### OPENING TIP

**The Game:** The No. 3 Buffs look to move to 6-0 for the fifth time in the **JR Payne** era. CU is in search of its third Power 5 win to start the season. The Buffs will play one more Power 5 this week in the Paradise Jam Classic, having already defeated Cincinnati on Thursday.

About the Buffaloes: Colorado jumped up to No. 3 in the AP rankings with it's 4-0 start. The team's upset over then No. 1 LSU propelled CU into the top 5 for the first time since 1995. It was the team's second win over a No. 1 opponent, both wins coming under head coach **JR Payne**. Last season, the Buffs advanced to its first Sweet 16 since 2003, making back-to-back NCAA Tournaments for the first time since 2001-04. The Buffs ended last season with their best Pac-12 finish and only their second firstround bye to start the conference tournament since joining the conference in 2011-12. Colorado returns 88.0% of its scoring from last season, boasting eight players back from last season's Sweet 16 appearance. Four players return to the starting lineup with Jaylyn Sherrod, Quay Miller, Frida Formann and Aaronette Vonleh all back and ready to pick up from last season. Sherrod and Miller were both Preseason All-Conference while Formann and Vonleh picked up honorable mentions.

**About the Wildcats:** The Wildcats fell to No. 10 NC State on Thursday in its opening game of the Paradise Classic.

### Scouting the Wildcats

- 6th in the SEC with 24.3 FTA/game, but 13th in the conference with a 62.9 FT%
- 12th in the SEC with a 40.2 FG%
- · Ajae Petty ranks 8th in the NCAA with 12.2 rebounds per game
- · She's got three double doubles this season

### **Sharing is Caring**

- CU entered the weekend 5th in the NCAA with 23.5 assists per game
- The Buffs handed out 29 assists on 39 FGM against Le Moyne
- It was the most assists for the Buffs since 29 against Iowa on Dec. 2, 2001

- It was the most since totaling 62 against Air Force (Nov. 28, 2020)

### One Giant Leap

- Colorado's move from preseason No. 20 to No. 5 week 1's AP Poll is the largest poll-to-poll jump in AP history according to AcrossTheTimeline.com
- CU is up two spots to No. 3 this week

### 50th Season

- Colorado kicked off its 50th season of women's basketball with the win over No. 1 LSU
- CU is 45-5 all-time in season openers and hasn't lost one since 1999 at Denver (71-67)

### **At Colorado**

- Named the eighth head coach in CU history on March 28, 2016
- Had contract extended in the spring of 2023
- Replaced Linda Lappe, who was at CU for five seasons
- Had career win No. 100 at CU against Western Michigan (Nov. 30, 2021) and career win No. 200 overall against Chicago State (Nov. 27, 2022)
- In 2021-22, led CU to its first 20 win season since 2012-13 and it's first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2017
- Upset No. 1 Stanford 77-72 in overtime, claiming CU's first win over a No. 1 opponent in school history (1/17/21)
- Opened 2019-20 with a 12-game winning streak, CU's best start since the 2011-12 season
- Guided the Buffs to one of the best single-season turnarounds in school history in 2016-17 as they more than doubled their win total from the previous year, finishing the year 17-16 overall and tied for ninth in the Pac-12, a year after a last-place finish in the conference in 2015-16.
