QUICK FACTS

- The University of Kentucky women's basketball team is in its 50th season in 2023-24, holding an 896-590 (.603) overall record.
- The Wildcats' first five games of the season are at five different locations, including its first three home games, as Memorial Coliseum is undergoing an \$82 million renovation.
- The Wildcats have had three different starting lineups over the last three games.
 - Senior guard Maddie Scherr (ankle) was unavailable for the last two games.
- This marks the fourth appearance for Kentucky at the Paradise Jam, including 2004, 2014 and 2018.
 - UK won the tournament title in 2014 and 2018.
- Senior forward Ajae Petty leads the Southeastern Conference and is ranked 10th in the nation in rebounds per game (12.2).
 - She has recorded three double-doubles through four games.
- Junior guard Brooklynn Miles is ranked third in the league and 46th in the nation in assist-turnover ratio (3.00).

GAME NOTES

INSIDE THE SERIES: VS. NC STATE / COLORADO / CINCINNATI

NC STATE

- Kentucky trails NC State in the all-time series, 2-4, which began in 1980.
 - UK has a two-game losing streak (1995, 2019)
- The last two meetings between the two teams also were on neutral courts (1995, 2019).
- In their most recent matchup, Kentucky dropped to NC State, 72-57, in the NCAA Tournament Second Round on March 25, 2019.
 - It marked the first time the two teams had met since in 1995.

COLORADO

- Kentucky and Colorado are tied in the all-time series, 1-1.
 - The two teams played a home-and-away in 2015 and 2016, with each team winning on its home court.
- In their most recent matchup, Kentucky dropped to Colorado, 79-69, on the road on Nov. 19, 2016.

CINCINNATI

- Kentucky leads Colorado in the all-time series, 19-6, which began in 1978.
 - UK has a two-game winning streak (2008, 2009) and has won three of the last four
- In their most recent matchup, Kentucky defeated Cincinnati, 68-57, on the road on Dec. 4, 2009.

KENTUCKY IN THE PARADISE JAM

- This marks Kentucky's fourth appearance at the Paradise Jam, including 2004, 2014 and 2018.
 - The Wildcats took home the tournament title in both 2014 and 2018.
- UK has own the past five straight games in the Paradise Jam, winning the last two of three games in 2014 to earn the tournament title and winning all three games in 2018 to claim another tournament title.
- The Wildcats have placed four players on the All-Tournament Team over the years, including two who were name MVP.
 - 2014 Makayla Epps (MVP), Jennifer O'Neill
 - 2018 Rhyne Howard (MVP), Taylor Murray

KENTUCKY IN REGULAR-SEASON TOURNAMENTS

- Kentucky is making its first trip away from the stateside since just last season in 2022, when it went 1-1 in the Baha Mar Hoops Pink Flamingo Championship in the Nassau, Bahamas last Thanksgiving.
 - It was a round robin, and no tournament champion crowned.
- The Cats are 91-38 all-time in regular-season tournaments.

KENTUCKY VS. RANKED OPPONENTS

- The Wildcats are 81-235 all-time against Associated Press ranked opponents.
- Kentucky went 0-5 against Associated Press ranked teams last season in 2022-23 and 4-7 against ranked teams in 2021-22, which included defeating three of its last four ranked opponents of the season.
 - The Wildcats' last ranked win was against then-No. 1 South Carolina, 64-62, to win the 2022 Southeastern Conference Tournament in Nashville, Tennessee, on March 6, 2022.
 - That was also Kentucky's last ranked win when UK was unranked.



PARADISE, YA SAY?

- The Wildcats are back at the Paradise Jam in the U.S. Virgin Islands this Thanksgiving after winning the tournament title the past two visits there (2014, 2018).
- Kentucky will have a tall test on the island, as it prepares to square off against No.
 10/16 NC State on Nov. 23 (the same NC State that defeated then-No. 2/2 UConn in Week 1) and No. 3/4 Colorado on Nov. 24 (the same Colorado that took down then-No.
 1/1 LSU in Week 1).
 - Kentucky also will meet Cincinnati on Nov. 25.

AJAE PETTY IS SETTING THE TONE

THE INVESTMENT

- Ajae Petty, a senior post player, had a huge off-season that has made an impact on both her and her team.
 - She did every workout recommended to her during both summer breaks, which
 paid dividends when she came back for summer practice.
 - She actually PR'd in every strength and conditioning category from a season ago.
 - She attributes her "new self" to several things:
 - Coach Elzy challenged her before the first summer break.
 - Petty realized she has a lot of support and a lot of resources and she wanted to start taking advantage of all that was given to her.
 - Her renewed mindset... she now embraces every challenge she is met with.
- As you would expect, Ajae's 180, mentally and physically, has completely influenced the team... they have had a total mindset shift since 2022-23.
 - More than ever before, they are embracing hard work and are receptive to what it takes to win.
 - More than ever before, they have developed a strong player-led culture.
 - They have put the past behind them and have a common goal of being the best versions of themselves.

THE RETURN

- Ajae Petty reset her career high in scoring already this season, twice putting up 19
 points, while she has also reset her career high in rebounding two times in 2023-24,
 which is currently sitting at 14.
- The Wildcat is leading her team in both scoring (16.3) and rebounding (12.3).
 - Meanwhile, she is leading the Southeastern Conference and is ranked 10th in the nation in rebounds per game (12.3) and offensive rebounds per game (4.5).
- She has put up a double-double in three of four games in 2023-24.

50TH ANNIVERSARY

- The Wildcats are celebrating their 50th anniversary of varsity status in 2023-24.
 - Sue Feamster became the first UK women's basketball head coach of the modern era, after the program regained its varsity status in 1974.
- In celebration of the 50th jubilee, Big Blue Nation can expect in-game elements such as:

- 14th-seed Kentucky became the lowest seeded team to ever reach the Southeastern Conference Tournament Quarterfinals last March.
 - 14th-seed Kentucky defeated both 11th-seed Florida (first round) and sixth-seed
 Alabama (second round) to meet third-seed Tennessee in the quarterfinals. It
 marked UK's 14th straight appearance in the quarterfinals, which is the longest
 active streak in the SEC (South Carolina is second with 12).
 - In Kentucky's win over Alabama in the second round, then-junior guard Maddie Scherr scored 19 points with three rebounds, four assists, six blocks and two steals in nearly 40 minutes. Her six blocks set a new program record for most blocks in an SEC Tournament game.
 - Also after Kentucky defeated Alabama in the second round, Kyra Elzy owned a 7-1
 record in the SEC Tournament, which tied with Melanie Balcomb of Vanderbilt for
 the best eight-game start for a head coach in tournament history.

"AND I ROCK KENTUCKY BLUE!"

- Drake gifted the University of Kentucky men's and women's basketball teams his brand new NOCTA Glides, embellished with a "UK" logo on them.
- John Calipari surprised the women's team with them a week before the season began.

OFFSEASON AWARDS

- Following summer practices, the team issued three awards:
 - The Wildcat Award Cassidy Rowe
 - Someone who exudes "the culture player."
 - Most Improved Award Emma King
 - Someone who has shown great improvement from the season before.
 - MVP Award Ajae Petty
 - Someone who both exudes "the culture player" and has shown a great deal
 of improvement. Someone who has taken on a clear and obvious leadership
 role and who has set the standard on and off the court.

SCHERR EFFORT

- Just in case you forgot how good Maddie Scherr is...
 - In 2022-23, she played and started in 29 games, averaging 11.6 points per game and 5.1 rebounds in 31.7 minutes per game on the season ... She added 125 assists (4.3 apg), 62 steals (2.1 spg) and 32 blocks (1.1 bpg)
 - Concluded the regular season ranked fourth in the SEC in apg (4.2), fourth in the SEC in steals (55), fifth in the SEC in assists (110) and sixth in the SEC in spg (2.1)
 - She also concluded the regular season as the SEC leader and school-record holder in FT% (80-87, 91.8%)
 - She shot 38.5 percent from the field (110-286) and 33.6 percent from the arc (37-110)
 - She doubled her offensive production from the nonconference schedule to the conference schedule, from 7.3 ppg in the nonconference to 14.9 points per game in the conference
 - Reset her career high in scoring four times this season, all against top-25 teams, including 18 vs. UofL, 22 vs. LSU, 25 vs. USC and 27 vs. Tennessee
 - In late January 2023, she was the only player in the SEC averaging at least 5.0 in three statistical categories on the season (10.2 ppg, 5.6 rpg, 5.0 apg)
 - Scored in double digits 17 times, at least 15 points nine times, at least 20 points three times and at least 25 points two times
 - Led Kentucky in assists in 19 games, in blocks in 12 games and in steals in 11 games
 - Set a new program record for most blocks in an SEC Tournament game when she recorded six in Kentucky's win against Alabama in the 2023 SEC Tournament Second Round, adding 19 points, four assists, three rebounds and two steals

- The Wildcats speak fondly of their team chemistry ahead of the upcoming season, so much so, many of them describe it as the closest team they have ever been a part of.
- That is evident by their random, fun, team initiatives, including coming to practice one
 time over the summer all wearing colorful wigs to prank the coaches and them begging
 head coach Kyra Elzy to have a sleepover (coaches and players) during fall practice.





MEMORIAL COLISEUM UNDERGOING RENOVATIONS

- UK's home court, Memorial Coliseum, is undergoing an \$82 million dollar renovation this season.
 - Kentucky women's basketball, gymnastics and volleyball are "taking over" Rupp
 Area in 2023-24, as it was named the official home floor for those sports for the
 upcoming season.
- Kentucky women's basketball is also getting a renovated locker room and team lounge.

NYAH LEVERETTER IS HEALING FROM ACL TEAR

- Nyah Leveretter, a senior forward, sustained a torn anterior cruciate ligament in her right knee during the Kentucky-Vanderbilt game in Memorial Gymnasium in Nashville, Tennessee, on Feb. 19, 2023.
 - She missed the remainder of last season.
- The Wildcat played in all 26 games and made 21 starts until her accident, including the prior 16 straight.
 - She was averaging 2.5 points per game and 3.9 rebounds per game, while adding
 2.8 points and 4.2 rebounds per game in conference action.

OUT BUT NOT DOWN

- The Wildcat had her first surgery in February and second surgery in September.
 However, she is taking full advantage of her recovery time:
 - NCAA DI Women's Basketball Student-Athlete Engagement Group appointee (2023-24)
 - UK SAAC Vice President (2023-24)
 - Nike, Inc. intern in New York City (Summer 2023)
 - CSC Academic All-District Team (2022-23)

 - SEC Men's and Women's Basketball Leadership Council (2022-23, 2023-24)
 - Frank G. Ham Society of Character (2022-23)
 - National Association of Black Journalists club member
 - She is also interning with Susan Lax (Slax), UK football's sports information director, this fall.

WHAT YOU DON'T KNOW ABOUT NYAH LEVERETTER

- Nyah Leveretter is never late and lives a very structured life. Coming from a military family, the lessons she has learned about organization and discipline directly translate to her life as a student athlete.
 - The Wildcat was born at Fort Campbell, Kentucky, an Army base that sits right on the border of Tennessee and the Bluegrass State. She lived there for a few years and moved to Japan once she turned five.
- Being in a military family, there are some ideals and practices that become so normal you don't realize it.
 - "I'm a very structured person. Like very. And I didn't realize it until I was around
 other people who weren't as structured," Leveretter said. "I felt like I was a structure maniac, and they weren't and it drives me insane. When people are late to
 things, it makes me tick so bad. And I didn't realize it was because I was raised
 this way."
- This shows up for her as a student as well.
 - "Even when I'm turning in assignments, I don't like turning things in late,"
 Leveretter said. "I don't ever do that. If I don't have an A, or at least a B, I'm mad at myself, like really mad."

- UK head coach Kyra Elzy hired several new, good coaching and staff hires in the offseason:
 - Assistant coach Crystal Kelly
 - Associate coach of player development Jenny Huth (will also serve as the program's additional on-court coach granted to them by the NCAA)
 - Associate coach of player relations Jaamal Rhodes (will also serve as the program's additional on-court coach granted to them by the NCAA)
 - NIL director Liz Brown
 - Coaching video coordinator Jerod McCullan
 - Recruiting assistant Jodi Ansert

ELZY & KELLY GO WAY BACK

- When Kyra Elzy was an assistant coach at Western Kentucky (2002-04), she recruited Crystal Kelly, who was a Miss Kentucky Basketball and 2x Gatorade Player of the Year out of Sacred Heart in Louisville.
 - Elzy pulled out all the stops to recruit her, including carving dozens and dozens
 of pumpkins for her and also driving more than an hour to get her food from her
 favorite restaurant.
- Crystal Kelly ended up signing to WKU, and still to this day holds more than a dozen records there.

BALTIMORE BABIES

- Ajae Petty, a senior who transfered from LSU before last season, and Eniya Russell, also a senior who transfered from South Carolina prior to last season, were reunited at last in 2022-23.
- The pair of Baltimore natives first met while playing on their middle school basketball team. They played several seasons together until they were separated by high school transfers and college commitments, only to be finally reunited as teammates last season.
 - "Living with Eniya has made this transfer a lot smoother for me, especially with having someone to relate to," Petty said.
 - This duo joined the team with a secret weapon knowing what to expect from one another at all times.
 - "I know when she wants the ball and where she wants it," Russell said. "I know what she's capable of. We've been playing together for so long, I just know her game."
- Fun Fact: If you ask them both the biggest difference between their prior programs and Kentucky, they will simultaneously say, "conditioning!"

LEADERSHIP COMMITTEE

- The coaching staff formed a "leadership committee" in Summer 2022. Emma King, Nyah Leveretter and Maddie Scherr were on the leadership committee last season and returned to it in 2023-24.
 - The team also voted in Ajae Petty and Cassidy Row to join the leadership committee in Summer 2023.

MAMBA & MAMBACITA SKILLS ACADEMY

- The Mamba & Mambacita Sports Foundation partnered with the University of Kentucky men's and women's basketball programs to put on the second annual Mamba & Mambacita Sports Foundation Skills Academy on Oct. 26, 2023.
 - Once again, it was held at the Joe Craft Center, and the event hosted 175 underserved kids – 100 girls and 75 boys – from the Lexington area.
- Mamba & Mambacita Sports Foundation Ambassador Natalia Bryant attended UK's first skills academy in 2022, while Mamba & Mambacita Sports Foundation Executive Director Kat Conlon represented the foundation on site in both 2022 and 2023.





- Each year, the event has begun with a spirited introduction of the Mamba &
 Mambacita Sports Foundation by Kentucky women's basketball head coach Kyra Elzy.
 That was followed by a moving speech about the Mamba Mentality Five Pillars by
 Kentucky men's basketball head coach John Calipari.
- The campers were then divided into teams, led by the Wildcats' men's and women's basketball coaches, staff and players. The teams rotated through almost a dozen stations during the two hours, where the campers learned a Kobe Bryant-inspired principle, and then took part in a practice drill related to that principle, at each stop.
- Printed materials with Kobe Bryant quotes and action photos have complemented each station to serve as a visual representation of the basketball legend.

KOBE & GIGI SHOES

 Kentucky was one of six schools selected to wear Kobe and Gigi NIKE shoes in 2023-24, thanks to its commitment to hosting Mamba & Mambacita Sports Foundation Skills Academies for undeserved children.

606 STRONG

- Cassidy Rowe's family and community were directly affected by the Eastern Kentucky floods last summer.
 - The Virgie, Kentucky, native and sophomore guard tells a great story about how her parents had to trudge through knee-deep water to evacuate to their neighbor's house on higher ground.
 - Meanwhile, Rowe texted her father to see if her childhood basketball goal was ok.
 He told her it wasn't, it had been washed away. He ended up finding it floating down the flood stream.
 - Her home ended up being ok, just some property damage. However, many, many folks around neighborhood were not so fortunate.
 - Rowe and her family were and continue to be very active in their community in the aftermath of the flooding, handing out meals and cleaning.
- Rowe, Emma King and alumnae Blair Green and Maci Morris all natives of Eastern Kentucky or otherwise known as the 606 - hosted a "606 Camp" for 606 residents at North Laurel High School last August.
 - The cost to attend was \$40 per player or \$60 for two in a family, while all proceeds from the camp went directly to the Foundation for Appalachian Kentucky Crisis Fund.

THE MAGIC "80"

- UK holds a remarkable 380-26 (.936) record since 1974 when scoring 80 points or more.
 - Kentucky is 1-0 when scoring at least 80 points in 2023-24.
- The last loss came vs. DePaul on Dec. 9, 2021 when the Cats fell 94-85. UK is 10-1 this
 year.

UK IN OVERTIME

• UK is 31-28 all-time in overtime games, including 1-1 under Kyra Elzy.

 - 0-1 (0.000) at the Davis-Reid Alumni Gym
- If you do the math, you will notice UK's losses in Memorial Coliseum, Rupp Arena, Clive M. Beck Center (Transylvania) and the Davis-Reid Alumni Gym are two more than UK has home losses.
 - That reason is UK's NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 game vs. Washington at Rupp Arena on March 25, 2016 and its NCAA Tournament game vs. Indiana on March 18, 1983 at Memorial Coliseum cannot count towards UK's home record.

81 YEARS OF COLLEGIATE COACHING EXPERI-ENCE

- Of the four Kentucky coaches, three have seen time at head coach at major Power Five programs.
 - Kyra Elzy is in her fourth season as the head coach at Kentucky, then associate head coach Niya Butts was the head coach at Arizona from 2008-16, and finally, Jen Hoover was the head coach at High Point in 2011-12, then Wake Forest from 2012-22.
- Between the four of them, including assistant coach Crystal Kelly, they have a combined 81 years of collegiate coaching experience as a full-time assistant coach or head coach.
- Fun Fact: Between Elzy and Butts, the two coaches have a combined 23 years of experience as members of the coaching staff at Kentucky, a testament to the culture of the program and the athletic department.

WILDCATS SHINE IN THE CLASSROOM

- The Wildcats have had a 3.0 team GPA or better each of the last 20 semesters, including six semesters under Kyra Elzy.
- She has put an emphasis on academics since arriving on campus as an assistant coach several years ago. In more than a decade of seasons with her on staff (2008-12, (2016-pres.), UK has a 100 percent graduation rate among four-year players.

 - The Wildcats took a hit during the pandemic and after the pandemic, but are gradually seeing a rise in attendance since
- Kentucky was involved in two of the top-25 most attended games in the nation in 2019-20, including 11,256 fans against Louisville at Rupp Arena, which ranked 23rd.

- Rupp Arena is entering its 48th season in 2023-24.
- Because of the \$82 million renovation going on at Memorial Coliseum throughout the season, the women's basketball program (alongside gymnastics and volleyball) will play majority of its games inside Rupp Arena in 2023-24. That includes 12 games - four nonconference games and all eight Southeastern Conference games.
- The Wildcats usually play at least one game inside Rupp Arena each season, giving Big Blue Nation a unique opportunity to see and experience a game inside the stunning arena but at a more affordable cost.
- A center-hung scoreboard, ribbon boards, a new sound system and lighting were installed over 2014-15 and 2015-16. Chair-back seating was installed in the uppersideline area prior to 2019-20. Two club areas for season ticket holders opened in 2021-22, with a third opening during 2022-23.
- Following renovations in 2019, capacity was lowered to 20,500.
- In 2013-14, UK women's basketball set the new single-game attendance record when 23,706 fans saw Kentucky face No. 2 Duke in Rupp Arena on Dec. 22, 2013. The attendance marked the largest crowd ever to see a college women's basketball game in the Commonwealth — the previous mark was 22,152 for the first Kentucky-Louisville game played in the KFC Yum! Center on Dec. 5, 2010.

DID YOU KNOW?

- Kyra Elzy is in the Kentucky High School Basketball Hall of Fame for her storied career at Oldham County High School. During her high school days, she was a two-time All-American selection by Parade Magazine and Street & Smith and considered by some to be the best high school basketball player in Kentucky history She led her Oldham County team to two KHSAA regional titles and a semifinal appearance in the 1993 KHSAA Sweet 16. Overall, she scored 3,000 points with 1,700 rebounds, 449 assists and 516 steals over a stellar career.
- An all-around athlete, Kyra also saw success in cross country and track and field where she was a state champion in the 400-meter dash as a junior in high school.
- Elzy holds a bachelor's degree in psychology from Tennessee in 1999 and a master's degree in cultural studies and education with an emphasis in
- sports psychology from UT in 2001. As a student-athlete at UT from 1996-2001, Elzy's game excelled under Hall of Famer Pat Summitt. A four-year letterwinner, Elzy was a member of two national championship teams (1997, 1998), a national runner-up squad (2000), four SEC regular-season championships (1998, 1999, 2000, 2001) and three SEC Tournament titles (1998, 1999, 2000).
- During her time in Knoxville, she played in 126 games and earned the Holly Warlick Defensive Player of the Year award in 1997 and the Unsung Hero Award in 1998. Elzy became just the fifth freshman in Tennessee history to start her first game as a Lady Vol when she started at guard in the 1996-97 season opener against Austin Peay. She also earned another distinction during her playing career, becoming the first UT player to earn her master's degree while still playing.

AWARDS & HONORS

- In 2022-23, under head coach Kyra Elzy, 14-seeded Kentucky became the lowest seeded team to ever reach the Southeastern Conference Tournament Quarterfinals after it defeated 11th-seeded Florida in the first round and sixth-seeded Alabama in the second round.
 - It marked UK's 14th straight appearance in the quarterfinals, which was the longest active streak in the SEC at the time (South Carolina is second with 12).
 - After Kentucky defeated Alabama in the second round, Coach Elzy owned a 7-1 record in the SEC Tournament, which tied with Melanie Balcomb of Vanderbilt for the best eight-game start for a head coach in tournament history.
- Kyra Elzy produced the program's first ever No. 1 WNBA Draft pick in Rhyne Howard, who was taken first
 overall by the Atlanta Dream on April 11, 2022.
 - In the process, Elzy helped UK become one of just 16 programs in the nation to produce a No. 1 WNBA
- · Kyra Elzy is the only coach in program history to lead her team to back-to-back NCAA Tournaments in her
- In 2022, Kyra Elzy led the Kentucky women's basketball program to its second SEC Tournament Title in program history, and its first since 1982, when it defeated No. 1 South Carolina, 64-62, at Bridgestone Arena in Nashville, Tenn., on March 6, 2022.
 - Elzy, who holds an impressive 5-1 record in her two-year tenure in the SEC Tournament, guided UK to the championship game for the first time since 2014. Elzy became the fifth coach in league history to win the tournament title in the first two seasons on
 - the job, joining Joe Ciampi (Auburn), Jim Foster (Vanderbilt), Melanie Balcomb (Vanderbilt) and Holly Warlick (Tennessee).
 - Kentucky, who was the seventh seed at the conference tournament, became the second-lowest seed to ever win the SEC Women's Basketball Tournament.
- Elzy's Wildcats became the only No. 7 seed in any power five conference tournament ever to defeat the No. 1, 2, and 3 seeds to earn the conference tournament title.
- Moreover, the Wildcats became the fourth team to ever defeat the No. 1 team in the Associated Press Poll in the SEC Tournament championship game. In defeating the top-ranked Gamecocks, Elzy aided UK to just its second win ever against a No. 1 team
- in the AP Poll.
- In just her second season at the helm of the program (2021-22), Kyra Elzy helped Kentucky to a 10-game win streak, UK's longest win streak in conference action in a decade (2011-12)
- WBCA Rookie Coach of the Year in 2021 after becoming the first UK head coach to lead their team to the NCAA Tournament in their first season at the helm.
- Named espnW National Coach of the Week on January 4, 2021, after back-to-back top-12 wins to start conference action (then-No. 10 Arkansas and then-No. 12 Mississippi State). It marked the first time Kentucky has ever earned back-to-back wins against teams ranked in the top-12 of the AP poll.
- Became the eighth head coach in UK women's basketball history as UK AD Mitch Barnhart named her
- head coach on Dec. 14, 2020 following the retirement of Matthew Mitchell. Kyra Elzy married Dexter Lander in August 2012 and the couple have one son Jackson, who was born in
