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WILDCATS HOST BEARCATS ON SENIOR DAY

The University of Kentucky men's and women's swimming and diving team will compete at the Lancaster Aquatic Center for the final time this season, concluding dual meet action by hosting Cincinnati on Friday, Jan. 28.

Prior to the start of the meet, the Wildcats will honor their 13 seniors in Kyle Barker, Daniel Blake, Riley Gaines, Izzy Gati, Parker Herren, Kyndal Knight, Kelly Rodriguez, Adam Rosipal, Sophie Sorenson, Caroline Szydlowski, Mason Wilby, and Danny Zhang as well as student manager Trent Lakes as part of the senior day ceremony.

The Wildcat women clocked in at No. 14 in the latest College Swimming & Diving Coaches Association of America (CSCAA) poll, their 15th-straight time in the top-15. They began the season at No. 12 while the men received votes in the preseason poll.

Kentucky and Cincinnati last competed against one another on Jan. 31, 2019, in Lexington where the Wildcats swept the Bearcats. UK earned a combined 24 first-place finishes out of the 32 events that were competed.

KENTUCKY'S LAST SPLASH

UK broke three pool records in the annual Battle of the Bluegrass in Louisville on Jan. 22 at the Ralph Wright Natatorium, but the No. 14 Wildcat women dropped a 174-126 decision to the No. 11 Cardinals. The UK men's team also suffered a 208.5-88.5 loss to their No. 9 in-state foe.

Riley Gaines set the first pool record of the day in the 200 free en route to winning the event by over a full second with a time of 1:43.93. The SEC Co-Swimmer of the Week on Jan. 18 also placed second in the 100 free (48.62) and third in the 50 free (22.49).

Caitlin Brooks dropped a time of 52.18 in the 100 back while Sophie Sorenson blasted a time of 1:52.11 in the 200 back to reset the UofL pool standards. Sorenson, the SEC Swimmer of the Week on Jan. 25, also won the 200 IM (1:57.77) and finished second in the 100 back (52.58) while Brooks placed third in the 100 fly (52.87).

Bailey Bonnett gave the Wildcats another win in the 100 breast as the only swimmer in the field to crack the minute-barrier, doing so in 59.89 to be just four-tenths off her lifetime best. She also finished third in both the 200 breast (2:10.03) and 200 IM (1:59.43) as Gillian Davey placed second (2:08.60) and fourth (1:59.49), respectively, in those events.

Kyndal Knight, the SEC Co-Diver of the Week on Oct. 18, dominated the 1-meter board with a final score of 290.48. Runner-up finishes for the women included Kaylee Williams in the mile (16:23.68) and Izzy Gati in the 500 free (4:45.61).

On the men's side, Mason Wilby won the 200 back in a lifetime best of 1:43.20 to move up to No. 2 all-time in school history. His time of 1:42.32 was fast enough for second in the 200 fly and was just shy of his program mark, and he also finished second in the 200 IM (1:45.85).

Danny Zhang swept both boards for the second time this season, winning the 1-meter (363.38) and 3-meter (387.30). Other notable swims included Jakob Clark who took second in both the 500 free (4:24.36) and mile (15:15.77) and Max Berg with a runner-up showing in the 200 free (1:35.80).

GUESS WHO'S BACK...BACK AGAIN

The Wildcat women return 27 student-athletes for the 2021-22 campaign as they begin their quest to make history once again. Included in those returners is co-captain Bailey Bonnett, who has opted to return to Lexington for her fifth year. The men's squad welcomes back 16 swimmers and divers who are eager to make a statement.

UK is in an excellent position to continue making their presence known in both the SEC and the NCAA. The women's program has returned all eight relay swimmers for the 2021-22 campaign, as well as 18 of the 20 point scorers and 803 of the 874 individual points accumulated a year ago.

The men's team is also in a great spot to continue moving up the rankings, as five of the eight relay swimmers, 11 of the 15 point scorers, and 330 of the 559 individual points scored are suiting up for the blue and white once again.

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NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

While UK boasts ample experience with its returning swimmers and divers, the team also has added plenty of talent with the freshman class. Nineteen newcomers will suit up in the blue and white for the first time this season, including 12 newbies on the women's team and seven for the men.

In total, the freshman class represents 12 different states — Florida, Illinois, Iowa, Kentucky, Maryland, Michigan, Missouri, Oklahoma, Pennsylvania, Tennessee, Texas, and Wisconsin — and two countries — the United States and Spain. Additionally, 21 percent of the new faces are Bluegrass State natives.

O CAPTAIN! MY CAPTAIN!

Leading the newcomers and returners alike are the team captains for the 2021-22 season. For the second straight year, the women's squad will again be led by fifth-year Bailey Bonnett and seniors Riley Gaines, Izzy Gati, Kyndal Knight, and Sophie Sorenson. Mason Wilby, a senior, will captain the men's team for yet another year, joining sophomore Sam Duncan and junior Max Hawton in the role.

MAKING HISTORY

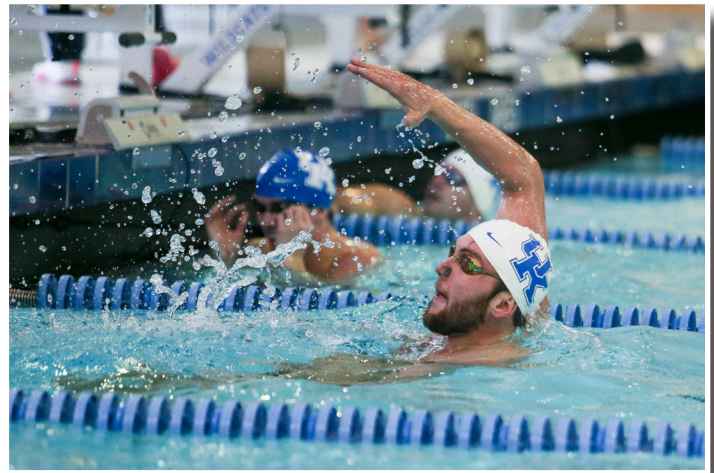
Last season saw the Wildcat women clinch their first Southeastern Conference title in program history with 1,124 points, besting the previous record of points scored by 136.5. UK collected 12 medals at the conference meet — three gold, three silver, and six bronze — in addition to breaking five school records. The 800 freestyle relay team of Izzy Gati, Riley Gaines, Kaitlynn Wheeler, and Sophie Sorenson combined to give UK their first SEC relay title since 2007, while Lauren Poole (400 IM) and Gaines (200 free) were individual champions. Ten women also landed on All-SEC teams, including five on the first team.

The men's team also experienced success at the conference meet in 2021, finishing seventh with 759 points. Their point total surpassed the previous program record of 724 points scored the year prior and was the fifth consecutive year the men's team had bested the school mark. Zane Rosely and Sam Duncan both landed on the All-SEC Freshman Team while Danny Zhang earned a spot on the All-SEC Second Team.

ON THE NATIONAL STAGE

A school-record 14 UK women were invited to the 2021 NCAA Championships en route to besting the previous record of 10 and tying for the third-most swimmers invited. Those 14 Wildcats combined for 35 entries total, which was also a school record. UK finished 11th with 152 points at NCAAs, marking their best team finish in school history as well as the most points scored, and also their fourth-straight year in the top-15. Kentucky collected 23 All-America honors — eight First Team and 15 Honorable Mention — for yet another school record, while the 800 free relay earned silver and Lauren Poole took bronze in the 400 IM.

Two swimmers and three divers were invited to compete at the big dance for the men in a combined 10 individual entries, placing 30th with 14 points. Rosely became the first UK male freshman swimmer since 2013 to earn a bid to the national meet while divers Danny Zhang and recent graduate Chase Lane earned All-American Honorable Mention honors. Mason Wilby also claimed the first All-American Honorable Mention of his career by finishing 13th in the 200 fly to break his own school record.





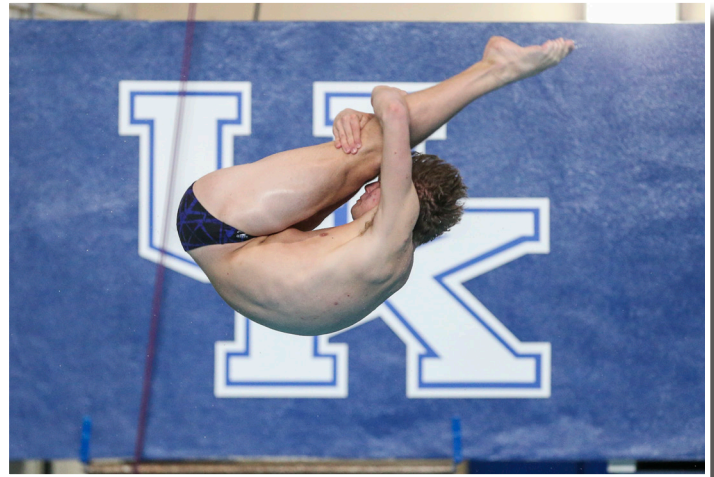
A SUMMER TO REMEMBER

This past summer was one to remember for Kentucky swimming and diving. Four Wildcats in Torie Buerger, Megan Drumm, Bridget Engel, and Jodi Ogle competed in Wave I of the U.S. Olympic Swim Trials in Omaha, Nebraska. Highlights included Ogle placing fifth in the 200m back, Buerger winning the B-final of the 200m back, and Drumm qualifying for the consolation final in the 200m free.

Kyle Barker, Bailey Bonnett, Caitlin Brooks, Gillian Davey, Izzy Gati, Parker Herren, Beth McNeese, Lauren Poole, and Sophie Sorenson raced in Wave II of Olympic Trials, which served as the sole qualifier for the U.S. Olympic Team. Those nine Wildcats qualified in a combined 26 events for the meet, which was also held in Omaha. Sorenson was a two-time semifinalist in both the 100m and 200m back, while Gillian Davey advanced to the 200m breast semifinal.

Three divers in Sam Duncan, Kyndal Knight, and Chase Lane participated at the U.S. Olympic Diving Trials in Indianapolis, Indiana. Lane, a recent graduate, was a finalist on the 10m platform and Knight was a semifinalist on the 1m springboard.

Other noteworthy from the long course season included Max Berg breaking two school records in the 200m free and 200m IM at the French Elite Championships. At Greensboro Speedo Sectionals, the Wildcats collected 10 gold, six silver, and four bronze medals in addition to setting 68 best times. Wilby won the 200m fly in dominant fashion, setting a new UK mark with a time that was the sixth-fastest in the country. Sorenson and Wilby also won the high point trophy for their respective women's and men's meets.



SMARTY CATS

Just as they excel in the pool and on the boards, the Wildcats also experience success in the classroom. Twenty-three women and 12 men found themselves on the 2021 SEC Winter Academic Honor Roll while 16 freshmen landed on the SEC First-Year Academic Honor Roll. An impressive 24 Wildcats were also named CSCAA Scholar All-Americans at the conclusion of the 2020-21 season. Boasting a 3.93 grade point average as a kinesiology major, Izzy Gati was selected to the 2020-21 CoSIDA Academic All-District Women's At-Large Team.



AN ELITE COACHING STAFF

Kentucky is undoubtedly in good hands with the coaching staff as the program prepares for another historic season. Leading the program to new heights is Lars Jorgensen and Ted Hautau, who are the defending SEC Women's Swimming Coach of the Year and SEC Men's Diving Coach of the Year, respectively.

Jorgensen begins his ninth year as the head coach, having guided UK to seven-straight top-25 team finishes at the NCAA Championships. He is also a five-time USA Swimming National Team coach and a USA Team World University Games coach. Hautau enters his 14th season as the head diving coach, completely transforming the program and leading it to national prominence where 11 student-athletes have combined for 38 All-America honors at NCAAs.

In July, Jorgensen announced that assistant coaches Michael Camper and Maclin Simpson would be elevated to associate head coaches. The 2021-22 season marks Camper's fourth year in Lexington while Simpson, a former team captain at UK, first joined the coaching staff in 2019.

Jordan Lieberman has begun his second year as an assistant coach. A four-time NCAA qualifier and former team captain for Kentucky, Bridgette Alexander returns to Lexington as an assistant coach.
