Kentucky defeated Akron, 47-10, in the lone meeting of the series. Akron tied the game 3-3 with 11:35 left in the second quarter, however the Wildcats countered with a field goal for a 6-3 advantage and scored 41 unanswered points for a 47-3 lead. Akron scored its lone touchdown with 1:31 left in regulation.

SCOUTING KENTUCKY

The Kentucky Wildcats enter the game with a 2-0 slate, defeating MAC opponent Ball State (44-14) and Eastern Kentucky (28-17). Kentucky QB Devin Leary has thrown five touchdown passes and averages 270.0 yards passing a game on 60.9 percent accuracy with two miscues (42-69-2). Leary has connected with nine different targets, including a team-best two touchdown passes to Tayvion Robinson. Robinson leads the receiving corps with 174 yards and 19.3 per reception with a 56-yard long connection. Barion Brown, Dane Key and Ray Davis also found the endzone on one occasion apiece. On the ground, Davis leads the way with 26 rushes for 164 yards and a pair of TDs. He averages 6.3 yards per carry and 82.0 yards per game with a 30-yard long run on the season. Kentucky has 768 yards of total offense to date. Defensively, UK is led by Trevin Wallace with 19 total tackles, while posting five sacks for 45 yards of loss. Wallace and Kahlil Sanders own 1.5 sacks apiece.

- Alex Adams caught his first TD pass of the season 29 yards from Jeff Undercuffler 5-5 on the 67-yard drive.
- Devonte Golden-Nelson recorded the Zips first interception of the season and first Pick-6, taking the 50 yards for his first-career touchdown.
- Akron outgained Morgan State 262-231, including a 254-152 advantage through the air.
- Akron converted 4 of 11 third downs while Morgan State was successful on 2 of 16.
- The Zips had three players with more than eight tackles in the ballgame led by Bryan McCoy, who had 14.
- The Zips racked up nine tackles for loss and added four sacks.
- Akron posted 279 yards of total offense in the season opener vs Temple
- DJ Irons accounted for 205 yards of offense with two TDs on 17-of-29 throwing.
- Lorenzo Lingard caught a career-high 77 yard TD reception from Irons on the second play of the game to give Akron a 7-0 lead.
- Daniel George caught a 50-yard long pass from Irons to setup the Zips second TD
- Myles Walker hauled in the second TD pass from Irons, a 14 yard reception and his first career touchdown
- Drake Anderson led the ground attack with 40 of the Zips 74 yards.
- Akron's defense registered three tackles for loss with eight total yards. Bryan McCoy (1), Shammond Cooper (0.5), Terray Jones (1) and CJ Nunnally (0.5) recorded the takedowns.
- Darrian Lewis, Antavious Fish and McCoy recorded seven tackles each to lead the Zips. Judson Tallendier, Cooper and KJ Martin followed with five each.
- Akron returns eight offensive starters and seven defensive starters

MAC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

CJ Nunnally was named Mid-American Conference East Division Defensive Player of the Week, the league announced on Monday. Nunnally provided a spark for Akron, helping them to a 24-21 win over Morgan State in their home opener at InfoCision Stadium on Saturday. With less than a minute to play, Nunnally forced a fumble to setup the game-winning touchdown. He forced the fumble at the Morgan State 13-yardline, stripping the Bears QB J.J. Davis of the ball, allowing teammate LB Bryan McCoy to recover the loose ball and score the game-winning touchdown. In addition, Nunnally opened the game with back-to-back sacks, recording two of the Zips four sacks on the game. His sacks totaled 10-yards of loss and posted a third tackle for an eight-yard loss. In all, Nunnally registered four tackles, three solo and one assisted, with three tackles for losses.

LAST TIME OUT

Akron won their home opener, 24-21 over Morgan State with a fumble recovered for a touchdown in the final minute of regulation as CJ Nunnally, IV forced the Bears fumble and Bryan McCoy scooped and scored at InfoCision Stadium on Saturday night. With the win Akron improved to 1-1 on the season while the Bears fell to 1-1. Jeff Undercuffler, Jr. led Akron's passing attack with 201 yards through the air on 17 of 25 passing with one touchdown. Jasaiah Gathings reeled in six catches for 78 yards, while Alex Adams hauled in six balls for 75 yards and one touchdown. Drake Anderson added 27 yards to lead the Zips' ground attack in the game, picking up 4.5 yards per carry along the way. Lorenzo Lingard also tacked on 24 yards on the ground. Devonte Golden-Nelson snagged the Zips' first of two interceptions and scored his first career touchdown while taking the ball 50 yards to the house. KJ Martin added an interception and Nunnally anchored the defense by opening the game with two sacks and finishing with four tackles, 3.0 TFL, two sacks, and one forced fumble in the win. The Zips forced three turnovers in Saturday's contest, with Akron turning those takeaways into 14 points.

Akron fell 24-21 in the season opener at Temple as the Zips flew to an early 21-7 advantage. Temple mounted a nine-play, 50-yard drive with 14:52 left to play, but the Zips were unable to complete a comeback. Akron QB DJ Irons led the Akron offense with 205 yards passing and two touchdowns with a 77-yard long TD reception to RB Lorenzo Lingard, who registered 61 yards after the catch. Lingard added 24 yards on the ground to finish with 101 yards of total offense. RB Drake Anderson rushed for 40 yards on seven carries to lead the unit, while WR Daniel George posted 60 yards receiving on three completions.

PRESEASON HONORS

Eight University of Akron football players were named to *Phil Steele's* 2023 preseason All-Mid-American Conference teams. Earning preseason first-team All-MAC was junior WR **Alex Adams** (Osyka, Miss.). Named to the preseason second-team All-MAC was redshirt senior TE **TJ Banks** (North Versailles, Pa.), while redshirt seniors QB **DJ Irons** (Lawrenceville, Ga.) and WR **Daniel George** (Fort Washington, Md.) garnered third-team preseason laurels and redshirt senior RB **Lorenzo Lingard** (Orange City, Fla.), senior DL **Ryan Johnson** (Starkville, Miss.), redshirt senior DB **Nate Thompson** (Sanford, N.C.), and junior KR **Blake Hester** (Ashland, Ky.) were preseason fourth-team All-MAC selections.

Eight Zips were named to *Athlon Sports'* 2023 preseason All-MAC teams as junior WR **Alex Adams** earned preseason first-team All-MAC accolades followed by redshirt seniors RB **Lorenzo Lingard**, WR **Daniel George**, TE **TJ Banks**, junior OL **Nate Williams** (Utica, Ohio) and junior KR **Blake Hester** as third-team honors. Redshirt seniors QB **DJ Irons** and DB **Nate Thompson** garnered fourth-team selections.

WHO IS WEARING NO. 1

Seniors WR **Daniel George** and DB **KJ Martin** have emerged as leaders for second-year head coach Joe Moorhead as the Zips enter their season opener at Temple on Sept. 2 and the duo was recently rewarded with the No. 1 jerseys for the upcoming campaign.

In January, Moorhead came to Jeff Sobol, Akron's head strength and conditioning coach, with a request to identify one player on each side of the ball that demonstrated their leadership both on and off the field over the course of the spring to earn the privilege of wearing the No. 1 jersey in the Akron Blue and Gold for the 2023 season.

"What I thought about when Coach Moorhead and I spoke was performance and leadership and all the qualities you want in someone in an elite or leadership position," said Sobol. "They earned it all the way from January being accountable, holding their teammates to higher standards, doing all the little things right on a day-to-day basis and being consistent."

A year ago, George started all 12 games for Akron en route to pulling in 67 catches for 793 yards and two touchdowns. He averaged 66.1 yards receiving per game and 11.8 yards per catch. Martin appeared in 11 games for the Zips, including nine starts and recorded 54 tackles, including 30 solo stops and 24 assisted tackles, while adding 3.0 tackles for a loss, one interception, one pass breakup and one quarterback hurry.

"They have a voice on the team and when they talk people listen," said Sobol. "They are the leaders on their side of the ball when it comes to holding their teammates accountable, having a high standard for themselves and their teammates and bringing people with them and picking people up when they're having bad days."

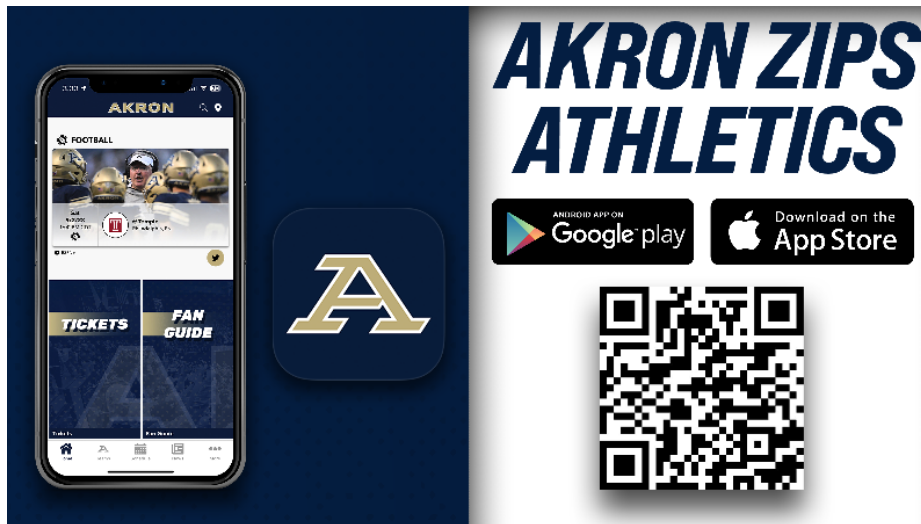
The University of Akron Department of Athletics launched a new mobile app for Zips fans developed in partnership with Snap!Mobile.

WR **Alex Adams** led the receiving corps in 2022, collecting a conference-best 739 yards in league play en route to averaging a second-best 92.4 yards per game. In league-only games, he ranked second in the league in touchdowns (8) and catches (51), while rating 10th in yards per catch (14.5). Overall, he was third in the MAC in receiving yards (77.3), receptions (5.7), touchdowns (9) per game, while ranking fourth in receiving yards (850), sixth in receptions (63) and 12th in yards per catch (13.5).

Adams pulled in every appearance for Akron last fall (11 games), including registering a career-high 10 catches for 115 yards against Miami on Oct. 29. He found the end zone nine times, including scoring a pair of touchdowns against Bowling Green (Oct. 1) and Northern Illinois (Nov. 26), while garnering a career-high 200 yards on nine catches versus Kent State (Oct. 22).

DID YOU KNOW

- Zippy is just one of eight female-gendered college mascots in Division I athletics. Do you know the other seven? (YoUDee, the Delaware Blue Hen; Mrs. Wuf of N.C. State; Lucy Lobo of New Mexico; Sue E. Pig of Arkansas; Miss Pawla of South Alabama, Kate the Lion of Hofstra; and Wilma Wildcat of Arizona).
- Akron was the first school to jump from Division I-AA football (now called FCS) to I-A (now called FBS). The Zips made the move in 1987.
- Hall of Fame coach **John Heisman** coached football from 1893-94 for Buchtel College (Akron's original name). The Cleveland native went on to take Georgia Tech to the national championship in 1917. The Heisman Trophy, given to the nation's most outstanding college player, is named in his honor.
- On Sept. 12, 2015, an 8-ft., 750-lb. bronze statue of Heisman was unveiled at InfoCision Stadium (outside Gate 1).
- Only one player in school history has had his number retired- #89 **Chris Angeloff**. The junior tight end collapsed and died of cardiac arrest during UA's 20-8 victory over Marshall on Sept. 6, 1975. The Chris Angeloff Scholarship was created in his honor.
- Three players, two coaches, and two teams are members of Akron's Ring of Honor: Coach **Jim Dennison**, **Chris Angeloff**, **1968 team**, and the **1976 team** (all inducted in 2003); **Jason Taylor** (2004); **Gordon Larson** (2005); and **Charlie Frye** (2015).

Viral moments related to the University of Akron football team rarely turn up in the program's favor. That changed Saturday when the Zips and their Turnover Tire enjoyed a moment in the spotlight after beating the Morgan State Bears on the type of play that sealed the team's fate in the past.

On a third-and-9 at their own 21 with 59 seconds left in the game and protecting a four-point lead, running back J.J. Davis took a handoff for the Bears. UA defensive lineman CJ Nunnally IV busted through the left side of the Bears O-line and poked the ball free. A split second later, linebacker Bryan McCoy scooped the ball up and ran 13 yards for a UA touchdown to ultimately give them a 24-21 victory in their home opener.

For their efforts, the team brought out the Turnover Tire in recognition.

The symbolism of it being associated with a college football team representing the Rubber City is inescapable, but it goes beyond that for UA coach Joe Moorhead, who is in his second year coaching the team.

The tire was something he conceived at the tail end of camp, he told the Beacon Journal on Tuesday.

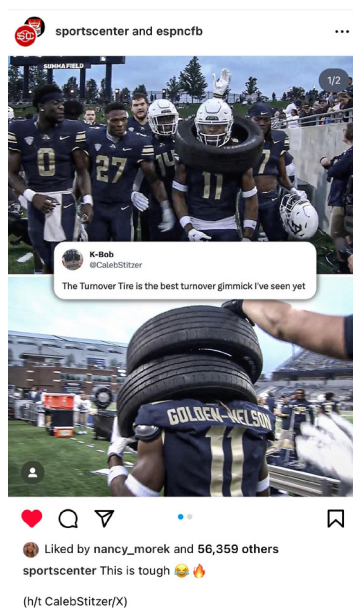
"Other people have the chains and the thrones and the slot machines, and that's kind of a lot of pomp and circumstance and glitz and glamor, and that's cool," he said. "But the identity that I want this football team to kind of embody is what the Akron area is." Moorhead understands where Akron fits in the fabric of Northeast Ohio and had his equipment manager acquire a couple of worn-down tires.

"It's almost symbolic in a lot of ways of how people view this program that we are just not a worthy or worthwhile program," he said. "And at the end of the day, what we got to do is find a way to dust it off and shine them up. And there's still plenty of tread on the tires in this program and we're going to find a way to make it work, put it on the car and drive this thing, drive this thing to success."

Not surprisingly, his players greeted the addition of the tire with enthusiasm. And Moorhead admits that it's pretty cool that it had a viral moment on the national stage, but he also appreciates hearing from fans.

"I was taking out the garbage [Monday] night and the guy who lives across the street from me was having a catch with his son and yelled across the street, 'Hey coach, great win. Congratulations. Love the tires, keep it rolling,'" he said. "So, I didn't mean for it to be gimmicky, there really is some substance to it, but at the same time it's kind of the anticelibration in a lot of ways."

JOE MOORHEAD

Head Coach
Second Season at Akron

Joe Moorhead, an inspirational leader of student-athletes and one of the most ingenious offensive minds in football, was named the head coach of The University of Akron football program on Dec. 4, 2021.

In his first season at Akron, Moorhead led the Zips to a 2-10 overall record and 1-7 in MAC play. The Zips ability to be competitive and be in a position to win games was evident as Akron dropped five of the final eight games by seven points or less. The Zips

A native of Pittsburgh, Moorhead returns to the Midwest, where he was a member of the Zips coaching staff from 2004-08, including serving as the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach from 2006-2008.

Moorhead, who has spent two seasons as offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at the University of Oregon, has a proven track record of success over his nearly quarter century in coaching, including six seasons as a head coach at Mississippi State (2018-19) and Fordham University (2012-15).

Moorhead has been the play-caller for five programs that have won a conference championship, including Oregon (2020), Penn State (2016), Fordham (2014), Connecticut (2010) and Akron (2005).

Moorhead has played an integral role in player development during his coaching career, including mentoring 20 players who have been chosen in the previous five NFL drafts. Among those selections were four first-round picks, headlined by New York Giants running back Saquon Barkley, who was named the Associated Press Offensive Rookie of the Year in 2019.

Moorhead guided Oregon's offensive efforts in 2021 in his 14th season as a team's primary offensive play-caller in the last 15 years. He played a key role in the success of the Oregon football team last fall, a 10-4 squad that played in its third consecutive Pac-12 Championship Game before competing at the Valero Alamo Bowl against No. 16 Oklahoma.

Moorhead directed the Ducks' offense to success last fall as Oregon ranked 42nd in the NCAA with 31.4 points per game and 50th with 423.6 yards of total offense per contest. Moorhead's unit was even more impressive on the ground as the Ducks rated 24th nationally with 202.4 rushing yards per tilt, including 36 rushing touchdowns, a total that ranked sixth in the NCAA in 2021.

Moorhead came to Oregon from Mississippi State, where he served as head coach during the 2018 and 2019 campaigns. He led the Bulldogs to back-to-back bowl appearances, the first Mississippi State head coach to do so in their first two seasons in program history, while also sparking the Bulldogs to a pair of triumphs over rival Ole Miss, claiming the Golden Egg Trophy both seasons.

Prior to his time at Mississippi State, Moorhead spent a pair of seasons at Penn State (2016-17), where the Nittany Lion offense averaged 39.3 points per game, including scoring 30 or more points 21 times, a mark that represents the third-highest total in the NCAA from 2016-17. He was honored as National Offensive Coordinator of the Year in each of the two seasons in State College.

Moorhead spent four seasons as the head coach at Fordham, compiling a 38-13 record from 2012-15. After taking over a program that was 1-10 in 2011, Moorhead led the Rams to a 12-2 record, the best season in program history in 2013 and the

Fordham reached the FCS playoffs the last three seasons under his leadership while compiling a 32-8 record. The Rams reached the highest ranking in program history, No. 5 in 2013, and the highest final in program history, No. 9 in 2013 and 2014, while recording the first two wins over FBS schools in program history.

In 2013, Moorhead earned AFCA Regional Co-Coach of the Year and Patriot League Coach of the Year honors and was also a finalist for the Eddie Robinson Award and the Liberty Mutual Coach of the Year.

Moorhead served as the assistant head coach, pass game and recruiting coordinator on Akron's Mid-American Conference championship team in 2005 when the Zips claimed the MAC Eastern Division title and then edged Northern Illinois in the MAC Championship Game, 31-30, to secure the school's first-ever bowl appearance.

Moorhead is a graduate of Fordham University, where he earned a bachelor's degree in English in 1996. A team captain and three-year starter at quarterback, he garnered second-team All-Patriot League accolades as a senior en route to ranking 13th nationally in total offense.

Moorhead and his wife, Jennifer, have three children: daughter Kyra, and sons Mason and Donovan.
