KENTUCKY RACE NOTES

Southeast Regional

o The Southeast Regional is made up of all Division I schools in Kentucky, Virginia, North Carolina, and South Carolina. It is one of nine regionals that serve as qualifiers to the NCAA Championships. The top-two teams in each race, along with the next four fastest individuals, qualify. 13 at-large teams are also selected from around the country.

Men's Team

- o The Kentucky men are coming off a tenth place finish at the SEC Championships. Ed Bird and Collins Kiprop Kipngok each finished in the top 25, earning All-SEC honors.
- o Freshman Collins Kiprop Kipngok won his first collegiate title at the Bradley Pink Classic Red Invite, taking first in the 8k in a personal best--and meet record-- time of 23:32.7. He is the fourth fastest freshman in the SEC this season.
- o Sophomore Ed Bird won the Gans Creek Classic 8k in a personal best time of 23:07.6. The win was the first of his collegiate career in his only start this season. His time was a course and meet record.
- o The Wildcats finished 14th at the Southeast Regional in 2023.

Women's Team

- o Junior Ally Kruger has led the Wildcats in scoring at every meet this season, finishing in the top 25 at all four races. She ran a personal best 6k at the SEC Championships in 19:57.5.
- o Sophomore Lyric Olson and senior Mollie Roden have closed the season strong, recording personal best times and finishes at the Bradley Pink Classic. Roden continued her fine form with another PB at SEC Championships, acting as the second-leading scorer for Kentucky.
- o The Wildcats finished 17th at the Southeast Regional in 2023.

CDOSS COUNTRY

BACK2BACK

In each of Kentucky's last two regular season meets, a Wildcat runner won the Men's 8k individual title. Ed Bird took home the Gans Creek Classic crown in a course--and meet--record time of 23:07.6. Collins Kiprop Kipngok followed that performance up with a win at the Bradley Pink Classic in a meet record time of 23:32.7. Both runners picked up their first collegiate win in the process.

MS. CONSISTENT

Ally Kruger has been a model of consistency for the Cats this season, leading her team in scoring at all three regular season meets. Additionally, she has finished within the top 20 in all three races.

FIRST OF MANY

Collins Kiprop Kipngok picked up his first career SEC honor on October 1, as he was named the SEC Freshman of the Week for his performance at the Gans Creek Classic. The Nakuru, Kenya native improved his collegiate debut time by some 12 seconds, running 23:33.0. While only placing 15th, the time was better than the previous course and meet record.

BIRD IS THE WORD

Sophomore Ed Bird ran the race of his life at the Gans Creek Classic, storming down the stretch to earn the first individual win of his career. His only race of the 2024 season to date, Bird ran the second fastest time in the SEC in September. The 2023 SEC All-Freshman Team member smashed his previous personal best as well, besting his mark from 2023 by over a minute. Bird also won the bronze medal in the 3000m at the World Athletics U20 Championships in August.

LAST ONE. BEST ONE

Senior Phoebe McCowan is enjoying a breakout season campaign for the Cats. In both of the regular season races in which she has ran, she has bettered her personal best by 15 seconds (one in the 5k, one in the 6k) and served as the team's No. 2 scorer.

FAST GREENS

At the Gans Creek Classic, 19 Wildcats ran personal best times. All 10 men in the Kentucky lineup set new personal standards while 9 of the 10 women also clocked their lifetime best.

JACK ATTACK

Graduate transfer Jack Pendergast has enjoyed a breakout final season in his only year in Lexington. Transfering in from Iowa, he has lowered his personal best in each of his three races this year. Most recently, he earned his first career top ten finish, placing 8th at the Bradley Pink Classic.

A DEBUT FOR THE AGES

Collins Kiprop Kipngok kicked off his collegiate career in style, placing fifth at the Southern Showcase in a time of 23:45.9. His run was the fastest 8k collegiate debut by a Kentucky runner since AT LEAST 2012 and was the fastest 8k season opener by a Wildcat runner since 2017. He has since gone on to become the fastest freshman in the tenure of Coach Hakon DeVries.
