on when the Wildcats have success.
- Kentucky is 10-0 under Kyra Elzy when it shoots 50 percent or better from the field. Conversely, Kentucky is 14-12 when it shoots under 50 percent. UK is 1-4 under Elzy when its opponent shots 50 percent or higher.
- UK is 22-4 under Kyra Elzy when it scores 70 or more points and 12-2 when it scores 80+.
- When Kentucky holds its opponents to 60 or fewer points under Kyra Elzy, it is 15-0 and 20-2 when it holds opponents to 70 points or less.
- Under Elzy, UK is 14-0 when it has more points in the paint and 9-12 when it has fewer.
- The Wildcats have had an incredible act of bouncing back under Elzy as UK is 8-2 after a loss, only losing back-to-back games twice.

CATS DISH OUT 30 ASSISTS VS. MERRIMACK

- For the fourth time this season, UK recorded 20 or more assists in a game, posting 30 against Merrimack. It was the first time UK has recorded 30 or more assists in a game since having 32 vs. Morehead State in November of 2015. UK had four total games last season of 20 or more assists, already hitting that number early on this season.
- Kentucky has already dished out 25 or more assists in three games this season, which is the first time a UK team has accomplished that since the 1993-94 team had four games of 25 or more assists.

KENTUCKY DOMINATED WVU WITH TOTAL TEAM EFFORT

- Facing a much bigger WVU lineup, the Kentucky women's basketball team put together one of its better performances under Kyra Elzy with a 83-60 victory over WVU.
- Kentucky hit 11 3s in the game, which was a season high, and became the first non-conference team to score 83 or more points against WVU since Iowa in 2018. Rhyne Howard led all scorers with 27 points, hitting five 3s with seven rebounds, four assists and three steals. Dre'una Edwards scored 19 points with 10 rebounds, recording her second straight double-double. Freshman Jada Walker scored in double figures for the fifth straight game.
- Defensively, UK had its best performance, limiting WVU to 37.1 percent from the field and 4-of-11 from long range. Kentucky had 10 blocks in the game, which was a season high and the most for a UK team since December 2017.
- The Wildcats won the rebounding battle 43-28, including 13-9 in offensive rebounds. The Wildcats outscored WVU 21-5 in second-chance points and had a 32-30 edge in paint points.
- "They pounded us on the boards, and they were more physical. I'm very disappointed in our team, we just weren't physical with them. We didn't put a body on them, or keep them off the board. We gave them too many chances." - WVU Head Coach Mike Carey

EDWARDS' DOUBLE-DOUBLE POWERS CATS PAST LA SALLE

- Kentucky held an 18-point first half lead on La Salle, but could not put the Explorers away until the fourth quarter in a 74-52 win on Nov. 27. Dre'una Edwards was the star for the Wildcats, earning her first double-double of the season with 22 points and 11 rebounds. She added four assists and three blocks.
- Four Wildcats scored in double figures in the game with Rhyne Howard earning 18 points with six rebounds and three assists. Robyn Benton scored 17 points and went 3-of-3 from long range with seven rebounds. Jada Walker scored in double figures for the fourth straight game with 12 points and four assists. Jasmine Massengill had seven assists.

FOUR-QUARTER EFFORT VS. WINTHROP

- Kentucky put together a quality performance against Winthrop, earning a 92-47 victory over the Eagles. The Wildcats jumped on WU from the start, scoring 50 points in the first half and never looked back.
- Kentucky dominated every aspect of the game, outrebounding WU 43-32 with a 52-20 edge in paint points and 27-6 advantage in second-chance points. UK forced the Eagles into 28





turnovers and scored 36 points off those miscues. Meanwhile, UK turned the ball over just 11 times and allowed just four points off those errors.

• Five Wildcats were in double-figures in the game for the first time this season. Kentucky hit 10 3s in the game, which was a season high as well.

HOWARD ADDS TRIPLE-DOUBLE TO HER ILLUSTRIOUS CAREER HONORS

- Kentucky's Rhyne Howard has pretty much accomplished everything possible during her
 career and is on pace to have her name planted inside the top 10 of almost every career
 record at Kentucky. Against Winthrop on Nov. 21, she added her name to a very short list
 becoming the third player in program history to record a triple-double.
- Howard scored 22 points against the Eagles with 10 rebounds and 10 assists, adding five steals and four 3s. The guard became the first player since Makayla Epps on Nov. 18, 2015.
 Leslie Nichols recorded the first triple-double in school history in 1986.

HISTORIC REBOUNDING NIGHT FOR UK VS. NORTH ALABAMA

- Kentucky's second-half surge against North Alabama was large part due to UK's dominance inside. After just 18 paint points in the first half, UK recorded 40 in the second half. The 58 paint points were a season high for UK.
- Kentucky had 30 second-chance points in the game, which was the most for a UK team since also having 30 on Nov. 19, 2014 vs. Morehead State.
- UK's 24 offensive rebounds was its most since it had 24 vs. Alabama State on Nov. 7, 2018.

SECOND HALF PROPELS CATS IN SEASON OPENER

- The first 20 minutes of basketball for Kentucky in 2021-22 was not what Kyra Elzy or anyone expected. Kentucky found itself trailing for most of the first half and faced a double-digit deficit several times. But as so often happens, Rhyne Howard made an incredible play with a halfcourt 3 at the buzzer at halftime to give UK its first lead of the game. Kentucky would never look back from there rolling to a 81-53 victory over Presbyterian.
- Kentucky picked up right where they left off after Howard's 3, scoring the first 19 points of the quarter. The run was part of an overall 22-0 run for Kentucky, which was Kentucky's largest since scoring 24 straight vs. Jackson State on Nov. 29, 2015. UK held Presbyterian scoreless for the first 5:52 of the second half and without a field goal for the first 6:58 of the third quarter. The Wildcats outscored Presbyterian 29-6 in the third quarter overall.
- The Wildcats dished out 26 assists in the game, which was the most for a Kentucky team in a game since 27 vs. Western Carolina on Dec. 18, 2018. Kentucky had 50 points in the paint in the game, which was its most in a game since 50 against Belmont last season on Nov. 29, 2020. UK also had a 39-9 advantage in points off turnovers in the game.
- Senior guard Rhyne Howard scored 15 points with four rebounds, seven assists, four steals
 and one block. She played a game-high 34 minutes. Redshirt junior Dre'una Edwards scored
 20 points with six rebounds. Edwards was 9-of-11 from the field and 2-of-2 from the freethrow line. It was the fourth career time she has led UK in scoring in her career.
- Sophomore wing Treasure Hunt had a career day for Kentucky, scoring 19 points with nine rebounds, five assists and a block. Hunt went 7-of-11 from the field in the game. Her 20 points, seven field-goals made, nine rebounds and five assists were career highs.

KENTUCKY RETURNS MAJORITY OF 2020-21 ROSTER

- Kentucky returns nine players from last year's roster, including three starters. Those numbers did take a hit when guard Blair Green sustained a torn Achilles in UK's closed scrimmage vs. EKU and will miss the entire 2021-22 season.
- The returners are headlined by 2020-21 consensus All-America First Team honoree Rhyne Howard. Howard averaged 20.7 points per game last season, adding 7.3 rebounds per game and a team-best 91 assists. Kentucky's third- and fourth-leading scorers also return in Dre'una Edwards and Robyn Benton. Point guard Jazmine Massengill, who missed the first half of the season due to NCAA transfer rules after finishing second on the team in assists per game. In all, UK returns 70% of its scoring, 3-pointers made and assists, while it brings back 63% of its rebounding and 58% of its steals.
- Also returning and expected to see expanded minutes are Treasure Hunt, Nyah Leveretter,
 Olivia Owens and Emma King. Hunt really came into her own at the end of the 2020-21 season, while Leveretter has added strength and experience and should help in the post. Owens
 is the big UK has sought the past few years and appears poised for a good season. King
 should see expanded minutes, especially with the injury to Green as she is instant offense.

ELZY TAKES FULL ADVANTAGE OF 2021 OFFSEASON

- Nearly every coach in the country has talked about losing the summer of 2020 to help build their teams last season. Kyra Elzy has made sure to make the most of that this offseason as the Wildcats have been very intentional about developing on and off the court.
- The first part was on-court development. Elzy hired Kentucky's first-ever women's basket-ball only strength coach in Lee Taylor, who is a well-respected women's basketball strength coach in the nation. The hire has paid off as across the board the Wildcats are in the best shapes of their lives and the players have raved about the work they have put in with Coach Taylor. Coach Elzy has been pleased with what she has seen and excited about how it could translate onto the floor.
- The second part was team building, which the Wildcats felt they missed out on last offseason. That has been corrected and then some in 2021 as Elzy has taken the team to countless team building events. First, the team went to Red River Gorge to hike and enjoy a day together in one of Kentucky's most beautiful landscapes. The team also went on a surprise trip to Fort Campbell, where they gave up their cell phones for the weekend and came together in a unique way.

WILDCATS LOOKING TO CONTINUE 3-POINT SHOOTING

- Kentucky shot 34.6 percent from 3 last season which ranked top 50 nationally. The Wildcats
 hit 195 3-pointers overall in 27 games, which ranked fifth most in program history. Since
 Elzy came back to Lexington in the spring of 2016, the Wildcats have posted a top-10 performance in program history in 3s made every year, including a school-record 252 in 2019-20.
- Elzy wants the Wildcats to play fast and with some impressive sharp-shooters on the roster, the Wildcats can be expected to make the top-10 of 3s made again this season.
- UK returns 70 percent of its made 3s from last season, including Rhyne Howard. Howard ranks top-five in program history in 3s made, 3s attempted and 3-point field-goal percentage. Last season, Howard hit 56 3s in 24 games for a 37.3 percentage.
- Also returning is Robyn Benton, who hit 23 3-pointers along with Jazmine Massengill, who hits 13 and Treasure Hunt, who hit 10.
- So far this season, UK is hitting 34.2 percent from long range.

KENTUCKY RANKED NO. 19 IN AP, NO. 19 USA TODAY/WBCA TOP 25

- For the 13th time since 2007, Kentucky started its season ranked or receiving votes in the national polls This marks the third straight season that Kentucky has started ranked in the top 15 of the AP Top 25. UK was No. 11 last season and No. 13 in 2019-20. UK has finished its season ranked in the top 25 of both major listings 11 of the last 12 seasons.
- UK is currently No. 19 in the USA Today/WBCA Top 25 and No. 19 in the AP Top 25.
- UK has been ranked 60 straight weeks the 10th longest active streak in the nation.

TOUGH SCHEDULE AWAITS WILDCATS

- Kentucky is scheduled to play six more games this season against teams that are ranked or receiving votes in the AP Top 25. Those opponents are: No. 1 South Carolina (twice), No. 7 Tennessee, No. 17 Georgia, No. 22 LSU and No. 23 Texas A&M.
- UK is 1-3 this season against teams ranked or receiving votes with a win vs. WVU and loss at Indiana, at Louisville and vs. DePaul.

KENTUCKY PICKED TO FINISH 4TH BY LEAGUE MEDIA, 5TH BY LEAGUE MEDIA

• A panel of league media voted the Wildcats to finish fourth in the SEC this season in the annual preseason poll, while all 14 league coaches voted the Wildcats to finish fifth.

HOWARD NAMED PRESEASON ALL-SEC BY MEDIA, COACHES

- Senior guard Rhyne Howard has been tabbed the Preseason SEC Player of the Year and Preseason All-SEC First Team by league media and league coaches.
- This is the second straight season that Howard has been the preseason player of the year by league media and league coaches. She has also been first team All-SEC each of the last two seasons.

HOWARD EARNS PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA

Rhyne Howard, who was a consensus first-team All-American last season, starts where she
left off last season as she was named a first-team preseason All-America honoree by the
Associated Press. She has also earned preseason All-America honors from Lindy's Sports and
The Athletic. The preseason honors join a lengthy list of praise for Howard, who recently was
tabbed the SEC Preseason Player of the Year by league coaches and league media.





HOWARD NAMED TO SEVERAL PRESEASON WATCH LISTS

 Rhyne Howard has been tabbed to the Cheryl Miller Award Preseson Watch List, Wooden Award Preseason Watch List, Wade Trophy Preseason Watch List and Naismith Trophy Preseason Watch List. Howard was a finalist for those awards last season.

RHYNE HOWARD LEAVING HER LEGACY AT KENTUCKY

- Rhyne Howard is out to show yet again that she is the best player in college basketball.
- Her junior season was one for the record books at Kentucky, earning first-team All-America
 honors from the Associated Press, WBCA, USBWA and Wooden Award. She was one of four
 finalists for the WBCA Wade Trophy, one of five finalists for the John R. Wooden Award, one
 of four finalists for the 2021 Naismith Trophy and a finalist for the 2021 Cheryl Miller Award.
 For the second year in a row, SEC coaches named Howard the SEC Player of the Year, while
 she earned All-SEC First Team honors for the third straight season.
- Howard who was the only player in the nation in 2020-21 to average over 20 points per game with at least 7.3 rebounds per game, 90 assists and 60 steals had a great junior season for the Wildcats, averaging 20.7 points per game with 7.3 rebounds per game. She hit a team-best 56 3-pointers and had 91 assists, 61 steals and 19 blocks. Although her scoring average was two points less than it was in 2019-20, Howard showed she is an all-around player and not just a scorer, upping her rebounds per game, assists per game and steals per game average from both her freshman and sophomore seasons.
- The native of Cleveland, Tennessee, played 24 games last season with nearly half of those coming against top-25 ranked opponents. In those games, Howard showed she is the best player in the country with impressive numbers. In 11 games against ranked opponents, Howard averaged 22.3 points per game, hitting 47.1 percent from the field and 39.7 percent from 3 with 6.7 rebounds per game and 3.0 assists per game. Howard had four 30+ scoring games during the season with three coming against top-25 ranked teams.
- For her career, Howard has scored 1,820 career points sitting fourth in UK history in points scored. She needs 26 more to tie Victoria Dunlap for third. Howard ranks second in school history in career scoring average at 19.8, while she is seventh in field-goals made with 631, third in career 3s made with 231 and third in career 3-point field-goal percentage at 37.9. She is also fourth in UK history in steals per game at 2.369.
- In 92 career games, Howard has ...

- The winner of the 2022 Nancy Lieberman Award will be presented on a to be determined date, along with the other four members of the Women's Starting Five. Additional awards being presented include the Ann Meyers Drysdale Shooting Guard Award, the Cheryl Miller Small Forward Award, the Katrina McClain Power Forward Award and the Lisa Leslie Center Award, in addition to the Men's Starting Five.
- Massengill will be looked at to lead the Wildcats from the point guard position this season.
 The native of Chattanooga, Tenn., is in her second season with Kentucky and played in 19 games last season with eight starts. She averaged 5.1 points and 3.3 assists per game with three or more assists in nine games. She led Kentucky in assists six times during the season.
- Massengill made her Kentucky debut against Wofford on Dec. 19 after missing the first half of the season due to NCAA transfer rules. In her debut, she played 18 minutes with a 3-pointer, two assists and a steal. In Kentucky's SEC opener against top-20 ranked Arkansas, Massengill scored five points with three assists and three blocks. She had seven assists against Auburn and played her best game against Tennessee at Rupp Arena, scoring 11 points, including 3-of-5 from long range with three assists. She recorded a season-high 10 assists against Florida, adding nine points.

BLAIR GREEN TO MISS 2021-22 SEASON DUE TO TORN ACHILLES

- Blair Green sustained a ruptured Achilles during UK's closed scrimmage vs. EKU on Saturday (Oct. 30) and will miss the 2021-22 season.
- Coach Elzy released the news later that day and said in a statement at the time: "This has been an emotional day for our program. Blair, her teammates and everyone in this program are hurting as we wrap our minds around potentially losing her for the season before it begins. Blair Green exemplifies what being a Kentucky women's basketball player is all about. Although it appears we have lost her on the court, her leadership off the court will still have an impact on our team this season. We will be here to support her through this and make sure she comes out better on the other side. I ask that Big Blue Nation fills her and her family with love and support right now."

JADA WALKER IMPRESSES IN EARLY GOING

- Kentucky's lone scholarship true freshman Jada Walker has made a huge impact on the team already this season and is expected to see significant playing time as the season progresses. Walker is a talented and energetic point guard that plays the game hard and the right way as she is a coach's daughter.
- Walker was a four-star guard by ESPN.com and ranked as the 18th-best guard in the 2021 class. She had a breakout junior season at Henrico High School averaging 26.3 points with 5.9 steals per game, hitting 54 percent from the field. She led the Warriors to the Class 5 Region B championship and a berth in the state tournament in 2020.

SECOND-YEAR TRANSFERS FEELING RIGHT AT HOME

- Olivia Owens, Robyn Benton and Jazmine Massengill all transferred to Kentucky during the height of the 2020 COVID-19 pandemic and did not get a summer with their teammates to mesh together. They also had to wait for the NCAA to decide their eligibility status. Owens' approval came before the season started while Benton's was days before the season and Massengill's not until December.
- Now with a full year under their belts and a majority of the roster back, all three are feeling
 way more at home and comfortable wearing the Blue and White and taking on their roles.
- Massengill may benefit the most as it was a tough transition last season to step in midseason and be asked to be the starting point guard. This season, that role has been Massengill's from the start and she is thriving running the Wildcats' offense.
- Benton has goals to be one of the conference's best defensive players this season and her
 work this offseason has paid off in that regard. She seems poised for a big season both offensively and defensively.
- Owens fought for time last season behind senior leaders KeKe McKinney and Tatyana Wyatt, but both have moved on and Owens seems to get a majority of the time at the five position.
 She worked hard this offseason on her conditioning and strength and should have a strong season as the Wildcats' center.

#ELZYERA IS HERE TO STAY

 It was a successful first season for the Kentucky women's basketball program under head coach Kyra Elzy, who became the first UK women's basketball head coach to lead his or her team to the NCAA Tournament in their first season at the helm.

The two wins led Elzy to be named the espnW National Coach of the Week and the United States Basketball Writers Association tabbed UK its first-ever team of the week. UK was one of 10 teams in the nation to have four wins against top-25 NCAA NET teams entering the tournament.

Kentucky was involved in two of the top-25 most attended games in the nation during the 2019-20 season, including 11,256 fans vs. Louisville at Rupp Arena which ranked 23rd.

Rupp Arena (23,500)

- Rupp Arena is entering its 45th season.
- An awesome structure in sight and scope, the arena is divided into two seating
 areas. The lower level features 10,000 cushioned theater seats while the upper
 arena has new chairback seats on the sidelines. The latter can be visually isolated
 to provide more natural setting for small shows.
- The Wildcats command an exclusive and updated state-of-the-art locker room, while other amenities include six team-size dressing rooms and eight smaller units.
- In 2013-14, UK set the new single-game attendance record when 23,706 fans saw UK face No. 2 Duke in Rupp Arena on Dec. 22, 2013. The attendance marked the largest crowd ever to see a college women's hoops game in the Commonwealth the previous mark was 22,152 for the first Kentucky-Louisville game played in the KFC Yum! Center on Dec. 5, 2010.
- In 2015-16, Kentucky packed 17,150 fans in Rupp Arena on Dec. 20 against Duke, which was the fourth-largest home crowd in program history. On Dec. 10, the Wildcats had 14,425 fans at the historic arena, which was the sixth-largest home crowd in school history.

- WBCA Rookie Coach of the Year in 2021 after becoming the first UK head coach to lead their team to the NCAA Tournament in their first season at the helm.
- Named espnW National Coach of the Week on January 4, 2021, after back-to-back top-12 wins to start conference action (then-No. 10 Arkansas and then-No. 12 Mississippi State). It marked the first time Kentucky has ever earned back-to-back wins against teams ranked in the top-12 of the AP poll.
- Became the eighth head coach in UK women's basketball history as UK AD Mitch Barnhart named her head coach on Dec. 14, 2020 following the retirement of Matthew Mitchell.
- Has been a huge key to the program's success the last 13 years as she has spent 10 seasons on the Kentucky staff. Started as assistant coach from 2008-2010 then associate head coach 2010-2012. Returned to UK in 2016 as the associate head coach.
- In her nine years at Kentucky, the Wildcats have been to the NCAA Tournament seven times, including two NCAA Elite Eights. UK won the SEC Regular Season Championship in 2012 only its second in program history. UK has had a winning season in eight of those nine season, including six 20-win seasons and six 10+ wins in league play.
- At Kentucky, Elzy has coached three SEC Players of the Year (Victoria Dunlap, A'dia Mathies, Rhyne Howard), three SEC Freshman of the Year (A'dia Mathies, Bria Goss, Rhyne Howard), one SEC Defensive Player of the Year (Victoria Dunlap), two SEC 6th Woman of the Year (Keyla Snowden, Chasity Patterson), two SEC Scholar-Athletes of the Year (Alyssa Rice, Maci Morris) and her players have earned 40 All-SEC honors overall.
- Elzy married Dexter Lander in August 2012 and the couple have one son Jackson, who was born in 2016.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Kyra Elzy is in the Kentucky High School Basketball Hall of Fame for her storied career at Oldham County High School. During her high school days, she was a two-time All-American selection by Parade Magazine and Street & Smith and considered by some to be the best high school basketball player in Kentucky history. She led her Oldham County team to two KHSAA regional titles and a semifinal appearance in the 1993 KHSAA Sweet 16. Overall, she scored 3,000 points with 1,700 rebounds, 449 assists and 516 steals over a stellar career.
- An all-around athlete, Kyra also saw success in cross country and track and field where she was a state champion in the 400-meter dash as a junior in high school.
- Elzy holds a bachelor's degree in psychology from Tennessee in 1999 and a master's degree in cultural studies and education with an emphasis in sports psychology from UT in 2001.
- As a student-athlete at UT from 1996-2001, Elzy's game excelled under Hall of Famer Pat Summitt. A four-year letterwinner, Elzy was a member of two national championship teams (1997, 1998), a national runner-up squad (2000), four SEC regular-season championships (1998, 1999, 2000, 2001) and three SEC Tournament titles (1998, 1999, 2000).
- During her time in Knoxville, she played in 126 games and earned the Holly Warlick
 Defensive Player of the Year award in 1997 and the Unsung Hero Award in 1998. Elzy
 became just the fifth freshman in Tennessee history to start her first game as a Lady Vol
 when she started at guard in the 1996-97 season opener against Austin Peay. She also
 earned another distinction during her playing career, becoming the first UT player to earn
 her master's degree while still playing.
