2nd Year at LSU · 9th Year as a Head Coach

LSU Men's Basketball Head Coach Matt McMahon has five simple core values that define him and his basketball program at LSU:

Hard work, unselfishness, toughness, accountability and joy.

Those were some of the first words he said when he stepped to the podium for the first time as the 25th LSU men's basketball head coach on March 22, 2022.

And even though the first season proved difficult as Coach McMahon and staff had to rebuild a roster completely from scratch in less than 45 days, the characteristics of a Matt McMahon program were there for people to clearly see.

Now as the LSU Basketball program begins its second season, Coach McMahon under the cornerstone of those core values has welcomed in an older, more experienced group of players who not only understand the fundamentals of the game, but also the culture of the environment with many having lived and played in around the Baton Rouge/LSU area.

LSU, Coach McMahon and staff laid a new foundation a year ago and now has many of the tools needed to build on that foundation.

The culture and success were on display during the seven years at Murray State University where Coach McMahon led the Racers to a record of 154-67, a .697 winning percentage. He led Murray State to 93 OVC regular-season wins, winning 75 percent of league games.

He has also coached multiple all-Americans and all-league players such as Ja Morant who was named NBA Rookie of the Year in 2020.

The Racers won regular season league titles in 2018, 2019, 2020 and 2022 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament in 2018, 2019 and 2022 (the 2020 appearance was canceled by the pandemic).

Since the native of Oak Ridge, Tennessee, became the third-youngest rookie among D1 coaches in 2015, McMahon has continued a steady move forward with a reputation for developing talent both as an assistant and head coach. He has become known nationally as an excellent recruiter and he is among the best in the nation in the area of player development and game planning.

In his final season at Murray State in 2021-22, McMahon coached OVC Player of the Year KJ Williams and two other recipients of first-team honors (Tevin Brown, Justice Hill). In addition, McMahon was named the league's Coach of the Year.

Williams and his successfully play translated to the Southeastern Conference where he earned All-SEC honors in a super senior year when he became at the time in January 2023 the 123rd player in Division I college basketball to amass 2,000 career points and 1,000 rebounds.

McMahon's Racers, in 2021-22, were just the

sixth team in league history to go undefeated and the first to do it in an 18-game conference schedule. Murray State then won the two league tournament games to advance to the NCAA Tournament where, as a No. 7 seed, the Racers defeated San Francisco to advance to the round of 32.

The 2021-22 team was one of seven teams to win 30 or more games and led the nation in win percentage at 91.2 percent (31-3). The Racers were ranked No. 20 in the final AP poll and No. 22 in the Ferris Mowers Coaches Poll.

McMahon was the first MSU coach to have three seasons of 25 or more wins and one of just three Murray State coaches to have four 20-win seasons.

Coach McMahon led the Racers to three-straight OVC regular season championships (2017-18, 2018-19 and 2019-20) and two consecutive OVC Tournament titles (2017-18, 2018-19).

The 2018-19 team won 28 games and made its mark in the NCAA Tournament when the 12th-seeded Racers won their fourth all-time tourney game by defeating No. 5 seed Marquette.

That season, Morant named the OVC POY, leading Division I in assists and earning first-team all-America honors from the USBWA.

He was drafted second overall in the 2019 NBA draft by the Memphis Grizzlies.

In 2017-18, McMahon's team won 26 games and the OVC regular season and tournament championship, sending the Racers to what was at that time the school's 16th NCAA Tournament.

Prior to being named head coach, he was a key part of Coach Steve Prohm's staff as assistant at Murray State as the Racers won a pair of Ohio Valley Conference championships, a Collegelnsider.com Tournament championship and an appearance in the NIT. He was part of a staff that won 104 games from 2011-15.

In 2014-15, MSU became the first team in school history to go undefeated in the OVC at 16-0 and set a league record with a 25-game win streak that was second best in the nation. Three seasons earlier, McMahon was named

to the list of best assistant coaches by FoxSports.com and Collegelnsider.com.

In his first season as an assistant at Murray State, the team was 31-2 and earned a No. 6 seed in the NCAA Tournament.

PRIOR TO MURRAY STATE

Coach McMahon has had success in college basketball since his days as a player at Appalachian State.

Known as an excellent shooter and tough competitor, he played on three Southern Conference regular season title teams in 1998, 1999 and 2000. The Mountaineers won the SoCon Tournament in 2000 and advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

He played in 90 career games under coach Buzz Peterson and made 124 three-pointers, graduating in 2000 with a bachelor's in marketing.

His coaching career began immediately at Appalachian State as a student assistant under Houston Fancher in 2000-01. He would rejoin Peterson's staff as a student coach at Tennessee before returning to ASU in 2002, where he stayed until the end of the 2009-10 season. A year at UNC Wilmington (2010-11) as assistant coach set the stage for his journey to Murray State, starting first as an assistant in the 2011-12 season and then as head coach prior to the 2015-16 season.

Coach McMahon and his wife Mary, a former standout for the Furman women's basketball team, have three children – Maris, Mason and Mabry.

SERIES VS. KENTUCKY

The teams met for the first time in 1933 (SEC Tournament) and the first seven meetings came in the SEC event at neutral sites. The teams did not play a regular season game until 1951 in Baton Rouge ... LSU's first win over Kentucky came in 1961, 73-59, in Baton Rouge at the then home of LSU Basketball -- the John Parker Agriculture Center ("the Cow Palace") ... Kentucky leads the overall series, 93-28, and 32-19 in games played in Baton Rouge.

Former LSU head coach Dale Brown is one of the winningest, if not the winningest coach against the Wildcats, with 18 wins in his 25 years from 1973-1997 ... That included three straight wins on three different occasions; a win in a 1986 Elite 8 game that sent LSU to the NCAA Final Four; and a 1987 35 point win at Rupp Arena in what was the debut of ABC's new college basketball package.

Kentucky has won the last two meetings in the series, both in Lexington, and the last three games have been decided by 5, 5, and 3 points. LSU's last win was in 2022, 65-60 on Jan. 4 at the Maravich Center.

MORE ON KENTUCKY

Kentucky is coming off a 70-59 victory at No. 13 Auburn on Saturday. Antonio Reeves led the Wildcats with 22 points while Aduo Thiero had 14 points and Rob Dillingham added 11. Ugonna Onyenso grabbed 11 rebounds. Kentucky had a 39-36 advantage in rebounds and shot 44.4 percent (24-of-54) with four treys and 18-of-24 at the free throw line. The Wildcats held Auburn to 9-of-32 in the first half from the field (28.1 percent).

Kentucky had a 23-10 advantage in points off turnovers off 11 Auburn miscues and was 20-10 off second chance points.

For the season Reeves leads the Wildcats at 19.5 points a game, with Dillingham at 14.7 points, Reed Sheppard at 12.1, Tre Mitchell 12.0 and D. J. Wagner 11.0 points per game. Mitchell missed the Auburn game with an injury.

THE FINAL THREE WEEKS

The Kentucky game marks the start of the final three weeks of the LSU men's basketball season. LSU has four home games and two road games remaining in the regular season.

LSU at present, entering play this week is 10th in the standings, one game out of the three-way tie for seventh place. The schedule on paper begins to turn for LSU, which already has three more wins than last year already in league play. The remaining games and the BPI prediction for the Tigers:

Entering the final three weeks of the season, LSU is the only team in the league to have played just five home SEC games.

BACK AT HOME FOR THREE-GAME HOMESTAND

LSU is 9-4 overall at home this year, 3-2 in SEC play.

This is the 53rd year of men's basketball play in what opened as the LSU Assembly Center and is now the Pete Maravich Assembly Center. It is the fourth oldest continuous use men's basketball venue in the league having hosted its first men's game in Jan. 1972. The older venues are: Memorial Gymnasium in Nashville opened in 1952, Stegeman Coliseum at UGA in 1964, and, Coleman Coliseum in Alabama had its first game in 1968. The Tigers are 624-213 all-time in the building and 293-160 in SEC contests.

AGAINST RANKED TEAMS

LSU will be playing its seventh team ranked in the AP poll this season with two wins in six games with an 89-80 win over No. 22 Ole Miss and the 64-63 win at No. 11 South Carolina. LSU has lost to No. 19 Texas in Houston, at No. 16 Auburn, at No. 6 Tennessee and No. 16 Alabama.

LSU is 95-282 against teams ranked in the AP Poll (25.1%) since its inception in 1949.

NOTES FROM CAROLINA WIN

Some notes regarding ranked wins for the Tigers after the 64-63 win at South Carolina (2/17):

***LSU posted its first true road victory over an AP Top-25 team since Feb. 12, 2019 at No. 5 Kentucky.**
***LSU snapped a 10-game losing streak in true road games vs. AP Top 25 teams.**
***LSU's 16-point comeback marked the first time LSU came from 15+ down to win on the road since March 6, 2014 vs. Vanderbilt (trailed by 16).**
***According to the ESPN Win Probability chart, the Tigers had a 3.0 percent chance to win when Carolina led the game, 41-25, in the second half.**

LEARNING TO WIN

It has been a grind for these Tigers learning how to win again in close games like the South Carolina game this past Saturday. Earlier in the week, LSU tied the game against Florida late and was unable to make a mid-lane floater before the horn to potentially tie the game. LSU against Carolina tied the game late and then had to rally twice more to get the lead that this time held up.

RALLY TIME

The South Carolina game (2/17) followed a theme that has been the Tigers script for some road games this season also at Auburn, at Tennessee and at Florida.

In all four games, LSU fell behind by 16 or more points in the game in the second half, but continued to fight and in the Auburn and Tennessee games cut the margin to single digits, in the Florida game got the game to a tie and then the rallying win over South Carolina. Some brief notes on the games:

***At Auburn (1/13) – LSU trailed by 28 with 11:37 to play before outscoring AU, 28-8, to cut the deficit to eight with 2:12 to play.**
***At Tennessee (2/7) – LSU trailed by 26 with 18:50 to play before outscoring UT, 37-19 to cut the deficit to eight with 4:39 to play**
***At Florida (2/13) – LSU trailed by 20 with 15:31 to play before outscoring UF, 38-18 to tie the game with 1:33 to play.**
***At Carolina (2/17) – LSU down 16 with 16:58 to play before outscoring USC, 32-16 to tie game with 1:24 to play. LSU went on to win the game.**

In LSU's other two-point loss, the Tigers were down nine at UGA with 5:48 left, outscoring Georgia, 14-4, to take 1-point lead with 16 seconds before losing in final seconds.

POINTS

LSU has scored 80 or more points in four-of-the-last-six games, including over 90 in the last two home games against Arkansas (95) and Alabama (92).

LSU is averaging 77.3 points per game this season, which is almost 10 points higher than last year's average of 67.6 per game. In SEC games, LSU is averaging 77.8 points. is sixth in the SEC in overall scoring.

LSU'S EQUALS SINGLE SEASON BEST IN THREE-POINT SHOOTING

Against Florida (2/13), LSU tied the school record for the most double figure three-pointers in a season since the shot started in the 1986-87 campaign:

9 – 2023-24
9 – 2017-18
9 – 2019-20

LSU recently posted five straight games in SEC play with double figure three-pointers. No previous LSU team has had five consecutive games with double figure three-pointers.

LSU did have four consecutive games during the turn of two seasons, finishing the 2019-20 season (when it was halted for the pandemic) with three consecutive three-point games and a fourth in the first game of the 2020-21 season.

For the season, LSU is 196-of-548 or 35.8 percent and in the league, 101-of-270 or 37.4 percent. In the last five games, LSU is 41-of-101 or 40.6 percent.

LSU's 35.8 percentage is three full points over last year when the Tigers shot 32.7 percent from the arc.

LSU is fourth in the league in overall three-point percentage and third in league three-point percentage.

LSU is averaging 7.8 three-pointers a game, up from 7.2 a year ago.

This season, Jordan Wright leads the team with 39 makes from distance. Tyrell Ward 35, Mike Williams III has 32 and Jalen Cook 26 for 132 of LSU's 199 makes (66.3%).

RECAP: The Tigers finally made one of their road rallies pay off as LSU rallied from 16 down with 16:58 to play. Tyrell Ward scored eight straight LSU points to help LSU get from 55-49 down with four minutes to play to tied at 57-57 with 1:24 to play. Then Jordan Wright scored LSU's last seven points to get LSU a 64-63 lead with five seconds to play. It was LSU's first true road win over an AP Top 25 team since Feb. 12, 2019 at No. 5 Kentucky. LSU won its second game against five losses in games of four points or fewer this season.

Ward led LSU with a career high 16 points, hitting 6-of-8 with three treys for the second straight game, while Wright had 14 points and Jalen Reed scored 13 of 6-of-9 shooting. Trae Hannibal has six points but an LSU season high 12 rebounds, his second double digit rebound game in the month of February. LSU had a 12-3 advantage in points off turnovers.

LSU trailed 60-40 with 15:31 to play and then went on a 38-18 run to tie the game at 78 on a Tyrell Ward three with 1:33 to play. Florida took the lead back and LSU had the game's final possession but a mid-lane shot fell short before the buzzer. LSU shot 62.5 percent (15-24) in the second half, making 6-of-9 three-pointers, but for the third straight road game shot under 65 percent at the line (13-of-21, 61.9 percent).

Tennessee made 9-of-14 three-pointers in the first half in building a 50-27 advantage at the intermission ... The Tigers were down 23, 70-47, with 9:05 to play and went on a 17-2 run to cut the Tennessee lead to eight, 72-64, with 4:39 to play. But the Tigers couldn't sustain the run and Tennessee was able to push the game out to the final margin.

Will Baker had another strong double figure game with 16 points and eight rebounds on 7-of-12 shooting ... Derek Fountain added 11 points and Trae Hannibal at the point positions had 8 points, 11 rebounds, four assists and two steals. LSU out rebounded Tennessee 40-26 and 18-5 on the offensive boards resulting in 20 second chance points.

JORDAN WRIGHT

It was a week of lows and highs for Jordan Wright – missing the potential tying shot at Florida in mid-week and then scoring the last seven points in the last 47 seconds that gave LSU the 64-63 over No. 11 South Carolina in Columbia.

Wright has had a good final season in his year at LSU, which included an 18-game double figure scoring streak that was stopped against Tennessee (2/7) when he was held to nine points. His was the longest double figure scoring streak by an LSU player since Cam Thomas posted a streak of 19 games to conclude his one-year college career at LSU.

Wright became the third player at LSU since 2010-11 to have a game of 25 points-5 rebounds-5 assists-5 steals per Sports-Reference.com when he had 27-7-5-7 against Ole Miss (Jan. 17):

Ben Simmons – vs. North Florida – 12-2-15 – 42 points-14 rebounds-7 assists-5 steals
Tremont Waters – vs. Alcorn State – 11-10-17 – 27 points-5 rebounds-6 assists- 5 steals
Jordan Wright – vs. Ole Miss – 1-17-24 – 27 points-7 rebounds – 5 assists – 7 steals

According to SEC Now, it was the first conference game in which an LSU player had at least 25 points and five rebounds, five assists, five steals since 2000.

Wright's seven steals were one more than freshman Mike Williams had earlier this year and the most since Waters got eight steals versus ULM on Dec. 28, 2018.

In both games against Texas A&M, he posted double double which now gives him 11 all-time in college basketball.

Wright had his career scoring game against Texas (12/16) and it was one of the best games for LSU in the second half of play. A total of 31 of his 33 points were scored in the final 20 minutes. It is the most second half points scored by an LSU player since Dec. 18, 1990 when Shaquille O'Neal scored 37 second half points in a 53-point effort in a 98-74 victory over Arkansas State at Baton Rouge.

For the season, Wright has made 39 three-pointers this season (39-of-115, 33.9%) and is averaging 31.1 minutes a game. He is fifth in steals in the SEC at 1.84 steals a game. He is averaging 15.0 points a game and is the team's leading rebounder at 5.1 a game.

Wright has played 149 collegiate games with 98 starts. In the game against Arkansas (2/3), he went over the 1,500 mark in career scoring. His next three-pointer will be his 150th career make from distance.

FREE THROWS

For the fourth straight road game, the Tigers luck on free throw shooting wasn't at its best against South Carolina. The numbers from the last four road tilts:

At South Carolina (2/17) – 9-of-14 – 64.3 percent

At Florida (2/13) – 13-of-21 – 61.9 percent

At Tennessee (2/7) – 14-of-22 – 63.6 percent

At Alabama 1/27) – 17-of-27 – 63.0 percent

In the last two home games against Arkansas (2/3) and Alabama (2/10), the Tigers were 44-of-54 combined at the line (81.4 percent).

Overall, LSU is 396-of-550 or 72.0 percent, making 28 more free throws than opponents on 60 more attempts (368-of-490, 75.1 percent). LSU is ninth in overall free throw percentage.

In SEC games, LSU is 187-of-252 (74.2). The Tigers are seventh in SEC games percentage.

One of the interesting similarities of the Texas A&M contests away and home is that they resulted in two of the lowest free throw attempt games of the season for the Tigers. LSU was 8-of-11 at Texas A&M and 8-of-10 this past Saturday at home. On the other hand, A&M was 18-of-26 in Bryan-College Station and 11-of-20 in Baton Rouge.

TRAE HANNIBAL

Trae Hannibal had a lot on his shoulders against Tennessee (2/7) with Jalen Cook not available, but he answered the call extremely well playing 31 minutes, scoring eight points with 11 rebounds, four assists and two steals. Hannibal had just two turnovers on the night.

He was again forced to shoulder a lot of the load when Cook was out again and he posted six points, two assists and a season high 12 rebounds for LSU to lead all players.

In the five games since he returned to the starting lineup, he has had 20 assists and 34 rebounds.

Hannibal showed his versatility and the different direction he can bring to the team in the Auburn game (1/13) when he played 23 minutes off the bench and scored a team co-high 18 points.

Hannibal hit 5-of-6 field goal attempts, including a three-pointer and made 7-of-7 from the free throw line. He had two assists and two steals as Hannibal and Jordan Wright combined for 32 second half points together in that Auburn game.

The fifth-year senior is averaging 19.9 minutes a game, 5.0 points, 3.5 rebounds, 2.5 assists and 1.2 steals.

Hannibal is known as an aggressive, full-speed ahead type point guard opening things up for his teammates and he continues to have that aggressive play style now that he is in the starting lineup.

In the Northwestern State game (12/29), Hannibal had eight assists in 19 minutes. It was the most assists by an LSU player since Brandon Murray had nine assists versus Missouri, March 10, 2022.

Hannibal had a very successful outing against ASU (12/13), getting his first double figure scoring game of the season (11 points). In fact, Mike Williams and Hannibal in that game combined for the No. 3 play on ESPN's SportsCenter when a Williams' steal ended in an alley-oop dunk to Hannibal.

For the season, Hannibal, in his second year at LSU, is 42-of-77 from the field (54.5%).

JALEN COOK

Jalen Cook came off the bench against Arkansas (2/3) and it didn't seem to bother him a bit as he came in to play 21 minutes, hitting 5-of-8 field goals (3-of-5 from distance) and 7-of-7 from the line scoring 20 points with three assists, two steals and just one turnover.

He did not play against Tennessee (2/7) with a hamstring issue, but played 29 minutes against Alabama (2/10) and had 20 points on 6-of-17 shooting with a trey and 7-of-9 at the free throw line.

Cook has had three 20-point games in the last five he has dressed. He had 12 points and three assists in the game at Florida (2/13) but did not dress against South Carolina (2/17) with some lingering leg issues.

For the year, Cook has appeared in 13 games and is averaging 15.6 points per game, 3.8 rebounds, 2.8 assists and 1.2 steals.

Cook has had double figures in the last seven games played and 12-of-the-13 games since he became eligible.

Against Vanderbilt (1/9), we saw the scoring Cook at his best, hitting 10 field goals and scoring 28 points, just two off his career high.

The Texas game on Dec. 16 was when Cook made his first appearance for the Tigers since the end of the 2020-21 season when he came in during the first half from off the bench. LSU struggled in the first half as Cook shook off the rust of not playing in the first 10 games, but in the second half Cook and Jordan Wright got in a rhythm that saw them cut a 19-point deficit down to seven and Wright score 31 second half points while Cook had 13 points and six assists with just one turnover in 32 minutes.

Cook played for LSU in the 20-21 season for the Tigers before heading to Tulane for two first-team All-AAC seasons in 21-22 and 22-23. He then elected to transfer back to his original school for 23-24 making him a multi-time transfer. Cook and his family were in the process of appealing an NCAA original denial of the waiver when a court decision and a subsequent negotiated settlement by the NCAA allowed all multi-transfers immediate eligibility for the remainder of the season shortly before LSU's game with Texas in Houston (Dec. 16).

In his first stint at LSU during the 2020-21 season, he played 20 games and averaged 3.1 points. He had no starts that season and his most playing minutes was against Nicholls when he played 25 minutes. He scored in double figures twice – 10 versus Louisiana Tech (12/6/20) and 11 at Georgia (2/23/21) in nine minutes.

WILL BAKER

The 7-footer is continuing to have a good stretch of games with five straight contests in double figures, including two 20-plus point games at the Maravich Center, before struggling from the field against South Carolina (2/17).

Against Alabama (2/10), Baker scored 22-of-his-24 points in the first half and for the game finished 9-of-14 field goals with two treys and four free throws. It was his fourth LSU 20-point game of the season and his 12th of his college career.

Against Arkansas (2/3), Baker scored 25 points on 9-of-11 field goals with four three-pointers.

Regarding the 25-point performance against Arkansas (2/3), Baker had a highlight game according to the Elias Sports Bureau. They reported that Baker in the Arkansas game recorded his second game of the season with 25+ points on 80% or better shooting (9-for-11). Baker is just the second SEC player over the last 10 seasons to record two games of the kind in a single season. The other was Tolu Smith of Mississippi State, who had two games of this kind in 2022-23.

Baker, one of three grad students playing on this year's Tiger team, has had 14 double figure scoring games overall after scoring 16 with three treys at Florida (2/13).

In the last five games, Baker is averaging 16.6 points, making 32-of-53 field goals (60.4%) with 9-of-17 from distance (52.9%) and 10-of-12 from the free throw line.

For the season, Baker is averaging 12.2 points per game and 5.0 rebounds. He is the only LSU players start all 25 games.

Against Northwestern State (12/29), Baker went over 1,000 career points for his Texas-Nevada-LSU career when he scored 17 points in 23 minutes against the Demons.

In his double figure scoring games, he has shot 50 percent or better in 11 of them. Baker's other 20-plus game

came when he scored 23 against Wake Forest in the final game in Charleston, with 8 rebounds.

For the season he is 111-of-210 for 52.9 percent from the field. He has made 18 treys.

Baker started his career at Texas, then two seasons at Nevada where he graduated and transferred to LSU.

MIKE WILLIAMS III

Mike Williams has had five double figure games in the last 11 contests.

Against Arkansas (2/3), Williams hit four treys in scoring 13 points in 20 minutes, following a 16-point performance against Alabama on (1/27).

Williams, the freshman from Baltimore, started the first 12 games of the season, before coming off the bench against Northwestern State and the conference opener against A&M (1/6). He was back in the starting lineup until this past Saturday at South Carolina (2/17) when Coach McMahon went with just a two-guard lineup. Williams has started 22 games this season.

In that Northwestern State contest (12/29), Williams played 21 minutes off the bench, hit 7-of-11 field goals, including 6-of-9 three-pointers to score 20 points and earn the SEC Freshman of the Week honors to end 2023.

Only 13 times in the history of the shot has an LSU player made more than six three-pointers in a game.

He is averaging 7.6 points, 2.1 rebounds, 1.3 assists and 1.1 steals this season.

Williams has 32 three-pointers this season (32-of-84, 38.1 percent).

JALEN REED

Jalen Reed came off the bench to post his second SEC double figure scoring game of the season with 13 points in 22 minutes on 6-of-9 shooting with one from distance against South Carolina (2/17).

Jalen Reed had a good couple of games after moving back into the starting lineup against Ole Miss (1/17) and Texas A&M (1/20). In two games he played 59 minutes, hit 7-of-13 field goals and 3-of-5 from distances, scored 18 points and grabbed 11 rebounds.

He had his first conference double figure game of the season against Texas A&M (1/20) with 10 points, hitting two treys for the first time in his college career.

He has eight games with double figure scoring this season.

Reed started early in his freshman season (2022-23), but had limited success at times and saw games where he did not have lots of minutes and averaged 3.7 points per game.

Reed has started 20 games this season and is already well past most of his numbers for his entire freshman season at LSU. He had 41 field goals in 2022-23 to 71 for this season and his free throws made (41) is already more than last year (36) when he played 33 games. He has already scored more points this year (194) than he did a year ago (122).

Reed's season included his first collegiate double double of 14 points and 11 rebounds against Syracuse (11/28).

For the year he is averaging 8.1 points and 4.4 rebounds.

Reed's late father Justin played at Ole Miss (2001-05) and was a four-time All-SEC selection and freshman of the year in the league in 2001.

HUNTER DEAN CONTINUES TO GET GOOD MINUTES

Grad student Hunter Dean has settled into his role as the backup post player very nicely and averaging 12.5 minutes overall, with 3.5 points and 3.0 rebounds for the season. He had eight points against South Carolina, making 4-of-5 field goals.

Against Northwestern State (Dec. 29) he had his first LSU double double of 11 points and 10 rebounds. It was his sixth double double of his career, having recorded five at George Washington.

For the season, Dean has made 33-of-45 field goal attempts (73.3%). The three-pointer he made against Texas (12/16) was the first of the grad transfer's career in eight attempts over his five seasons. For his career at Southern Miss, George Washington and LSU he has made 201-of-326 (61.7%).

TYRELL WARD

Tyrell Ward is another second-year player with Coach Matt McMahon who has shown the development from freshman to sophomore season and his transition has helped the Tigers at various points during the season.

This past week, Ward his the three-pointer that capped LSU's rally from 20 down to tie the game at 78-78 with 1:33 to play at Florida (2/10). Ward finished with 12 points.

Then on Saturday, with LSU down six and some four minutes to play, Ward would score LSU's next eight points with his second three of the series tying the game at 57-57 with 1:24 to play at South Carolina (2/17). Ward would have his LSU career high of 16 points with 6-of-8 from the field and three treys.

The sophomore was a big factor in LSU's 21-2 run that cut a 28-point lead to single digits by hitting three-consecutive three-pointers in the game at Auburn (1/13).

Ward finished with 12 points on 4-of-7 shooting from distance in 27 minutes with two blocks.

Then against Ole Miss (1/17), Ward came in at the 15:45 mark of the second half. It was over three minutes before he got involved but he hit his first attempt for three at the 12:22 mark that gave LSU a 54-44 lead. On LSU's next possession he hit another three-pointer to push the Tiger lead to 57-46 with 11:51 to play. And, after a possession in which Trae Hannibal made a layup, Ward took his third consecutive three-point shot at the 10:24 mark to push LSU's lead to 62-48 with 10:24 to play.

He finished with 11 points against the Rebels.

Against Alabama (2/10), Ward played 28 minutes, hit 7-of-9 field goals with a three-pointer for 15 points.

In the last five games, Ward is averaging 11.0 points, hitting 21-of-34 FGs and 8-of-15 (53.3%) from distance. For the season, Ward is averaging 8.3 points and 1.9 rebounds. Ward is 35-of-83 from the arc (42.2 percent).

Ward struggled early in his freshman campaign of 2022-23, but rallied at the end of the season to play 23 total games with eight starts. He averaged 3.7 points a game.

DEREK FOUNTAIN CONTINUING TO HELP TIGERS

When Derek Fountain came to LSU prior to the 2022-23 season after two years at Mississippi State, he had averaged 5.4 points as a freshman in 19 games and then 1.8 points in 25 games as a sophomore.

But LSU jump started his career and he became a vital part of the offense in Matt McMahon's first year, starting 23-of-31 games and averaging 8.0 points and 23.5 minutes per game.

After dealing with some off-season stomach issues that limited his preseason practice, he has been able to be full go for the Tigers, averaging 20.1 minutes per game.

He equaled his best game of the year at Alabama (1/27) in 19 minutes, hitting 6-of-9 three-pointers and both attempts from distance to score 14 points with six rebounds.

Against Tennessee (2/7) he hit 4-of-6 field goals including a three-pointer in recording his fifth double figure game of the year, 11 points in 25 minutes.

In his first start against Northwestern State (12/29) he responded with his fifth career double double (all at LSU) with 10 points and 10 rebounds. Fountain was 3-of-3 from the field and 4-of-5 at the free throw line.

He was a major factor in the win over North Texas (Nov. 17), hitting all six field goal attempts, including a three-pointer in scoring 14 points while grabbing a team high seven boards in 24 minutes. In the three Charleston games, he averaged 8.0 points and 5.0 rebounds in 20.7 minutes per game.

Against Kansas State (12/9) he hit 4-of-7 field goals to get eight points with a team best six boards and three steals in 26 minutes. He also had eight points in the win over Alabama State (12/13). Against Texas, Fountain was in double figures for the second time this season with 13 points in 32 minutes, hitting 6-of-9 field goals and a three-pointer. He also had three blocks.

Fountain overall is averaging 5.8 points and 4.1 rebounds, making 55-of-96 field goal attempts (57.3%).

MWANI WILKINSON

He's almost a survivor and a rarity in college basketball – a player who has stayed at the same school for all four years. After entering the transfer portal after his sophomore season, he decided to stay at LSU and play for Coach Matt McMahon. Unfortunately, his junior year was slowed by a preseason shoulder injury that he tried to play through, but after 12 games required surgery.

Again, his 2023-24 season has had a bump as he didn't dress for two games with a hip issue. He played for the first time in a couple of games against UGA (1/24), scoring two points with three rebounds and a block in six minutes of play.

At Alabama (1/27), Wilkinson had four points, hitting his first trey after a 0-for-16 slump from distance. He played 11 minutes against the Crimson Tide.

At Tennessee (2/7), Wilkinson played the most minutes since the season opener (20), hitting three three-point attempts in scoring nine points for the Tigers. After going through a long spell of no made threes, Wilkinson has made 5-of-9 in the last four games combined.

For the season Wilkinson is averaging 1.9 points and 1.4 rebounds.

TIGERS HAVE NINE DOUBLE FIGURE STEALS GAME

The Tigers remain number one in the league in steals, entering the weekend at 8.61 a game. LSU's double figure steal games:

Mississippi Valley (11/6) – 12; Nicholls (11/10) – 11; Wake Forest (11/19) – 13; North Florida (11/24) – 10; Kansas State (12/9) – 10; Lamar (12/21) – 12; Northwestern State (12/29) – 12; Vanderbilt (1/9) -- 11; Ole Miss (1/17) – 10

LSU has had three others games where they finished with nine steals.

SINGLE DIGIT TURNOVERS

It took to game 15, but the Tigers finally broke through with single digit turnovers against Vanderbilt (8) (1/9). That was the number of turnovers LSU had in the game against Texas A&M (1/20) as well.

Between the Vandy and second A&M game, the numbers went back up again as LSU struggled again to hold on to the ball against Auburn (1/13), giving up 17 miscues and more importantly, leading to 16 Auburn steals and 26 Auburn points off turnovers.

LSU is averaging 12.9 turnovers a game and 12.0 in the SEC games.

The Tigers have turned the ball over 323 times in 25 games. The Tigers have forced 331 turnovers.

LSU has averaged 16.0 points off turnovers, compared to 14.2 for opponents.

LOUISIANA INFLUENCE RETURNS

After a year away, the logo and phrase "Boot Up" has truly returned to the LSU Basketball program as five players have Southeast Louisiana ties to the program in 2023-24.

Carlos Stewart is from Baton Rouge and Jordan Wright is from Waggaman. Both played for The Dunham School in Baton Rouge. Stewart transferred from Santa Clara and Wright from Vanderbilt.

Jalen Cook played for LSU in the 2020-21 season and returns to Baton Rouge after two seasons at Tulane. He is from Walker. Hunter Dean is from Mandeville and came to LSU from George Washington.

Freshman Corey Chest hails from New Orleans where he played three years of high school before finishing up last year at The Link Academy in Missouri. He is being redshirted this season.

It is the most since there were eight players from Louisiana on the 2017-18 roster.

KENPOM RATES LSU EXPERIENCE HIGHER THIS YEAR

For the last several years, Kenpom.com had LSU's experience rating deep in the 300s of Division I teams.

But this year the experience is listed at 2.39 years which is listed as 77th in the rankings. The DI average this year is 1.83. This is one of the older rosters in recent LSU basketball history with 11 players who are at least in their third year of college basketball.

Three players – Jordan Wright (Vanderbilt), Will Baker (Nevada), Hunter Dean (George Washington) – are grad transfers, while Trae Hannibal is a fifth-year senior thanks to the pandemic season of 2020.

CARLOS STEWART

Carlos Stewart has missed the last 10 games with a minor knee injury with no return date announced.

The Baton Rouge native didn't see the floor in the game in Houston against Texas (Dec. 16), but played 21 minutes against Lamar (Dec. 21) and posted his first double figure game at LSU with 16 points with three assists and three steals with just one turnover. Stewart was 5-of-9 from the field, including 4-of-8 from distance.

It was his first three-point attempts since he went 0-of-3 at Syracuse (11/28) and 0-of-4 versus Southeastern (12/1).

Stewart, who started the first seven games, returned to the starting lineup against Northwestern State (12/29) where he had seven points, two steals in 26 minutes.

For the season, he is averaging 4.7 points, 2.2 rebounds and 1.0 assists per game.

DAIMION COLLINS

Daimion Collins was playing well against North Florida (11/24), having scored nine points and grabbed four rebounds on 4-of-6 shooting in 13 minutes before he dislocated his right shoulder in the second half. He missed six games before returning to game action against Northwestern State (12/29).

He has been able to go through non-contract practice since then, but has not dressed for an SEC game. He had played just a combined three minutes in games against Dayton and Wake Forest with a DNP against North Texas in the three games in Charleston prior to the North Florida game.

His season best was 11 points in the opener against Mississippi Valley (11/6) in the opener.

Against Northwestern State, Collins played 13 minutes and had two points and two rebounds.

He is averaging 4.3 points and 2.2 rebounds.

The Tigers host Mississippi State Saturday night in the SEC Network nightcap at 7:30 p.m. at the Maravich Center. The game will also be broadcast on the affiliates of the LSU Sports Radio Network.
