HEAD COACH GATOR TODD



Gator Todd enters his first season as head coach of the Kentucky men's golf team in 2023-24. The former professional golfer comes to Lexington from Vanderbilt, where he spent six seasons, most recently as associate head coach.

Working alongside head coach Scott Limbaugh, Todd has helped lead VU to four top-10 finishes at the NCAA Championships, the first two NCAA Regional championships in school history and two Southeastern Conference crowns.

During Todd's time in Nashville, the Commodores accumulated 22 regular-season and postseason tournament titles. VU totaled 18 All-Americans – including six first-team honorees – 24 All-Region selections, four SEC Players of the Year and 18 first- and second-team All-SEC choices.

The 2022-23 Commodores won six team titles while advancing to the NCAA Championships for the ninth-consecutive season. Four Commodores earned Division I PING All-America honors, headlined by first-team selection and Ben Hogan Award finalist Gordon Sargent.

The 2021-2022 season, Todd's fifth in Nashville, was the best campaign in VU history. Todd helped lead the Commodores to a No. 2 end-of-season national ranking as Vandy won the stroke-play portion of the NCAA Championships, earning the No. 1 seed, and advanced to the semifinals in match play. Sargent won the NCAA individual title and was named national freshman of the year.

Todd, selected as a Golf Coaches Association of America representative for assistant coaches, was named a finalist for the 2022 Jan Strickland Outstanding Assistant Coach Award. The Commodores went 133-2 during the spring portion of the '22 schedule, marking one of the best runs in college golf history.

In 2021 Todd helped sign the nation's No. 1 recruiting class as Vandy added Gordon Sargent and Jackson Van Paris. Sargent entered college as the No. 1 junior in the World Amateur Golf Rankings as well as being tabbed National Player of the Year by USA Today.

Todd came to Vanderbilt after spending one season at Marquette. Marquette won the 2017 Big East title and, along with head coach Steve Bailey, Todd was part of the Coaching Staff of the Year. Todd coached All-Big East players Oliver Farrell and Matt Murlick as well as Big East Freshman of the Year Matthew Bachmann. Marquette advanced to its third NCAA Regional appearance in program history.

From 2010-2015, Todd competed in more than 75 professional events in the United States, Europe and South America. He earned 17 top-10 finishes during that time on the PGA and EPGA Tours. In 2011 Todd advanced to the final stage of PGA Qualifying school after finishing tied for second at the second stage of PGA Tour Q School. He went on to earn conditional status on the Nationwide Tour for the 2012 season.

While competing as a professional, Todd was based and experienced high-level instruction at The Sea Island Golf Performance Center in St. Simons Island, Georgia, under world renowned and PGA winning instructors Todd Anderson and Randy Myers. The GPC was used by multiple major champions and Ryder Cup players such as Davis Love III, Lucas Glover, Zach Johnson, Brandt Snedeker and Harris English.

Todd played college golf at the University of Alabama under head coach Jay Seawell from 2004-08. Todd was a first-team All-SEC selection while notching 14 top-10 finishes in 44 tournaments, highlighted by a career-low round of 64. Todd played in three NCAA Championships and, in his senior season, the Tide won the 2008 SEC Championship for the first time

in more than 30 years and earned the program's first-ever season-ending No. 1 national ranking.

Todd is a native of Florence, Alabama, where he won the Alabama high school individual championship and was tabbed a junior golf All-American at Coffee High School. His father, Richard Todd, was a national champion quarterback at Alabama and was the sixth overall pick by the New York Jets and first quarterback taken in the 1976 NFL Draft.

Todd is married to the former Mary Katherine Lake of Tuscaloosa, Alabama, and they have a daughter, Sylvie.

ASSISTANT COACH CHIP MCDANIEL



Former Wildcat Chip McDaniel begins his first season as assistant coach of the Wildcats in 2023-24. A four-year letterwinner for the Wildcats and a 2018 graduate, McDaniel comes to Lexington after a year as an assistant coach for the men's and women's golf programs at Eastern Kentucky.

Prior to his coaching career, McDaniel spent four years playing professionally, making 43 starts on the Korn Ferry Tour and 11 on the PGA Tour. McDaniel notched seven top-20 finishes on the Korn Ferry Tour and highlighted his PGA Tour experience with a tie for fifth at the Corales Puntacana Resort and Club Championship in 2019 prior to making the cut at the 2019 U.S. Open at Pebble Beach Golf Links.

As a Wildcat, the Manchester, Kentucky, native played 133 rounds over 45 career tournaments, tallying a 72.02 scoring average. McDaniel, a 2016 PING Third-Team All-American and Second-Team All-SEC selection, also was an Academic All-SEC selection as a senior. Dating back to the 1993-94 season, McDaniel's career scoring average ranks second in program history, behind current Wildcat Alex Goff, and his 71.82 scoring average in the 2016-17 campaign is the third-best in that era. McDaniel won the individual title at the Grove Intercollegiate as a sophomore, participating in three NCAA Regionals and the two NCAA Championships.

McDaniel earned his bachelor's degree in accounting from Kentucky in May 2018. A graduate of Clay County High School, McDaniel was named Kentucky's Mr. Golf in 2011. A two-time winner of the Kentucky State Amateur, McDaniel was a three-time Kentucky PGA Junior Player of the Year, a four-time Kentucky Junior Am champion and 2013 Junior PGA champion.

ASSISTANT COACH JACOB COOK



Former Kentucky standout Jacob Cook enters his first season as an assistant coach of the Wildcats in 2023-24. A six-time Academic All-Southeastern Conference selection, Cook spent the 2022-23 season as an assistant coach at Rhodes College.

Cook, who received his bachelor's degree in business administration from Kentucky in 2020 before earning his master's in finance in 2022, returns to Lexington after competing in 32 career tournaments for the Wildcats. After redshirting in the 2016-17 season, Cook played in 13 tournaments over the next three seasons but really came on in the 2020-21 season, when he started all nine events, posting a 73.26 scoring average with 10 par-or-better rounds. Then in his graduate season, he started all 10 events, ranking second on the team with a 71.80 scoring average. He led the Wildcats with five top-10 finishes and six in the top-20.

Cook also excelled off the course, where he was an Academic All-SEC selection each season. He was a 2019-20 Early Wave Srixon/Cleveland Golf All-America Scholar and a record four-time SEC Community Service team honoree.

A native of Frankfort, Kentucky, Cook was a two-time Central Kentucky Golf Conference Player of the Year and all-state selection at Franklin County High School. He was Lexington City champion in 2020 and 2021 and a 2021 U.S. Amateur participant.
