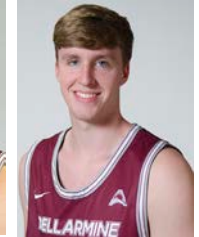

KNIGHT INSIGHTS

A COSTLY PRACTICE

In the midst of a particularly harsh portion of its schedule, Bellarmine had a particularly harsh practice on Saturday. With two starters (Suder and Hopf) already sitting out of practice to nurse injuries, the Knights saw three injuries occur in a 10-minute span. ASUN Preseason Defensive Player of the Year Juston Betz, who leads the team in rebounds and assists took a knee to the labrum; Nick Thelen suffered a knee injury and Zac Jennings dislocated a shoulder. All three missed the UCLA game on Sunday and their playing status for future games is currently being evaluated.

CAREER GAMES

While injuries prevented several Knights from competing against UCLA, several more turned in career-best performances. Redshirt freshman Ben Johnson--Kentucky's "Mr. Basketball" in 2021--tossed in a career-best 20 points while Curt Hopf set new career standards in points (16) and 3-pointers made (4). Jaylen Fairman took advantage of increased minutes to notch career bests of five assists and four rebounds.

MILESTONE VICTORY

Coach Scott Davenport secured his 400th win when the Knights romped past Campbellsville-Harrodsburg 86-46 on Nov. 14. He accomplished the feat in just 531 games...faster than his former

bosses (and Hall of Fame members) Denny Crum (536 games) and Rick Pitino (548 games).

THE GAUNTLET 2.0

In nine days, Bellarmine will play at No. 8 Duke (11/21), at Loyola Marymount (11/25), at No. 19 UCLA (11/27) and at No. 15 Kentucky (11/29). In playing in the iconic venues of Cameron Indoor Stadium, Pauley Pavilion and Rupp Arena along the way, Bellarmine joins only four other schools to play in all three of those arenas (St. John's North Carolina, University of Louisville, and Notre Dame). The Knights are the only team to do it in the same year with the next closest being 333 days over two seasons. **Total mileage** for the Knights in this 9-day span clocks in at **5,633 miles**, and that doesn't include incidental travel between hotel and other destinations such as practice and team meals.

THE GAUNTLET 1.0

Last November, BU ran through a similar gauntlet, facing Purdue, Gonzaga and UCLA all of whom carried the No. 1 ranking at some point in the month. According to last season's final NCAA NET ratings, BU played the nation's 2nd toughest nonconference schedule. Other top nonconference opponents included St. Mary's and Murray State, both of whom were ranked in the nation's top 25 in the AP's final poll of 2021-22.

HEAD COACH SCOTT DAVENPORT

Scott Davenport, who in just two seasons in Division I guided the Bellarmine University men's basketball to an ASUN Tournament title after leading the Knights to a Division II national championship, will enter his 18th season at Bellarmine in 2022-23.

Davenport, who became the 11th coach in program history on April 29, 2005, embarks on his latest campaign carrying a 398-130 career record at Bellarmine. He is the program's all-time winningest coach.

Achieving unprecedented feats has been a hallmark of Davenport's legendary career at Bellarmine. The latest landmark accomplishment came last season, when Davenport guided the Knights to their first-ever ASUN Tournament championship and first 20-win season at the D1 level. For the second time in as many years, Davenport was nominated for the Hugh Durham National Coach of the Year Award, which recognizes coaches from mid-major conferences.

Hoisting the ASUN Tournament trophy was the defining moment in an unforgettable first two seasons in the highest NCAA level for Davenport and his charges. In 2020-21, Bellarmine's D1 debut, the Knights sported a 14-8 record overall and earned an invitation to a national postseason tournament (CBI) after falling just one game shy of capturing the ASUN Conference regular-season crown. In addition to the Hugh Durham Award, Davenport was also nominated for the Jim Phelan National Coach of the Year Award.

Prior to Bellarmine's rise to D1 and the ASUN, Davenport built the program into a D2 powerhouse. In his sixth year, he took Bellarmine all the way to the top by leading the Knights to the 2011 NCAA II Tournament national championship. For his efforts, he was named national Coach of the Year by two different organizations: the National Association of Basketball Coaches and the Division II Bulletin.

In 15 seasons in D2 at Bellarmine, Davenport amassed an overall record of 364-109 (.770 winning percentage) and a Great Lakes Valley Conference record of 192-65 (.747). The Knights advanced to four Final Fours (2011, 2012, 2015, 2017), captured five GLVC Tournament titles (2010, 2011, 2017, 2018, 2019) and secured at least a share of six GLVC regular-season championships. Before transitioning to D1, Bellarmine carried the nation's longest active streak of consecutive appearances in the NCAA II Tournament with 12. The Knights won at least 20 games in all 12 of those seasons and reached 30 wins on three occasions.

In addition to his national Coach of the Year honors in 2011, Davenport was named GLVC Coach of the Year in 2011, 2012, 2017 and 2018. He mentored: five D2 All-Americans in Braydon Hobbs, Jeremy Kendle, Jake Thelen, Rusty Troutman and Adam Eberhard; three GLVC Player of the Year recipients in Kendle, Hobbs and Thelen; and another GLVC Freshman of the Year and National Player of the Year in Hobbs.

In Bellarmine's final season in D2, Davenport pushed the Knights to their 12th straight berth in the NCAA II Tournament before the tourney was canceled as a precautionary measure against the coronavirus. Bellarmine went 20-8, racking up its 12th season in a row of at least 20 wins under Davenport.

BU extended its run of championship seasons under Davenport in 2018-19. The Knights wrangled their third straight GLVC Tournament championship and posted a 28-5 record, marking a third consecutive season with at least 28 wins. Bellarmine earned its 11th straight berth in the NCAA Tournament and advanced to the Sweet 16.

Bellarmine had yet another extraordinary season under Davenport in 2017-18. The Knights finished 29-3 and captured their second GLVC Tournament title in a row and fourth overall on Davenport's watch. Bellarmine won an outright GLVC regular-season championship for the second straight season, marking the fifth consecutive year the Knights won at least a share of the regular-season crown. Davenport was voted GLVC Coach of the Year for the fourth time and guided Bellarmine to a 10th straight appearance in the NCAA Tournament.

In 2016-17, the Knights earned a fourth NCAA Midwest Region title and trip to the Final Four in seven years while going 32-4 in accumulating the second-most wins in program history. The NCAA Tournament appearance represented the program's ninth in a row. Davenport pushed the Knights to an outright GLVC East title and their third GLVC Tourna-

ment championship. For his efforts, Davenport was chosen as the GLVC Coach of the Year for a third time.

In 2014-15, Davenport led the Knights to their third Final Four in five years following a GLVC East championship and an NCAA Midwest Regional title. The Knights finished 31-4 overall and 17-1 in the GLVC. The run to the national semifinals of the NCAA Tournament marked Bellarmine's seventh straight appearance in the Big Dance.

The 2011-12 campaign was another outstanding season as the Knights went 29-4 and made their second straight appearance in the Elite Eight and Final Four. Bellarmine captured another GLVC East crown with a 16-2 league mark as Davenport earned co-Coach of the Year honors in the GLVC.

In 2010-11, everything came together as Davenport led Bellarmine to a 33-2 record while capturing the Knights' first national championship in any sport. Among the milestones reached by the 2011 squad were best winning percentage, most wins and most consecutive wins. Davenport's Knights had a 17-1 GLVC regular-season record while competing in arguably the toughest conference division in all of college basketball. His colleagues recognized him for this accomplishment by voting him the GLVC Coach of the Year.

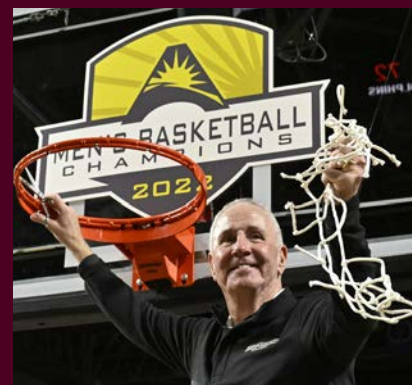
After a breakout 2008-09 season, the nation was beginning to take notice of Bellarmine University. Heading into the 2009-10 season, Sporting News tabbed the Knights as preseason No. 1. The Knights would finish with a 23-9 record and win the GLVC Tournament championship for the first time in program history.

In the 2008-09 season, Davenport led the Knights to one of the best seasons in Bellarmine basketball history, setting then-school records for most wins in a season, most games played and highest in-season national ranking. His 26-7 Knights made it to the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament, narrowly losing to the eventual national champion in overtime in the NCAA Midwest Regional final.

In his debut season, Davenport — who inherited a program that had finished last in the GLVC the year before — led his troops to Bellarmine's first .500 finish since 2001, and the first conference tournament appearance since 2002. Improvement continued in 2007-08, as Davenport and the Knights once again finished with a winning record at 17-11 and returned to the GLVC Tournament.

Prior to coming to Bellarmine, Davenport served nine years as an assistant coach at the University of Louisville under national championship-winning Hall of Fame coaches Denny Crum and Rick Pitino. He also served a year as an assistant coach on Mike Pollio's staff at Virginia Commonwealth where he coached alongside future Kentucky coach Tubby Smith. Before heading to Louisville, Davenport spent 10 seasons as the head boys' coach at Ballard High School, where he won a state championship in 1988 and coached two future NBA players in DeJuan Wheat and Allan Houston.

A Louisville native, Davenport and his wife, Sharon, have two sons, Russ and Doug, who are both Bellarmine graduates. Doug is an assistant coach under his father.

“D”EDICATION TO THE PROGRAM

After completing his fifth year with the team and after earning undergraduate and graduate degrees (both with honors), Bellarmine’s Juston Betz announced he would use his “COVID year” and return for an unprecedented sixth season with the Knights program. The ASUN Conference coaches were among those who took notice by voting him the league’s preseason Defensive Player of the Year. Last season, Betz was the ASUN’s third-best rebounder with an average of 7.1 per game, a statistic made more impressive that he did that as a 6-3 guard. He also ranked among the league’s top eight in steals, assist to turnover ratio, and minutes played, He also was named the All-Tournament Team of the ASUN Championship. Betz, a graduate student who is working on his second master’s degree, also raked in the academic honors a year ago. He was one of just 48 D1 men’s basketball players to earn Academic All-District honors and he was on the ASUN’s All-Academic Team. The ASUN also sponsored a fan vote for preseason honors, and Betz also won Defensive Player of the Year on that ballot as well.

HEIR APPARENT

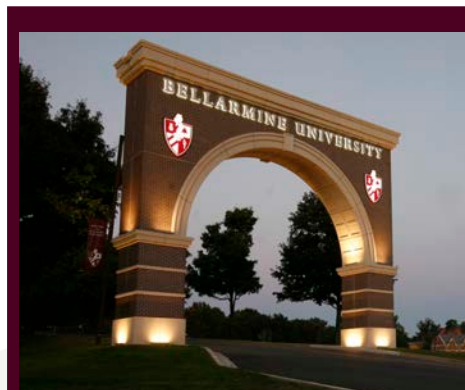
In May, Bellarmine University Director of Athletics Scott Wiegandt announced that Doug Davenport had been named as men’s basketball’s Coach-in-Waiting, which essentially provides for the reins of the Knights to be transferred to Doug Davenport when his father, Scott Davenport, decides to retire. A 2010 graduate of Bellarmine, Doug Davenport played for the Knights all four years before embarking on his coaching career at Xavier University, where he earned a master’s in education in 2012. He went on to serve on Coach Rick Pitino’s staff at Louisville from 2012-2015 (2013 NCAA champions, 2015 NCAA Elite Eight) before moving on to Eastern Kentucky University in 2015-16, where he served under Coach Dan McHale. Since joining his father’s coaching staff prior to the 2016-17 season, he helped guide the Knights to three straight Great Lakes Valley Conference Tournament championships, an NCAA II Final Four appearance and a highly successful transition as an NCAA Division I school. Last season, the Knights captured the ASUN Tournament crown and notched their first 20-win season in Bellarmine’s D1 era. U of L went 29-5 overall and 16-2 in the ACC last season en route to the Final Four.

IMPACT PLAYER

In June, Bellarmine University Head Men’s Basketball Coach Scott Davenport added to his roster by signing 7-year-old Seth Walsh through Team IMPACT, a national non-profit organization that has developed a unique multiyear program that matches children facing serious illnesses and disabilities with college athletic teams across the country. Seth, from Mt. Washington, Kentucky, had been a five-time leukemia survivor when he was officially introduced at a “signing” press conference at Bellarmine’s Knights Hall at the conclusion of the youth basketball camp being offered through the Bellarmine men’s basketball team. Seth and his older brothers, Brayden and Max, participated in the camp. By signing with the team, Seth will participate in many activities with the Knights, including games, practices and other events.

DIFFERENCE-MAKER

In March, Bellarmine Men’s Basketball Coach Scott Davenport announced the formation and launch of the Davenport Family Scholarship to offset tuition costs for the student managers in the men’s basketball program and to recognize their selfless commitment to the Bellarmine Basketball Program. The primary fund raiser for the foundation was the Davenport Derby Dash — the inaugural event was held May 4. The event consisted of a handicapping seminar and a live/silent auction, blending a few of Coach Davenport’s passions: helping young people, Bellarmine Basketball and, of course, the Kentucky Derby.



BELLARMINE ATHLETICS ENTERS 3RD SEASON IN D1

The 2022-23 season marks Bellarmine University’s third as a full-scale Division I athletics program.

Bellarmine celebrated the elevation of its athletics program from NCAA Division II to NCAA Division I on July 1, 2020.

The jump made Bellarmine the only private D1 university in Kentucky and one of only a handful of D1 Catholic universities in the South.

All 22 of the Knights’ varsity sports programs now compete in D1, including 18 in the ASUN Conference. Previously, only lacrosse competed in the NCAA’s highest level.

Bellarmine teams in the following 18 sports compete in the ASUN Conference: baseball, men’s and women’s basketball, men’s and women’s cross country, men’s and women’s golf, men’s and women’s soccer, softball, men’s and women’s tennis, men’s and women’s indoor and outdoor track and field, volleyball and lacrosse.

Wrestling is a member of the Southern Conference.

Men’s and women’s swimming participate in the Coastal Collegiate Sports Association.

Field hockey is in the Mid-American Conference.

BEAMED UP

In recognition of the Bellarmine men's basketball team winning the league's tournament title last year as a reclassifying NCAA member, the ASUN Conference has honored the Knights with the ASUN Beam Award. The conference office bestows the Beam Award to a school program when it breaks new ground in ASUN achievement. Always Students First, the Beam Award recognizes the teams that Rise, Connect, and Impact the reputation for achievement at their school and the ASUN. The Bellarmine men's basketball program became the first reclassifying program to ever win its conference's season-ending tournament. The Knights pulled off this historic feat despite being ineligible for an NCAA bid. The citation which accompanied the award said, "Bellarmine and the ASUN have received much acclaim for their joint push for postseason eligibility — the ASUN is eligible and Bellarmine earned it. We hope to change the access for future classes, but the 2022 Bellarmine men's basketball team will always be the first to earn the right to a bid which could not be granted. We respect the achievement and are honored that Bellarmine and the ASUN are teammates."

THE "TRI-STATE" AREA

A look at the Bellarmine roster shows that the coaching staff didn't have to travel too far from home to recruit the 2022-23 Knights. The 17 players on the roster are from just three states: Kentucky, Indiana and Ohio. The majority of the players are Hoosiers with nine of the 17 hailing from Indiana. Freshman Michael Bova holds the distinction of being the farthest from home as Lakewood, Ohio (near Akron) is approximately 350 miles from the Bellarmine campus.

THE "TEAM THAT DOESN'T DRIBBLE"

Last season, the a YouTube video was uploaded by hoopvision68 titled "The Team That Doesn't Dribble." The video breaks down the Bellarmine offense that emphasizes passing over dribbling and results in a high shooting percentage--the Knights were six-time national statistical champions for field goal percentage at the DII level. The video is still generating some interest, and to date, has more that 1.7 million views.

BOOKS AND BASKETBALL

Bellarmino players have thrived in the classroom over Coach Scott Davenport's tenure. Last season, 13 Knights made the ASUN Honor Roll (minimum 3.0 GPA), and Juston Betz and CJ Fleming were named to the First Team of the Co-sida Academic All-District Team--an honor earned by fewer than 50 DI men's basketball players. In addition, Fleming was named Scholar-Athlete of the Year by the ASUN and Betz and Alec Pfriem joined him on the 8-member ASUN All-Academic Team. Over Davenport's 17 years at Bellarmine, 36 different players have earned academic accolades from either the Great Lakes Valley Conference or the ASUN.

A PROUD TRADITION

In its final 12 seasons in Division II (2009-20), all under Scott Davenport, Bellarmine filled its trophy case. The ultimate crown came in 2010-11, when the Knights captured the NCAA II Tournament national title. That was the first of four appearances in the Final Four for Bellarmine, which also advanced to the national semifinals in 2012, 2015 and 2017. The Knights clinched berths in the Elite Eight all four of those seasons after earning the top seed — and hosting duties — in the three-round Midwest Regional and subsequently winning the regional title on their then-home court of Knights Hall. Bellarmine hoisted the GLVC Tournament trophy in 2010 and 2011 and then racked up three more titles in 2017, 2018 and 2019. The Knights also secured at least a share of six GLVC regular-season championships, including four straight from 2015-18. They were the outright champions in 2011, 2012, 2017 and 2018.
