KENTUCKY, STILL UNBEATEN, RETURNS HOME

No. 18 Kentucky continues its historical start to the 2023 campaign as the Wildcats are back on home turf to face Vanderbilt this Sunday. Kentucky is unbeaten through 12 matches to start a season for the first time in program histroy, and without a loss during its first five SEC matches for the first time since 2003. The Cats are one of just eight unbeaten teams this year in Division I and the only side without a loss in the SEC.

In Thursday's draw at Tennessee, UK got a goal from Úlfa Úlfarsdóttir in the 60th minute, as well as a crucial save from Marz Joesphson on a late Volunteers' PK, to take a point in Knoxville. Jordyn Rhodes, who earned the primary assist on the goal, is now up to 20 points on the season, tied for the second most in the conference.

The Cats defense continues to be stout, with just six goals allowed this season, the fewest in the SEC and tied for the 10th fewest in Division I. UK has not surrendered more than one goal in any of its 12 contests thus far.

Vanderbilt brings momentum into Sunday, fresh off a commanding 6-0 win at home against Texas A&M. It was the most goals for the Commodores against an SEC opponent since 2000.

Kentucky is 15-18-2 against Vandy all-time, having lost six straight to the 'Dores. Last season, Vanderbilt earned a 2-0 victory in Nashville.

ROSTER RUNDOWN

- Kentucky's 2022 roster features 35 players including 23 newcomers and 12 returners for a total of ten grad-students, five seniors, six juniors, three sophomores, and 11 freshmen.
- All 11 freshmen are true first-years and include one goalkeepers, four defenders, two midfielders and four forwards.
- Three countries are represented on the roster, including Canada (2), Iceland (1) and the United States (32).
- In the United States, 16 states are represented on the team, including Wisconsin (4), Florida (4), North Carolina (3) Maryland (3), Ohio (3), Michigan (3), Kentucky (2), Illinois (2), Texas (1), Arizona (1), Arkansas (1), Pennsylvania (1), Virginia (1), Indiana (1), California, Conneticutt (1).
- The 12 returning players are responsible for 60.6 percent (20 of 33) of goals scored, 47.8 percent (117 of 245) of shots taken, 49.5 percent (51 of 103) of shots on goal, and 40.7 percent (11 of 27) of assists during the 2022 season.

RHODES BECOMES ALL-TIME LEADER

Jordyn Rhodes became the new all-time goals leader in program history with her two goals against Alabama on Sept. 29. Rhodes now has 45 goals for her collegiate career, passing Kim LaBelle's record of 44 which had stood since 1997.

HISTORIC START

The Wildcats are unbeaten through their first 12 matches for the first time in program history. The previous record was 11 straight results to start the 2005 season. Kentucky is the only team in the SEC without a loss this season and one of just 8 unbeaten sides in Division I.

FABIANO'S FIRST

Second-vear head coach Troy Fabiano captured his first SEC win as Kentucky beat Alabama on Sept. 29. Fabiano had previously recorded five draws against SEC opponents.

ENTER STAGE RIGHT

Kentucky found itself in the United Soccer Coaches top-25 this week, coming in at No. 18. It is the first time in the top-25 for the Wildcats since Oct. 6, 2015 when they appeared in the poll at No. 20. The Cats also earned a spot in this week's Top Drawer Soccer rankings at No. 23.

RANKED WIN

The Wildcats win over No. 9 Alabama was its first over a ranked opponent since the 2016 (No. 15 Arkansas) season and its first over a top 10 opponent since 2014 (No. 5 Florida).

NCAA SOCCER TEAM OF THE WEEK

NCAA Soccer selected Kentucky as their team of the week after the Wildcats upset No. 9 Alabama last Friday.

RHODES SEC PLAYER OF THE WEEK

After her record breaking performance, Jordyn Rhodes was selected as the SEC Offensive Player of the Week on Oct. 2. It was Rhodes' second weekly award from the SEC this season and the third of her collegiate career.

STREAK BREAKERS

The Wildcats have snapped two extended losing streaks against SEC foes with their draws vs. Texas A&M and South Carolina. The tie with the Aggies was their first since 2012, while the draw vs. the Gamecocks snapped a seven-match losing streak dating back to 2014. 2023 is also the first time Kentucky has gotten results in its first four SEC matches since 2003.

STINGY BACKLINE

Kentucky has allowed just six goals this season and has not surrendered more than one goal in any match. The six goals allowed are the

SEC POINTS

Kentucky is at seven points in SEC play thus far, its most points in the conference since the Wildcats finished with nine points in 2017. Kentucky is looking to post at least two wins in conference play for the first time since 2017.

EIGHT WIN THRESHOLD

Kentucky is up to seven wins on the season, the same number of wins the Cats have finished with the last two years. UK has not won eight games in a season since 2017.

RHODES GAME WINNERS

Rhodes has scored the game-winning goal in five of Kentucky's victories this season. Her five game-winners are already a new careerhigh for a single season and are just one shy of Kim Boyce's record of six game-winning goals in a season set in 1999. The five game-winning goals are tied for fourth in Division I this season.

FIRST WILDCAT GOALS

Of the nine Wildcats to record a goal this season, seven of them are first-time goal scorers for UK. Mia Bookhard, Katelyn Fishnick, Taya Hjorth, Ella Kane, Maya Lacognato, Tanner Strickland and Payton Robertson all scored their first goals at Kentucky this season. For Hjorth, Kane and Strickland, the goals were the first of their collegiate careers.

season watchlist prior to the start of the 2023 season. Marz Josephson, Maggy Henschler, Anna Young and Payton Robertson all received the recognition. It marked the firsttime for all four student-athletes on the list. A total of 72 student-athletes were recognized by the Conference.

ROBERTSON IS PLAYER TO WATCH

Transfer defender/midfielder Payton Robertson earned a spot of the United Soccer Coaches Player to Watch list for the 2023 season. Robertson helped Buffulo to a program record 14 clean sheets in 2022, while also leading the team with eight assists. She was named to the United Soccer Coaches All-Midwest Region Second Team for her performance.

HITTING THE PORTAL

Kentucky brings in a group of 12 transfers in 2023, adding plenty of exciting new talent to the roster. Among the transfers is one sophomore, three juniors, two seniors, and six fifth-years/graduate students. The group is made up of one goalkeeper, four defenders, three midfielders, and four forwards. The transfers arrive from the following schools: St. John's, Texas Tech, Wofford, Green Bay, UNC, DePaul, Iowa State, IUPUI, Davidson, RIT, UT Martin and Buffulo. Collectively, the group has scored 46 goals and picked up 52 assists during their collegiate careers. Six of the 12 transfers were All-Conference awardees at their previous schools.

INJURIES

Three of Kentucky's returning players will miss the 2023 season due to injury. Tallulah Miller, Mallory Glass and Hadley Williams have all been declared out for the year with the expectation that all three will return next season.

CATS ON NATIONAL TELEVISION

The ESPN Family of Networks and the Southeastern Conference have announced three nationally televised games for the Wildcats. Kentucky will be facing Florida on ESPNU on Sept. 24, Vanderbilt on the SEC Network, Oct. 8, and Mississippi State on the SEC Network, Oct. 15.

FRESHMAN FEVER

Kentucky brings in a class of 11 freshman for the 2023 season including one goalkeeper, four defenders, two midfielders and four forwards. The group comes to Kentucky by way of seven different states and two countries (U.S + Canada). Four of this year's freshman hail from the state of Florida.

BALLIN' AT THE BELL

The Wildcats are scheduled for 10 home matches in 2023, including five of its seven non-conference contests. Noteable home games include a matchup with the defending SEC Tournament champions, South Carolina, on Sept. 21, as well as the defending SEC regular season champions, Alabama on Sept. 29. Last season, Kentucky posted a 6-4-1 record on home turf.

She left the program ranked second in goals against average (1.06), third in shutouts (14) and fourth in wins (29).
