### OPENING TIP

**The Game:** The No. 3 Buffs look to move to 6-0 for the fifth time in the **JR Payne** era. CU is in search of its third Power 5 win to start the season. The Buffs will play one more Power 5 this week in the Paradise Jam Classic, having already defeated Cincinnati on Thursday.

**About the Buffaloes:** Colorado jumped up to No. 3 in the AP rankings with its 4-0 start. The team's upset over then No. 1 LSU propelled CU into the top 5 for the first time since 1995. It was the team's second win over a No. 1 opponent, both wins coming under head coach **JR Payne**. Last season, the Buffs advanced to its first Sweet 16 since 2003, making back-to-back NCAA Tournaments for the first time since 2001-04. The Buffs ended last season with their best Pac-12 finish and only their second first-round bye to start the conference tournament since joining the conference in 2011-12. Colorado returns 88.0% of its scoring from last season, boasting eight players back from last season's Sweet 16 appearance. Four players return to the starting lineup with **Jaylyn Sherrod**, **Quay Miller**, **Frida Formann** and **Aaronette Vonleh** all back and ready to pick up from last season. Sherrod and Miller were both Preseason All-Conference while Formann and Vonleh picked up honorable mentions.

**About the Wildcats:** The Wildcats fell to No. 10 NC State on Thursday in its opening game of the Paradise Classic.

## TEAM NOTES

- (10-Jackson State, 11- Louisiana, 11- Southern Utah, 11- Alcorn State, Middle Tennessee-13, Iowa-10)
- The Buffs added Michigan sharp-shooter **Maddie Nolan** through the transfer portal
- Nolan led the Wolverines last season with 65 3FGM and 1.97/G
- Nolan and Formann entered the season combined for 345 career 3-pointers (178 Formann, 167 Nolan)

### LS-Who?

- Colorado's win over No. 1 LSU was just the fourth win vs a No. 1 opponent in CU athletic history and the first away from Boulder
- The win was the first time the defending national champions have lost a season-opener since Louisiana Tech defeated UConn, 83-81, to open the 1995-96 season
- It's just the fourth time the defending women's national champion has ever lost a season opener

- Colorado has wins over the top-ranked team in back-to-back tries (No. 1 Stanford, 77-72, in overtime on Jan. 17, 2021)
- Both wins have been orchestrated by head coach **JR Payne**
- Jaylyn Sherrod**, **Frida Formann** and **Charlotte Whitaker** were a part of both CU teams

- Quay Miller** and **Jaylyn Sherrod** were picked All-Pac-12
- Frida Formann** and **Aaronette Vonleh** both were All-honorable mentions

### vs Ranked

- Colorado is 66-209 all-time against opponents ranked in the AP Top 25 (4-6 last season)
- Three of CU's last five games have all been against ranked opponents (3-1)
- Before the OT win at No. 13 Duke in last season's NCAA Tournament, CU's last AP Top 25 win on the road was at No. 20 Vanderbilt (62-51) in the 2007-08 season

### In the Spotlight

- The Buffs started the season ranked No. 20 in the AP poll

- It's the first time CU has started the season ranked since the 2013-14 season
- CU spent eight weeks in the AP rankings last season

### History Made

- CU's 25-9 record last season was the team's best mark since going 25-7 in the 2012-13 season
- It's the most wins under JR Payne
- It was just the second time since in the last 27 seasons that a Colorado team has reached 25 wins and the most since going 26-9 in 1995-96
- Just the eighth 25-win season in CU history
- The Buffs had 20 wins in back-to-back seasons for the first time since he 2011-12 and the 2012-13 seasons
- Colorado's 13-5 mark in conference play was just the second time the Buffs have 13 wins in the Pac-12 (13 in 2012-13)
- CU twice went 14-0 in the Big Eight

### The Long and Winding Road

- CU's advanced to its seventh Sweet Sixteen with two wins in Durham
- It was the only time CU has advance to the Sweet Sixteen coming out of a road site
- The previous six trips all came when CU hosted first two rounds in Boulder

### Made it Rain

- Colorado hit a program NCAA Tournament record 13 3-pointers against Middle Tennessee
- Frida Formann** led the way with 5, becoming the third player to hit at least 5 3's in a NCAA Tournament game for the Buffs (Shelley Sheetz and Kate Fagan)
- The 13 3-pointers tied for seventh most in CU history and were the most in over a decade since hitting 15 against Oklahoma State in a WNIT game on 3/25/12
- CU hit seven 3's in the first half, tied for the second most in a half this season
- CU hit 6-of-9 from deep in the third quarter, matching the overall program record for most 3-pointers in a quarter set against Idaho State on 12/3/16

### Hot Shots

- The Buffs ranked 4th Pac-12 with a 43.4 FG% last season
- The team shot a season-high 59.6% (31-52) at Marquette
- Aaronette Vonleh** was 18th in the country (2nd Pac-12) shooting 58.5% in 2022-23

### Can't Drive 55

- The Buffs held teams to 55 points or under in 13 games last season
- CU was 16-0 this season when holding teams to under 60
- Colorado's defense allowed 59.3 ppg (4th Pac-12)
- Colorado held four consecutive opponents to 50 points or less (Chicago 32, Western Michigan 37, Boise State 48, Southern Utah 48)
- It was the first time since the 1996-97 season the Buffs have held four consecutive opponents to 50 points or less (Mar. 5 – Iowa State, 39, Mar. 6 – Texas, 50, Mar. 8 – Kansas State, 44, Mar. 14 – Marshall, 49)
- The team has held opponents to under 50 points eight times last season

### Boarding

- CU had 13 games of 40+ rebounds last season
- The Buffs snatched a season-high 50 rebounds against Washington (Feb. 12, 2023)
- It was the most rebounds in conference play since grabbing 50 vs USC (Jan. 10, 2020)
- The Buffs outrebounded Washington 50-29 for a +21 rebounding margin, the largest margin in a Pac-12 game for the Buffs last season and the largest margin in a conference game since +21 against Arizona (Feb. 23, 2020)
- Quay Miller** had a career-high 19 rebounds against

- Oregon State, helping the team beat the Beavers by 20 on the boards (46-26)
- The 19 rebounds tied for the fourth most in program history

### Life on the Road

- Colorado played 15 games on the road last season (six non-conference, one NCAA Tournament)
- CU went 10-5 on the road in 2022-23
- It tied for the most road wins in program history (10-4 in 1993-94 and 10-2 in 1988-89)
- The Buffs had 12 total wins away from Boulder (3-2 neutral site)
- Colorado had seven road wins for the entire 2021-22 season (7-4)

### Down and Out

- Seven of CU's nine losses last season were by 11+ points
- All five of the Buffs' Pac-12 losses have been by a double digit margin

### Complete Control

- The Buffs led from start to finish five times last season (at Boise State, Alcorn State, at Marquette, Washington, California)
- The Buffs win over UW was the first Pac-12 game CU had not trailed since its 73-56 win at Cal (Feb. 11, 2022) and was the just the second Pac-12 game the team had not trailed since the 2020-21 finale at Washington (Feb. 21, 2021)

### Back2Back

- CU pulled consecutive upsets over ranked teams (No. 8 Utah, No. 14 Arizona) for the first time since the 2007-08 season (No. 21 Wyoming, No. 20 Vanderbilt)
- It was the first time CU has beaten top-15 opponents in consecutive games since the 1981-82 season (No. 13 Oregon, No. 10 Tennessee)

## HEAD COACH JR PAYNE

- 8th year as CU head coach, 14th season overall as a head coach
- 124-93 (.571) record at CU
- Career record of 225-206 (.522)
- Record since 2020-21 season 64-29 (.688)
- No. 6 seed in the 2023 NCAA Tournament, marking back-to-back appearances
- Women's NIT appearance in 2014 at Southern Utah, 2016 at Santa Clara and 2017 and 2021 at Colorado
- Has coached three All-Americans, three conference players of the year, 43 all-conference players and 45 all-academic team members as an assistant and head coach
- Has been a part of three NCAA Tournament team (2007 as assistant at Boise State, 2022, 2023 at CU) and seven Women's NIT teams as an assistant and head coach



### At Colorado

- Named the eighth head coach in CU history on March 28, 2016
- Had contract extended in the spring of 2023
- Replaced Linda Lappe, who was at CU for five seasons
- Had career win No. 100 at CU against Western Michigan (Nov. 30, 2021) and career win No. 200 overall against Chicago State (Nov. 27, 2022)
- In 2021-22, led CU to its first 20 win season since 2012-13 and it's first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2017
- Upset No. 1 Stanford 77-72 in overtime, claiming CU's first win over a No. 1 opponent in school history (1/17/21)
- Opened 2019-20 with a 12-game winning streak, CU's best start since the 2011-12 season
- Guided the Buffs to one of the best single-season turnarounds in school history in 2016-17 as they more than doubled their win total from the previous year, finishing the year 17-16 overall and tied for ninth in the Pac-12, a year after a last-place finish in the conference in 2015-16.
- The Buffs also reached the third round of the WNIT in 2016-17, their first postseason appearance since 2014.
- CU started the 2016-17 season 10-0 for just the fifth time in school history, including a win over No. 15/19 Kentucky
- Became just the second CU coach to begin her career with 10 straight wins and the first since 1980.
- In Pac-12 play, the Buffs' signature win came on Feb. 12 when they upset No. 24 California on the road, their first win over a ranked team on the road since 2007.
- Three players earned postseason awards from the Pac-12, including first-team all-conference sophomore Kennedy Leonard.

### At Santa Clara

- Spent past two seasons at Santa Clara and had a 34-27 record
- Led SCU to a 23-9 record in 2015-16, tying for third in the West Coast Conference with a 13-5 league mark
- Santa Clara reached its first postseason appearance in 10 years in 2016, qualifying for the Women's NIT
- Signature wins included defeating No. 13 Stanford 61-58 in 2015-16 and LSU 69-67 in 2014-15, SCU's first win over an SEC team in 19 years
- SCU ranked third in the nation in steals (12.6), sixth in forced turnovers (21.7) and 29th in rebounding margin (+7.2) in 2015-16

### At Southern Utah

- Spent five seasons at Southern Utah
- Her second season at SUU went 16-14 in 2010-11, the first winning season in seven years
- Led SUU to a school record for wins and a share of the Big Sky Conference regular season championship in her final season in 2013-14 with a 23-10 record and reached the postseason for the first time in school history, playing in the Women's NIT

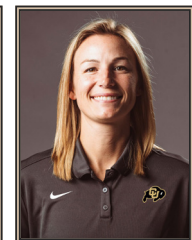
