

OPENING TIP-OFF

- The University of Minnesota (5-3, 1-0 B1G) will host the Kentucky Wildcats (6-1, 0-0 SEC) at Williams Arena on Dec. 7, at 7 p.m. The game, which can be found on B1G+, will be the third Power 5 opponent the Gophers have played this season. The game can be heard on KFAN+ or on the iHeartRadio app with Justin Gaard and Lynnette Sigguist on the call.
- Minnesota's game with Kentucky is the first game for Minnesota against a 2022 NCAA Tournament team. The Wildcats were the 2022 SEC Tournament champions, defeating eventual champions South Carolina, and then lost in the first round of the NCAA Tournament to
- Princeton. • Last time out the Gophers overcame a 10-point fourth quarter

deficit and won a thrilling double overtime game against Penn State



Minnesota's matchup with Kentucky will be the team's fourth in five games against a Power 5 opponent.

- in the team's Big Ten opener. Minnesota's four starting freshmen combined for 76 of the 98 points, highlighted by Mara Braun's 26 and Mallory Heyer's 18-point 11-rebound double double. Braun and Heyer combined for 15 of the team's 22 points in the two overtime periods. The overtime winner makes head coach Lindsay Whalen 5-0 in her coaching career in overtime games, including a 2-0 mark in double overtime games.
- Braun earned a second Big Ten Freshman of the Week honor, the conference announced on Monday. The Wayzata, Minn., native set a new Minnesota record for points in a Big Ten debut with 26 in a comeback win over Penn State and in two games averaged 26.5 points per game, 3.0 assists, 3.0 steals and 2.5 rebounds while shooting 51.6 percent from the floor and hitting six threes. On Saturday Braun hit 11-of-11 free throws against Penn State, becoming just one of 24th Gopher to connect on 10 or more free throws in a game and make them all. She led Minnesota to two second-half comebacks this past week, overcoming a 10-point deficit to defeat Penn State in double overtime and helping the Gophers tie the game with 19 seconds left against Wake Forest.
- Minnesota's latest starting lineup of Braun, Battle, Heyer, Katie Borowicz and Alanna 'Rose' Micheaux, is an average age of 19 years and 4 months. The group consists of three true freshman, one redshirt sophomore and one sophomore with the group's first two games against Power 5 opponents. Minnesota is the only Big Ten team to start four freshmen in a game this season (Wisconsin is the only other team to start start three).
- Mara Braun continued her red-hot start to the season with her fourth 24+ point performance in seven games played. Braun has scored three of the top 10 freshmen scoring marks (34, 27 & 26) in program history since 2000. Braun's 27-point performance against Wake Forest made her just the fourth freshman since 2009-10 to score 27+ points, make 5+ 3FG, register 3+ steals and 1+ blocks against a Power 5 opponent.
- Through eight games the Golden Gophers have been one of the rest rebounding teams in the Big Ten and the nation with an average of 44.4 per game as a team which is No. 2 in the conference and No. 22 in the nation. The team has been one of the best on the offensive glass at 14.8 per game, No. 2 in the Big Ten. Minnesota's perimeter defense has also been solid, ranked No. 4 in the Big Ten at 29.2 percent.

GOPHERS QUICK HITTERS

- According to Minnesota's Strength and Conditioning Coach, Alanna 'Rose' Micheaux is the strongest player in the weight room that head coach Lindsay Whalen has had in her tenure at Minnesota benching 165 pounds.
- There are 23 student-athletes on 2022-23 Big Ten rosters that are from Minnesota. That's just under 12 percent of all Big Ten student-athletes that are Minnesota na-
- Freshman guard Mara Braun is a student-athlete ambassador with Special Olympics Minnesota.
- Freshman forward Niamya Holloway helpe co-found the Black Student Union and worked to promote youth leadership at Central Middle School in Minnesota and promoted racial equity as a senior officer for the Dare 2 Be Real organization.
- When coming out of high school in California Mi'Cole Cayton was recruited by Shimmy Gray-Miller. Cayton credits that relationship back in 2014/2015 to why she decided to join the Gophers as a graduate transfer this season.
- Freshman Maria Counts has four siblings, all who play or played basketball at Providence Academy. Maria played with her sisters Grace and Hope last year during her senior year and her elder sisters Clara and Anna played for Providence Academy baack in 2016 and 2018.
- Angelina Hammond graduated from Hopkins high school in 2018, playing alongside then-sophomore Paige Bueckers, then-eighth-grader Amaya Battle and then-eighthgrader Maya Nnaji.
- Mallory Hever was an outstanding volleyball player at Chaska high school, emassing over 1,000 kills in her career and led her volleyball team to a 2AAAA Section runnerup finish in 2019.
- Niaymya Holloway was a two-time high school high jump state champion at Eden Prairie high school where she cleared a personal record 5-10. Her senior year she won a state championship in the high jump, took third in both the 4x200m relay and the 4x400m relay and was ninth in the shot put competition. Two days after the state championship track meet, she was at summer workouts with the Gophers.
- Alexa Ratzlaff's brother Jake plays for the Wisconsin Badgers football team as an inside linebacker. Her brother was the 2020 Metro Football Player of the Year by the Minneapolis Star Tribune and was a finalist for Minnesota's Mr. Football Award. He also committed to the Gophers men's hockey program early in his career before focusing and shifting to football.
- Freshman guard Mara Braun is the first graduate from Wayzata high school to play for the Golden Gophers.
- Katie Borowicz: Joined Gophers as early enrollee in 2019-20; graduated early from high school after signing NLI in November of 2020
- Maggie Czinano: Her sister Monika, is currently a senior on the lowa women's basketball team and is a multiple time All-Big Ten selection
- Alanna Micheaux: Changed her number from No. 54 to No. 4 in honor of her brother.
- Kelly Curry: Was a freshman on the 2004 Final Four team, which was Lindsay Whalen's senior season; was previously an assistant at North Dakota State (2008-10) and Minnesota (2010-14) and most recently served as head coach at Macalaster College in Saint Paul (2014-18).

- Minnesota's incoming freshman class has been heralded as one of the most highly touted recruiting classes in program history. All four hail from the great state of Minnesota with Mara Braun (Wayzata, Minn.), Amaya Battle (Hopkins, Minn.), Mallory Heyer (Chaska, Minn.) and Niamya Holloway (Eden Prairie, Minn.).
- The Maroon and Gold's 11 newcomers are broken up by five transfers, four incoming freshmen and two walk-ons. Minnesota's transfers include Destinee Oberg (Arkansas), Mi'Cole Cayton (Nebraska), Isabelle Gradwell (Cleveland State), Angelina Hammond (Miami Dade) and Aminata Zie (Western Nebraska CC).

FACING KENTUCKY

- Wednesday's matchup between the Wildcats and Gophers is just the second time the two programs have met with the only other meeting coming in 2007 when Minnesota won 92-80 at Williams Arena.
- Kentucky comes into Wednesday on a two-game winning streak, defeating Dayton and UNC Greensboro after losing their first game of the year to Virginia Tech at the Baha Mar hoops Pink Flamingo Championship in the Bahamas on Nov. 21.
- Kentucky was picked to finish seventh in the SEC by the members of the media. The team did not have a player on the Preseason All-SEC First or Second Team.
- The Wildcats' leading scorer this season has been sophomore Jada Walker, who averages 14.9 ppg and 3.9 assists per game. She was an All-SEC Freshman Team selection by the league's coaches last season.
- Robyn Benton, a third-year Wildcat who was at Auburn prior to Kentucky, is the team's other leading scorer at 14.3. She was an All-SEC Freshman Team selection while at Auburn and has averaged just over eight points per game in her career in 110 career games played.
- Kentucky brought in 10 newcomers (six freshmen, four transfers) for the 2022-23 season. Kentucky added four prominent transfers in Adebola Adeyeye (Buffalo), Ajae Petty (LSU), Maddie Scherr (Oregon) and Eniya Russell (South Carolina). Those four average 25.1 points per game this season.

CLUTCH-TIME STATS FOR THE GOPHERS

- This season the Gophers have outscored their opponents by 35 in the fourth quarter and overtime.
- In the last two minutes of regulation (not including OT/20T) the Gophers have shot 50 percent (15-of-30) from the floor and 87.5 percent (14-of-16) from the free throw line.
- In fourth quarters this season the Gophers have shot 46.5 percent (66-of-142) and have shot 79.5 percent (39-of-49) from the free throw line.
- In games decided by six points or less the Gophers have shot 50.0 percent (10-of-20) in the final two minutes of regulation and 90.9 percent (10-of-11) from the free throw line.
- In games decided by six points or less the Gophers have shot 47.7 percent (42-of-88) from the floor in the fourth quarter and 77.8 percent from the free throw line (28-of-36).
- NOTE: Minnesota has played FIVE games that have been decided by six points or less this season.

WHALEN TO BE INDUCTED IN WOMEN'S BASKETBALL HOF

- Announced on Sunday on ESPN, Minnesota's Lindsay Whalen has been named as an inductee for the Women's Basketball Hall of Fame.
- Whalen, who was inducted into the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame earlier this year, is joined by Carolyn Peck, Cathy Boswell, Donna Lopiano and Lisa Mattingly.
- The induction will be April 29, 2023, at the Historic Tennessee Tehatre in Knoxville, Tennessee.

WAKE FOREST ESCAPES WITH THRILLING WIN OVER GOPHERS IN FINAL ACC-BIG TEN CHALLENGE

- Despite a frantic Minnesota fourth-quarter comeback against the Demon Deacons the Gophers fell 63-59 after Wake Forest hit a step-back three with three seconds left with the game tied.
- Freshman standout Mara Braun scored a game-high 27 points and hit five threes while Alanna 'Rose' Micheaux notched her fourth double double of the season with 13 points and 10 rebounds.

GOPHERS USE STRONG SECOND HALF TO HANDLE LIBERTY

- Katie Borowicz bounced back from a tough game against Virginia (6 points, 7 turnovers) with a career-best performance against Liberty. The redshirt-freshman scored a career high 21 points and matched her career-high in assists (5) and steals (5). She shot 9-of-11 from the floor.
- The Gophers out rebounded the lengthy Flames 22-13 in the second half to split the reboudning battle 38-38.
- Amaya Battle scored 10 of her 14 points in the fourth quarter and finished with seven rebounds and five assists in the victory.

BRAUN RETURNS TO LINEUP IN LOSS TO VIRGINIA

- Mara Braun returned to the starting lineup against Virginia (11/26) and scored 24 points and snagged 10 boards in the 73-70 loss on the road.
- Alanna Micheaux added 13 points in the loss while Amaya Battle had seven points, 10 rebounds and six assists.
- The Gophers led by as much as 10 points during the game, and trailed by as much as 11. Trailing by nine with 3 minutes to go, the Gophers came within one with 19 seconds left and had the ball but could not complete the comeback.

HEYER NAMED BIG TEN FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK (NOV. 21)

• The Chaska, Minn., native posted her first career double double with 19 points and 10 rebounds in a win over Presbyterian on Nov. 20, and averaged 14.5 points and 9.0 rebounds during the week while shooting 66.7 percent from the floor (14-of-21). She brought down an average of 4.5 offensive rebounds per game and added 2.0 assists and 1.0 block per game.

MINNESOTA HANDLES PRESBYTERIAN TO BOUNCE BACK

• The University of Minnesota bounced back after their first loss of the season with a 34-point victory on Nov. 20, against Presbyterian (2-3, 0-0 Big South). The Gophers 82-48 win was highlighted by double doubles from both sophomore Alanna 'Rose' Micheaux (16-11) and freshman Mallory Heyer (19-10).

CZINANO LEADS GOPHERS IN FIRST LOSS OF SEASON

- Without Freshman of the Week Mara Braun the Maroon and Gold dropped their first contest of the season on the road against North Dakota State University on Nov. 17.
- Maggie Czinano scored a career high 13 points and added seven boards in the loss, getting to the line eight times and connecting on six.
- The Gophers had four reach double figures in the loss in Battle (15), Czinano (13), Borowicz (11) and Heyer (10)

BRAUN HITS BUZZER BEATER AGAINST LEHIGH

- The Maroon and Gold came from behind in thrilling fashion to defeat Lehigh 101-99 at Williams Arena on Nov. 13
- The 10-point comeback win was led by a 32-point fourth quarter from the Gophers and was capped off by a Mara Braun three at the buzzer.
- Braun led the way with 34 while fellow freshman Amaya Battle scored 17 off the bench and Alanna 'Rose' Micheaux secured her second straight double double with 13 and 10 rebounds.

BRAUN NAMED BIG TEN FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK (NOV. 14)

- The Wayzata, Minn., native dropped an average of 27.5 points per game in her first two collegiate contests, including 34 and a buzzer-beating shot to take down Lehigh 101-99 on Sunday night. Her 27.5 points per game ranks first in the Big Ten and No. 7 nationally.
- Braun's buzzer beater with 1.7 seconds left was the first last-second winning shot for Minnesota since Feb. 26, 2016, when Carlie Wagner downed No. 5 Ohio State in overtime. Her 34 points are the second most points by a freshman in school history and are the most since Laura Coenen at Wisconsin back on Feb. 18, 1983
- Nationally Braun is one of nine players to drop at least 34 points in a game this season with the most in a game this season being 39 by Oral Roberts' Hannah Cooper against UNLV.

OTHER GOPHER STATS IN THE BIG TEN

- As of Dec. 5 here's where the Gophers individually rank in the Big Ten:
- Mara Braun is ranked third in scoring at 20.6 points per game. Braun is also ranked No. 5 in threes made per game at 2.4 and is fourth in free throw percentage at 93.5 percent. She's also ranked 8th in steals per game at 2.1.
- Minnesota's Alanna 'Rose' Micheaux is fifth in the conference in rebounds per game at 7.6 per game and is No. 2 in offensive rebounds per game at 3.3.
- Katie Borowicz is fourth in the Big Ten in steals per game at 2.3. She's also No. 8 in the Big Ten in 3-point percentage at 40.6 percent.

THE BABY GOPHS

.Record

- As of Dec. 5, the Gophers top three players in average minutes are the trio of true freshman with Braun leading the way at 34.0 followed by Heyer at 31.3 and Battle at 29.5. In the Big Ten Braun has played the second-most minutes per game.
- So far this season 402 of the Gophers 627 points (64.1 percent) have been scored by true or redshirt freshman. Four of the top five scorers this season for the Gophers are all freshmen or redshirt freshmen. In total the Gophers freshmen average 53.6 points per game combined.
- The University of Minnesota women's basketball team brings in a total of seven freshmen to the 2022-23 roster (redshirts included). That is the second most freshmen on any Big Ten roster, only behind Wisconsin's nine.
- The Gophers roster is comprised of 10 underclassmen (seven freshmen and three sophomores).

ADDITIONAL GOPHER NOTES

- The Gophers starting season-opening lineup against Western Illinois featured three freshmen, which was be the youngest lineup for the Gophers to start the season with (exhibitions included) in over 11 years. In that span the Gophers have never started more than one freshmen to start a season or exhibition.
- The Gophers return just 6.2 percent (143 of 2300) of their total points scored in 2021-22 and just 10.3 percent (125 of 1218) of the team's total rebounds last season.

WOMEN'S HOOPS SIGN FIVE FOR 2023-24

- Minnesota head coach Lindsay Whalen has announced the addition of five student-athletes that have signed National Letters of Intent or an Acceptance of Admission to join the Minnesota women's basketball program for the 2023-24 season. Signing NLIs with the Golden Gophers are Kennedy Klick, MyKynnlie Dalan, Ajok Madol and Dominika Paurová while Brynn Senden signed an Acceptance of Admission
- "I am thrilled to announce this incoming recruiting class that includes five outstanding young women who come from all over the world and embody exactly what it means to be a Gopher," Whalen said. "This group has a wide range of skills that we are extremely excited about. They are not only outstanding basketball players, but are also outstanding people that will positively impact our University and community for years to come."

GOPHER TO HOST UCONN IN 2023-24 AT WILLIAMS ARENA

- The University of Minnesota women's basketball program has added UConn to its upcoming schedule with a game to be played at Williams Arena in 2023.
- The Gophers will host the Huskies on Nov. 19, 2023, with the meeting being the first between the two programs in the state of Minnesota. The Gophers have met UConn three times all time with the last meeting coming on Nov. 20, 2021 in the Bahamas at the Battle 4 Atlantis. The Gophers also met the Huskies in the 2004 Final Four in New Orleans, La. UConn holds an all-time record of 3-0 against the Maroon and Gold. Minnesota is 24-13 against current teams in the BIG EAST.

BRAUN'S BIG DEBUT LEADS GOPHERS OVER W. ILLINOIS

- The 75-45 win over the Leathernecks was head coach Lindsay Whalen's 30th career non-conference win. Whalen's record against non-conference opponents is 30-7 (.811).
- True freshman Mara Braun made her collegiate debut with a game-high 21 points to go with seven rebounds and four steals, Katie Borowicz added a career high 16 points, and Alanna Micheaux registered her first career double-double with 14 points and a career-high 13 rebounds.
- Minnesota's 54 rebounds against Western Illinois is the most rebounds the Gophers have collected in a game since she became head coach in 2018. The 42 defensive rebounds were also the most in the Whalen era
- Minnesota allowed just five offensive rebounds against the Leathernecks, which is tied for the thirdfewest under Lindsay Whalen.

BRAUN IMPRESSES IN EXHIBITION VS UWRF

- On Oct. 30, the Gophers took care of UW-River Falls 104-64 at Williams Arena with Mara Braun leading the way with 23 points.
- Braun scored 21 of her 23 points in the first half and made five threes and had three steals.
- Six Gophers scored in double figures with four starters and two coming off the bench.
- Off the bench freshman Amaya Battle led the Gophers in rebounds (7), assists (4) and steals (4) while also committing zero turnovers in 28 minutes of play.
- As a team the Gophers shot 56.3 percent, made 40 shots from the floor and hit 8-of-17 (47.1 percent) from beyond the arc.
- The Gophers freshmen group combined for 56 of the 104 points scored against UW-River Falls.

WHALEN INDUCTED TO BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME

- Minnesota's Lindsay Whalen officially was enshrined in the Naismith Basketball Hall of Fame on September 10, 2022, in Springfield Mass.
- Whalen (Hutchinson, Minn.) was a first ballot Hall of Famer, and was a part of a class that saw Leta Andrews, Swin Cash, Michael Cooper, Hugh Evans, Manu Ginóbili, Tim Hardaway, Bob Huggins, Marques Johnson, George Karl and Marianne Stanley all get enshrined.
- Whalen's Hall of Fame presenters were Charles Barkley and Dawn Staley.
- Whalen was the first Gopher women's basketball player, and the seventh player overall, to be enshrined in the Hall of Fame joining the likes of Kevin McHale who was inducted in 1999 and "Sweet Lou" Hudson.

THE INCREDIBLE 2022 FRESHMEN CLASS

- The class was the No. 1 ranked recruiting class in the Big Ten (No. 10 nationally) ahead of lowa who's class was ranked No. 20 nationally by ESPN/Premier Basketball and Michigan at No. 22.
- Amaya Battle (Hopkins, Minn.) won Minnesota's Ms. Basketball as a senior out of Hopkins High School. Battle helped her team win a state championship on the floor of Williams Arena. Battle also won a state championship with Hopkins in 2019
- Mara Braun and Niamya Holloway are both outstanding off the court as well with Braun a Student-Athlete ambassador for the Special Olympics in Minnesota and Holloway was a co-founder of her high school's Black Student Union and worked to promote youth leadership at Central Middle School and promoted racial equity as a senior officer for the Dare 2 Be Real organization.
- Braun (Track and Field), Heyer (Volleyball) and Holloway (Track and Field) all were multi-sport athletes at the prep level.
- Holloway was a two-time Minnesota high school state champion with a personal best leap of 5-11 during her senior season.
- Mallory Heyer had over 1,000 kills as a volleyball player at Chaska High School where her team made multiple section finals, including once as a No. 8 seed.
- On top of the Gophers four ranked prospects, the Gophers added two walk on freshmen, all six hail from the great state of Minnesota.
- Between Battle, Heyer, Braun and Holloway they bring in nine All-State honors and three Minnesota high school state championships.

THE BIG TEN TOURNAMENT IS COMING TO MINNEAPOLIS

- On April 20, 2022, the Big Ten announced that the Big Ten basketball tournaments in 2023 and 2024 were coming to Minneapolis and the Target Center.
- Target Center will host the 2023 women's tourney and the men's and women's tourney in 2024.
- Numbers Don't Lie: The 2022 Women's Final Four, which was held in Target Center, set an attendance record with over 216,000 spectators during the event. That was the most at the Women's Final Four since 2004... which was when the Golden Gophers led by Lindsay Whalen made their first Final Four in New Orleans.

SOUTH CAROLINA WINS 2022 FINAL FOUR IN MINNEAPOLIS

- On April 3, 2022, the University of South Carolina defeated UConn 64-49 at Target Center in Minneapolis, Minn., to win the 2022 NCAA Tournament.
- The 2022 Final Four was the first that was played on a WNBA court.

THE INCREDIBLE RETURN OF KATIE BOROWICZ

- After missing the entire 2021-22 season with a season-ending skull/spinal surgery, the Gophers welcome back guard Katie Borowicz (Roseau, Minn.).
- On Monday, Nov. 7, Borowicz played her first game at Williams Arena in over 600 days (Feb. 28, 2021 vs. Michigan).
- In her return to the court Borowicz scored a career-high 16 points on 6-of-9 shooting from the floor including a career-high four made threes in 22 minutes.
- Borowicz had not played in front of fans since high school (March 4, 2020 vs. Fergus Falls in the Minnesota State Tournament).
- Borowicz missed last season after having surgery to relieve pressure that her brain was putting on her spine. Her condition is called Chiari malformation.
- Borowicz was a four-star recruit according to ESPN, the 98th ranked player overall
 in the class and the No. 19 point guard. She averaged 31.3 points, 6.8 rebounds,
 6.2 steals and 6.0 steals during her junior season in high school. She scored over
 2,000 points in her high school career and played on the varsity team from seventh
 grade onward.
- Borowicz was an early enrolee in 2020-21, joining the Gophers as a 17-year old.
 Borowicz played in 14 games with one start in 2020-21 and averaged 3.9 points,
 2.1 assists and 1.4 rebounds.

THE GOPHERS AND THE TRANSFER PORTAL

- In total the Maroon and Gold bring in five transfers to the 2022-23 roster. Joining Minnesota this season are Mi'Cole Cayton (Nebraska/Cal), Destinee Oberg (Arkansas), Isabelle Gradwell (Cleveland State), Angelina Hammond (Siena/Southeastern/Miami Dade) and Aminata Zie (Western Nebraska CC/Stony Brook).
- Minnesota lost seven players from the 2021-22 roster to the transfer portal that included Jasmine Powell (Tennessee), Sara Scalia (Indiana), Kadi Sissoko (Southern Cal), Alexia Smith (Virginia), Erin Hedman (Sacramento State), Klarke Sconiers (Delaware) and Carolina Strande (Butler).

ZIE AND HOLLOWAY TO MISS ALL OF 2022-23 SEASON

- Prior to the start of the 2022-23 season the Gophers have sustained a pair of season-ending injuries from a pair of post players in Niamya Holloway (knee) and Aminata Zie (leg).
- Zie suffered her injury in late October while Holloway's injury was suffered in July. Both student-athletes have completed successful surgery and are currently in rehab.

GRAY-MILLER PROMOTED TO ASSOCIATE HEAD COACH

- On July 5, 2022, head coach Lindsay Whalen announced that Shimmy Gray-Miller had been promoted to the title of Associate Head Coach.
- Gray-Miller took over the position for the departed Carly Thibault-DuDonis who is now the head coach at Fairfield University.
- In her lone season at Minnesota, the Gophers reached the postseason and Gray-Miller coached Alanna Micheaux to a Big Ten Freshman of the Week honor after a big-time performance in B1G/ACC Challenge game against North Carolina. She also coached Bailey Helgren who was named the Gophers' honoree on the Big Ten All-Sportsmanship team. Gray-Miller directly impacted the Gophers statistical improvement in a number of categories from the 2020-21 season to the 2021-22 season including field goal percentage (.402 to .407), opponent field goal percentage (.463 to .426), rebounds per game (35.95 to 36.91), blocks per game (2.5 to 3.5), turnovers committed per game (15.3 to 12.7) and turnover margin (-2.33 to -1.70).

THE RETURN OF THE MAROON MAMBA

- The University of Minnesota welcomed back one of the most successful players in program history this offseason with Rachel Banham joining the Gophers' staff as the Director of Quality Control.
- As the Director of Quality Control Banham, who still is playing in the WNBA, will
 provide support to the staff to enhance the quality and efficiency of day-to-day
 operations, and is responsible for assisting with practice, game preparation, statistical analysis and more.
- Banham rejoins the program where she shattered the record books during her playing time from 2011-16. She scored 3,093 points, leaving the college game as the No. 1 scorer in Big Ten history and sixth in NCAA history. She was the 2016 Big Ten Player of the Year and made 354 threes during her career, a program record. She is arguably most known for her then-NCAA record 60-point performance against Northwestern in 2016, a year that ended with her earning a First Team All-American nod

NEW COACH, WHO DIS?

- On May 19, 2022, head coach Lindsay Whalen added Marwan Miller to the Gophers' coaching staff as an assistant coach.
- Miller is the Gophers' first Black male assistant coach since Marc Wilson from 1997-2001.
- In six seasons at Ohio, Miller and the Bobcats finished with a record of 121-64 including a 30-win season and a 26-win season during his tenue. The team also won the 2015-16 MAC regular season title with Miller on staff.
- Miller coached six All-MAC honorees, five Defensive Players of the Year, seven All-Defensive team members, four All-Freshmen, two top freshmen, and one Sixth Player of the Year.
- Miller received his Bachelor's degree from Franklin University in 2012, and his Associate's degree from Columbus State Community College. He is a member of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association and the Adidas Top Ten All-American Selection Committee.

MAINES PROMOTED TO 'FIRST OF ITS KIND' GENERAL MANAGER ROLE

- On August 2, 2022, head coach Lindsay Whalen announced that Director of Basketball Operations Melissa Maines had been promoted to the position of General Manager of Women's Basketball.
- In her new role, Maines will oversee all off-court aspects of the Minnesota women's basketball program. The role is the first of its kind in the Big Ten conference.
- "Today I am happy to announce Melissa Maines as our General Manager of our program," Whalen said. "With an immeasurable amount of knowledge in the world of basketball, Melissa makes our program better in every way and we are excited for her to thrive in this new role."

THE LINDSAY WHALEN COACHING TREE

- Entering just her fifth season as head coach, Lindsay Whalen has already aided numerous coaches in their pursuit to becoming head coaches at the Division I level.
- Two of Whalen's former staff members are current head coaches including Carly Thibault-DuDonis (Fairfield University) and Danielle O'Banion, Loyola University Maryland). Thibault-DuDonis is entering her first year as a head coach while O'Banion is entering her second season as the head of her program.

HEAD COACH LINDSAY WHALEN FIFTH SEASON · MINNESOTA, 2004



One of the most decorated players in women's basketball history, Lindsay Whalen returned to her alma mater as the 12th head women's basketball coach at the University of Minnesota on April 13, 2018.

In her four seasons guiding the Golden Gophers, Whalen has led the team to a 60-57 mark (.518) with a trip to the WNIT in 2018-19 and 2021-22. In addition, she has coached one WNBA draft pick, one All-American, 11 All-Big Ten

honorees, two members of the Big Ten All-Freshman team, one Big Ten All-Defensive Team player and countless Academic All-Big Ten honorees.

The 2021-22 season saw the Maroon and Gold make their way to the postseason for the second time in four seasons under Whalen with a bid to the WNIT where the squad reached the second round. The team matched its 7-11 Big Ten record from the previous season and finished 15-18 overall. Minnesota played one of the toughest schedules in the country, and the hardest in the Big Ten, playing a total of 10 NCAA Tournament teams, defeating one. The Gophers also partook in the first women's Battle 4 Atlantis tournament in the Bahamas, defeating Syracuse while also battling UConn and Oklahoma.

Sara Scalia was named Second Team All-Big Ten by the league's coaches and media while first-year Gopher Deja Winters earned an Honorable Mention All-Big Ten nod by the members of the media.

The 2020-21 campaign, which took place amidst the COVID-19 pandemic, saw a young Gophers squad improve their conference win total from five to seven as they went 8-13 on the season and 7-11 in conference play. With 10 of its 13 players either freshmen or sophomores, no team in the Big Ten had a higher percentage of its roster comprised of underclassmen than Minnesota. In fact, of the 13 Gophers on the roster, six were playing in their first season of collegiate basketball and three transfers were playing in their first year at Minnesota.

Jasmine Powell was named Second Team All-Big Ten by the league's coaches and Honorable Mention All-Big Ten by the media covering the conference. Meanwhile, Sara Scalia was chosen Honorable Mention All-Big Ten by the coaches and media.

In Whalen's second season the Gophers went 16-15, including winning 11 straight games at one point, which was the sixth longest win streak in program history. During the stretch, they won four straight on the road, the seventh longest such streak at Minnesota. Included in the 11-game streak was an 80-66 upset of then-No. 19 Arizona State.

Five members of the team took home season honors from the Big Ten. Taiye Bello was a consensus All-Big Ten Second Team selection by the league's coaches and media, while Powell was a consensus pick for both All-Big Ten Honorable Mention and the Big Ten All-Freshman Team. Gadiva Hubbard was an All-Big Ten Honorable Mention honoree by the media, as was Scalia, who also earned a place on the media's Big Ten All-Freshman Team.



In her first season at the helm of the Gophers, Whalen guided the team to a 21-11 record overall, a 9-9 mark in league play and a spot in the second round of the WNIT. She became the fifth coach in program history to lead the team to 20 wins in their first season. The Gophers enjoyed a 10-week run in the AP Poll, their longest stretch since the 2005-06 season.

Minnesota began the 2018-19 season by winning its first 12 games, tied for the third best streak in team history.

With the 12-0 start, Whalen tied her former coach, Pam Borton (2002-03), for the best undefeated start by a coach in their first year at a Big Ten school since the incorporation of women's athletics in the conference in 1982-83. The only coach at a Big Ten school with more wins in his or her first year there was Ohio State's Debbie Wilson, who started 14-0 in 1972-73.

Under Whalen's tutelage, Kenisha Bell earned honorable mention All-America honors from the AP, was a semifinalist for the 2019 Naismith Women's Defensive Player of the Year Award, garnered consensus First Team All-Big Ten honors from the league's coaches and media and was a member of the All-Big Ten Defensive Team. In addition, Destiny Pitts was named First Team All-Big Ten by the league's coaches (second team by the media), and Taiye Bello was an All-Big Ten honorable mention honoree.

Whalen returned to the Gophers after destroying the program's record book in the early 2000s, finishing her career as Minnesota's all-time points leader, along with being second all-time in assists and third all-time in steals. A four-time all-state selection at Hutchinson High School, about an hour west of Minneapolis, Whalen went on to become the catalyst for the most successful seasons in the history of Gopher women's basketball.

In international competition, Whalen was a key piece to dominant performances by Team USA in world championship and Olympic competition. Whalen played for two gold medal teams at the World Championships (2010, 2014) and has also won two Olympic gold medals (2012, 2016).

As part of Whalen's agreement to become head coach, she continued to play for the Minnesota Lynx before retiring at the end of the 2018 season. Previously, Whalen announced in February of 2018 that she was retiring from international competition. She had played for the U.S. National team since 2002, joining Team USA following her sophomore season with the Gophers.
