The University of Dayton women's basketball team finishes up the Baha Mar Pink Flamingo Championship Wednesday, Nov. 23 at 4:30 p.m. against the University of Kentucky. The game will take place at the Baha Mar Convention Center in Nassau, Bahamas.

SCOUTING THE FLYERS

Dayton is looking for its first win of the season with an 0-5 record, but has battled to end each and every game. The Flyers are 0-1 in neutral site games after falling to RV Ole Miss Monday.

Head coach Tamika Williams-Jeter is in her first season in charge of her hometown Flyers, coming over after a year at Wittenberg. She has assistant coaching stops at Kansas, Kentucky, Penn State, and Ohio State.

As a team this year, the Flyers are averaging 65.4 points per game and giving up 74.6 points to opponents each outing. Dayton is shooting 41.7 percent overall, 35.4 percent from three point range and 70.7 percent from the free throw line. The Flyers have a positive rebounding margin, but face a negative turnover margin.

Dayton is led by redshirt junior Destiny Bohanon with 16.8 points and 3.8 rebounds per game while junior Anyssa Jones is chipping in 10.2 points and 6.2 boards each outing. Freshman Nayo Lear and sophomore Shannon Wheeler have contributed 9.6 points and 9.0 points per game respectively.

SCOUTING KENTUCKY

Kentucky sits at 4-1 on the year and coming off its first loss of the season to No. 14 Virginia Tech Monday. The Wildcats are also 0-1 in neutral site games on the season.

Head coach Kyra Elzy is in her third season at the helm of Kentucky after serving as an assistant and associate head coach for eight seasons.

As a team, the Wildcats are scoring 74.2 points per game and allowing just 61.2 points for a +13.0 margin. UK is shooting 43.7 percent from the floor, 22.3 percent from behind the arc, and 68.2 percent from the charity stripe. The Wildcats have been out-rebounded, but benefit from a +8.4 turnover margin this season.

Individually, Kentucky is anchored by the trio of Jada Walker, Robyn Benton, and Blair Green, who combine for 40 points per game, with Walker's 14.6 ppg leading the way. The Wildcats have a deep squad with 10 players averaging double-digit minutes.

LAST TIME OUT

Dayton opened up the Baha Mar Pink Flamingo Championship with a 63-50 loss to RV Ole Miss Monday evening, despite tying the game up with just over seven minutes to go in the fourth. Bohanon had a team-high 11 points while the Flyers outshot the Rebels in all three phases of the game.

Kentucky suffered its first loss of the season to Virginia Tech Monday at the tournament as well, 82-74. The Wildcats also had a fourth-quarter rally despite trailing by 18 going into it, but UK was unable to upset the No. 14 Hokies.

SERIES HISTORY

This will be the 22nd meeting in series history with Kentucky holding a 17-4 win advantage. The last time the two teams met was back in 2015 in the second round of the NCAA Tournament in which the Flyers advanced to the Sweet Sixteen and eventually the Elite Eight. UD upset the host Wildcats, 99-94, thanks to 28 points from Ally Malott.

STATISTICAL RANKINGS

Individually, Destiny Bohanon ranks second in the nation in minutes played and 33rd in field goal attempts.

FLYERS PICKED 10TH IN PRESEASON POLL

Dayton was picked to finish 10th in the 2022-23 Atlantic 10 Preseason poll. The Flyers were selected ahead of George Washington, Saint Louis, and A-10 newcomer Loyola Chicago. UMass was chosen as the preseason favorite with all 15-first place votes, followed by La Salle, Rhode Island, Fordham, and VCU.

NEW FACES

The Dayton women's basketball program hit reset after the 2021-22 season, both on the roster and on the coaching staff. The Flyers brought in new head coach Tamika Williams-Jeter, who added nine new members to her coaching and support staff. On top of that, only four players return from last year's student-athletes in Destiny Bohanon, Mariah Perez, Maliya Perry, and Shannon Wheeler. Coach Williams-Jeter added three freshmen signees and four transfers to complete the roster for this season.

EXTRA TIME AT HOME

Dayton has already played two overtime games at UD Arena this season, one against Illinois State in the home opener and two against Northern Kentucky the following games. The most overtimes for the Flyers in a single season is three games, which the Flyers are well on their way to breaking. Dayton ranks second to NKU in the country in OT's played.

FLYERS IN REGULAR SEASON LEAGUE PLAY

Dayton has won 140 of its last 168 regular season Atlantic 10 games (.833), a streak that dates back to a 97-46 win over Rhode Island on Jan. 7, 2012, and includes a perfect 14-0 mark in conference play during the 2012-13 season.

THREE POINTS OF EXCELLENCE

Dayton has hit at least one three-point shot in 658 consecutive games dating back to Jan. 2, 2001, the longest streak in the Atlantic 10 Conference and one of the top streaks in the nation. The Flyers made a program-record 15 three-point field goals against Buffalo in the Connecticut World Vision Classic on Nov. 25, 2011. Dayton tied the record with 15 vs. Wright State on Nov. 28, 2012.

FLYERS WIN 2022 A-10 REGULAR SEASON TITLE

Dayton won the regular season finale at home against Rhode Island on Feb. 26, clinching the Atlantic 10 title for the fifth time in the past six seasons, including three straight championships.

POSTSEASON EXPECTATION

THE FIRST IN THE FIRST FOUR

For the first time ever, the 2021-22 NCAA Women's Basketball tournament held the First Four round similar to the men's tournament. Dayton was one of the four teams selected to compete in the opening games, and defeated DePaul 88-57 to earn the No. 11 seed. The Flyers went on to face No. 6 seed Georgia, who they eventually lost to, but they still earned one of the first victories of the NCAA Tournament last year.

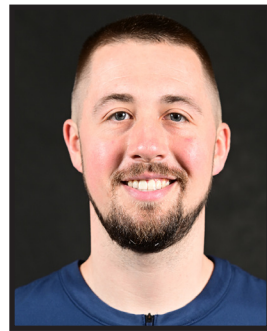

University of Dayton Vice President and Director of Athletics Neil Sullivan announced that Tamika Williams-Jeter will be the next head women's basketball coach for the Flyers in March 2022.

Williams-Jeter has been successful at every level of basketball, both as a player and as a coach. From a stellar playing career at the top levels of high school, college, and professionally, to coaching stops at Division I powerhouses such as Kansas, Kentucky, Penn State, and Ohio State, and head coaching experience at Wittenberg and with the India National Team, she has been a winner everywhere she goes. Williams-Jeter has helped advance the game for women athletes and coaches, both domestically and internationally.

"I am delighted to welcome Tamika Williams-Jeter and her family to the University of Dayton," said Sullivan. "She is a proven winner and teacher of the game who has a distinctive personal impact on those around her. She has successful experience coaching, recruiting and playing basketball at every level, and has done it with integrity. Her core values, combined with her basketball acumen, led us to this decision. Our staff looks forward to partnering with her on advancing not only women's basketball, but the University of Dayton's impact on the community."

"Dayton represents my family, my foundation, and my heart," said Williams-Jeter. "The University of Dayton is a stellar academic institution immersed in a vibrant community where excellence is a standard. I am excited and honored to have the opportunity to lead this program full of phenomenal young women. I am grateful to President Spina, Neil Sullivan, and (Senior Associate A.D.) Angie Petrovic for giving me the opportunity to continue to guide UD women's basketball to greatness. Lastly, I want to thank my husband, Richard Jeter, for allowing me to bring my sons back to the city that made me. Go Flyers!"

Williams-Jeter joins the Flyers from Wittenberg University where she has served as a head coach last season, leading the Tigers to an 18-8 record overall, a NCAC Tournament Championship, and the 2022 NCAA Division III Tournament. During the season, Wittenberg rode a 10-game winning streak to the conference championship which included a win over 10th-ranked DePauw. It was their first national tournament appearance since 2014-15.

Prior to her time at Wittenberg, Williams-Jeter had assistant coaching stints at prominent Division I programs such as Ohio State, Penn State, Kentucky, and Kansas. She helped lead those programs to eight NCAA Division I Tournaments and 11 postseason season appearances overall.

"I join Neil and the Athletics Department in welcoming Coach Williams-Jeter and her family to the UD Community," said UD president Dr. Eric Spina. "We are thrilled to have Tamika join UD, where her quality as a person, her values and integrity, and her caring nature will make her a leader across campus and in the Dayton community."

Coming out of high school at nearby Chaminade-Julienne, Williams-Jeter was the No. 1 recruit in the nation and two-time Ohio Player of the Year. The former forward was named Ohio Miss Basketball and led the Eagles to their first ever Final Four appearance. A highly sought-after recruit and arguably the best women's basketball player to ever come out of Dayton, Williams-Jeter went on to UConn as part of the No. 1 recruiting class in the nation in 1998.

Collegiately, Williams-Jeter had a Ring of Honor playing career at the University of Connecticut where she won two national championships in 2000 and 2002. She earned National Freshman of the Year honors from The Sporting News and was Big East Rookie of the Year. She went on to be named Most Outstanding Performer at the 2000 Big East Tournament en route to her first national title and received All-America Honorable Mention accolades as part of her second championship in 2002. Williams-Jeter was a Naismith Player of the Year candidate her senior season as well. Her career field goal percentage of 70.3 percent is the current NCAA Division I record.

While at UConn, she served as the president of the Huskies' student-athlete advisory committee.

Williams-Jeter went into coaching after playing professionally for seven seasons in the WNBA. She was selected in the 2002 WNBA Draft with the No. 6 overall pick by the Minnesota Lynx and earned WNBA All-Rookie team honors her first year. She finished with over 1,400 points and 1,100 rebounds in her career, and set a WNBA single-season field goal accuracy record in 2003 at 66.8 percent that still stands today.

Williams-Jeter earned her bachelor's degree from UConn in interpersonal communication. She and her husband Richard have two sons, R.J. and Jojo.

Williams-Jeter takes over a Dayton program coming off a 2021-22 regular season Atlantic 10 Championship. The Flyers finished 26-6 with a win over DePaul in the NCAA Tournament. Dayton has reached the postseason for 15 consecutive seasons, including 10 of the last 13 NCAA tournaments.
