THE OPENING TIP

Michigan State's men's basketball team plays No. 4 Kentucky in the Champions Classic on Tuesday, Nov. 15 at Gainbridge Fieldhouse in Indianapolis (7 p.m., ESPN) ... The Spartans are coming off a 64-63 loss to No. 2 Gonzaga in the 2022 Armed Forces Classic – Carrier Edition aboard the deck of the USS Abraham Lincoln on Veterans Day (11/11/22) ... MSU opens its season by playing six of its first eight games away from home against one of its toughest schedules ever ... The Spartans are scheduled to play six teams who were ranked in the preseason Associated Press poll ... Since 2009-10, the Spartans are one of six teams (including the 2016-17 Spartans) to play at least four AP ranked opponents in the month of November ... MSU is the ONLY team to play two teams in the top 4, with No. 2 Gonzaga last Friday and No. 4 Kentucky on Tuesday night.

No. 1 nationally in assist rate (46.9%) per KenPom last year ... Started eight of the final 13 games of the season ... Finished the season averaging 7.0 points, 2.3 rebounds and led the team with 4.8 assists per game while playing 20.3 minutes.

Second season at Michigan State after transferring from Northeastern ... Tied for most career starts on the team (78) ... Averaged 9.6 points and 3.9 assists in Big Ten games ... Needs 6 points to reach 1,000 for his career (he scored 680 at Northeastern).

A preseason All-Big Ten selection ... An honorable mention selection (coaches) last year as a junior ... Last year finished fourth on the team in scoring with 8.9 points and third on the team with 4.6 rebounds ... Also averaged 1.1 assists.

A starter in 29 of 35 games played last season ... Reached double figures in scoring eight times ... Tied his career-high with 27 points in NCAA Tournament win over Davidson ... Had three games with at least 10 rebounds ... Two double-doubles.

Appeared in 25 games, averaging 1.1 points and 1.8 rebounds in 5.5 minutes per game ... Connected on 58.8 percent of his field goals (10-of-17) and 43.8 percent of his free throws (7-of-16) ... Scored a career-high 8 points and had 2 rebounds at Michigan (3/4).

THE STARTING FIVE

1. The Nation's Toughest November

Like they did at the start of the 2016-17 season, Michigan State will begin the 2022-23 season with arguably one of the toughest opening months in college basketball ... In 2016-17, the Spartans faced No. 1 Duke, No. 2 Kentucky and No. 10 Arizona ... This year, the Spartans will face four teams ranked in the preseason AP Top 25 (Gonzaga, No. 2; Kentucky, No. 4; Indiana, No. 13; Villanova, No. 16; Michigan, No. 22; Illinois, No. 23) ... Since 2009-10, Michigan State is one of only six teams (including that 2016-17 team) to play at least four AP ranked opponents in the month of November ... Michigan State is the ONLY team to play two teams in the top 4, with No. 2 Gonzaga on Friday and No. 4 Kentucky on Tuesday in the Champions Classic in Indianapolis (credit: Sportsradar).

2. Series History

Michigan State and Kentucky meet for the 26th time in program history on Tuesday, Nov. 15 ... Kentucky leads the head-to-head series, 14-11 ... Kentucky has won the last two meetings, but the teams have split the last eight overall ... Michigan State is 1-2 against Kentucky in the Champions Classic.

3. Champions Classic

Michigan State is 4-7 all-time in the Champions Classic ... The Spartans lost to then-No. 3 Kansas, 87-74, at Madison Square Garden... Kentucky has a 5-6 record in the Champions Classic, Duke is 7-4 and Kansas is 6-5.

3. About the Spartans

The Spartans return nine letterwinners from last year's team that finished 23-13 overall and 11-9 in the Big Ten and reached the NCAA Tournament for the 24th-straight season ... Head Coach Tom Izzo welcomes back five players who started at least one game last year, and a trio of seniors – forwards Malik Hall and Joey Hauser and guard Tyson Walker – who have combined to play 278 games and started 177 games in their careers ... Hall is coming of a junior year that saw him earn honorable mention All-Big Ten honors from the league's coaches after averaging 8.9 points and 4.6 rebounds per game ... He is expected to be joined in the starting lineup by graduate forward Hauser, who enters his third year at MSU ...The 6-9 forward averaged 7.3 points and 5.3 rebounds last year in 22.2 minutes per game ... Walker appeared in all 36 games last year, starting 28 times and finishing third on the team in minutes played (22.6 mpg) ... He was fifth on the team in scoring with 8.2 points per game and second on the team with 4.3 assists per game ... Also back for the Spartans is junior guard A.J. Hoggard, who started eight games last year and finished the season averaging 7.0 points, 2.3 rebounds and led the team with 4.8 assists in 20.3 minutes per game ... He ranked No. 1 in the country per kenpom.com in assist rate (46.0 percent) ... Sophomore guards Jaden Akins and Pierre Brooks II, along with junior center Mady Sissoko, are expected to play significant minutes this season ... Akins, who is recovering from surgery in the off-season, averaged 3.4 points and 2.4 rebounds last year.

5. Four Newcomers Make up Freshman Class

The Spartans welcome four freshmen to the 2022-23 team ... The freshmen class includes a group of players expected to make contributions immediately: forward Jaxon Kohler, guard Tre Holloman and center Carson Cooper, as well as walk-on guard Nick Sanders.

MICHIGAN STATE FALLS TO GONZAGA, 64-63, IN ARMED FORCES CLASSIC

- » Michigan State had a chance to win the game at the buzzer, but its shot was off the mark and No. 2 Gonzaga escaped with a 64-63 win over the Spartans in the Armed Forces Classic, held on the flight deck of the USS Abraham Lincoln on Friday evening.
- » Junior forward Mady Sissoko scored 14 points and had nine rebounds to lead the Spartans, while junior guard A.J. Hoggard 12 points and six assists, senior guard Tyson Walker added 12 points and senior forward Malik Hall finished with 11 points and seven rebounds.

LOGGING MILES

In the early portion of the season, not only will Michigan State be playing some of the best teams in the country, the Spartans will be putting in a lot of mileage, with a trip to San Diego to start the season, a trip to Oregon for the Phil Knight Invitational and a pair of trips to Indiana for the Champions Classic and the ACC/Big Ten Challenge ... All told, MSU will log more than 10,000 miles of travel in November.

ABOUT THE WILDCATS

- » Kentucky enters the game on Tuesday night with a 2-0 record following wins over Howard (95-63) and Duquesne (77-52) to star the season.
- » The Wildcats returned No. 4 in the Associated Press and the USA Today Coaches preseason polls.
- » Senior guard Antonio Reeves (an Illinois State transfer) and redshirt senior CJ Fredrick (Iowa) lead the Wildcats in scoring, averaging 20.0 points and 17.0 points per game, respectively ... The guards have combined to hit more than 50 percent of their 3-point attempts (16-of-30, 53.3%).
- » Kentucky has not had senior forward Oscar Tshiebwe play yet this season ... A preseason Player of the Year candidate, Tshiebwe averaged 17.4 points and 15.1 rebounds last year.
- » Toppin, a Rhode Island transfer, is averaging 11.5 points and 9.5 rebounds through two games, while 6-11, 225-pound freshman Ugonna Onyenso has played 19 minutes and is averaging 7.5 points and 7.0 rebounds.
- » Freshman guard Cason Wallace has averaged 31 minutes in the first two games, with 11.5 points, 5.5 rebounds and 6.5 assists.

AGAINST KENTUCKY

- » Michigan State and Kentucky meet for the 26th time in program history on Tuesday, Nov. 15.
- » Kentucky leads the head-to-head series, 14-11, including a 2-1 mark in Champions Classic games.
- » The Wildcats have won the last two games, but the teams have split the last eight meetings, with seven of those games either decided by fewer than 10 points or overtime (a 94-82 MSU overtime win in the 2005 NCAA Tournament).

MSU AGAINST THE SEC

- » The game against Kentucky will be the 70th all-time for Michigan State against a team from the Southeastern Conference.
- » The Spartans have an all-time record of 42-27 record against teams from the SEC.
- » Tom Izzo has an all-time record of 20-6 against teams from the SEC.

MSU IN NOVEMBER

- » Michigan State has an all-time record of 149-43 in games played in the month of November ... This includes a 95-3 mark at home ... The last team to beat MSU at home in November was a David Robinson-led Navy squad that bested the Spartans, 91-90, in overtime on Nov. 29, 1986.

- » Tom Izzo is 73-0 all-time at home in November, 111-36 for the month overall.

- » The Spartans went 5-2 in November last year, rattling off five-straight wins after losing the season opener ... The Spartans posted a 73-52 win at Butler's famed Hinkle Fieldhouse, then posted a pair of wins in the Battle 4 Atlantis, including a 64-60 win over then-No. 20 UConn.



WHAT'S BACK

- » Michigan State lost its top three scorers from last season, but still returns more than 50 percent (50.2% to be exact) of its scoring from last season.
- » Despite the losses of All-Big Ten selection Gabe Brown (11.6 ppg), Marcus Bingham Jr. (9.3 ppg) and second round NBA Draft pick Max Christie (9.3 ppg), the Spartans return four players – Malik Hall (8.9 ppg), Tyson Walker (8.2 ppg), Joey Hauser (7.3 ppg) and A.J. Hoggard (7.0 ppg) – who each averaged between 7 and 9 points per game.
- » The Spartans also return more than 50 percent of their rebounds (55.1%), with second-leading rebounder Hauser (5.3 rpg) and Hall (4.6 rpg, third on the team) among the returnees.
- » The Green & White also have 80.5 percent of the team's assists back, with Hoggard (4.8 apg, #1 in the country in assist rate per KenPom.com last year) and Walker (4.3 apg) leading the way.
- » **Experience Matters** – Three Spartans – Hall, Hauser and Walker – have combined to play 278 games in their careers and started 177 games, with Hauser and Walker lead the way with 76 starts apiece.

HALL OF FAME CONNECTIONS

- » Michigan State's roster includes several players with Hall of Fame connections.
- » The Spartans have the sons of a Pro Basketball Hall of Famer (Steven Izzo) and the son of an NFL Hall of Famer (Nick Sanders, the son of long-time Detroit Lions standout Barry Sanders) on the roster.
- » Michigan State is the only school in the country with the sons of a basketball and football Hall of Famer on the roster.
- » Add in Davis Smith, whose father Steve is a Michigan State Hall of Famer, and the Spartans have three sons of Hall of Famers on the roster.

MALIK HALL SELECTED TO PRESEASON ALL-BIG TEN TEAM

- » Senior forward Malik Hall was one of 11 players selected to the Preseason All-Big Ten men's basketball team on October 6.
- » It was the second career All-Big Ten honor for Hall, who was an honorable mention selection for his performance during the 2021-22 season.
- » A fourth-year senior, Hall appeared in all 36 games and started seven times, finishing fourth on the team in scoring with 8.9 points and third on the team with 4.6 rebounds with 1.1 assists per game.
- » Hall is among the most experienced players on the MSU roster entering the 2022-23, with 95 career games played as a Spartan. He has a career average of 6.3 points and 4.2 rebounds
- » An Academic All-Big Ten selection, Hall earned his bachelor's degree in communication and is pursuing a master's degree in sport coaching & leadership.

COACHING STAFF CHANGES

- » Head Coach Tom Izzo had positions to fill on his staff after long-time assistant Dwayne Stephens was named head coach at Western Michigan and Mike Garland announced his retirement at the end of the school year.
- » Former Michigan State men's basketball standout and graduate assistant Thomas Kelley rejoined the program as an assistant in June after spending four seasons as an assistant coach at Western Michigan.
- » Kelley started his coaching career at Michigan State in 2015-16 and the Spartans won two Big Ten Championships and reached three NCAA Tournaments during that time.
- » Kelley played at Michigan State from 1994-99 and as a fifth-year senior in 1998-99, he was part of Izzo's first Final Four team, helping to lead the Spartans to a 33-5 overall record, the No. 2 national ranking by the Associated Press and a Big Ten Championship.
- » Jon Borovich was named director of recruiting operations for the Michigan State men's basketball program in August.
- » Borovich started his coaching career at Michigan State as a graduate assistant from 2001-03 under Izzo ... Borovich comes to East Lansing after spending three seasons as an assistant coach at Northwestern. He helped lead the Wildcats to seven Big Ten wins in each of the last two seasons, the program's most in a year since the 2016-17 season.

HEAD COACH TOM IZZO

- » Now in his 28th season at Michigan State, Hall of Fame coach Tom Izzo has built the Spartans into one of the elite programs in the nation.
- » The Spartans' 24 straight NCAA Tournaments are a Big Ten record, the second-longest active streak in Division I and tied for the third-longest in NCAA history ... He's been able to accomplish this while playing more ranked teams than anyone else since 1998.
- » Michigan State has appeared in eight Final Fours since 1999, the most in the nation.

COACHING STABILITY

- » Michigan State has had just two basketball coaches in the last 46 seasons and three in the last 53 ... Tom Izzo is in his 28th season, having taking over from his mentor Jud Heathcote, who spent 19 years as head coach (1976-95).
- » Before Heathcote, Gus Ganakas spent seven seasons as head coach ... The late Ganakas provided commentary on Spartan radio broadcasts for 31 seasons before his passing in 2019.

**IZZO PASSES KNIGHT FOR ALL-TIME OVERALL BIG TEN WIN RECORD**

- » When Michigan State beat Maryland in the regular season finale last season, the win was the 663rd for Head Coach Tom Izzo.
- » The win moved Izzo past former Indiana coach Bob Knight for the Big Ten record for overall wins by a league coach with at least 10 years in the conference ... He tied Knight when the Spartans beat Purdue on Feb. 26.
- » Knight won 662 games in 29 years in Bloomington (662-240, .734) ... Izzo has a career record of 666-267 (.714) ... Knight is the all-time leader for Big Ten Conference wins (353), with Izzo second at 322.

SPARTANS SHARE THE BALL

- » Unselfishness has always been a trademark of all Tom Izzo teams.
- » That has been especially true for nearly the last decade as MSU established the top-five school record for assists during that span.
- » In 2018-19, the Spartans led the country in total assists and handed out the second-most in a single season in MSU history (715), recording an assist on 66.8 percent of their field goals that season.
- » In 2017-18, MSU led the country in assists per game (19.1) and handed out 670, then the second-best mark in program history.
- » In 2015-16, MSU tallied a school record 719 assists, good for the 22nd-best total in NCAA history ... MSU's nation's-best assist average of 20.5 was the 23rd-best average in NCAA history.
- » **Last year, the Spartans handed out at least 20 seven times and at least 15 on 20 occasions, and averaged 15.7 per game(4th in the Big Ten) ... MSU ranked No. 18 nationally per KenPom in Assist Rate at 60.2% (565 assists on 939 made field goals).**

POINT OF ATTACK

- » Junior Tyson Walker and sophomore A.J. Hoggard split the point guard duties last season, with Walker starting 28 games and averaging 22.6 mpg while Hoggard averaging 20.3 and started the final eight games of the season.
- » In 36 games last year, the duo combined to average 15.2 points, 9.1 assists, 3.6 rebounds and 1.9 steals per game.
- » **Hoggard ranked No. 1 in the country in Assist Rate (46.1%) per KenPom, while Walker was No. 14 nationally (36.0%).**

DEFENSIVE MINDED

- » One of the mantras for Michigan State Head Coach Tom Izzo has always been to Defend, Rebound and Run ... The Spartans ranked No. 53 nationally in the KenPom Adjusted Defensive Efficiency ratings.
- » MSU allowed 60 points or fewer five times last season and ranked seventh in Big Ten games in scoring defense (70.0 ppg)

DEFEND, REBOUND, RUN

- » Michigan State Head Coach Tom Izzo has always said that if his teams can defend and rebound, it will lead to positives.
- » The Spartans have led the Big Ten in rebounding 10 times in the last 19 years and led the nation in rebounding four times (in 2009, 2010, 2016 and 2019) since 2009.
- » In 2019-20, MSU led the Big Ten in rebounding offense (40.6 rpg) and tied for the league lead in rebounding margin (+7.5 rebounds) ... That same year, the Spartans led the Big Ten in field goal percentage defense, limiting opponents to 37.9 percent shooting.
- » **In 2021-22, the Spartans were 4th in rebounding offense (36.9 rpg) and 4th in rebounding margin (+4.2 rpg) overall ... In B1G games, Michigan State was 6th in rebounding offense (35.1) and 5th in rebounding margin (+2.8).**

GRADUATE MATTERS

MICHIGAN STATE TO HONOR TWO FORMER PLAYERS

- » Michigan State will wear patches this season to honor two former players who passed away in the past year, Adreian Payne and Stanley Washington.
- » Washington, who passed away on July 12 at 78-years-old, played at Michigan State from 1963-66 ... He finished his career at Michigan State ranked second all-time in scoring at the school and is currently 31st all-time with 1,242 points in 69 games over three seasons, averaging 18.0 points per game
- » He still ranks sixth all-time in scoring average (18.0 ppg), his 10.5 rebounds per game during his career ranks fifth all-time and he is ninth all-time in free throw percentage, connecting on 81.5 percent of his shots (278-of-341).
- » Payne, a 2014 NBA First Round pick of the Atlanta Hawks, left Michigan State in 2014 as one of nine players in program history with 1,200 career points (1,232) and 700 career rebounds (735), while also ranking as the school's all-time leader in blocked shots (141) at the time.
- » As a senior in 2014, he averaged 16.4 points and 7.3 rebounds as an All-Big Ten Second Team selection, while also earning USBWA and NABC All-District accolades as well as honorable mention Associated Press All-America honors.
- » He was selected to the Big Ten All-Tournament and the NCAA East Regional All-Tournament teams as the Spartans captured the 2014 Big Ten Tournament title and advanced to the Elite Eight of the NCAA Tournament.
- » His postseason included a 41-point performance against Delaware in the second round of the NCAA Tournament, establishing many school records, including the most points ever by an Izzo-coached Spartan and the most points ever by a Spartan in the NCAA Tournament.

MEN'S BASKETBALL ADDS FOUR ON SIGNING DAY IN CLASS THAT RANKS AMONG NATION'S BEST

Michigan State's men's basketball team has received signed National Letters of Intent from Xavier Booker (Indianapolis, Ind./Cathedral), Coen Carr (East Point, Ga./Legacy Early College), Jeremy Fears (Joliet, Ill./Joliet West) and Gehrig Normand (North Richland Hills, Texas/Birdville).

The Spartans recruiting class has been recognized nationally as one of the best in the country, ranked No. 3 by Rivals, No. 3 by 247 Sports and No. 5 by ON3 Sports. All four players are ranked among the top-55 nationally by ON3 Sports.

"As we get ready to go on our trip to San Diego, nothing is more exciting than having the four players that my staff did such a job recruiting and my players did a good job," Michigan State Head Coach Tom Izzo said. "We got four guys that are "OKG" – Our Kinda Guys. They were guys that get along, they kind of united together, all four of them spent a lot of time talking to each other. Coen Carr was the last one, Gehrig (Normand) from down in Texas, he was one of the early ones. Of course Book (Xavier Booker) down in Indianapolis is the, I guess, marquee in the class, but Jeremy Fears is probably the ringmaster. He's the Mateen Cleaves, the Magic Johnson of the bunch. He just brings a unity and a confidence. He's an extroverted personality who I think will fit in here very well."

Xavier Booker (6-11, 220, F – Indianapolis, Ind. / Cathedral)

Listed as the No. 1 recruit in the country by Rivals ... Also carries three top-20 selections, No. 3 by ESPN, No. 6 by 247 Sports and No. 9 by On3 Sports ... The No. 1 rated (Rivals, ESPN) or No. 2 (247 Sports, On3 Sports) at his position ... The highest-ranked recruit to commit to Michigan State under Head Coach Tom Izzo, per 247 Sports ... Coached by Jason Delaney at Cathedral High School ... As a junior, averaged 12.5 points and 6.7 rebounds while shooting 36.0 percent from 3-point land ... Had 19 points, 14 rebounds and nine blocked shots against Ben Davis in the Indiana state tournament ... Plays for the George Hill All-Indy AAU team, coached by Mike Saunders ... Most Valuable Player at the Pangos All-American Camp ... Has a 7-5 wingspan.

Izzo on Booker...

"Xavier Booker is the marquee player in this class at 6-10, with a 7-4 wingspan. He can really shoot the ball, and he reminds us a lot of a younger Jaren Jackson Jr. He's a player that can do a lot of versatile things. He's got versatility, he's got athleticism, he's got a solid shot and he has a great understanding of the game. He has been very well-coached, and he's won a state championship, so he knows what winning is all about. As he gets stronger – I think we've only seen a small portion of what this kid is going to be able to do. I'm excited to have him. He too comes from an incredible family. His mom videotapes every game. I have more fun watching her in the stands sometimes. We have had some great success with kids out of Indianapolis, and I hope that Xavier will be the next great one."

Coen Carr (6-6, 215, F – East Point, Ga. / Legacy Early College [S.C.]

Ranked as the No. 29 overall player in the country by On3 Sports and No. 45 by 247 Sports ... Also ranked No. 71 by ESPN and No. 87 by Rivals ... Slotted among the top 20 players in the country at his position, coming in at No. 8 by 247 Sports, No. 6 by On3 Sports, No. 17 by Rivals and No. 18 by ESPN ... Coached by Barney Jackson at Legacy Early College ... Played his first two seasons at Dutchtown High School in Hampton, Ga. ... Named to the GBCBA First Team All-County squad in 2022 ... Plays for the Georgia Stars AAU ... A member of the USA Basketball 3x3 U18 World Cup Team.

Izzo on Carr...

"Coen Carr is 6-6, kind of a swingman from Georgia. He's really here because of his mother, Cynthia. When we had him on his official visit, he was unbelievable. He got along with everybody. But his mother was super. She was playing games with us all, and kind of made everybody feel comfortable. On the official visit, I got a chance to meet his dad too. We have a saying here, 'Our Kinda Guy,' but we also look for 'Our Kind of Family.' Coen Carr has an incredible athletic ability and is improving his shooting every day. He has risen in the standings because he plays hard. We're really excited about him."

Jeremy Fears Jr. (6-2, 185, F – Joliet, Ill. / Joliet West)

The first player of the class to commit to MSU ... Tabbed No. 33 in his class by 247 Sports ... Also ranked No. 34 by ESPN, No. 37 from Rivals and No. 54 from On3 Sports ... Among point guards, he is ranked No. 8 by 247 Sports and On3 Sports, No. 9 by ESPN and No. 11 by Rivals ... Plays at Joliet West High School ... Spent his sophomore and junior years playing at LaLumiere in LaPorte, Ind. ... Helped lead LaLumiere to a 21-5 record in 2021-22, averaging 8.5 points and 4.1 assists ... Plays for Bradley Beal Elite and the Indy Heat AAU ... Has USA Basketball experience, playing on the U17 team that won the gold medal at the 2022 FIBA U17 Basketball World Cup ... Scored 17 points in the semifinals vs. Lithuania ... Had 18 points and six assists in the final versus host Spain ... Averaged 9.9 points, 2.9 rebounds and 4.4 assists ... Also a member of the U16 National Team that went 6-0 and won a gold medal at the 2021 FIBA American U16 Championship in Mexico ... Selected as a Most Valuable Player at the Pangos All-American camp.

Izzo on Fears...

"Jeremy Fears is the straw that stirs the drink. He's the pied piper for everybody in the country. He reminds me so much of Mateen Cleaves as far as how he gets along with everybody. Tough, rugged, and competitive kid, but as much as he is all of those things, he is friends with everybody. Everybody knows of him, and everybody loves to talk to him. He has done very well with USA Basketball, and he is the consummate point guard. He is improving his shooting every day, but he's as good a quarterback as any we've had here. I guess Mateen is who I recognize the most, even though he isn't quite built like him, but he's tough as nails. He has an ability to make other people around him better than they actually are, and that's a quality that coaches are always looking for. His family has been up here a couple of times, and his dad was a very good college basketball player, so we are excited to have Jeremy."

Gehrig Normand (6-5, 185, G – North Richlands, Texas / Birdville)

Tabbed as the No. 48 player in the country by Rivals ... Also ranked among the top-100 by three other organizations, coming in at No. 51 by On3 Sports, No. 94 from 247 Sports and No. 98 by ESPN ... Among shooting guards, Normand is ranked No. 8 at Rivals, No. 9 by On3 Sports, No. 20 by 247 Sports and No. 24 by ESPN ... Played for Anthony Holman at Birdville High School ... Averaged 11.8 points, 6.3 rebounds, 4.3 assists as a junior ... Helped lead Birdville to a 23-11 record, including a 12-game win streak, as the team won the District 6-5A Championship ... Also plays for the 3D Empire AAU, coached by Shawn Ward.

Izzo on Normand...

"Gehrig Normand is a 6-5 guard from down in Texas, not far from Matt McQuaid. That's intriguing, because they are similar types of players, and now Matt is on our staff. Gehrig has an incredible family. His dad actually played some college football. He has a great, competitive nature. He's got a brother who is a good football player too, so he comes from an athletic family. With Gehrig, we've got a guy who can shoot the ball, and he's also a very good athlete. He's another personality that seems to get along with everybody, and that's really the theme of this whole class. We're excited to get another guy from Texas. Matt McQuaid was a great find for us, and I think Gehrig Normand will be right there with him."

Coach Izzo

In his 28th year, Tom Izzo (Northern Michigan, '77) is 667-268 (.713), and 322-152 (.679) in the Big Ten, as the head coach of the Michigan State basketball program. He ranks as the winningest coach in Michigan State history, having passed his mentor Jud Heathcote with his 341st career victory on Nov. 28, 2009. In his 26-plus seasons as a head coach, Izzo has captured eight National Coach of the Year awards, including the Clair Bee Award in 2005 and NABC honors in 2001 and 2012. In 1999, Izzo was named National Coach of the Year by Basketball Times, while earning similar honors from The Associated Press, Basketball News and the USBWA in '98. He also earned National Coach of the Year accolades from CBSSports.com in 2012. He earned Big Ten Coach of the Year honors in 1998, 2009 and 2012. Izzo was enshrined in the Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame on September 9, 2016, cementing his status as one of the game's all-time greats.

Among The Big Ten's Best

Tom Izzo's .679 winning percentage in Big Ten games ranks fourth all-time among league coaches with at least 10 years of service, behind former Wisconsin coach Bo Ryan (.717), former Indiana coach Bob Knight (.700), and former Purdue coach Ward Lambert (.685). In all games, Ohio State's Thad Matta ranks first at .748, followed by Ryan (.737), Knight (.734), Izzo (.713), Wisconsin's Walter Meanwell (.712), and Lambert (.709). With 322 conference victories, Izzo ranks second all time. When MSU beat Maryland on March 6, 2022, Izzo reached 663 wins, passing Knight (662) for most overall wins as a head coach at a Big Ten school.

Izzo Among Best Ever

Through his first 27 seasons, Tom Izzo won 666 games, ranking fifth in college basketball history for most wins by a college coach in his first 27 years.

Final Fours

Tom Izzo led MSU to eight Final Four appearances between 1999 and 2019, becoming just the fourth school in college basketball history to do it in any 21-year span, including just the third since the tournament field expanded to 64 teams in 1985. Izzo's eight Final Fours are the most by any coach since his first season in 1996 and he ranks fifth all-time, including third among active coaches. The eight Final Fours are also the most by any Big Ten coach.
