OPENING TIP-OFF

- The University of Minnesota women's basketball team (7-1, 0-0 B1G) is headed to Lexington, Ky., to take on the Kentucky Wildcats (4-5, 0-0 SEC) in its first road contest of the 2023-24 season. The game at Rupp Arena is scheduled to begin at 6 p.m. CT, and will be streamed on SEC Network+ while Justin Gaard and Lynnette Sjoquist will broadcast the game on KFAN+.
- Minnesota won its fourth straight on Dec. 2, defeating the defending Missouri Valley Conference champions, Drake, in double overtime 94-88 at Williams Arena. In the victory, the Gophers erased an 11-point fourth-quarter deficit with 7:50 to go, and a five-point deficit with 40 seconds to go. All of Minnesota's starters scored in double figures with Mara Braun leading the way with her second career 30-point game, scoring 14 of her 33 in the two overtime peribi-weekly WBB podcast, the Gold Blooded Podcast, ods, including all nine of the Gophers' points in the first overtime.

- For the first time this season freshman Grace Grocholski was honored by the Big Ten Conference as the Freshman of the Week, aiding in Minnesota's victories over two teams that participated in the 2023 NCAA Tournament. Grocholski averaged 19 points, 4.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists in the two wins while shooting 50 percent from the floor. Her 26 points against Norfolk State were the most points scored in a single game this season by a freshman in the league. Through Dec. 4, Grocholski is second among Big Ten freshmen in points per game (11.0), first in rebounds per game (5.4) and is tied for first in assists per game (2.9).
- Minnesota's defense has been outstanding this season, with the team's 53.8 points per game allowed leading the Big Ten and good enough for 35th in the NCAA. This season the 'U' allows teams to shoot just 35 percent from the floor, which is No. 2 in the conference and is 43rd in the NCAA while committing just 11.9 fouls per game, which is No. 1 in the league and No. 5 in the country through Dec. 3. The 'U' has forced 20.9 turnovers per game, good enough for 39th in the NCAA and No. 3 in the Big Ten Conference.
- Mara Braun made history against Drake, making her 34th consecutive free throw in the victory to set a new program record. The sophomore has started the season 27-for-27 from the charity stripe with her streak dating back to last season. Braun is one of five players in the country who hasn't missed a free throw this season with her ongoing streak being No. 8 in Big Ten history and is the longest streak in the conference since 2018.
- Sophie Hart has been one of the hottest players on the Gophers in the last four games with the junior center posting back-to-back career highs in wins over CSUN (13) and Stony Brook (17) followed by another double figures performance (11) against Norfolk State and Drake (12). After a perfect 6-of-6 from the field against CSUN, Hart made each of her first six shots against the Seawolves to extend her consecutive makes to 13 before she missed her first shot in the third quarter. During the four-game stretch Hart has shot 24-of-36 (66.7 percent) from the floor and has swatted six shots, highlighted by her career high three against Stony Brook.
- Minnesota and Kentucky have met just twice with the Wildcats and Gophers splitting those two meetings with the latest coming in 2022 at Williams Arena. Kentucky won the latest matchup 80-74 with Minnesota's lone victory coming back in 2007 in Minneapolis by a score of 92-80.



GOPHERS QUICK HITTERS

- Both Mara Braun and Maggie Czinano are student-athlete ambassadors with Special Olympics Minnesota.
- Redshirt freshman forward Niamva Holloway helped co-found the Black Student Union and worked to promote youth leadership at Central Middle School in Minnesota and promoted racial equity as a senior officer for the Dare 2 Be Real organization.
- Mallory Heyer was an outstanding volleyball player at Chaska high school, emassing over 1,000 kills in her career and led her volleyball team to a 2AAAA Section runnerup finish in 2019.
- Niaymya Holloway was a two-time high school high jump state champion at Eden Prairie high school where she cleared a personal record 5-10. Her senior year she won a state championship in the high jump, took third in both the 4x200m relay and the 4x400m relay and was ninth in the shot put competition. Two days after the state championship track meet, she was at summer workouts with the Gophers.
- Freshman Ayianna Johnson played five different sports throughout high school. She was a member of the basketball, football, golf, wrestling and track and field teams throughout her time at Jefferson high school in Wisconsin.
- Graduate transfer guard Janay Sanders is the first Gopher to play for the Minnesota Golden Gophers from the state of North Carolina (Charlotte).
- Freshman forward McKynnlie Dalan's family runs a gym in Washington.
- Sophie Hart is the lone Gopher to have played in the NCAA Tournament in her career. She came off the bench for the Wolfpack while playing her first two seasons at NC State.
- Brynn Senden is a third-generation Gopher. Both of freshman guard's parents were student-athletes at the University of Minnesota. Senden's mother, Kristen, was a gymnast while her father, Stuart, played on the men's hockey team. Senden's grandfather, Bruce Vandersall, was also a member of the Gopher football staff from 1973-82.
- Sophomore guard Amaya Battle and Niamya Holloway both attended the Black Student-Athlete Summit this past summer in Los Angeles, Calif.
- Freshman Grace Grocholski won two state basketball titles in the state of Wisconsin, winning the championships in back-to-back seasons where Grocholski was the team's leading scorer both seasons.
- Sophomore Mara Braun won a gold medal with Team USA this past summer at the FIBA 3x3 Nations League Final where her U21 team finished undefeated against both U21 and U23 age group teams.
- Freshman Ajok Madol brought back a bronze medal with Team Canada this past summer with the U19 team in Spain.
- Ayianna Johnson has claimed in interviews that she can hit a "7 of 8-iron about 250 yards off the golf tee."

- The Minnesota Golden Gophers are tied for the youngest team in the Big Ten with Wisconsin with 10 underclassmen (does not include redshirts in their third year of college).
- Minnesota is comprised of seven freshmen and three sophomores along with two juniors, one senior and one graduate student. Despite the youth on the team, the Gophers still return 55.9 percent of their scoring from last year's team.
- The Maroon and Gold have eight different players who call the Land of 10,000 Lakes their home, which is tied for the most of any team in the Big Ten from their home state (Michigan State).
- Minnesota's upperclassmen are led, in experience, by guard Janay Sanders who has played in 118 career games and 2942 minutes in her career. Meanwhile juniors Sophie Hart and Maggie Czinano have combined to play in 79

games while senior Aminata Zie has appeared in nine Division I games and not since 2020-21.

 Despite the youth on the roster the Gophers team still brings in a total of 206 Division I starts between Sanders (87), Heyer (38), Braun (36), Battle (32) and Czinano (13). Of Minnesota's 14 players, six made their college debuts against LIU on Nov. 8, at Williams Arena.

LITTLE 'GOLD' CORVETTES

- Six of Minnesota's seven freshmen made their debuts against LIU. Of those six that made their debuts, five of them scored in the 92-57 victory over the Sharks.
- Grace Grocholski, Coach Plitzuweit's first signee as the head coach of the 'U', comes in as the No. 98 ranked player in the country according to ESPN's Class of 2023 rankings.
- Freshman wing Ajok Madol out of Canada brought a FIBA U19 World Cup bronze medal from this past summer prior to joining the Gophers. Madol played with her home country in Spain, her second time she has appeared on the international circuit for her home country (U17 World Cup).

 Minnesota's freshman class will miss out on the debut of guard Kennedy Klick, who will miss the entire 2023-24 season due to a knee injury suffered during the fall semester.

FACING KENTUCKY

- Minnesota and the Kentucky Wildcats are meeting for just the third time in history with the Gophers holding a 14-22 all-time record against teams from the Southeastern Conference.
- This season Kentucky is 4-5 overall but has picked up back-to-back narrow victories over Boston College (83-81) and Tennessee Tech (73-67). Prior to the pair of recent wins the Wildcats had lost five games in a row including a home loss to Austin Peay, 68-63.
- Senior forward Ajae Petty has been the team's top scorer at 15.4 while also averaging 9.8 rebounds per contest. Kentucky also gets double figure scoring from Maddie Scherr and Eniya Russell at 14.0 and 10.1, respectively. The Wildcats roster is composed of five Kentucky natives with Amiya Jenkins being the top contributor of that group at 8.6 points per game and 4.3 rebounds.
- Through Dec. 3, Kentucky has been one of the best teams in the SEC at getting to the free throw line at 22.1 per game, which is third in their conference and 38th in the NCAA. Ajae Petty has four double doubles this season and is No. 1 in the SEC in field goal percentage at 60.9 percent, which is No. 19 in the country. Petty's 9.8 rebounds per game are third in the Southeastern Conference and is good enough for 34th in the nation while her 58 total free throw attempts are good enough for 10th in the country so far this season.
- Last season Kentucky finished 12-19 overall and were 2-14 in the SEC. The team started 7-1, including its victory over the Maroon and Gold on Dec. 7, but finished the season just 5-18 with its only conference wins being against Florida and Missouri. The Wildcats only home conference victory last season was against Missouri, at Memorial
- Kentucky's last win against a Power 5 opponent at Rupp Arena was on Feb. 11, 2021, against No. 16 Tennessee, 71-56.

THE FUTURE

- Highlighted by her most recent outing of 26 points against Norfolk State, Grace Grocholski has been a breakout rookie in her first seven games. Starting all seven, Grocholski has made an impact in a different way each time. She's had career highs of 26 points, nine rebounds, seven assists, three steals and has registered two total blocks. Grocholski is the only freshman in the Big Ten this season to post 26 points in a game, seven assists in a game, is one of two with nine or more rebounds in a game and is one of two to make five or more threes in a game.
- It was an emotional debut for redshirt freshman Niamya Holloway against LIU on Nov. 8, the Eden Prairie, Minn., native waited 607 days between official basketball games. Holloway overcame a torn ACL and made the most of her debut by scoring 11 points off the bench, six coming in the fourth quarter, while grabbing six rebounds with five coming on the offensive glass, a team high.
- Holloway's start to her career has been stellar, following up her debut with four different games with three or more steals. She posted five steals in the team's win over Chicago State, four against Stony Brook and had three against NDSU and CSUN. Through five games Holloway is second on the team with 15 steals.
- Minnesota's young squad continued to show its potential against Chicago State, highlighted by Ayianna Johnson's 19 points off the bench in just 13 minutes. Johnson followed that up with a perfect 3-of-3 shooting night against CSUN along with a career high five rebounds in 11 minutes off the bench.
- . Minnesota also saw a glimpse of what Ajok Madol can bring to the court against LIU, with the true freshman out of Canada scoring all seven of her points in the second quarter, Madol connected on each of her first three shots and impacted the game on the defensive end as well, snagging one steal.

AROUND THE WORLD IN A DAY

- Sophomore standout Mara Braun had one of the busiest summers one can have after their first year of college, playing basketball in four countries outside of the United States as a member of Team USA's U21 3x3 team.
- During her FIBA 3x3 campaign the Wayzata, Minn., native traveled to Handan, China and Ulaanbaatar, Mongolia, along with a training trip to Colorado Springs. Braun's time with Team USA resulted in a gold medal at the FIBA 3x3 Nations League Final, where she led the Red, White and Blue in scoring in the title game against China.
- Shortly after her return to the U.S., Braun joined her teammates on a trip to Croatia and Greece where the team played in three exhibition contests against local club teams.
- Braun led the team in scoring as a true freshman (15.6 ppg) in 2022-23, becoming the first true freshman to do so since Rachel Banham in 2011-12 (16.1). She ended the 2022-23 season scoring in double figures in each of her final nine games and hit at least one three in each of her final 12 contests.

DIAMONDS AND PEARLS

- Minnesota's "B1G 3" have returned with sophomores Amaya Battle (9.0 ppg, 5.9 rpg, 4.4 apg) and Mallory Heyer (10.4 ppg, 7.1 rpg) joining Braun (15.6 ppg, 3.3 rpg).
- The sophomore class has returned with a vengeance so far in 2023-24 with Braun leading the way with an impressive 18.8 points per game clip while Battle has already posted a new career high in points (20) and rebounds (12) while Heyer notched her sixth and seventh double doubles against NDSU (12 pts, 12 reb) and Drake (16 pts, 10 reb).
- Battle was a stat-sheet stuffer in her rookie campaign, highlighted by crushing a 45-year-old single-season record for assists in a single season by a freshman (Joan Kowalsky. 1977-78). Battle finished with 133 assists, besting Kowal-
- \bullet Heyer was the No. 1 rebounding freshman in the conference last season at 7.1 per game. Overall in the Big Ten Heyer finished eighth in rebounding average and was 10th in total offensive rebounds.

THE BIG TEN TOURNAMENT IN MINNEAPOLIS

- On April 20, 2022, the Big Ten announced that the Big Ten basketball tournaments in 2023 and 2024 were coming to Minneapolis and the Target Center. Target Center will host both the men's and women's tourney in 2024.
- The 2023 Big Ten Tournament had a record-setting attendance of 47,923 fans during its first year in Minneapolis at the Target Center. The event featured three of the 10 largest single-session crowds in the event's 30-year history, and its 6,846 average per session was the most since 2008.
- The 2022 Women's Final Four, which was held in Target Center, set an attendance record with over 216,000 spectators. The 216,000 fans were the most at the Women's Final Four since 2004, which was when the Golden Gophers led made their first Final Four in New Orleans.

TICK, TICK, BANG: MARA BRAUN

- Sophomore Mara Braun earned some well-deserved preseason recognition prior to the start of the 2023-24 season. The second-year Gopher was named to the watch list of the Cheryl Miller Award for the nation's top small forward as well as the Big Ten's 2023-24 Preseason All-Big Ten Team, as voted by the league's coaches. Braun was one of just two sophomores to be honored by the conference's coaches, joining Cotie McMahon of Ohio State.
- Braun's program record of 34-straight free throws made is no surprise as the Wayzata, Minn., native holds a career percentage of 90.2 in 37 games, shooting 111-0f-123
- In just her 31st game sophomore Mara Braun reached 500 career points, eclipsing the mark with her 25-point performance against Chicago St. Braun reached the half-century mark the third-fastest in program history, just two games shy of the program record of 29 games by Lindsay Whalen. She was one game shy of Laura Coenen and beat out the likes of WNBA draftees Rachel Banham (32 games), Kenisha Bell (32) and Amanda Zahui B. (34).

- Braun has shown why she was deserving of the Preseason All-Big Ten selection, scoring 25 points in each of the first two games this season. She now scored in double figures 29 times in her 37-game career and has registered 12 20-point performances, with the Gophers record 9-3 in those contests.
- Braun has continued to show her range with at least one three made in 20 straight games. She's also No. 4 in the Big Ten this season in steals per game at 2.3, and is second on the team overall with 18 this season.

LET'S WORK: THE NEW COACHING STAFF

- First year head coach Dawn Plitzuweit brought along many from her previous staff, including her entire assistant coaching staff from West Virginia. Associate head coach Jason Jeschke and assistant coaches Aaron Horn and Ariel Braker all joined Plitzuweit from Morgantown.
- New NCAA rules allowed the addition of more on-court coaches starting this season. Plitzuweit announced the
 elevation of Rachel Banham and Tyler VanWinkle as assistant coaches. Banham also serves as the team's Director of
 Quality Control while VanWinkle is also the team's Director of Video Services.
- Plitzuweit's assistant coaching staff brings in a plethora of experience and success at multiple levels. Jeschke has been with Plitzuweit for six seasons, Horn has been with Coach P since 2016 while Braker joined Plitzuweit's staff in 2021 at South Dakota. VanWinkle also worked with the staff in West Virginia as the team's video coordinator.
- Both Braker and Banham were successful on the court as NCAA players. Braker was a part of four Final Four teams while playing at Notre Dame, reaching the NCAA Championship game three times. Banham finished her college career as the No. 1 scorer in Big Ten history and left as the sixth-highest Division I scorer ever with 3,093 points.

MULTI-SPORT ATHLETES

- Of Minnesota's 14 student-athletes, 10 of them were multi-sport athletes at the high school level.
- Most notably Ayianna 'AJ' Johnson was a five-sport athlete at Jefferson High School in Jefferson, Wis. On top of being a standout basketball player, Johnson was a top-five nationally ranked discus thrower and won a pair of Division 2 state championships. Johnson also helped her high school's golf team win a regional title while also participating in wrestling and football. On the gridiron Johnson played both quarterback and offensive line. Johnson has stated in interviews that she can hit a "7 or 8-iron about 250 yards off the tee."
- Redshirt freshman Niamya Holloway was a two-time state high jump champion in the state of Minnesota and was also state qualifier in the shot put and multiple relay teams for Eden Prairie. Her personal best mark was 5-11.
- Additoinally, Mara Braun, Maggie Czinano, Janay Sanders and Sophie Hart were all were on their high school track
 and field teams. Braun was a state qualifier in the triple jump, Czinano holds multiple school records in sprints,
 Sanders was a state qualifier in the high and long jumps while Hart was a high jumper for her father, Tom Hart, at
 Farmington high school.
- Multiple Gophers on the 2023-24 roster were also standout volleyball players. Led by Mallory Heyer who had over 1,000 kills for Chaska high school. McKynnlie Dalan was also a standout on the volleyball court as well as Grace Grocholski. Lastly, Ajok Madol was a member of her high school's soccer team during her prep career.

CHECK THE RECORD

- The University of Minnesota picked up its 400th victory all-time at Williams Arena against Drake. The team has played in Williams Arena since the 2002 season, and also played at the Barn from 1971-93.
- Grace Grocholski scored the ninth-most points by a freshman in program history with 26 against Norfolk St.
- Mara Braun has made 34 straight free throws dating back to last season, the eighth longest streak in Big Ten history. Braun is just four free throws away from moving from eighth to fourth with the all-time record being 60.

NEXT-GEN GOPHS

- McKenna Johnson and Tori McKinney signed their National Letters of Intent to join Minnesota in 2024-25. Johnson brings a dynamic game to the Gophers as the No. 60 ranked recruit in the latest 2024 ESPN top 100 rankings. In her most recent season, the 5-9 guard averaged 26.1 points, 10 rebounds, 2.7 steals and 2.0 assists per contest.
- McKinney earned back-to-back Defensive Player of the Year laurels from Prep Girls Hoops during the 2022 and 2023 AAU season, which she played with North Tartan. In McKinney's most recent AAU campaign she averaged 11.0 points, 6.0 rebounds, 3.5 assists and 2.1 steals.

FIND A WAY

- Dawn Plitzuweit got off to a fast start at Minnesota with three straight wins to start the season. Plitzuweit's record breaking first win over LIU was a 35-point victory, the largest margin of victory for Minnesota in a coaching debut in program history. Plitzuweit's debut included a program record for points in the first quarter with 34 (quarters were introduced to NCAA WBB prior to the 2015-16 season).
- Under the direction of Plitzuweit the Gophers started the season 3-0 for the first time since 2018-19. Plitzuweit picked up victories against LIU, Chicago State and North Dakota State University by an average score of 38.8 points per game.
- The Maroon and Gold have started 7-1 for the first time since 2019-20 when the team started 11-1. For Plitzuweit, she has started 7-1 or better in her first season as the head coach at four of her five programs she has led. Plitzuweit's best first-year start came at Grand Valley State University (Div. II) in 2002-03 when the team started 14-0, and then 16-1, before dropping their second game on Jan. 23.

MOVE DA CROWD

- On Dec. 4, the Gophers announced an advanced sellout for the Feb. 28, matchup with lowa. Over 13,000 fans are expected to witness the border battle between the Gophers and Hawkeyes, which will be streamed on Peacock.
- The University of Minnesota hosted 10.869 fans against No. 8/8 UConn on Nov. 19, the 14th-most fans at a single regular season game this season.
- For Minnesota, the 10,869 fans were the most at a single game for the program since 2018, when the team sold out their season opening game against New Hampshire. Since 2007, the UConn game was just the second time the program had hosted over 10,000 fans at a game.
- The 10,869 fans against UConn marked the 24th time in program history the Gophers had hosted over 10,000 fans with the total being the 20th-largest crowd in program history.

IF YOU WANT TO DANCE

- The first NET Rankings dropped on Dec. 4, with the Minnesota Golden Gophers debuting at No. 42 through their first eight games of the season. The No. 42 ranking is the highest for the program since the NET algorithm was adopted in the 2020-21 season when the Division I Women's Basketball Committee officially moved on from the RPI system.
- As of Dec. 4, the Gophers are 2-1 against top 100 teams in the NET rankings, defeating Stony Brook (No. 59) and Drake (No. 90) and losing to UConn (No. 16). Minnesota's December schedule will be highlighted by matchups with Purdue (No. 88) and lowa (No. 6).
- As of Nov. 28, there are 10 teams on Minnesota's 2023-24 schedule that are included in the latest ESPN Bracketology by Charlie Creme. Of the 10 teams, Minnesota has faced three so far this season (UConn, Stony Brook, Norfolk State) with seven of the 10 being from the Big Ten (Iowa, Maryland, Michigan, Michigan State, Indiana, Penn State and Ohio State).
- Minnesota's latest victory was over Drake, who was a team that made the 2023 NCAA Tournament. The Bulldogs are currently sitting at Creme's 'First Four Out'. Illinois and Nebraska are also in the 'First Four Out'.

LET'S ROCK: STARTING FAST

- On average the Maroon and Gold have outscored their opponents 21.0 to 12.5 in first quarters this season. In the first half the Golden Gophers have outscored their opposition 320-193, or an average of 40.0-24.1.
- Mara Braun has posted two 14-point first quarters this season. The sophomore also registered a 23-point first half performance earlier this season against Chicago St. Freshman Grace Grocholski also scored 17 of her 26 points against Norfolk St., in the first half.

HEAD COACH DAWN PLITZUWEIT FIRST SEASON • MICHIGAN TECH, '95



Dawn Plitzuweit was named the 13th women's basketball coach in Minnesota history on March 18, 2023.

Plitzuweit (PLITTS-zoo-white) joins the Maroon and Gold after serving as the head coach at West Virginia University last season where she led the Mountaineers to an NCAA Tournament berth in 2023.

Prior to her season in Morgantown, Plitzuweit also served as the head coach at South Dakota from 2016-22. During her six seasons in Vermillion, S.D., she amassed a 158-36 record, including an 83-10 mark in the Summit League. The three-time Summit League Coach of the Year, Plitzuweit led the Coyotes to three regular-season championships, three conference tournament championships, four NCAA Tournament appearances and a berth in the 2022 NCAA Sweet 16 during her tenure at USD.

Plitzuweit brings in a career coaching record of 365-141 (.721) in 16 seasons as a head coach, including a 248-103 (.707) at the Division I level. Prior to South Dakota and West Virginia Plitzuweit also was the head coach at Northern Kentucky (2012-16) and Grand Valley State (2002-07). She also was an assistant coach at Michigan (2007-12), Green Bay (1998-02), Wisconsin (1997-98) and her alma mater Michigan Tech (1995-97).

As a head coach Plitzuweit has been a mainstay in post-season play, reaching either the NCAA Tournament or WNIT in 15 of her 16 seasons as a head coach. She holds the Summit League record for overall winning percentage (.814) and conference winning percentage (.892). She's totaled 15 winning seasons, two 30-win campaigns and nine 20-win seasons.

Plitzuweit's honors over her coaching career include the 2021-22 Kay Yow Award, presented annually to the Division I women's head college basketball coach who embodies a winning spirit while displaying great character, on and off the court. She was the Summit League Coach of the Year three straight years (2017-18, 2018-19, 2019-20). She also was the 2005-06 NCAA Division II National Coach of the Year at Grand Valley State University.

Statistically, Plitzuweit's teams in each of the past five seasons have ranked in the top 20 nationally in turnover margin, including the 2022-23 season at West Virginia at a

margin of 6.1, which was the No. 1 mark in the Big 12 and the ninth-best margin in the country.

A 1995 graduate of Michigan Tech, Plitzuweit earned back-to-back GLIAC Player of the Year awards, four all-conference honors and three all-defensive team nods. She led the Huskies to a 99-22 record and four trips to the NCAA Division II Tournament. She was a Division II Bulletin All-America Second Team selection and a two-time Kodak All-America honorable mention pick (1994, 1995). She earned WBCA All-Academic accolades in 1994 and 1995 and was named Michigan's NCAA Woman of the Year in 1995.
