Noting the Golden Eagles

- Southern Miss will play its 108th football season in 2024, having first fielded a team in 1912. The Golden Eagles are 617-462-27, which is 43rd best among FBS teams by win percentage (.570).
- The Golden Eagles play in their fourth different conference in their football history, after holding a spot in the Southern Intercollegiate Athletic Association from 1931-41, the Gulf States Conference from 1948-1951 and Conference USA from 1996-2021, before starting play in the Sun Belt Conference for the 2022 season.
- The program has collected 24 winning seasons since 1994 and appeared in 19 bowl games during that time.
- Overall, Southern Miss has enjoyed 74 winning seasons and five years of .500 football over its history. Since 2000, the Golden Eagles have had 18 of 24 winning seasons.
- Against the current membership of the Sun Belt Conference, the Golden Eagles are 80-38-1 versus league foes, having never met James Madison.
- The 2022 LendingTree Bowl was the 27th bowl appearance for the Golden Eagles as they hold an 12-15 record overall in postseason games.

The Kentucky Series

- The Golden Eagles meet the Wildcats for the fifth time with Kentucky holding a 3-1 advantage in the series.
- The lone win in the series for Southern Miss happened to open the 2016 season - the school's 100th season - by scoring 34 unanswered points to win in Lexington, 44-35. The Golden Eagles trailed 35-10 with 56 seconds remaining in the first half. The comeback was the largest in school history as Nick Mullens threw 258 yards and two touchdowns and both Ito Smith (173) and George Payne (100) rushed for at least 100 yards to lead the Golden Eagles in the come-from-behind victory.
- Southern Miss also suffered a 71-7 setback to UK on Sept. 17, 1949, to open that season in the two team's first meeting and also lost a 32-0 decision on Oct. 4, 1986. Both games were played in Lexington.
- The only other meeting between the two schools came in Hattiesburg, Sept. 2, 2017, with UK taking a 24-17 decision at The Rock.

Against the SEC

- Southern Miss has dropped eight-straight games against SEC foes. The last win over an SEC team came in the 2016 win at Kentucky.
- The Golden Eagles are 35-117-3 against the current configuration of the SEC, having played Alabama (6-37-2), Arkansas (0-1), Auburn (5-18), Florida (0-5), Georgia (2-3), Kentucky (1-3), LSU (1-2), Ole Miss (6-18), Mississippi State (14-15-1), Missouri (0-1), South Carolina (0-1), Tennessee (0-6) and Texas A&M (0-7). The Golden Eagles have never played Vanderbilt or league newcomers Texas or Oklahoma in football.
- The Golden Eagles snapped a 13-game losing streak against SEC foes when they defeated Kentucky in 2016. The previous victory for Southern Miss in defeating an SEC foe was on Sept. 16, 2000, when they blanked Alabama 21-0 at Legion Field in Birmingham.
- The Golden Eagles are 4-16 against SEC foes in season openers with the last victory over an SEC squad coming in 2016.
- Since 1964, the Golden Eagles played at least one SEC school in a season for 45 consecutive years, before that streak ended during the 2009 season. Southern Miss has played at least one SEC game 54 years over the last 60.
- This will be the seventh-straight road game for Southern Miss versus the SEC.

Will Hall

Head Football Coach | Fourth Season - 13-24 (.351) / Overall - 10th Season 69-44 (.611)

At his introductory press conference in December of 2020 as the 22nd head coach of Southern Miss football, Will Hall spoke about how 'attitude is everything' in his initial comments to those in attendance at Reed Green Coliseum.

That attitude has provided a relentlessly positive approach in how he has communicated and prepared his players, elevated the growth of every facet of this football program, while also energizing a fan base since first taking the stage as the Golden Eagles top football coach.

In his opening season for the Golden Eagles, adversity struck hard for the program as the Golden Eagles saw most of their quarterback corps go down due to injury during the early portion of the season. Despite that fact, the Golden Eagles remained upbeat each week and transitioned its offense that many fans dubbed the "Superback" featuring a running back overseeing the offense from a shotgun position toward the latter part of the campaign.

That transition allowed the Golden Eagles to win two of their final three games of the campaign, while also almost knocking off the league champion, UTSA, in San Antonio.

Hall also oversaw a Nasty Bunch defense that provided many highlights, including holding its opponents to the second fewest first downs in the country (197), while collecting the fourth most fumble recoveries (13). The defense gave up just 358.5 yards per game, which ranked No. 3 in Conference USA and No. 42 in the country. Southern Miss bettered their national ranking in total defense by 18 spots from the previous year.

In year two, the Golden Eagles made great strides in the school's first year in the Sun Belt Conference, bettering their win total by four from the previous season and reaching a bowl game for the first time since the 2019 season. The Golden Eagles defeated Rice, 38-24, in the LendingTree Bowl in Mobile, Ala., behind a school-record 329 rushing yards from Frank Gore, Jr., to give the school its first bowl win since 2016.

The Golden Eagles were also one of 16 FBS programs to play 10-win teams during the year and Hall registered arguably his biggest win of his early tenure in Hattiesburg against his old program, Tulane, 27-24, in New Orleans. The Green Wave went on to win 12 games, including a victory in the Cotton Bowl over USC.

At one point during the 2022 campaign, Southern Miss captured three-straight victories and won five of six games over that stretch.

His total offense national ranking jumped 28 spots from the previous season as the Golden Eagles ranked No. 8 in passing yards per completion (14.13), while Gore, Jr., became the school's first 1,000-yard rusher since Ito Smith in 2017.

On defense, the unit ranked No. 2 in tackles for loss (8.3 per game), No. 3 nationally in fourth down conversions (.231), No. 4 in sacks (3.38 per game) and defensive touchdowns (4), No. 7 in interceptions (17). On special teams, the Golden Eagles ranked fifth in blocked kicks (5), No. 14 in blocked punts (2) and No. 19 in punt returns (11.92).

In year three, it was Gore again that highlighted the Golden Eagle offense as he ranked No. 28 nationally in rushing yards per game at 94.3. He also was No. 35 in all-purpose yards per contest (112.67) and his total touchdowns of 13 ranked him No. 31 in the country. It was Gore's rushing that helped the Golden Eagles win consecutive games in November. Gore rushed for 131 yards in a home win over ULM, followed by a 158-yard, three touchdown performance the following week in an overtime victory at Louisiana. Gore finished his career ranked No. 3 in rushing at the school with 4,022 yards.

Teammate Jakarius Caston helped in the offensive attack by averaging 18.82 yards per catch, which ranked No. 13 in the country. The squad also saw the emergence of freshman quarterback Ethan Crawford, who started the final two games of the season and threw for 240 yards on 17-of-36 passing with three touchdowns and no interceptions. Southern Miss also ranked No. 6 in time of possession at 33 minutes, 12 seconds per contest.

The Golden Eagle defense showed a penchant for forcing turnovers, capturing 17 on the year, which ranked No. 46 in turnover margin in the country. Southern Miss also returns its top tackler from a season ago, Dylan Lawrence, who posted 78 stops. Jalil Clemons also returns on defense after posting team highs for both sacks (5.5) and tackles for loss (11.0).

The special teams also enjoyed a solid season in 2023 as Andrew Stein finished No. 29 nationally in field goals made per game (1.42), while Ti Mims finished No. 2 in punt return touchdowns with one, and No. 13 in punt returns at 11.1 yards per return. Antavious Willis ranked No. 32 in the country in yards per kickoff returns at 22.2 and 10th in combined kick returns with 645.

Over his first three seasons, Hall has put together his roster of mostly Mississippi players and the 2023 roster had 71 players, or 66.4 percent of the team, represented by the Magnolia State.

Hall, a native of Amory, Miss., came to Southern Miss after serving the previous two years as offensive coordinator at Tulane.

Hall made an immediate impact on the Tulane offense and helped the Green Wave rewrite their offensive record books. He helped Tulane post one of the most successful offensive seasons in program history in 2019. The Green Wave finished the season ranked 11th in the nation in rushing offense (243.2), 22nd in total offense (449.3) and 30th in scoring offense (33.1). Hall helped the Green Wave

rush for over 200 yards in nine games in 2019 and over 300 times four times.

The Tulane offense set the program record in rushing yards at 3,162 yards in 2019. The offense ranked second in program history in rushing yards per game (243.2), rushing touchdowns (33) and rushing first downs (166).

Tulane's offense also eclipsed 500 yards five times, including a season-high 634 total yards against UConn. The Green Wave also set a season-high in passing yards against the Huskies with 323.

In 2020, the Green Wave enjoyed more success offensively as they finished No. 17 nationally in rushing offense (217.1), No. 19 in first downs (258) and No. 22 in scoring offense (34.7), while adding two more 500-yard total offensive games to his resume.

Hall joined the Green Wave coaching staff after he spent the 2018 campaign as the Associate Head Coach/Tight Ends Coach at the University of Memphis where he helped guide the Tigers to the American Athletic Conference Championship game for the second straight season and helped the Tigers to their fifth straight bowl appearance.

During his lone season at Memphis, Hall helped guide the Tigers to a school record with 42 rushing touchdowns during the regular season. In addition, Memphis finished the regular season with 3,311 rushing yards, setting a new school record.

Memphis' offense ranked in the nation's top 10 in rushing (No. 5, 275.9), scoring offense (No. 6, 43.8) and total offense (No. 6, 530.3) under Hall's assistance. In addition, Hall helped four Memphis offensive players earn All-AAC honors.

Hall joined the Memphis staff in January 2018 after spending the 2017 season as the offensive coordinator for the Louisiana-Lafayette Ragin' Cajuns, where six offensive players received all-conference honors.

In his one season as offensive coordinator at Louisiana-Lafayette, the Ragin' Cajuns compiled the Sun Belt Conference's third-best rushing offense with 2,204 yards and 27 rushing touchdowns.

In his three-year head coaching stint at West Georgia (UWG), Hall led the Wolves to a 31-9 record, the first Gulf South Conference (GSC) title since 2000 and a pair of NCAA Division II semifinal appearances. His first two seasons at UWG produced a pair of 12-win seasons before he finished 7-4 in 2016.

Success was immediate for Hall as the Wolves set multiple school records, won their first GSC title in 14 years and reached the NCAA Division II playoffs.

Under his direction, a program that had not made an impact in the conference, much less nationally, in over a decade transformed into the talk of the nation in NCAA Division II. Under Hall's direction, the Wolves were nationally ranked for 17 weeks consecutively and earned the program's first No. 1 national ranking on Oct. 26, 2015.

Hall's first UWG squad in 2014 caught more than a few people by surprise. The Wolves finished the regular season strong with a 9-2 record and earned the program's first NCAA playoffs bid since 2000. Road wins at Tuskegee, Delta State, and Valdosta State were the first postseason victories in the school's Division II history and gave UWG the NCAA Super Region 2 title.

Though UWG caught no one by surprise in 2015, it didn't matter. Hall's juggernaut roared through the first nine games of the regular season, all wins, and none were closer than a 17-point margin. A three-touchdown, Week 8 win over nationally ranked North Alabama pushed the Wolves into the top spot in the nation in Division II for the first time in school history.

Hall was twice named GSC Coach of the Year and was the Super Region 2 Coach of the Year.

From 2011-13 as the head coach at West Alabama, his teams won two league titles and twice earned spots in the NCAA Division II Playoffs.

Hall's players also have had success at the next level, and among that group of honored athletes is 2015 Super Bowl hero and current Tennessee Titan Malcolm Butler, who was a two-time All-GSC performer for Hall at West Alabama. In the spring of 2016, offensive tackle Dominique Robertson became the first UWG player in school history to receive an invitation to the NFL Draft Combine.

Prior to his six seasons at West Alabama, Hall enjoyed successful stints on the coaching staff at Arkansas-Monticello, Southwest Baptist, Henderson State, and Presbyterian. Hall's achievements in the coaching profession are a carryover from his illustrious career on the playing field at North Alabama.

Hall played for his father, Bobby Hall, at Amory High School leading the Panthers to the 1998 Mississippi High School Athletic Association (MHSAA) Class 3A state title. From 1999-2000, he attended Northwest Mississippi Community College, where he was a two-time National Junior College Athletic Association (NJCAA) All-American.

In 2000, Hall set a NJCAA record for total offense in a season (4,075 yards) and added an NJCAA single-game record with nine touchdown passes.

Hall then moved to North Alabama, where he was a quarterback for the Lions from 2002-03. He won the Harlan Hill Trophy in 2003, emblematic of being America's top player in NCAA Division II. In 2003, Hall, who threw for 3,531 yards and 30 touchdowns, led the Lions to a 13-1 record and an NCAA Division II semifinals appearance.

A 2003 graduate of North Alabama, Hall, and wife Rebecca, have two sons - Tripp and Pete.

Last Time Versus Kentucky

Kentucky 24, Southern Miss 17 Sept. 2, 2017

HATTIESBURG, Miss. - For a long moment or three Saturday afternoon, it appeared Southern Miss might just turn back the clock and mount a second-half comeback to take down Kentucky in a second, consecutive season opener.

But a 74-second swing late in the third quarter gave the Wildcats enough of a cushion and the Golden Eagles thwarted themselves down the stretch, falling 24-17 to Kentucky before 22,761 at M.M. Roberts Stadium.

Southern Miss did plenty right. The defense held Kentucky to 254 yards total offense, including 76 rushing. The offense took 78 snaps compared to Kentucky's 55, and gained 364 yards.

But the Golden Eagles did more than enough wrong to come up short. Three lost fumbles that led to 14 Kentucky points. A failed fake punt that set up a Wildcat field goal. A 48-yard kickoff return with a personal foul penalty that set up a 37-yard scoring drive by Kentucky. A slew of end-game penalties that short-circuited the Golden Eagles' comeback hopes.

In 2016, USM rallied for a 44-35 victory at Lexington, Ky., and after trailing 14-3 at halftime, it looked as if another comeback might be in the works.

Southern Miss went 85 yards on six plays early in the third quarter, with Griggs throwing his first career touchdown for the Golden Eagles and cutting Kentucky's lead to 14-10 with 10:40 left in the third quarter.

But a gamble with a fake punt from the Kentucky 45-yard line came up far short, and signaled the start of the 74-second swing.

The Wildcats drove far enough after the fake punt to set up Austin MacGinnis' 41-yard field goal for a 17-10 lead with 2:03 left in the quarter.

On the ensuing possession, safety Darius West knocked the ball from Griggs as he rolled left, sending it back to the USM 20-yard line. Ware scooped up the loose ball and scored to put the Wildcats ahead 24-10 with 49 seconds to play in the period.

Griggs and Roberts connected again to cap an 11-play, 75-yard scoring drive at the start of the fourth quarter, but the Golden Eagles could not get out of their own way down the stretch.

With Kentucky at its own 8-yard line with less than 5 minutes to play, an unsportsmanlike conduct penalty on a first-and-15, was followed by a defensive holding call on third-and-11 from the Kentucky 31 with about 3 1/2 minutes to play.

Both penalties gave the Wildcats first downs and forced Southern Miss to burn its last two timeouts.

After forcing Kentucky to punt, three penalties on the return included two, block-in-the-back flags as well as an unsportsmanlike conduct penalty. That left the Golden Eagles on their own 4-yard line with 1:37 to play and no timeouts.

Southern Miss played two quarterbacks, with sophomore Keon Howard starting and playing all but one snap in a first half that ended with the Golden Eagles trailing 14-3. Howard completed 7 of 14 passes for 87 yards.

Robertson finished with a career-high 111 yards on seven catches and logged his first-ever multi-touchdown game with scoring catches of 42 yards in the third quarter and 26 yards in the fourth.

The Wildcats, in general, bottled up the Southern Miss ground game, and specifically, senior tailback Ito Smith.

Smith, who rushed for 173 yards and a touchdown against the Wildcats last season, was limited to 37 yards rushing on 16 carries. Smith did grab a game-high and career-best nine passes for 78 yards, giving him 115 all-purpose yards.

Southern Miss dodged an early Kentucky threat when quarterback Stephen Johnson II hit tight end C.J. Conrad for a 58-yard gain to the Golden Eagles' 4-yard line.

But on first-and-goal, Snell was stripped of the ball by defensive tackle Rod Crayton and safety Tarvarius Moore gobbled up the Golden Eagles' first takeaway of the season at USM's 3.

Kentucky's pass blitz got to Howard late in the first quarter with linebacker Josh Allen sacking and forcing the ball out, with defensive end Denzil Ware recovering the fumble at the USM 14.

The city of Hattiesburg leads the way with nine Golden Eagles, followed by four from Madison and three each from Brandon, Starkville and Tylertown.

Golden Eagles Enjoying Third Season in Sun Belt Conference

- After spending 26 seasons in Conference USA, the Golden Eagles start their third Sun Belt Conference season in 2024.
- The Golden Eagles are part of a 14-team Sun Belt that are separated in the East (App State, Coastal Carolina, Georgia Southern, Georgia State, James Madison, Marshall and Old Dominion) and West (Arkansas State, Louisiana, South Alabama, Southern Miss, Texas State, Troy and ULM) division. JMU, ODU and Marshall joined the Golden Eagles as first-year members during the 2022 season.
- Southern Miss played at Troy for its first Sun Belt contest on Oct. 8, 2022, dropping a 27-10 decision.
- Southern Miss won five Conference USA titles during its tenure, including one since divisional play started in 2005. They captured their only league title contest and the school's fifth overall C-USA league crown when they beat Houston, 49-28, in 2011.
- The school's other C-USA titles came in the inaugural season of 1996 as well as the 1997, 1999 and 2003 campaigns. The Golden Eagles also won two East Division crowns in C-USA (2006, 2011), and captured their first West title in 2015 after moving to that division during the 2014 campaign. Southern Miss won its third division title in 2015, but lost in the C-USA championship game at WKU, 45-28. Southern Miss were 1-2 in C-USA title games.
- Along with the five C-USA titles, the Golden Eagles also won three additional league titles - 1948, 1950, 1951 - when they were members of the Gulf States Conference.

The Offensive Line

On the first week depth chart, Southern Miss features only one offensive lineman that has made starts for the Golden Eagles and another that have started games at the FBS level on their potential starting lineup this week. Left tackle Gabe Cavazos, Jr. holds seven starts for Southern Miss to start the 2024 campaign, while transfer right guard Dontae Lucas has 35 career starts over five seasons with Florida State (14 in three seasons) and South Alabama (21 over the last two seasons). Wil Saxton and Drew Lawson are both expected to make their first collegiate starts for the Golden Eagles at left guard and center, respectively, while junior college transfer Greg Nunnery looks to start at right tackle. Only one other Golden Eagle, Kyron Barnes has started on the offensive line for the Golden Eagles, having done it 10 times over the last two seasons. He is currently injured to start the 2024 campaign.

Golden Eagles Graduate Frank Gore, Jr.

Frank Gore, Jr., finished his four-year career last fall by registering the third-most rushing yards in school history. Gore rushed for 1,131 yards a season ago with 10 touchdowns on the ground and finished his four-year career with 4,022 yards, trailing just Damion Fletcher (5,302) and Ito Smith (4,538) on the school career chart. Gore is one of three Southern Miss running backs that have finished their career over 4,000 yards rushing.

New Offensive and Defensive Coordinators

Southern Miss will have the services of a new offensive and defensive coordinator for the 2024 season as Chip Long has taken over the offensive coordinator duties from offensive line coach Sam Gregg. Greg Bignell, who comes to Southern Miss from Eastern Illinois, takes over the role as defensive coordinator as well as coaching the safeties position.

Golden Eagles Enjoy Two Quarterbacks That Can Start at UK This Week

Both redshirt junior Tate Rodemaker, a transfer from Florida State, and sophomore Ethan Crawford could see action under center this week when the Golden Eagles travel to Kentucky. Rodemaker transferred from Florida State after four seasons, where he threw for 901 yards on 68-of-118 with five interceptions and seven touchdown passes. Last season, he threw for 519 yards on 32-of-56 throws with five touchdowns and no picks.

Crawford appeared in six games last season for Southern Miss in his true freshman campaign and threw for 240 yards on 17-of-36 attempts with three touchdowns and no picks. He started the final two games of the year at Mississippi State and at home versus Troy.

The Golden Eagles also could see true freshman John White at QB, who attended Madison-Ridgeland Academy last season.

A Trio of Running Backs for the Golden Eagles to Start 2024

With Gore, Jr., not returning in 2024, the Golden Eagles will look to three returning backs, including Rodrigues "Dreke" Clark and Kenyon Clay, as well as JQ Gray, to lead the running game. Clark, a transfer from Memphis, ran for 429 yards and a pair of touchdowns in 10 games. Clay added 179 yards over 11 games with a rushing score. In limited action as a true freshman, Gray added six yards on three carries.

Ti Mims Returns to Lead Receivers

Ti Mims returns for his third season with the Golden Eagles as he led the team in catches with 39 a year ago. Mims enjoyed his best day at receiver at App State in 2023 with 10 catches for 141 yards. Both his catches and yardage were season bests for the team. Mims finished with 445 receiving yards with a pair of touchdown catches.

He also totaled 167 punt return yards and one touchdown. He ranked No. 2 in punt return touchdowns nationally and No. 13 in punt returns at 11.1 yards per return.

Not Turning the Ball Over

The Golden Eagles turned over the football just 15 times last season (8 INTs, 7 fumbles), which was the fewest turnovers they have allowed since 2009 (16), finishing No. 33 nationally in turnovers allowed. USM also ended 2023 plus-two in turnovers, forcing 17.

Nasty Bunch Continuing with Solid Performances Under Hall

After a down season in the defensive department, the Golden Eagles hope to regain some of their solid play that they enjoyed the two previous seasons.

In 2022, the Golden Eagles allowed an average of 372.2 yards per game (No. 58). They limited Liberty to just 194 yards over the first three quarters, while holding Miami to 10 points in the opening half and gave up only 198 yards to Tulane in the second half.

They held Arkansas State to 50 yards rushing, forced negative six yards rushing at Texas State, before restricting Louisiana to 69 yards rushing. At Coastal Carolina, after giving up 176 yards in the opening quarter, the defense held the Chanticleers to just 185 yards the remainder of the contest and forced three turnovers versus South Alabama before keeping ULM to only 232 total yards. Southern Miss held Rice to 55 total yards in the final period, including minus-six yards rushing to capture the LendingTree Bowl. They produced 22 turnovers, including a season-high four versus Louisiana, three versus Liberty and two at Troy and CCU.

USM limited their opponents to 23.5 points per game, which ranked No. 44 in the FBS.

Southern Miss finished 2021 at No. 42 nationally in total defense, allowing 358.5 yards per contest. The group finished No. 73 in the country in rushing defense (156.5 ypg), holding opponents to under 100 yards on the ground three times, and 24th in passing yards allowed at 202.0 per game.

The D-Line Returns Solid Players

Southern Miss' defensive line features four players that all have started in their Golden Eagle careers, including Jalil Clemons, who tallied 31 tackles a year ago with team highs of 11 tackles for loss for 45 yards and 5 1/2 sacks for 29 yards. Jalen Williams tallied 30 tackles with 1.5 tackles for loss and a half sack, while Kristin Booth added 29 stops in 2023 with three tackles for losses and two sacks. Demeco Roland notched 23 tackles last fall with 3.5 TFLs and a half sack.

The foursome have combined for 41 starts for the Golden Eagles, including 20 from Booth, 19 from Williams, seven from Clemons and two from Roland.

Top Tackler is Back on Defense

Graduate student Dylan Lawrence returns after leading the team in tackles a season ago. Lawrence, who transferred from Mississippi State prior to the 2023 season, posted 78 total tackles with a tackle for loss and one breakup. He enjoyed a season-high 11 stops versus Arkansas State last season.

A Pair of Kicking Specialists Return for 2024

Both Andrew Stein and Bryce Lofton are expected to take care of the place kicking and punts, respectively, as the Golden Eagles open the season. True freshman Luke Stewart is expected to handle the kickoff duties for Connor Gibbs, who was nursing an injury in the preseason.

Stein has converted 17-of-23 field goals and 27-of-28 extra points in 2023. Lofton averaged 40.4 yards per punt over 60 boots with a long of 57 yards. He collected 13 inside the opponent's 20 and ended the year with five punts of 50 or more yards.

When Gibbs had the duties, he averaged 60.2 yards per kickoff, including 15 touchbacks.

Seventh-Year Player Deep Snapping for the Golden Eagles

Brennen Milliron, who handles the Golden Eagle deep snapping duties, is in his seventh year of college football. After being a part of Troy's program for five seasons, Milliron came to Southern Miss prior to the 2023 campaign. He is one of 34 seventh-year players in FBS football this season. His brother, Carter, is a deep snapper at league foe Louisiana and is in his sophomore season.

The 2024 Schedule

- The 2024 Southern Miss football schedule shows the Golden Eagles playing seven teams that enjoyed winning records last season and 10 schools that played in bowl games.
- The Golden Eagles open the 2024 campaign with Kentucky for the third time since 2016.
- Southern Miss meets Southeastern Louisiana for the first time since 2011.
- USF and the Golden Eagles play for the first time since 2004 when they were both members of Conference USA.
- Southern Miss plays Jacksonville State for the first time since the 1946 season and lead that series 2-0.
- The winning streak over Louisiana extended to 11 games last season after winning at Lafayette in overtime, 34-31.
- The Golden Eagles make just their third trip to Monroe this season.
- Arkansas State and Southern Miss meet for the 13th time on the gridiron this fall.
- Southern Miss plays James Madison for the first time this season, marking the 78th different current FBS team that they will have played.
- Marshall returns to The Rock for the first time since the 2018 season when both teams were part of Conference USA.
- No home team has won in the four meetings between Southern Miss and Texas State.
- The Golden Eagles look for their first-ever win over South Alabama.
- Southern Miss looks to snap a three-game losing streak to Troy in the regular-season finale.

The Golden Eagles at Home

Since the start of the 1976 season, following the renovation of M.M. Roberts Stadium, the Golden Eagles have posted a 160-82 (.664) record at The Rock. The program has finished at .500 or better in home games for a season 39 times during that span.

Southern Miss in August

This will be the 11th game ever played for the Golden Eagles in the month of August as they have posted a 6-4 record during this month. The biggest victory of this month came on August 31, 1996, when the Golden Eagles went to Athens and defeated Georgia 11-7 at Sanford Stadium, ruining the debut of coach Jim Donnan. Southern Miss first played during this month on Aug. 31, 1991, in a 25-7 home win over Delta State.

Game 1: at Southern Miss 40, Alcorn State 14 (Sept. 2, 2023)

HATTIESBURG, Miss. (AP) – Billy Wiles threw for 267 yards and three touchdowns and Southern Miss was never threatened in a 40-14 season-opening win over Alcorn State on Saturday night at Carlisle-Faulkner Field at M.M. Roberts Stadium.

It was the first time Golden Eagle coach Will Hall has captured his season opener in three seasons.

The Golden Eagles' Jay Stanley came up with the first of two interceptions against Alcorn State quarterback Tyler Macon on the second play from scrimmage. Southern Miss took advantage and went up 7-0 when Wiles threw a 16-yard score to Jakarius Caston. After forcing the Braves to three-and-out, Frank Gore Jr. ended a seven-play, 63-yard drive for a two-score lead on a 9-yard run. Gore later added a 9-yard scoring reception from Wiles later in the opening half.

After a field goal put the Eagles up 17-0, with 3:50 left in the first quarter, Macon raced 75 yards for a touchdown for Alcorn State's biggest highlight of the contest. The play accounted for a third of the Braves' yardage total (226).

Wiles, who was making his first start for the Golden Eagles, finished 21-of-28 passing and Caston finished with five receptions for 104 yards and a score. It was Caston's first 100-yard receiving game of his career.

Stanley registered the first multiple interception game for the Golden Eagles since Ky'el Hemby by collecting two picks versus UTEP on Nov. 24, 2018.

Golden Eagle kicker Andrew Stein went four-for-four in field goal attempts, hitting from 25, 23, 52 and 41 yards. It was the first time since the 2019 season, spanning 1,371 days, that he attempted a field goal for the Golden Eagles.

Jordan Travis threw for 175 yards and two touchdowns, and backup Tate Rodemaker added a pair of touchdown passes in the third quarter. Travis' first touchdown, a 10-yard pass to Darion Williamson, gave him 50 career TD passes.

The Seminoles (2-0) have scored 35 or more points in eight straight games, the longest active streak in the nation. On Saturday, they did it in the third quarter — and before Southern Miss (1-1) found the end zone.

Caziah Holmes added a 40-yard touchdown run as the Seminoles ran for 306 yards. Florida State was able to move the ball at will even without starting offensive linemen Maurice Smith and Robert Scott.

Dreke Clark had 67 yards on 12 carries, including a 12-yard touchdown in the third quarter for Southern Miss, while Billy Wiles completed just 11 of 34 passes for 154 yards in his second college start for the Golden Eagles.

Andrew Stein also converted field goals of 30 and 40 yards as he has now collected eight-straight made field goals.

The Golden Eagles fell to 1-21 all-time against Associated Press teams ranked in the Top 5.

Game 4: at Arkansas State 44, Southern Miss 37 (Sept. 23, 2023)

JONESBORO, Ark. – Dominic Zvada belted a 21-yard field goal and quarterback Jaylen Raynor added a 62-yard scoring run just over a minute later deep in the fourth quarter to lift Arkansas State to a 44-37 Sun Belt Conference opener win over Southern Miss at Centennial Bank Stadium.

The late Red Wolves rally spoiled a 17-point, second-half comeback by the Golden Eagles as they dropped their third game in a row.

Frank Gore, Jr., rushed for a game-high 132 yards, putting him over 3,000 yards for his career as it also marked the ninth 100-yard rushing game of his career, tying him for sixth with Sammy Winder and Shelton Gandy.

After opening the game with a 12-play, 84-yard drive that was culminated on a two-yard Gore, Jr., run, the Red Wolves scored on their first four drives, taking advantage of a Southern Miss interception on their second drive and a blocked punt on their third drive which turned into 10 additional points for the home team.

Down just 20-17 at the half, A-State scored on their first two possessions of the second half, including a 60-yard pass from Raynor to Clayton Jackson on the first play of the third period. Raynor, who threw for 233 yards and three touchdowns on 11-of-22 passing with an interception, then added a eight-yard scoring rush some five minutes late to give the Red Wolves its biggest lead at 34-17.

The Golden Eagles rallied as Dreke Clark collected a 59-yard scoring run – the longest rushing play of the year for Southern Miss – and Andrew Stein converted the second of three field goals, from 42 yards out with 3:10 left in the third.

Southern Miss then tied the game at 34-34 on a 22-yard pass from Billy Wiles to Jakarius Caston early in the fourth quarter. Wiles finished with a season-high 215 on 20-of-36 passing with two interceptions and two TD passes.

Southern Miss fell to 7-1 under Will Hall when they scored 30 points in a game.

HATTIESBURG, Miss. (AP) — Ismail Mahdi returned the opening kickoff 100 yards for a touchdown and added three rushing touchdowns to highlight Texas State's 50-36 Sun Belt Conference victory over Southern Miss at M.M. Roberts Stadium.

Mahdi nearly had a fifth touchdown on a bizarre play in the third quarter. Bobcats quarterback TJ Finley was about to be sacked deep in Texas State territory but managed to flip the ball forward to Mahdi who took off down the sideline. As he approached the end zone, Southern Miss defensive back Jay Stanley knocked the ball loose and it bounced out of bounds in the end zone. The play was first ruled a touchdown, but the call was reversed and Mahdi was left with a 90-yard reception and a fumble for a touchback.

Texas State led 42-16 at the time but the Golden Eagles rallied, scoring touchdowns on their next three possessions for a 42-36 deficit. The Bobcats, who scored 42 points in the first half, finally got on the board again with a 14-yard run by Malik Hornsby with 1:39 left in the game. It was only a 3-play, 18-yard drive after the Bobcats stopped the Golden Eagles on downs.

Finley completed 19 of 24 passes for 339 yards with two touchdowns for Texas State (4-1, 1-0 Sun Belt). Mahdi had 89 yards rushing, 90 yards receiving and 117 yards in kick returns. Joey Hobert had 126 yards on 10 receptions and Ashtyn Hawkins caught five for 101 yards.

Billy Wiles went 21-for-45 for 275 yards with two touchdowns and an interception for Southern Miss (1-4, 0-2). Frank Gore Jr. had two touchdowns and 123 rushing yards and Latreal Jones had six receptions for 124 yards.

For Gore, it was his 10th 100-yard rushing game, which puts him in sixth place by himself on the school charts, while Jones added his first 100-yard receiving game. Wiles' passing total also was a season-high for the first-year Golden Eagles quarterback.

BOONE, N.C. — Joey Aguilar threw for 391 yards and four touchdowns, App State scored three fourth-quarter touchdowns, and the Mountaineers rallied for a 48-38 win over Southern Miss Saturday evening.

Jakarius Caston's 11-yard scoring run 59 seconds into the fourth quarter gave the Golden Eagles a 38-28 lead. App State (4-4, 2-2 Sun Belt) responded with a 78-yard scoring drive with Aguilar throwing a 49-yard scoring pass to Christian Horn. After forcing a punt, on the third play of the Mountaineers' drive, Kanye Roberts ran for a 61-yard score to make it 42-38 with 6:37 remaining. Southern Miss countered with a drive that took it to the Mountaineers' 30 but it ended with an incomplete pass on fourth-and-2.

Aguilar and Appalachian State closed it out with a six-play, 70-yard drive that ended with a 21-yard scoring pass to Horn for the final margin.

Horn finished with 165 yards receiving on eight catches and Roberts had 109 yards rushing with 13 catches.

Frank Gore, Jr. ran for 247 yards on 24 carries and scored twice, from 42 and 75 yards, for Southern Miss (1-7, 0-5) which had leads of 10 points three times.

Gore, Jr., posted his 11th, 100-yard rushing game in his career, tying for fifth in 100-yard rushing games at the school with Sam DeJarnette. Gore, Jr.'s 200-plus rushing yards was the 14th rushing game in school history with 200 or more yards. His 247 yards is the second most rushing yards for a Golden Eagle junior.

Ti Mims registered a career-high for both catches (10) and yards (141) as it was his first career 100-yard receiving game. He is the first Golden Eagle to collect 10 catches in a game since Jason Brownlee had 10 versus Troy last season.

Louisiana scored two fourth-quarter touchdowns to go up 28-21 with 5:55 remaining. But Ethan Crawford then led Southern Miss on a 10-play, 75-yard drive, capped by a 9-yard touchdown pass to Jakarius Caston, that tied it 28-28 with 1:26 left.
